The Temple on Mount Moriah versus The Temple of our heart! Which Temple does God desire to build and dwell in?

And the LORD your God will <u>circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants</u> to love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, **that you may live!** Deuteronomy 30:6 (Jeremiah 4:4) [Except the LORD builds the House, they labor in vain that build it. Psalm 127:1]

Both Orthodox Jews and Messianic Jews want God's blessings of **Eternal Life!** This can never be attained through our efforts or our works; only God gives us the gift of **Eternal Life** with Him!

God has told us repeatedly that **our sins and our iniquities** have separated us from a Holy God. Isaiah 59:1-3 God has also said that all our righteounesses are like <u>filthy rags</u>. Isaiah 64:6 There is <u>only one basis</u> by which a Holy God can forgive our sins in order for us to receive **Eternal Life**; and this is a free gift for all: "He (Messiah) was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities...and by His stripes we are healed!" Isaiah 53:5 **Eternal Life** can only be attained <u>by accepting Yeshua's Sacrifice!</u>

The Orthodox 3rd Temple will soon be built in Jerusalem: Does God want to come down to dwell in man's Temple on Mount Moriah? Man's religion: man's control, distant and impersonal relationship with God. Exodus 25:8 Let them make Me a Sanctuary (Mikdash). (the 1st Sanctuary) This will be a work of **the Aaronic priesthood**, from the sons of Levi.

The Messianic Temple is inside every believer's heart and spirit! God desires to come down and dwell in an earthly Temple inside our heart! God's Reality: God's control with our surrender, for a deep and personal and intimate relationship (**sonship**) with God as our real Father; we His true sons. [After we confess and repent of all our sins, and ask Lord Yeshua to forgive us, and to come and live in our heart and in our spirit, and to be our Lord and Savior, then God, the Holy Spirit, comes in and lives inside our heart.] Jeremiah 31:31 God puts His Torah in my mind, and writes it on my heart. Ezekiel 36:24-28 God gives me a new heart and a new spirit, and God puts His Spirit within me, and causes me to walk in His ways & forgives my sins.

John 14:23 If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him! Ephesian 3:19 To know the Love of Messiah which passes knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

1 Corinthians 3:16 Do you not know that you are the temple of God

and the Spirit of God dwells in you.

The Restored Tent of David is a forerunner for Messiah's future Temple. This is found in Isaiah 16:5 and Amos 9:11-15. The real Messiah now sits on His Throne as KING - Priest in the Tent of David, Judging, seeking Justice, and hastening Righteousness ... (the coming of our KING and the Kingdom of Heaven to earth)! This is the Melchi Zedek priesthood, the Priesthood of Heaven! Psalm 22:3 But You are Holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel. God promised that the restored Tent of David will bring the greatest Kingdom revival and harvest of souls that the earth has ever seen! This will begin at the end of Gog-Magog war (Ezekiel 39:22, 29).

As the Orthodox Jews begin putting up their man made Temple on the Temple Mount, <u>God will begin pouring out His Spirit at the lowest place</u>, the base of Zion, ben Hinnom Valley, by Jaffa Gate, outside Old City of Jerusalem. Jeremiah 7:30, 31; 32:34-42; 31:40

Messiah's Millinneal Temple: King Yeshua builds this Temple! "Behold **the Man** whose name is **the Branch!... He shall build** the Temple of the LORD. Yes, He shall build the Temple of the LORD! Zechariah 6:12,13 I will put My Sanctuary (Mikdash) in their midst forever! Ezekiel 37: 26-28; [Psalm 68:16; 132:13; Isaiah 60:13; Ezekiel 43:5-7; Micah 4:7; Zech 1:16] 2nd Samuel 7:12-16 "When your days (David) are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your Son after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish His Kingdom. He shall build a House **for My name**, and I will establish the Throne of His Kingdom forever. I will be to Him a Father, and He shall be to Me a Son. My steadfast love will not depart from Him. And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before Me. Your throne shall be established forever." 1st Chronicles 17:11-13 When your days are fulfilled (David) to walk with your fathers, I will raise up one of your own sons, and I will establish His Kingdom. He shall build a House for Me, and I will establish His Throne forever. I will be to Him a Father, and He shall be to Me a Son.
