All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

Matthew 8:16-17 (witness #2)

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demonpossessed. And He cast out the spirits **with a Word**, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "<u>He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses!</u>"

1st Peter 2:21-24 (witness #3)

"For to this you were called, because the Messiah also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps. Who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in His mouth. Who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return. When He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges Righteously; who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for

righteousness, by whose stripes you were healed!"

And when He had opened the book, He found the place (61:1,2) where it was written: "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has Anointed Me to preach the Gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable Year of the LORD."

Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing!"

Acts 10:34-38

Then Peter opened his mouth and said: "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him. The Word which God sent to the children of Israel, preaching Peace through Jesus the Messiah, He is Lord of all, that Word you know, which was proclaimed throughout all Judea, and began from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached. How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with Power, who went about doing good, and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."

Malachi 4:2-3

"But to you who fear My Name, **the Sun of Righteousness** shall arise **with healing in His Wings**; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. You shall trample the wicked, for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the Day that I do this," says the LORD of hosts.

Isaiah 49:6-10

Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved ones of Israel;

I will also give You as a Light to the Nations, that You should be My Salvation to the ends of the earth.' And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the Kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. Then His fame went throughout all Syria. And they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics. And He healed them!

I John 3:7-9

Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is Righteous. He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. **For this purpose the Son of God was manifested,** that He might destroy the works of the devil. Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God.

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life! No one comes to the Father except through Me!"

Matthew 9:35

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, <u>teaching</u> in their synagogues, <u>preaching</u> the gospel of the Kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew 12:10-13,15

And behold, there was a man who had a withered hand. And they asked Him, saying, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?", that they might accuse Him. Then He said to them, "What man is there among you who has one sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will not lay hold of it and lift it out? Of how much more value then is a man than a sheep? Therefore it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath." Then He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched it out, and it was restored as whole as the other.

... And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all!

John 10:10

"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy.

<u>I have come that they may have Life,</u>
and that they may have it more abundantly!"

Matthew 8:2-3

And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean." Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Matthew 14:14

And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, **and healed their sick**.

Isaiah 42:6-7

"I, the LORD, have called You in Righteousness, and will hold Your Hand; I will keep You and give You as <u>a Covenant to the people</u>, as <u>a Light</u> to the Nations, to open blind eyes, to bring out prisoners from the prison, those who sit in darkness from the prison house.

Matthew 15:30-31

Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them. So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

Luke 13:11-13,16

And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up. But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, "Woman, be loosed from your infirmity." And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. "So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound, think of it, eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?"

Mark 1:32-34

Now at evening, when the sun had set, they brought to Him all who were sick and those who were demon-possessed. And the whole city was gathered together at the door. Then **He healed many** who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him.

Mark 5:27-29

When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well." Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction.

Mark 5:35,36,39-42

While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue's house who said, "Your daughter is dead! Why trouble the Teacher any further?" As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not be afraid, only believe!" When He came in, He said to them, "Why make this commotion and weep? The child is not dead, but sleeping." And they ridiculed Him. But when He had put them all outside, He took the father and the mother of the child, and those who were with Him, and entered where the child was lying. Then He took the child by the hand, and said to her, "Talitha, cumi," which is translated, "Little girl, I say to you, arise." Immediately the girl arose and walked, she was twelve years of age. And they were overcome with great amazement.

Mark 3:10-12

For He healed many, so that as many as had afflictions pressed about Him to touch Him. And the unclean spirits, whenever they saw Him, fell down before Him and cried out, saying, "You are the Son of God!"

Luke 4:40-41

When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them. And demons also came out of many, crying out and saying, "You are the Messiah, the Son of God!" And He, rebuking them, did not allow them to speak, for they knew that He was the Messiah.

Luke 5:17-26

Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the Power of the Lord was present to heal them. Then behold, men brought on a bed a man who was paralyzed, whom they sought to bring in and lay before Him. And when they could not find how they might bring him in, because of the crowd, they went up on the housetop and let him down with his bed through the tiling into the midst before Jesus. When He saw their faith, He said to him, "Man, your sins are forgiven you." And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, "Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?" But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, He answered and said to them, "Why are you reasoning in your hearts? Which is easier to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Rise up and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has Power on earth to forgive sins." He said to the man who was paralyzed, "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." Immediately he rose up before them, took up what he had been lying on, and departed to his own house, glorifying God. And they were all amazed, and they glorified God and were filled with fear, saying, "We have seen strange things today!"

Luke 6:17-19

And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases, as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed. And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for Power went out from Him, and healed them all.

Luke 9:11

But when the multitudes knew it, they followed Him. And He received them, and spoke to them about the Kingdom of God, and healed those who had need of healing.

John 8:31,32,34-36

Then Yeshua said to those Jews who believed Him, "**If you abide in My Word**, <u>you are My disciples indeed</u>. **And you shall know the Truth**, **and <u>the Truth shall make you free</u>**." Yeshua answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever."

"Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed!"

Hebrews 2:14-16

Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death, He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is the devil, and release (us) those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. For indeed He does not give aid to angels, but He does give aid to the seed of Abraham.

Psalm 23:1-6 (a psalm of David...)

'The LORD is my Shepherd! I shall not want. He makes me to lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside the still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in the paths of Righteousness for His Name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me. Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil, my cup runs over. Surely Goodness and Mercy shall follow me all the days of my life. And I will dwell in the House of the LORD forever.'

Matthew 6:9-13 (Jesus gave us this special prayer...)

"Our Father in Heaven, <u>hallowed be Your Name</u>. Your Kingdom come. Your will be done on earth, as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread (God's healing and deliverance). And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Yours is the Kingdom, and the Power, and the Glory forever! Amen."

Leviticus 17:11

'For **the life of the flesh is in the blood**, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make **atonement** for your souls; for **it is the blood** that makes atonement for the soul.'

"Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people; for ... He will provide **Atonement** for His land and His people." Deuteronomy 32:43

Jesus, the Great High Priest of God, 'Melchi-Zedek', offered the **Perfect Atonement Sacrifice** for humanity, Himself, His own Flesh and **Blood** which had no sin, in exchange for the sins of His Creation. Jesus, which in Hebrew is 'Yeshua', [meaning 'Salvation'], came into this world to bring **God's Salvation to all of His lost sons and daughters**. He came to unite us together in Him and in His Love, and to bring us back to His Father, our Father, the Creator of Heaven and Earth!

John 11:21-27, 38-41,42-44

Then Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, <u>my brother would not have died</u>. But even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You." Jesus said, "**Your brother will rise again**." Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the Resurrection at the last day."

Jesus said to her, "I Am the Resurrection and the Life! He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die!

Do you believe this?" She said to Him, "Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Messiah, the Son of God, who is to come into the world."

Then Jesus, again groaning in Himself, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay against it. Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of him who was dead, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there is a stench, for he has been dead four days." Jesus said to her, "Didn't I say to you that if you would believe you would see **the Glory of God?**" And Jesus lifted up His eyes and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me. And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the people who are standing by I said this, that they may believe that You sent Me." Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, **Come forth!**"

And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go!"

God's Word says we are healed; we were healed 2000 years ago, when Messiah Jesus took our sins and sicknesses upon Himself, and died for us upon the Tree just outside Jerusalem!

Hebrews 13:8

Yeshua, the Messiah, is the same yesterday, today, and forever!

Isaiah 53:4,5

Surely **He has borne our sicknesses and carried our sorrows**; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But **He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities**; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him,

and by His stripes we are healed!

Mark 10:27

But Jesus looked at them and said, "With men it is impossible, but not with God. For with God all things are possible!"

God cannot lie! **So what's the Problem?**Whose report are we believing, our physical symptoms or feelings, and medical doctor's reports? Or are we believing the Good Report given to us in God's Word, fulfilled by Jesus, the Great Physician?

We receive our healing from God, and from God's Living Word, by standing firm, believing what God's Word says.

Acts 10:38

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with Power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."

For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. 1st John 3:8

Sickness and disease are from the devil! The devil and his demons have attempted to put symptoms, sicknesses, and diseases upon us. If our bodies, and our carnal minds (senses) accept these conditions, then we claim them as our own. But if we stand on the Word of God, and **resist them** ...

Our bodies are unsaved, and our carnal minds do not believe the Word of God; they only believe the conditions of the body.

Proverbs 23:7

For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he!

Jesus said to him, "**If you can believe**, <u>all things are possible to him</u> who believes." Mark 9:23

We must contend for our healings and for our well being by obeying God and standing on the Word of God, and resisting all the attacks of the devil, with his symptoms, and sicknesses and diseases. For God has given us **Power and Authority** over all the works of the devil, through the Name of Jesus, and the Word of God.

Luke 10:19

Joshua 1:5-9

"No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the Torah which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.

And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming the Word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

John 14:12-17

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the Works that I do he will do also; and Greater Works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My Name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

If you ask anything in My Name, <u>I will do it!</u> If you love Me, keep My commandments.

And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another **Helper**, that He may abide with you forever, even **the Spirit of Truth**, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. But you know Him, for <u>He dwells with you</u> and will be in you!"

Matthew 10:1,7,8

And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, <u>He gave them Power</u> over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and (Power) to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease. "And as you go, preach, saying, 'The Kingdom of heaven is at hand!' **Heal the sick**, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give."

Matthew 18:18-20

"Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

Matthew 28:18-20

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All Authority

has been given to Me in heaven and on earth! Go therefore and make disciples in all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you.

And lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age!"

Luke 10:18-20

And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you <u>Authority</u> to trample on serpents and scorpions, and <u>over all the power of the enemy</u>, and <u>nothing shall by any means hurt you</u>. Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

Mark 3:13-15

And He went up on the mountain and called to Him those He Himself wanted. And they came to Him. Then He appointed twelve, that

they might be with Him, and that He might send them out to preach, and to have Power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out demons.

Mark 9:23

Jesus said to him, "If you can believe,

all things are possible to him who believes!"

Mark 6:7,12-13

And He called the twelve to Himself, and began to send them out two by two, <u>and gave them Power over unclean spirits</u>. So they went out and preached that people should repent. And <u>they cast out many demons</u>, and anointed with oil many who were sick, <u>and healed them</u>.

Mark 11:22-24

So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God! For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, <u>but believes</u> that those things he says will come to pass, <u>he will have whatever he says</u>. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, <u>believe that you receive them</u>, and you will have them!" (or) <u>believe that you have received them!</u>"

Luke 9:1,2,6

Then He called His twelve disciples together and **gave them Power** and Authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. He sent them to preach the Kingdom of God, and to heal the sick. So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere.

Luke 10:1-3,9,17

After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore **pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers** into His harvest. Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves. And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The Kingdom of God has come near to you.' "Then the seventy returned with joy, saying,

"Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name!"

Matthew 6:6

"But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, **pray to your Father who is in the secret place.**

And your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly."

Matthew 7:1,2,7-8

"Judge not, that you be not judged. For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you. Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened."

John 1:9-13

That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. But to as many as received Him, to them

He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name,

who were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but **of God!**

Matthew 21:21-22

So Jesus answered and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you, <u>if you have faith</u>, and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' it will be done! **And whatever things you ask in prayer**, <u>believing</u>, <u>you will receive!</u>" (or) <u>believe that you have received!</u>"

John 15:5-7

"I Am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.

If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you!"

John 15:16-17

"You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My Name He may give you! These things I command you, that you love one another."

John 16:23-24

"And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My Name He will give you.

Until now you have asked nothing in My Name.

Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full!"

Philippians 4:13

I can do all things through the Messiah who strengthens me!

Acts 3:2-8

And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the Temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms from those who entered the Temple; who, seeing Peter and John about to go into the Temple, asked for alms. And fixing his eyes on him, with John, Peter said, "Look at us." So he gave them his attention, expecting to receive something from them. Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the Name of Jesus the Messiah of Nazareth, rise up and walk." And he took him by the right hand and lifted him up, and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. So he, leaping up, stood and walked and entered the temple with them, walking, leaping, and praising God.

Acts 5:12,14-16

And through the hands of the apostles <u>many signs and wonders</u> were done among the people. And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, so that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least <u>the shadow of Peter</u> passing by might fall on some of them. Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and <u>they were all healed</u>.

Acts 8:5-7

Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and preached the Messiah to them. And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, <u>hearing and seeing the miracles</u> which he did. For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and **many who were paralyzed and lame were healed**.

Acts 19:11-12

Now **God worked unusual miracles** by the hands of Paul, so that even <u>handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body</u> to the sick, and the diseases left them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

I John 5:14-15

Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, <u>He hears us</u>. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know we have the petitions that we have asked of Him!

I John 4:16-18

God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him. Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the Day of Judgment; because as He is (the Majestic Lord, Reigning Gloriously in all Power), so are we in this world!

There is no fear in love; **but Perfect Love casts out fear**, because fear involves torment.

But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

Romans 8:31-32

If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

Ephesians 1:3-6

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus, the Messiah, **who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing** in the heavenly places in Messiah, just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him **in love**.

Having predestined us to **adoption as sons** by Messiah Jesus to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His Grace, by which **He has made us accepted in the Beloved**.

Ephesians 2:4-6

But God, who is rich in Mercy, because of His great Love with which He Loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Messiah (by Grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us <u>sit together in heavenly places</u> in Messiah Jesus...

Philippians 3:10

...<u>that I may know Him</u>, and the Power of His Resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death...

Revelation 12:11

"And they overcame him by the Blood of the Lamb and by the Word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death!"

I John 4:4

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because Greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world!

1 Peter 3:12

"For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and **His ears are open** to their prayers; but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."

Proverbs 28:1

The wicked flee when no one pursues, but the righteous are bold as a lion!

John 7:38

"He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow Rivers of Living Water!"

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore, if anyone is **in Messiah**, **he is a New Creation!**Old things have passed away; **behold**, **all things have become new.**

Matthew 7:11,12 [Luke 11:13]

"If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will **your Father** who is in heaven give [the Holy Spirit] to those who ask Him! Therefore, **whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them**, for this is the Law and the Prophets."

1 Corinthians 12:7-11

But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all. For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another **gifts of healings** by the same Spirit, to another the working of **miracles**, to another prophecy, to another <u>discerning of spirits</u>, to another <u>different kinds of tongues</u>, to another the interpretation of tongues.

But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable! Romans 11:29

2nd Chronicles 26:5

...and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper.

SINS: WE MUST CONFESS AND REPENT OF OUR SINS, AND THE SINS OF OUR ANCESTORS:

And the LORD passed before him (Moses) and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD God, Merciful and Gracious, Longsuffering, and abounding in Goodness and Truth, keeping Mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means clearing the guilty, <u>visiting the iniquity</u> <u>of the fathers upon the children and the children's children</u> to the third and the fourth generation." Exodus 34:6-7 and Numbers 14:18; (also found in Exodus 20 and Deuteronomy 5: God's 'Ten Commandments!')

Psalm 32:1,2,5 and 38:18 (Psalms of David) [see also Psalm 51:1-12,17] Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit. I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD." And You forgave the iniquity of my sin.

For I will declare my iniquity; I will be in anguish over my sin.

[Revelation 13:8

... the Book of Life of the Lamb <u>slain from the foundation of the world!</u> Because the Word of God is Eternal, David was forgiven by God because of this Blood (Leviticus 17:11), the precious Blood of the Lamb of God!]

Proverbs 28:13 [see also Isaiah 1:16-20]

He who covers (hides) his sins <u>will not prosper</u>, but whoever confesses and forsakes them <u>will have mercy</u>.

I John 1:7-9

But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the Blood of Jesus the Messiah, His Son, cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

If we confess our sins, He is Faithful and Just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

WE MUST FORGIVE EVERYONE:

ALL OTHERS, OURSELVES, OUR ANCESTORS, AND OUR GOD!

Matthew 5: 23-24, 43-45

"Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there **remember** that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. **First be reconciled to your brother**, and then come and offer your gift. You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, **love your enemies, bless those** who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust."

Matthew 6:9-15

"<u>Our Father</u> in heaven, <u>hallowed be Your name</u>. Your Kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily Bread. **And forgive us our debts, <u>as we forgive</u> our debtors**.

And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

For Yours is the Kingdom, and the Power, and the Glory, forever. Amen.

For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. **But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.**"

Matthew 18:33-35

'Should you not also have had compassion on your fellow servant, just as I had pity on you?" And his master was angry, <u>and delivered him to the torturers</u> until he should pay all that was due to him.

"So My heavenly Father will do also to you, if each of you from his heart, does not forgive his brother his trespasses."

Mark 11:25,26

And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, <u>forgive him</u>, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. <u>But if you do not forgive</u>, <u>neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses!</u>"

HAVE FAITH IN GOD AND TRUST HIS WORD

The Prayer of Faith will save the sick... James 5:15

Matthew 17:15-21

"Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water." And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour. Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast him out?" So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."

So Jesus answered and said to them, "**Have faith in God!** For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will come to pass, **he will have whatever he says**.

Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. Mark 11:22-24

"But say 'the Word', and my servant will be healed..." When Jesus heard these things, He marveled at him... "I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!" And those who were sent, returning to the house, found the servant well who had been sick. Luke 7:7,9,10

Romans 10:17

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

Luke 8:43-45,46-48

Now a woman, having a flow of blood for twelve years, who had spent all her livelihood on physicians and could not be healed by any, came from behind and touched the border of His garment. And immediately her flow of blood stopped. And Jesus said, "Who touched Me?" "Somebody touched Me, for I perceived Power going out from Me." Now when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before Him, she declared to Him in the presence of all the people the reason she had touched Him, and how she was healed immediately. And He said to her, "Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well! Go in peace."

Luke 17:12-16,19

Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were **lepers**, who stood afar off. And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed. And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, and fell down on his face at His feet... And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. **Your faith has made you well!**"

Romans 1:16-17

For <u>I am not ashamed of the Good News of the Messiah</u>, for it is the Power of God unto Salvation (Deliverance, Healing) for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the Righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith. As it is written, "The just shall live by his faith!"

Galatians 2:20

"I have been crucified with the Messiah Jesus; it is no longer I who live, but the Messiah who lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

John 6:37

"All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out."

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world, our faith! Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that **Jesus is the Son of God**? I John 5:4,5

Hebrews 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

James 5:14-16

Is anyone sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And **the Prayer of Faith** will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed.

The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

Proverbs 3:5-9

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding.

In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and depart from evil. It will be health to your flesh, and strength to your bones. Honor the LORD with your possessions, and with the firstfruits of all your increase.

Psalm 34:8

Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good. Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!

Isaiah 43:4,5

Since you were precious in My sight, you have been honored, and I have loved you; therefore I will give men for you, and people for your life. **Fear not, for I am with you!**

Matthew 28:20

"... and truly, I am with you always, even to the end of the age!"

Matthew 10:28

"And **do not fear those who kill the body** <u>but cannot kill the soul</u>. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell."

John 10:27-29

"My sheep hear My Voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them Eternal Life, and they shall never perish! Neither shall anyone snatch them out of My Hand.

My Father, who has given them to Me, is Greater than all! And no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's Hand."

Psalm 20:1-4

May the LORD answer you in the day of trouble; May the name of the God of Jacob defend you; May He send you help from the sanctuary, and strengthen you out of Zion; May He remember all your sacrifices, and accept your burnt offerings. May He give you the desire of your heart, and make all your plans succeed.

WE MUST STAY HUMBLE:

Proverbs 16:18-19

Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall. Better to be of a humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud.

Proverbs 29:23

A man's pride will bring him low, but the humble in spirit will retain honor.

Micah 6:8

He has shown you, O man, what is good, and what the LORD does require of you. But to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?

Matthew 23:11-12

"But he who is greatest among you shall be your servant. And whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind, let each esteem others better than himself. Let this Mind be in you which was also in Messiah Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

And being found in appearance as a man, <u>He humbled Himself, and</u> became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

Therefore God has also highly exalted Him and given Him the Name which is above every name, that <u>at the Name of Jesus</u> every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that <u>Messiah Jesus is Lord</u>, to the Glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:3,5-11

1 Peter 5:5-7

Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you <u>be submissive to one another</u>, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble!" Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself. Galatians 6:3

FOLLOW GOD; DON'T TRY TO LEAD:

Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and **that** <u>I do nothing of Myself</u>; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things. And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, <u>for I always do those things that please Him!</u>" John 8:28-29

So He answered and said to me: "This is the Word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the LORD of hosts." Zechariah 4:6

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Messiah Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of Life in Messiah Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin. He condemned sin in the flesh, that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of the Messiah, he is not His. And if the Messiah is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised the Messiah from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are the sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God. And if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Messiah, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together. Romans 8:1-11,13-17

GOD ANSWERS OUR PRAYERS AND OUR CRY FOR HELP, TO HEAL AND DELIVER US, ESPECIALLY WHEN WE PRAY, BELIEVING HIS WORD, AND STAY HUMBLE, TRUSTING ON HIS PROMISES:

Isaiah 41:9-14

'You are My servant, I have chosen you and have not cast you away. Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you. I will uphold you with My Righteous Right Hand. Behold, all those who were incensed against you shall be ashamed and disgraced; **they shall be as nothing.** And those who strive with you shall perish. You shall seek them and not find them. Those who contended with you, those who war against you shall be as nothing, as a nonexistent thing. For I, the LORD your God, will hold your right hand, saying to you, "Fear not, I will help you. Fear not, you worm Jacob, you men of Israel! I will help you," says the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 35:3-6

Strengthen the weak hands, and make firm the feeble knees.
Say to those who are fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear!"
"Behold, your God will come with Vengeance, with the recompense of God.
He will come and save you." Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then the lame shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the dumb sing.

Isaiah 54:13-17

All your children shall be taught by the LORD, and great shall be the peace of your children. In righteousness you shall be established; you shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear, and from terror, for it shall not come near you. Indeed they shall surely assemble, but not because of Me. Whoever assembles against you shall fall for your sake. "Behold, I have created the blacksmith who blows the coals in the fire, who brings forth an instrument for his work; and I have created the spoiler **to destroy**.

No weapon formed against you shall prosper,

and every tongue which rises against you in judgment, you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is from Me," says the LORD.

Psalm 34:4-19

I sought the LORD, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. They looked to Him and were radiant, and their faces were not ashamed. This poor man cried out, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles. The angel of the LORD encamps all around those who fear Him, and delivers them. Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the man who trusts in Him! Oh, fear the LORD, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him. The young lions lack and suffer hunger; but those who seek the LORD shall not lack any good thing. Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD. Who is the man who desires life, and loves many days, that he may see good?

<u>Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit</u>. Depart from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it. The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, and <u>His ears are open to their cry</u>. The face of the LORD is against those who do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.

The righteous cry out, <u>and the LORD hears</u>, and <u>delivers them out</u> <u>of all their troubles</u>. The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have <u>a contrite spirit</u>. Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but <u>the LORD delivers him out of them all</u>.

Isaiah 25:4-5

For You have been <u>a strength to the poor</u>, <u>a strength to the needy in his distress</u>, a refuge from the storm, a shade from the heat; for the blast of the terrible ones is as a storm against the wall. <u>You will reduce the noise of aliens</u>, as heat in a dry place; as heat in the shadow of a cloud, <u>the song of the terrible ones will be diminished</u>.

Isaiah 29:18-20

In that Day the deaf shall hear the Words of the Book, and the eyes of the blind shall see out of obscurity and out of darkness. **The humble** also shall increase their joy in the LORD, and the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel. For the terrible one is brought to nothing, the scornful one is consumed, and all who watch for iniquity are cut off...

I John 1:6-7

If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But **if we walk in the light** as He is in the light, **we have fellowship with one another**, and **the Blood of Jesus** the Messiah, His Son, <u>cleanses us from all sin</u>.

Psalm 91:1-16

He who dwells in the Secret Place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; my God, in Him I will trust." Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence. He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge. His Truth shall be your shield and buckler. You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand, but it shall not come near you. Only with your eyes shall you look, and see the reward of the wicked.

Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, even the Most High your dwelling place, <u>no evil shall befall you</u>, nor shall any plague <u>come near your dwelling</u>. For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways. In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone. You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot.

"Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore <u>I will deliver him</u>; I will set him on high, because he has known My name. He shall call upon Me, **and I will answer him**. I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him. With long life I will satisfy him, and show him **My Salvation**."

Psalm 89:20-24

I have found My servant David; with My holy oil I have anointed him, With whom My hand shall be established; also My arm shall strengthen him. The enemy shall not outwit him, nor the son of wickedness afflict him.

I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague those who hate him. "But My Faithfulness, and My Mercy shall be with him, and in My name his horn shall be exalted."

Zechariah 9:9-12

"Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, **your King is coming to you.** He is Just and having **Salvation**, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey. I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim and the horse from Jerusalem; the battle bow shall be cut off. **He shall speak Peace to the Nations**. His Dominion shall be from sea to sea, and from the River to the ends of the earth."

"As for you also, because of the Blood of your Covenant, <u>I will set</u> your prisoners free from the waterless pit. Return to the stronghold, you prisoners of hope. Even today I declare that I will restore double to you."

2 Corinthians 10:3-5

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the Weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but Mighty in God for <u>pulling down strongholds</u>, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and <u>bringing every thought</u> into captivity, to the obedience of the Messiah.

Psalm 35:1-10

Plead my cause, O LORD, with those who strive with me; <u>fight against those</u> who fight against me. Take hold of shield and buckler, and stand up for my help. Also draw out the spear, and stop those who pursue me. Say to my soul, "I am your Salvation!" Let those be put to shame and brought to dishonor who seek after my life; let those be turned back and brought to confusion who plot my hurt. Let them be like chaff before the wind, and let the angel of the LORD chase them. Let their way be dark and slippery, and let the angel of the LORD pursue them. For without cause they have hidden their net for me in a pit, which they have dug without cause for my life. Let destruction come upon him unexpectedly, and let his net that he has hidden catch himself; into that very destruction let him fall. And my soul shall be joyful in the LORD; it shall rejoice in His Salvation. All my bones shall say, "LORD, who is like You, delivering the poor from him who is too strong for him, yes, the poor and the needy from him who plunders him?"

Psalm 18:27-40

For You will save the humble people, but will bring down haughty looks. For You will light my lamp. The LORD my God will enlighten my darkness. For by You I can run against a troop, by my God I can leap over a wall. As for God, His Way is Perfect. The Word of the LORD is proven. He is a Shield to all who trust in Him. For who is God, except the LORD? And who is a Rock, except our God? It is God who arms me with strength, and makes my way perfect. He makes my feet like the feet of deer, and sets me on my high places. He teaches my hands to make war, so that my arms can bend a bow of bronze. You have also given me the shield of Your Salvation. Your Right Hand has held me up, Your Gentleness has made me great.

You enlarged my path under me, so my feet did not slip. I have pursued my enemies and overtaken them. Neither did I turn back again till they were destroyed. I have wounded them, so that they could not rise; they have fallen under my feet. For You have armed me with strength for the battle. You have subdued under me those who rose up against me. You have also given me the necks of my enemies, so that I destroyed those who hated me.

Psalm 18:1-19

I love You, O LORD, my strength. The LORD is my Rock and my Fortress and my Deliverer; my God, my Strength, in whom I will trust; my Shield and the horn of my Salvation, my Stronghold. I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised; so shall I be saved from my enemies. The pangs of death surrounded me, and the floods of ungodliness made me afraid. The sorrows of Sheol surrounded me; the snares of death confronted me. In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried out to my God.

He heard my voice from His Temple, and my cry came before Him, even to His ears. Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of the hills also quaked and were shaken, because He was angry. Smoke went up from His nostrils, and devouring fire from His mouth; coals were kindled by it. He bowed the heavens also, and came down, with darkness under His feet. And He rode upon a cherub, and flew. He flew upon the wings of the wind. He made darkness His secret place; His canopy around Him was dark waters and thick clouds of the skies. From the brightness before Him, His thick clouds passed with **hailstones and coals of fire**. The LORD also thundered from heaven, and the Most High uttered His Voice. **Hailstones and coals of** fire. He sent out His arrows and scattered my foes, lightnings in abundance, and He vanguished them. Then the channels of the sea were seen, the foundations of the world were uncovered at Your rebuke, O LORD, at the blast of the breath of Your nostrils. He sent from above, He took me, He drew me out of many waters. He delivered me from my strong enemy, from those who hated me, for they were too strong for me. They confronted me in the day of my calamity, but the LORD was my support. He also brought me out into a broad place. He delivered me because He delighted in me.

Hebrews 4:12-16

For the Word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

Seeing then that we have a **Great High Priest** who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast to our confession. For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

Let us therefore **come boldly to the Throne of Grace**, that we may **obtain mercy and find grace** to help in time of need.

But Messiah came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect Tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own Blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained Eternal Redemption. For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the Blood of Messiah, who through the Eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? Hebrews 9:11-14

I John 1:5-7

This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that **God is Light**, and in Him is no darkness at all.

If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not practice the Truth. **But if we walk in the light**, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the Blood of the Messiah, Jesus His Son, cleanses us from all sin!

John 15:1-14

"I Am **the True Vine**, and My Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away. And every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. You are already clean because of the Word which I have spoken to you. **Abide in Me**, and I in you, as the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I Am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; **for without Me you can do nothing!**

If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.

If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

As the Father Loved Me, I also have Loved you; abide in My Love. If you keep My Commandments, you will abide in My Love. Just as I have kept My Father's Commandments and abide in His Love. These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full.

<u>This is My Commandment</u>, <u>that you Love one another as I have</u> <u>Loved you</u>. Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. You are My friends if you do whatever I command you." Deuteronomy 30:14,16-20

"But **the Word is very near you**, in your mouth and in your heart, **that you may obey it!** See, <u>I have set before you today</u> **Life and good**, death and evil, in that I command you today **to love the LORD your God**, to walk in His ways, and to keep His commandments, His statutes, and His judgments, that you may live and multiply. And the LORD your God will bless you in the land which you go to possess.

But if your heart turns away so that you do not hear, and are drawn away, and worship other gods and serve them, I announce to you today that you shall surely perish. You shall not prolong your days in the land which you cross over the Jordan to go in and possess. I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you **Life and Death**,

Blessing and cursing; therefore <u>Choose Life</u>, that both you and your descendants may live; that you may love the LORD your God, that you may obey His Voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days; and that you may dwell in the land which the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them."

Jeremiah 29:11-13

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you", says the LORD, "thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me, and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart."

Colossians 1:13-14

He has delivered us from the power of darkness, and conveyed us into **the Kingdom of His Beloved Son**, in whom we have redemption **through His Blood**, the forgiveness of our sins.

2 Timothy 1:6,7

"Therefore I remind you to **stir up the gift of God** which is in you through the laying on of my hands. For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but (a Spirit) of Power, and of Love, and of a Sound Mind!

Isaiah 40:31

But those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

Isaiah 58:6-11,13-14

"Is this not the fast that I have chosen: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and that you bring into your house the poor who are cast out. When you see the naked, that you cover him, and not hide yourself from your own flesh? Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you. The Glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard. Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer. You shall cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.' "If you take away the yoke from your midst, the pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness. If you extend your soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul, then your light shall dawn in the darkness, and your darkness shall be as the noonday.

The LORD will guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones. You shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.

If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My Holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the Holy day of the LORD honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, nor speaking your own words. Then you shall delight yourself in the LORD; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father.

The mouth of the LORD has spoken."

Deuteronomy 28:1-2,7

"Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that **the LORD your God will set you high above all nations** of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God. The LORD will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way **and flee before you seven ways**.

Deuteronomy 33:27

The Eternal God is your refuge, and underneath are His everlasting arms; He will thrust out the enemy from before you, and will say, 'Destroy!'

Psalm 27:1

The LORD is my Light and my Salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

I John 4:7-11

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God, and knows God. He who does not love does not know God, for **God is love**. In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. And we have known and believed the love that God has for us.

1 Corinthians 2:16

"For who has known the Mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" **But we have the Mind of the Messiah!**

Psalm 27:5

For in the time of trouble <u>He shall hide me in His Succah</u>; <u>He shall hide me in the shelter of His Tent</u>. He shall set me high upon a rock.

Galatians 3:13

Messiah has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us; for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree..."

Psalm 16:8,9,11

<u>I have set the LORD always before me</u>; because He is at my right hand <u>I shall not be moved</u>. Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; my flesh also will rest in hope. You will show me **the Path of Life**; in Your Presence is **Fullness of Joy**; at Your Right Hand are **Pleasures forevermore!**

Romans 8:35,37-39

Who shall separate us from the love of the Messiah? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that [nothing] neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Messiah Jesus our Lord!

Isaiah 30:15

For thus says the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel:

"In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and confidence shall be your strength."

Hebrews 7:24,25

'But this Man, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable Priesthood. Wherefore **He is able also to save to the uttermost** them that come to God by Him, seeing that He ever lives to make intercession for them.'

1Corinthians 3:16-17; 6:19-20

Do you not know that **you are the temple of God** and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him.
