He was the Perfect Son, Perfectly Surrendered and Reflecting His Father's nature, in Word and Deed, at all times. **He manifested His Father's Name Perfectly through His own Name 'Yeshua'!**

And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My Beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." (Matthew 3:17)  
Jesus said to him, "...He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father' "? (John 14:9)

"At that Day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you." (John 14:20)

Matthew 9:28

And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that **I Am** able to do this?" They said to Him, "Yes, Lord."

Matthew 11:28-30

"Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for **I Am Gentle and Lowly in Heart**, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where **I Am**, that they may behold My Glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.”

“Indeed the hour is coming, yes, has now come, that you will be scattered, each to his own, and will leave Me alone. And yet **I Am** not alone, because the Father is with Me.”

Pilate therefore said to Him, “Are You a king then?” Jesus answered, “You say rightly that **I Am King**. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the Truth. Everyone who is of the Truth hears My voice.”

Jesus said to her, “Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, ‘**I Am** ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.’ ”

Isaiah 6:1-3

I saw the Lord (Adonai) sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one cried to another and said: “**Holy, Holy, Holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!**”

Then **the Spirit of the LORD came upon Jahaziel** the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, in the midst of the assembly. And he said, “Listen, all you of Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you, King Jehoshaphat! Thus says the LORD to you:

**‘Do not be afraid** nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God’s. Tomorrow go down against them. They will surely come up by the Ascent of Ziz, and you will find them at the end of the brook before the Wilderness of Jeruel. **You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of the LORD, who is with you, O Judah and Jerusalem! Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for the LORD is with you.’**”

And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground, and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem bowed before the LORD, worshiping the LORD. Then the Levites of the children of the Kohathites and of the children of the Korahites stood up to praise the LORD God of Israel with voices loud and high. So they rose early in the morning and went out into the Wilderness of Tekoa; and as they went out, **Jehoshaphat stood and said:**

**“Hear me, O Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem: Believe in the LORD your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper.”**

And when he had consulted with the people, **he appointed those who should sing to the LORD, and who should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army and were saying: “Praise the LORD, for His Mercy endures forever.”**

Now when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushes against the people of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; and they were defeated. For the people of Ammon and Moab stood up against the inhabitants of Mount Seir to utterly kill and destroy them. And when they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir, they helped to destroy one another.



So when Judah came to a place overlooking the wilderness, they looked toward the multitude; and there were their dead bodies, fallen on the earth. No one had escaped. When Jehoshaphat and his people came to take away their spoil, they found among them an abundance of valuables on the dead bodies, and precious jewelry, which they stripped off for themselves, more than they could carry away; and they were three days gathering the spoil because there was so much. 2 Chronicles 20:14-25
