Behold, **THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN** is at hand! Yeshua's Good News message was about **the Kingdom of Heaven**. This was never a message about another religion called Christianity. Yeshua's message about **the Kingdom of Heaven** loses its Power and influence if we put it into a man made religious box which is not found anywhere in the Bible. His is **a KINGDOM Message! The Kingdom of Heaven** is truly now at hand, even much more so than ever before in history. Let's read God's Words on this subject **God's Word** (Mount Sinai) + **God's Spirit** (Mount Zion) = preparations for **KING** YESHUA and **His Coming KINGDOM!**

Luke 16:16 "The Torah and the prophets were until Yochanan; since that time **the Kingdom of God is proclaimed**, and everyone (today) presses into it."

John 3:3 Yeshua answered and said to him, Truly, truly, I say to you, **Except a man be born again**, **he cannot see the Kingdom of God.** 3:4 Nicodemus said to Him, How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? 3:5 Yeshua answered, Truly, truly, I say to you, **Except a man be born of water and the Spirit**, he cannot enter into the Kingdom of God.

Matthew 18:1 At the same time the disciples came to Yeshua, saying, Who is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven? 18:2 And Yeshua called a little child to Him, and set him in the midst of them, 18:3 And said, Truly I say to you, unless you are changed **and become as little children**, **you shall not enter** into the Kingdom of Heaven. 18:4 Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child shall be greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven. Matthew 19:14 But Yeshua said, Permit the little children to come to Me, and do not forbid them, for of such is the Kingdom of Heaven.

Mark 10:14 But when Yeshua saw it, He was much displeased, and said to them, Suffer **the little children** to come unto Me, and forbid them not, for of such is the Kingdom of God. 10:15 Truly I say to you, Whosoever shall not receive the Kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter.

Luke 18:16 But Yeshua called them to Himself, and said, Permil the little children to come to Me, and forbid them not, for of such is the Kingdom of God. 18:17 Truly I say to you, Whosoever shall not receive the Kingdom of God as a little child shall in no wise enter.

Enter the Kingdom of Heaven through the New Covenant ratified in Yeshua's Blood

a New Covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah, 31:32 not according to the Covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, which My Covenant they broke, although I was a Husband unto them, says the LORD. 31:33 But this shall be **the Covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD, I will put My Torah in their minds, and write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 31:34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD. For they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD.

For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

Matthew 26:26 And as they were eating, Yeshua took bread, and blessed it, and broke it, and gave it to the disciples, saying, Take, eat, **this is My Body**. 26:27 And He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink you all of it, 26:28 for **this is My Blood** of **New Covenant** which is shed for many for the remission of sins. 26:29 But I say to you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in **My Father's Kingdom**.

Luke 22:15-20 And He said to them, With desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. For I say to you, I will not any more eat it until it be fulfilled in the Kingdom of God. And He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves. For I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until **the Kingdom of God** shall come. And He took bread, and gave thanks, and broke it, and gave it to them saying, This is **My Body** which is given for you; this do in remembrance of Me. Likewise also after supper He took the cup, saying, This cup is **the New Covenant in My Blood** which is shed for you.

Mark 14:22-25 And as they did eat, Yeshua took bread, and blessed, and broke it, and gave it to them, and said, Take, eat! **This is My Body**. And He took the cup, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, and they all drank of it. And He said to them, **This My Blood of the New Covenant**, which is shed for many. Truly I say to you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in **the Kingdom of God**.

John 6:47 Trully, truly I say to you, He that believes in Me has Everlasting Life. 6:48 **I Am that Bread of Life**. 6:50 This is the Bread which comes down from Heaven, that a man may eat of, and not die. 6:51 I am the Living Bread which came down from heaven. If any man eat of this Bread, he shall live forever. And the Bread that I will give is **My flesh**, which I shall give for the life of the world. 6:53 Then Yeshua said to them, Truly, truly, I say to you, Except you eat the flesh of **the Son of man**, and drink **His Blood**, you have no life in you. 6:54 Whoso eats My flesh, and drinks My Blood, has Eternal Life; and I will raise him up at the last day. 6:55 For My flesh is meat indeed, and My Blood is drink indeed. 6:56 He that eats My flesh, and drinks My Blood, abides in Me, and I in him. 6:57 As the Living Father has sent Me, and I live by the Father, so he that eats of Me, even he shall live by Me. 6:58 This is that Bread which came down from Heaven ... he that eats of this Bread shall live forever. 6:63 It is the Spirit that quickens; the flesh profits nothing: the Words that I speak to you **are Spirit**, and are **Life**.

Matthew 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water to repentance, but He that is coming after me is Mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear. He shall baptize you with the Holy Spirit, and with fire, 3:12 whose fan is in His hand, and He will throughly purge His floor, and gather His wheat into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire. (also see Mark 1:8; Luke 3:16,17)

Matthew 28:18-20 And Yeshua came and spoke to them, saying, All Power and Authority is given to Me in Heaven and on earth. 28:19 Go therefore, and <u>make disciples of all nations</u>, **baptizing them** in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. 28:20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. And, lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the Age. Amen.

Mark 16:15 And He said to them, Go into all the world, and preach the Good News to every creature. 16:16 **He that believes and is baptized shall be saved**; but he that does not believe shall be damned.

Let's look at Old Covenant Scriptures on 'the Kingdom of God'

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let Us make **man** in Our image, after Our Likeness. And **let them have <u>dominion</u>** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and <u>over all the earth</u>, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth. 1:27 So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created He them. 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said to them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it, **and have <u>dominion</u>** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moves upon the earth.

Exodus 19:6 And you shall be to Me a Kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 17:15 You shall surely set him as king over you, one whom the LORD your God shall choose, one from among your brethren you shall set as king over you,. You may not set a stranger over you, which is not of your brothers. 17:16 But he shall not multiply horses to himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt, to the end that he should multiply horses, forasmuch as the LORD has said to you, You shall henceforth return no more that way. 17:17 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his not heart turn away, neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold. 17:18 And it shall be, when he sits upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write himself a copy of this Torah in a book out of that which is before the priests, the Levites. 17:19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this Torah and to do these statutes. 17:20 That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren, and that he turn not aside from the commandments to the right hand or to the left to the end that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel.

2Samuel 7:12 And when your days (David) are fulfilled, and you sleep with your fathers, I will set up your seed after you, which shall proceed out of your bowels, and I will establish his kingdom. 7:13 He shall build a house for My name, and I will stablish the Throne of his kingdom forever. 7:14 I will be His father, and he shall be My son. If he commits iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men. 7:15 But My mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took it from Saul ... 7:16 And your house and your Kingdom shall be established forever before you; your Throne shall be established forever.

1st Kings 9:5 Then I will establish the throne of your kingdom (Solomon) over Israel forever, as I promised to David your father, saying, There shall not fail you a man upon the throne of Israel.

1st Chronicles 16:14 He is the LORD our God. His judgments are in all the earth. 16:15 Be you always mindful of His Covenant; the word which He commanded to a thousand generations; 16:16 Even of the covenant which He made with Abraham, and of His oath to Isaac; 16:17 And He has confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an Everlasting Covenant, 16:18 saying, Unto you will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance.

1Chronicles 17:11 And it shall come to pass, when your days are expired that you must go to be with your fathers, that <u>I will raise up your seed after you, which shall be of your sons</u>. And <u>I will establish His Kingdom</u>. 17:12 He shall build Me **a House**, and I will stablish His Throne **forever**. 17:13 I will be His Father, and He shall be My Son, and I will not take My mercy away from him, as I took it from him who was before you. 17:14 But I will settle Him in My House and in My Kingdom **forever**: and His Throne shall be established **forevermore**.

1st Chronicles 22:9 Behold, a son shall be born to you (David), who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about. For his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quietness unto Israel in his days. 22:10 He shall build a house for My name; and he shall be My son, and I will be his Father; and I will establish the Throne of his kingdom over Israel forever.

1st Chronicles 28:4 Howbeit the LORD God of Israel chose me before all the house of my father to be king over Israel forever. For He has chosen Judah to be the ruler; and of the house of Judah, the house of my father; and among the sons of my father He liked me to make me king over all Israel. 28:5 And of all my sons, (for the LORD has given me many sons) he has chosen Solomon my son to sit upon the throne of the Kingdom of the LORD over Israel.

1st Chronicles 29:11 Yours, O LORD, is the Greatness, and the Power, and the Glory, and the Victory, and the Majesty. For all that is in the heaven and in the earth are Yours. Yours is the Kingdom, O LORD, and You are exalted as Head above all.

2nd Chronicles 13:5 Ought you not know that the LORD God of Israel gave the kingdom over Israel to David forever, even to him and to his sons by a covenant of salt?

2nd Chronicles 36:22 Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the Word of the LORD spoken by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and also put it in writing, saying, 36:23 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia, All the kingdoms of the earth has the LORD God of heaven given me. And He has charged me to build Him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah.

Ezra 1:1 Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the Word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and put it also in writing, saying, 1:2 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven has given me all the kingdoms of the earth, and He has charged me to build Him a house at Jerusalem, in Judah.

Psalm 8:4 What is man, that You are mindful of him? and **the son of man**, that You visit him? 8:5 For You have made him a little lower than Elohim, and have crowned him with glory and honour. 8:6 You made him to have **dominion** over the works of Your hands. You put all things under his feet.

Psalm 22:27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn to the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before You. 22:28 For the Kingdom is the LORD'S, and He rules over the nations.

Psalm 45:6 Your Throne, O God, is forever and ever, the scepter of Your Kingdom is a right scepter.

Psalm 103:19 The LORD has prepared His Throne in the Heavens; and His Kingdom rules over all.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us **a Child** is born, unto us **a Son** is given. And the Government shall be upon His shoulder. And His name shall be called **Wonderful**, Counsellor, **the Mighty God**, **the Everlasting Father**, **Prince of Peace**. 9:7 Of the increase of His Government and Peace there shall be no end upon **the Throne of David** and over His Kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with Judgment and with Justice from henceforth even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Psalm 145:12 To make known to the sons of men His Mighty acts, and the Glorious Majesty of His Kingdom. 145:13 Your Kingdom is an Everlasting Kingdom, and Your Dominion endures throughout all generations.

Isaiah 37:16 O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, who dwells between the cherubims, You are God, even You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth.

Isaiah 60:12 For the nation and kingdom which will not serve You shall perish; yes, those nations shall be utterly wasted.

Daniel 4:3 How Great are His signs! and how Mighty are His wonders! **His Kingdom** is **an Everlasting Kingdom**, and His Dominion is from generation to generation.

Daniel 4:34 And at the end of the days, I, Nebuchadnezzar lifted up my eyes to heaven, and my understanding returned to me, and I blessed the Most High, and I praised and honored Him who lives forever, whose Dominion is an Everlasting Dominion, and His Kingdom is from generation to generation 4:35 and all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing. And He does according to His will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth, and none can stay His hand or say to Him, What are You doing?

Daniel 7:13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like **the Son of man** came with the clouds of Heaven, and came to **the Ancient of days**, and they brought Him near before Him. 7:14 And there was given Him **Dominion**, and **Glory**, and **a Kingdom**, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve Him. His Dominion is **an Everlasting Dominion**, which shall not pass away, and **His Kingdom** one which shall not be destroyed.

Daniel 7:18 But the saints of the Most High shall take the Kingdom, and possess the Kingdom forever, even forever and ever. 7:27 And the Kingdom and Dominion, and the greatness of the Kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High, whose Kingdom is an Everlasting Kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey Him.

Obadiah 1:21 And saviors shall come up on Mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the Kingdom shall be the LORD'S.

Matthew 3:1 In those days came **Yochanan** the baptizer, proclaiming in the wilderness of Judaea, 3:2 and saying, "**Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand!**"

Matthew 4:17 From that time **Yeshua** began to proclaim, and to say, "**Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand!**"

Matthew 4:23 And Yeshua went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and <u>preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom (of Heaven)</u>, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit; theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven. 5:10 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven.

Matthew 5:19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of the least of these commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the Kingdom of Heaven; but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven. 5:20 For I say to you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you shall in no wise enter into the Kingdom of Heaven.

Matthew 6:9 After this manner shall you therefore pray, Our Father who are in Heaven, hallowed be Your name. 6:10 Your Kingdom come. Your will be done on earth, as it is in Heaven. 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Yours is the Kingdom, and the Power, and the Glory, forever. Amen. (also see Luke 11:2)

Matthew 6:32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek) for your Heavenly Father knows that you have need of all these things. 6:33 But seek first the Kingdom of God, and His Righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Matthew 7:21 Not every one that says to Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the Kingdom of Heaven; <u>but he that does the will of My Father</u> which is in Heaven.

Matthew 8:11 And I say to you, That many shall come from the east and the west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob in the Kingdom of Heaven. 8:12 But the children of the Kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness. There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 9:35 And Yeshua went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew 10:5 These twelve Yeshua sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter into any city of the Samaritans. 10:6 But go rather to the lost sheep of the House of Israel. 10:7 And as you go, proclaim, saying, The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand. 10:8 <u>Heal the sick</u>, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils; freely you have received, freely give.

Matthew 11:11 Truly I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen a greater than Yochanan the baptizer. Notwithstanding he that is least in the Kingdom of Heaven is greater than he (Yochanan). Matthew 11:12 And from the days of Yochanan the baptizer until now the Kingdom of Heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force. 11:13 For the Torah and all the prophets prophesied until Yochanan.

Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the Kingdom of God has come to you.

Matthew 13:11 He answered and said to them, Because it is given to you to know the mysteries of the Kingdom of Heaven, but to them it is not given. 13:18 Hear therefore the parable of the sower. 13:19 When any one hears the Word of the Kingdom, and understands it not, then comes the wicked one, and catches away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side. 13:24 Another parable He put forth to them, saying, The Kingdom of Heaven is likened to a man which sowed good seed in his field: 13:31 Another parable He put forth to them, saying, The Kingdom of Heaven is like a grain of mustard seed, which a man took and sowed in his field: 13:33 Another parable He spoke to them; The Kingdom of Heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened. 13:38 The field is the world. The good seed are the children of the Kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one. 13:41 The Son of man shall send forth His angels, and they shall gather out of His Kingdom all things that offend, and those which do iniquity; 13:42 and shall cast them into a furnace of fire. There shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. 13:43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the Kingdom of their Father. Who has ears to hear, let him hear. 13:44 Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like treasure hid in a field; which

when a man has found, he hides, and for joy goes and sells all that he has, and buys that field. 13:45 Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls. 13:46 Who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had, and bought it. 13:47 Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a net that was cast into the sea, and gathered of every kind, 13:48 which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away. 13:49 So shall it be at the end of the world. The angels shall come forth and sever the wicked from among the just. 13:50 And shall cast them into the furnace of fire. There shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. 13:52 Then He said to them, Therefore every scribe which is instructed in the Kingdom of Heaven is like a man that is a householder, which brings forth out of his treasure things new and old. (Mark 4:11)

Matthew 16:19 And I will give you <u>the keys</u> of the Kingdom of Heaven. And whatsoever you shalt <u>bind on earth</u> shall be bound in heaven, and whatsoever you shalt <u>loose on earth</u> shall be loosed in heaven.

Matthew 16:28 Truly I say to you, There are some standing here, who shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in His Kingdom.

Matthew 18:23 Therefore is the Kingdom of Heaven likened to a certain king, which would take account of his servants.

Matthew 19:23 Then Yeshua said to His disciples, Truly I say to you, that a rich man shall hardly enter into the Kingdom of Heaven. 19:24 And again I say to you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the Kingdom of God.

Matthew 20:1 For the Kingdom of Heaven is like a man that is a householder, which went out early in the morning to hire labourers into his vineyard.

Matthew 21:43 Therefore say I to you, The Kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a people bringing forth the fruits thereof.

Matthew 22:2 The Kingdom of Heaven is like a certain king, which made a marriage for His Son, 22:3 and sent forth His servants to call them who were bidden to the wedding, and they would not come. 22:4 Again, He sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared My dinner. My oxen and My fatlings are killed, and all things are now ready. Come to the marriage!

Matthew 23:13 But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the Kingdom of Heaven to men; for you neither go in yourselves, neither allow them that are entering to go in.

Matthew 24:14 And this Gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness to all nations; and then shall the end come.

Matthew 25:1 Then shall **the Kingdom of Heaven** be likened to ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet **the Bridegroom**. 25:2 And five of them were wise, and five were foolish. 25:3 They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them. 25:4 But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. 25:5 While the Bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. 25:6 And at Midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the Bridegroom comes; go out to meet him. 25:10 **The Bridegroom came**. **They that were ready** went in with Him to the marriage ... door was shut.

Matthew 25:14 For the Kingdom of Heaven is as a Man travelling into a far country, who called His own servants, and delivered to them his goods.

Matthew 25:34 Then shall the King say to them on His right hand, Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

Mark 1:14 Now after Yochanan was put in prison, Yeshua came into Galilee preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom of God, 1:15 and saying, The time is fulfilled, and the Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe the Gospel.

Mark 9:1 And He said to them, Truly I say to you, That there are some of you that stand here which shall not taste of death until they have seen the Kingdom of God come with Power.

Mark 9:47 And if your eye offend you, pluck it out. It is better for you to enter into the Kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.

Mark 10:23 And Yeshua looked round about, and said to His disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the Kingdom of God! 10:24 And the disciples were astonished at His words. But Yeshua answered again, and said to them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the Kingdom of God! 10:25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the Kingdom of God.

- Mark 11:10 Blessed be the Kingdom of our father David, that comes in the name of the LORD. Hosanna in the highest.
- Mark 15:43 Joseph of Arimathaea, an honorable counsellor, who also waited for the Kingdom of God, came, and went in boldly to Pilate, and requested the body of Yeshua.
- Luke 1:33 And He shall Reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His Kingdom there shall be no end. (Isaiah 9:7)
- Luke 4:43 And He said to them, <u>I must proclaim the Kingdom of God</u> to other cities also; <u>for therefore am I sent</u>.
- Luke 6:20 And He lifted up His eyes on His disciples, and said, Blessed be you poor, for yours is the Kingdom of God.
- Luke 8:1 And it came to pass afterward, that He went throughout every city and village, preaching and showing the glad tidings of the Kingdom of God; and the twelve were with him.
- Luke 9:1 Then He called His twelve disciples together, and gave them Power and Authority over all devils, and to cure diseases. 9:2 And He sent them to proclaim the Kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.
- Luke 9:11 And the people, when they knew it, followed Him. And He received them, and spake to them of the Kingdom of God, and healed them that had need of healing.
- Luke 9:60 Yeshua said to him, Let the dead bury their dead. But you go and preach the Kingdom of God. 9:62 And Yeshua said to him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the Kingdom of God.
- Luke 10:9 And heal the sick that are therein, and say to them, The Kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.
- Luke 11:20 But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the Kingdom of God is come upon you.
- Luke 17:20 And when He was demanded by the Pharisees when the Kingdom of God should come, He answered them and said, The Kingdom of God comes not with observation. 17:21 Neither shall they say, Look here, or look there! For, behold, **the Kingdom of God is within you**.

Luke 12:31 But rather seek the Kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. 12:32 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you **the Kingdom**.

Luke 13:28 There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when you shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets in the Kingdom of God, and you yourselves thrust out. 13:29 And they shall come from the east, and from the west, and from the north, and from the south, and shall sit down in **the Kingdom of God**.

Luke 18:24 And when Yeshua saw that he was very sorrowful, He said, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the Kingdom of God! 18:25 For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the Kingdom of God.

Luke 18:29 And He said to them, Truly I say to you, There is no man who has left house, or parents, or brethren, or wife, or children, for the Kingdom of God's sake, 18:30 who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come **Life Everlasting**.

Luke 19:11 And as they heard these things, He added and spake a parable, because He was near to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the Kingdom of God should immediately appear. 19:12 He said therefore, A certain Nobleman went into a far country to receive for Himself a Kingdom, and to return. 19:13 And He called His ten servants, and delivered to them ten pounds, and said to them, **Occupy till I come!** 19:14 But His citizens hated Him, and sent a message after Him, saying, We will not have this Man to Reign over us. ... 19:27 But those enemies of Mine, who would not that I should Reign over them, bring them here, **and slay them before Me**.

Luke 22:29 And I appoint to you a Kingdom, as My Father has appointed to Me; 22:30 that you may eat and drink at My table in My Kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

Luke 23:42 And he said to Yeshua, **Lord, remember me when You come into Your Kingdom.** 23:43 And Yeshua said to him,

Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me **in Paradise**.

John 18:36 Yeshua answered, **My Kingdom is not of this world.** If My Kingdom were of this world, then My servants would fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews. But My Kingdom is not from hence.

Luke 24:27 And beginning with Moses and all the prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures (of the Tanakh) the things concerning Himself. 24:44 And He said to them, These are the words which I spoke to you while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Torah of Moses, and the Prophets, and the Psalms concerning Me. 24:45 Then He opened their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures, 24:46 and said to them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved the Messiaht to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day. 24:47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name among all the nations, beginning at Jerusalem. 24:48 And you are My witnesses of these things. 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of My Father upon you. But tarry in Jerusalem, until you are endued with Power from on high.

Acts 1:3 To whom He also shewed Himself alive after His passion by many infallible proofs, being seen by them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to **the Kingdom of God**.

Acts 1:6 When they therefore were come together, they asked Him, saying, Lord, will You at this time **restore again the kingdom** to Israel?

KINGDOM Of GOD, AS TAUGHT by YESHUA'S DISCIPLES

Acts 8:12 But when they believed Philip's preaching of the things concerning the Kingdom of God, and the name of Yeshua the Messiah, they were baptized, both men and women.

Acts 14:22 Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the Kingdom of God.

Acts 19:8 And he (Paul) went into the synagogue, and spoke boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading them of the things concerning the Kingdom of God.

Acts 20:25 And now, behold, I know that you all, among whom I have gone preaching the Kingdom of God, shall see my face no more.

Acts 28:23 And when they had appointed for him a day, there came many to him to his lodging; to whom he expounded and testified of the Kingdom of God, persuading them concerning **Yeshua** both out of the Torah of Moses and out of the Prophets, from morning till evening.

Acts 28:30 And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came to him, 28:31 preaching the Kingdom of God, and teaching with all confidence those things which concern the Lord Yeshua the Messiah, no man forbidding him.

1st Corinthians 4:20 For the Kingdom of God is not in word, but in Power.

1st Corinthians 6:9 Know you not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the Kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 6:10 nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the Kingdom of God.

1Corinthians 15:23 But every man in his own order: Messiah, the firstfruits, and afterward those who are Messiah's at His Coming. 15:24 Then comes the End, when He shall deliver up the Kingdom to God His Father; when He shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. 15:25 For He must Reign until He has put all enemies under His feet. 15:26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. 15:27 For He has put all things under His feet. But when He says all things are put under Him, it is evident that He which did put all things under Him is excepted. 15:28 And when all things shall be subdued under Him, then the Son also shall Himself be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all.

1st Corinthians 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the Kingdom of God; neither does corruption inherit incorruption.

Galatians 5:21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like, of which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the Kingdom of God.

Ephesians 5:5 For know this, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the Kingdom of Messiah and of God.

Colossians 1:13 Who has delivered us from the power of darkness, and has translated us into the Kingdom of His dear Son. 1:14 In whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins.

2nd Timothy 4:1 I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Yeshua the Messiah, who shall judge the quick and the dead at His appearing and His Kingdom; 4:2 Preach the word; be instant in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

2nd Timothy 4:18 And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me to His Heavenly Kingdom; to whom be Glory forever and ever. Amen.

Hebrews 12:28 Wherefore we receive a Kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and Godly fear.

And the seventh angel sounded!
And there were great voices in heaven, saying,
The kingdoms of this world have become Kingdoms of our LORD,
and of His Messiah, and He shall reign forever and ever.
Revelation 11:15

Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in Heaven, Now is come Salvation, and Strength, and **the Kingdom** of our God, and the Power of His Messiah. For the accuser of our brethren is cast down, who accused them before our God day and night. 12:11 And **they overcame him by the Blood of the Lamb**, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives even to the death.

Your eyes will see **the KING** in His Beauty; they will see the land (Heaven) that is very far off. Isaiah 33:17
