## **SCRIPTURES ON ZION and THE TENT OF DAVID**

There are many scriptures showing what God is about to do at this key position in Jerusalem called Zion. One of these scriptures is that God said that He would **Raise Up the Succah of David** that is fallen. Amos 9:11-13 This particular work, and many other scriptures about Zion **relate to the Body of believers in Yeshua** as being the priests whom God would use for this great end time victory! Let's take a closer look at these scriptures...

## 2 Samuel 5:7 **<u>David took the stronghold of Zion</u>**: the same is the city of David.

I King 8:1 Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, to king Solomon in Jerusalem, that they might bring up the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD <u>out of the city of David</u>, <u>which is Zion</u>.

II Kings 19:21 This is the word that the LORD has spoken concerning him; The virgin the daughter of Zion has despised you, and laughed you to scorn; the daughter of Jerusalem has shaken her head at you.

II Kings 19:31 For out of Jerusalem shall go forth <u>a remnant</u>, and <u>they</u> that escape out of Mount Zion: the zeal of the LORD of hosts shall do this.

1 Chron 11:5 And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, you shall not come here. Nevertheless David took the castle of Zion, which is the city of David.

1 Chronicles 15 & 16 David gathered all Israel together at Jerusalem to bring up the Ark of the LORD to Zion. The ark was brought up by David, with Zadok and the priests and the Levites, and placed in the tent that David had pitched for it in the city of David. Here, God gives David the biblical pattern for bringing in God's Presence (the ark) into the city of David.

This pattern was <u>seven priests blowing seven silver trumpets</u>, <u>with</u> the shofars, and with the Levites sang and worshipped the LORD, using <u>music instruments</u>. Once the Ark was placed in the Tent, <u>the Levites</u> <u>worshipped and used music instruments</u> <u>continually</u>, and <u>two priests</u> <u>regularly sounded two silver trumpets</u>. 1<sup>st</sup> Chronicles 15:14-23, 24; 1<sup>st</sup> Chronicles 16:6,37,38; and 1<sup>st</sup> Chronicles 6:31,32; 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 6:1-18;

2 Chronicles 5:2 Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, to Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which is Zion.

Psalm 2:6 And I have set My King on Zion the Mountain of My holiness.

Psalm 9:11,14 Sing praises to **the LORD**, **who dwells in Zion**: declare among the people His doings. That I may shew forth all Your praise in the gates of the daughter of Zion: I will rejoice in Your salvation.

Psalm 14:7 Oh that the Salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when the LORD brings back the captivity of His people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad.

Psalm 15:1-4 LORD, who may abide in Your Tabernacle? Who may dwell in Your holy hill? He who walks uprightly, and works righteousness, and speaks the truth in his heart; He who does not backbite with his tongue, nor does evil to his neighbor, nor does he take up a reproach against his friend; In whose eyes a vile person is despised, but he honors those who fear the LORD; he who swears to his own hurt and does not change;

Psalm 20:2 Send Your help from the Sanctuary, and strengthen thee out of Zion;

Psalm 24:3,4 Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD or who may stand in His Holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul to vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

Psalm 48:2 Beautiful for situation, <u>the joy of the whole earth,</u> <u>is Mount Zion</u>, on the sides of the north, <u>the city of the Great King</u>.

Psalm 48:11,12 Let Mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of Your judgments. Walk about Zion, and go round about her: tell the towers thereof.

Psalm 50:2 Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God has shined.

Psalm 51:18 Do good in Your good pleasure to Zion: build the walls of Jerusalem.

Psalm 53:6 Oh that the Salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! When God brings back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad.

Psalm 65:1 Praise waits for You, O God, in Zion: and to You is paid a vow.

Psalm 69:35 For <u>God will save Zion</u>, and will build the cities of Judah: that they may dwell there, and have it in possession.

Psalm 74:2 Remember Your congregation, which You have purchased of old; the rod of Your inheritance, which You have redeemed; this Mount Zion, wherein You have dwelt.

Psalm 76:2 In Salem also is His Tabernacle, and His dwelling place in Zion.

Psalm 78:68 But chose the tribe of **Judah**, the Mount Zion which He loved.

Ps 84:7 They go from strength to strength, **appearing before God in Zion**.

## Psalm 87:2 The LORD loves the gates of Zion more than all the dwellings of Jacob.

Psalm 87:5 And of Zion it shall be said, 'This and that man was born in her: and the Highest Himself shall establish her.'

Psalm 97:8 Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah rejoiced because of Your judgments, O LORD.

Psalm 99:2 The LORD is great in Zion; and He is high above all the people.

Psalm 102:13 You shall arise and have mercy on Zion, for the time to favor her, yes, the set time (season) is come!

Psalm 102:16 When the LORD builds up Zion, (then) <u>He shall appear</u> in His Glory.

Psalm 102:21 To declare the name of the LORD in Zion, and His praise in Jerusalem;

Ps. 110:2-4 The LORD shall send the Scepter of Your Might out of Zion: rule in the midst of your enemies. Your people shall be willing in the Day of Your Power, in the beauty of holiness... The LORD has sworn and will not repent, You are a Priest forever after the Order of Melchi-Zedek.

Psalm 125:1 They that trust in the LORD shall be as <u>Mount Zion</u>, which cannot be removed, but abides forever.

Psalm 126:1 When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream.

Psalm 128:5 The LORD shall bless you out of Zion, and you shall see the good of Jerusalem all the days of your life.

Psalm 129:5 Let them all be confounded and turned back that hate Zion.

Psalm 132:8,13,14 Arise O LORD, to Your resting place... For the LORD has chosen **Zion**; He has desired it for His habitation. **This is My resting place forever**; here will I dwell, for I have desired it.

Psalm 133:3 As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: <u>for there the LORD commanded</u> the blessing, even life forever more!

Psalm 134:3 The LORD that made heaven and earth bless thee out of Zion.

Psalm 135:21 Blessed be the LORD out of Zion, which dwells at Jerusalem. Praise the LORD.

Psalm 137:1 By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down; yes, we wept, when we remembered Zion.

Psalm 137:3 For there they that carried us away captive required of us a song; and they that wasted us required of us mirth, saying, Sing us one of the songs of Zion.

Psalm 146:10 The LORD shall reign for ever, even your God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD.

Psalm 147:12 Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem; praise your God, O Zion.

Psalm 149:2 Let Israel rejoice in Him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.

Song of Songs 3:11 Go forth, O daughters of Zion, and behold king Solomon with the crown wherewith his mother crowned him in the day of his espousals, and in the day of the gladness of his heart.

Isaiah 1:8 And the daughter of Zion is left as a cottage in a vineyard, as a lodge in a garden of cucumbers, as a besieged city.

Isaiah 1:27 Zion shall be redeemed with Judgment, and her converts with Righteousness.

Isaiah 2:3 And many people shall go and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths: **for out of Zion shall go forth the Torah**, **and the Word of the LORD from Jerusalem**.

Isaiah 3:16,17 Moreover the LORD says, Because the daughters of Zion are haughty, and walk with stretched forth necks and wanton eyes, walking and mincing as they go, and making a tinkling with their feet. Therefore the LORD will smite with a scab the crown of the head of the daughters of Zion, and the LORD will discover their secret parts.

Isaiah 4:3 And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remains in Jerusalem **shall be called holy**, even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem:

Isaiah 4:4 When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the Spirit of Judgment, and by the Spirit of Burning.

Isaiah 4:5,6 And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of Mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a Cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for over all the glory there shall be a Chupah. And there a Succah for shade in the daytime from the heat, for a place of refuge, and for a shelter from storm and rain.

Isaiah 8:18 Behold, I and the children whom the LORD has given me are <u>for signs and for wonders in Israel</u>, from the LORD of hosts, which dwells in Mount Zion.

Isaiah 10:12 Wherefore it shall come to pass, that when the Lord has performed His whole work upon Mount Zion and on Jerusalem, I will punish the fruit of the stout heart of the king of Assyria, and the glory of his high looks.

Isaiah 10:24 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD of hosts, O My people that dwell in Zion, be not afraid of the Assyrian: he shall smite you with a rod, and shall lift up his staff against you, after the manner of Egypt.

Isaiah 10:32 As yet shall he remain at Nob that day: He shall shake his hand against the Mount of the daughter of Zion, the hill of Jerusalem.

Isaiah 12:6 Cry out and **shout**, you inhabitant of Zion: for **Great** is the Holy One of Israel in the midst of you.

Isaiah 14:32 What shall one then answer the messengers of the nation? That the LORD has founded Zion, and the poor of His people shall trust in it.

Isaiah 16:1 Send the lamb to the ruler of the land from Sela to the wilderness, to the Mount of the daughter of Zion.

Isaiah 16:5 And in Mercy shall <u>the Throne</u> be established. And **He shall** sit upon it in Truth, <u>in the Tent of David</u>, Judging, and seeking Judgment, and hastening Righteousness.

Isaaih 18:7 In that time shall **the present** be brought to the LORD of hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, **the Mount Zion**.

Isaiah 25:6-9 And the LORD of hosts shall make a feast for all peoples in this Mountain (Zion) a feast of fat things, a feast of wine on the lees, fat things full of marrow, wine on the lees refined. [The Marriage Supper of the Lamb] And in this Mountain (Zion) He will swallow the face of the covering which covers all over the peoples, and the veil that is woven over all the nations. He will swallow up death forever! And the LORD of hosts will wipe away tears from all faces... This is our God... we shall rejoice in His Salvation!

Isaiah 24:23 Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed, when the LORD of hosts shall reign in Mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before His ancients Gloriously.

Isaiah 28:16 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, Behold, <u>I lay in Zion</u> for a foundation a Stone, a tried Stone, a precious corner Stone, a sure foundation: he that believes shall not make haste.

Isa 29:8 It shall even be as when a hungry man <u>dreams</u>, and, behold, he eats; but he awakes, and his soul is empty: or as when a thirsty man dreams, and, behold, he drinks; but he awakes, and, behold, he is faint, and his soul has appetite: so shall the multitude of all the nations be that fight against Mt Zion.

Isaiah 30:19-21 For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem: you shall weep no more: He will be very gracious to you at the voice of <u>your cry</u>; when <u>He shall hear it</u>, <u>He will answer you</u>. And though the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, yet your teachers will not be moved into a corner anymore, but your eyes shall see your teachers. Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "<u>This is the way, walk in it</u>," whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left.

Isaiah 31:4,5,9 For thus has the LORD spoken to me, Like as the lion and the young lion roaring on his prey, when a multitude of shepherds is called forth against Him, He will not be afraid of their voice, nor abase Himself for the noise of them: so shall the LORD of hosts descend to fight on Mount Zion and on its hill. Like birds flying about, so will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem. Defending, He will also deliver it; passing over, He will preserve it. And he shall pass over to his stronghold for fear, and his princes shall be afraid of the ensign, saith the LORD, whose fire is in Zion, and His furnace in Jerusalem.

Isaiah 33:5,14 The LORD is exalted; for He dwells on high: <u>He has filled Zion with Judgment and Righteousness</u>. The sinners in Zion are afraid; fearfulness has surprised the hypocrites. Who among us shall dwell with the <u>devouring fire</u>? Who among us shall dwell with <u>everlasting burnings</u>?

Isaiah 33:20,21 Look upon Zion, the city of our solemnities: your eyes shall see Jerusalem a quiet habitation, a Tent that shall not be taken down; not one of its stakes shall ever be removed, neither shall any of its cords be broken. But there the Glorious LORD shall be for us, a place of broad rivers and streams...

Isaiah 34:8 For it is **the Day of the LORD's vengeance**, and **the year of recompences** for the controversy of Zion.

Isaiah 35:1-8,10 The wilderness and the wasteland shall be glad for them, and the desert shall rejoice and blossom as the rose; It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, even with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, the excellence of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the Glory of the LORD, the excellency of our God. Strengthen the weak hands, and make firm the feeble knees. Say to those who are fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, **your God will come with Vengeance**, with the recompense of God; he will come and save you." Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then the lame shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, and streams in the desert. The parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water; in the habitation of jackals, where each lay, there shall be grass with reeds and rushes.

A highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, but it shall be for others...

And **the ransomed** of the LORD **shall return, and come to Zion** with songs, and **everlasting joy upon their heads**: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Isaiah 37:22 This is the word which the LORD has spoken concerning him; The virgin, the daughter of Zion, has despised you, and laughed you to scorn; the daughter of Jerusalem has shaken her head at you.

Isaiah 37:32 For out of Jerusalem shall go forth <u>a remnant</u>, <u>and they</u> that escape out of Mount Zion: the zeal of the LORD of hosts shall do this.

Isaiah 40:9 **O Zion**, that brings **good tidings**, get thee up into the high mountain; **O Jerusalem**, that brings **good tidings**, <u>lift up your voice</u> with strength; lift it up, be not afraid; say to the cities of Judah, Behold your God!

Isaiah 41:27 The first shall say to Zion, Behold, behold them: and I will give to Jerusalem one that brings good tidings.

Isaiah 46:13 I bring near My Righteousness; It shall not be far off, and My Salvation shall not tarry: and I will place Salvation (Yeshuah) in Zion for Israel My Glory.

- Isaiah 49:14 But Zion said, The LORD has forsaken me, and my Lord has forgotten me.
- Isaiah 51:3 For the LORD comforts Zion: <u>He comforts all Her waste</u> <u>places (Valley of ben Hinnon)</u>, and He makes Her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD; <u>joy</u> and <u>gladness shall</u> be found in it, thanksgiving, and the voice of singing praise.
- Isaiah 51:11 Therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall return, and come with singing to Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head. They shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away. [This Scripture is also found in Isaiah 35:10]
- Isaiah 51:16 And I have put My words in your mouth, and I have covered you in the shadow of My hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and <u>say to Zion</u>, "You are My people".
- Isaiah 52:1 Awake, awake; put on your strength, O Zion; put on your beautiful garments, <u>O Jerusalem, the Holy City</u>: for henceforth there shall no more come into you the uncircumcised and the unclean.
- Isaiah 52:2 Shake yourself from the dust; arise, and sit down, O Jerusalem: loose yourself from the bands of your neck, O captive daughter of Zion.
- Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful on the mountains are **the feet** of him bringing Good Tidings, making heard Peace; bringing tidings of good, making heard Salvation; **saying** to Zion, **'Your God reigns!'**
- Isaiah 52:8,9 **The voice of Your watchmen**: they lift the voice together for they **sing** aloud: **they shall see** eye to eye, when the LORD brings back Zion. Break forth into joy, sing together, you waste places of Jerusalem. For the LORD has comforted His people, He has redeemed Jerusalem.
- Isaiah 59:20 And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and to them that turn from transgression in Jacob, says the LORD.
- Isaiah 60:13 ...and I will make the place of My feet Glorious!
- Isaiah 64:10 Your holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation.

Isaiah 60:14,15 The sons also of them that afflicted you shall come bending to you; and all they that despised you shall bow themselves down at the soles of your feet; and they shall call you, <u>The city of the LORD</u>, <u>The Zion of the Holy One of Israel</u>. Instead of your being forsaken and hated ... I will make you for everlasting excellency, a joy of many generations.

Isaiah 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give to them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of **praise** for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called **trees of Righteousness**, the planting of the LORD, that He might be Glorified.

Isaiah 62:11 Behold, the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the world, Say to the daughter of Zion, <u>Behold</u>, **your Salvation** (**Yeshuah**) **comes**; behold, **His reward** is with Him, and **His work** before Him.

Isaiah 66:8 Who has heard such a thing? who has seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? or shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as **Zion travailed**, **She brought forth her children**.

Jeremiah 3:14 Return, O backsliding **children** (**Israel**), says the LORD; for **I am married to you**: and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, and <u>I will bring you to Zion</u>:

Jer 4:6 31 Set up the standard toward Zion: retire, stay not: for I will bring evil from the north, and a great destruction. For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, and the anguish as of her that brings forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, bewailing herself, that spreads her hands, saying, Woe is me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

Jer 6:2 I have likened the daughter of Zion to a comely and delicate woman.

Jeremiah 6:23 They shall lay hold on bow and spear; they are cruel, and have no mercy; their voice roars like the sea; and they ride upon horses, set in array as men for war against you, O daughter of Zion.

Jeremiah 8:19 Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of my people because of them that dwell in a far country: <u>Is not the LORD in Zion</u>? <u>Is not her King in her</u>? Why have they provoked me to anger with their graven images, and with strange vanities?

Jeremiah 9:19 For a voice of wailing is heard out of Zion, 'How are we spoiled! We are greatly confounded, because we have forsaken the land, because our dwellings have cast us out.

Jere 14:19 Have You utterly rejected Judah? Has Your soul loathed Zion? Why have You smitten us, and there is no healing for us? We looked for peace, and there is no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble!

Jeremiah 26:18 Micah the Morasthite prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and spoke to all the people of Judah, saying, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts; Zion shall be plowed like a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the House as the high places of a forest.'

Jeremiah 30:17 For **I** will restore health to you, and **I** will heal you of your wounds, says the LORD; because they called you an Outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeks after.

Jeremiah 31:6 For there shall be a Day, that the watchmen upon mount Ephraim shall cry, 'Arise, and let us go up to Zion to the LORD our God.'

Jerem 31:12,13 Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, and be radiant over the goodness of the LORD, for wheat, and for new wine, and for oil, and for the sons of the flock and the herd: and their life shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more.

Then the virgins shall rejoice in the dance, both young men and elders together. For <u>I will turn their mourning into joy</u>, and will comfort them, and make them rejoice from their sorrow.

Jeremiah 31:40 And the whole (ben Hinnon) Valley of the dead bodies, and of the ashes, and all the fields unto the brook of Kidron, ... **shall be Holy** to the LORD; it shall not be plucked up nor thrown down anymore, forever.

Jeremiah 50:5 They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, saying, Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual covenant that shall not be forgotten.

Jer 50:28 The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of Babylon, to declare in Zion the Vengeance of the LORD our God, the Vengeance of His Temple.

Jeremiah 51:24,35 And I will render to Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their evil that they have done in Zion in your sight, says the LORD. The violence done to me and to my flesh be upon Babylon, shall the inhabitant of Zion say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say.

Jeremiah 51:10 The LORD has brought forth our righteousness: come, and **let us declare in Zion the work of the LORD** our God.

Lamentations 1:4, The ways of Zion do mourn, because none come to the solemn feasts: all her gates are desolate: her priests sigh, her virgins are afflicted, and she is in bitterness.

Lamentations 1:6 And from the daughter of Zion all her beauty is departed: her princes are become like harts that find no pasture, and they are gone without strength before the pursuer.

Lamen 1:17 Zion spreads forth her hands, and there is none to comfort her: the LORD has commanded concerning Jacob, that his adversaries should be round about him: Jerusalem is as a menstruous woman among them.

Lamentations 2:1,4 How has the Lord covered the daughter of Zion with a cloud in His anger, and cast down from heaven to the earth the beauty of Israel, and remembered not His footstool in the day of His anger! He has bent His bow like an enemy: He stood with His right hand as an adversary, and slew all that were pleasant to the eye in the Tabernacle of the daughter of Zion: He poured out His fury like fire.

Lamentations 2:6,8 And He has violently taken away <u>His Tabernacle</u>, <u>as if it were of a garden</u>: He has destroyed His places of the assembly: the LORD has caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and has despised in the indignation of His anger the king and the priest.

Lamentations 2:8 The LORD has purposed to destroy the wall of the daughter of Zion: He has stretched out a line, He has not withdrawn His hand from destroying: therefore He made the rampart and the wall to lament; they languished together.

Lamentations 2:13,18 What thing shall I take to witness for you? What thing shall I liken to you, O daughter of Jerusalem? What shall I equal to you, that I may comfort you, O virgin daughter of Zion? For your breach is great like the sea: who can heal you? Their heart cried to the Lord, O wall of the daughter of Zion, let tears run down like a river day and night: give yourself no rest; let not the apple of your eye cease.

Lamentations 4:2 <u>The precious sons of Zion, comparable to fine gold,</u> how are they esteemed as earthen pitchers, the work of the hands of the potter!

Lamentations 2:10 The elders of the daughter of Zion sit upon the ground, and keep silence: they have cast up dust on their heads; they have girded themselves with sackcloth: the virgins of Jerusalem hang down their heads to the ground.

Lamentations 4:11 The LORD has accomplished <u>His fury</u>; He has poured out <u>His fierce anger</u>, and <u>has kindled a fire in Zion</u>, and it has devoured the foundations thereof.

Lamentations 4:22 **The punishment of your iniquity is accomplished, O daughter of Zion.** He will no more carry you away into captivity:

Lamentations 5:11,18 They ravished the women in Zion, and the maids in the cities of Judah. ... Because of the mountain of Zion, which is desolate, the foxes walk upon it.

Ezekiel 20:40 For **in My holy Mountain (Zion**), in the mountain height of Israel, says the Lord Jehovah, **there all the house of Israel, all of them in the land shall serve Me**; there I will accept them, and there I will require your offerings and the firstfruits of your sacrifices, together with all your holy things.

Ezekiel 34:26 I will make them and the places all around My hill a blessing; and I will cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing.

Ezekiel 43:7 And He said to me, "Son of man, this is **the place of My Throne and the place of the soles of My feet**, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever. No more shall the house of Israel defile My holy name, they nor their kings, by their harlotry or with the carcasses of their kings on their high places.

Ezekiel 43:12 This is the law of the House: All the area on the Mountain top surrounding the Holy of Holies. See, this is the law of the House.

Joel 2:1 <u>Blow the shofar in Zion</u>, and sound an alarm in **My holy Mountain**! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble, for **the Day of the LORD comes**, for it is at hand;

Joel 2:15 Blow the shofar in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly.

- Joel 2:23 And Zion's sons <u>rejoice</u> and be glad in Jehovah your God: for He has given to you the early rain according to righteousness, and <u>made</u> come down to you the rain, <u>the early rain and the latter rain at the first</u>.
- Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions. And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days. And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth: blood and fire and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the coming of the Great and awesome Day of the LORD. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD has said, and among the remnant whom the LORD shall call.
- Joel 3:16 <u>The LORD also shall **Roar out of Zion**, and utter **His Voice** from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD will be **the hope** of His people, and **the strength** of the children of Israel.</u>
- Joel 3:17 So shall you know that **I am the LORD your God <u>dwelling</u>** in **Zion**, **My holy Mountain**: then shall Jerusalem be Holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.
- Joel 3:21 For **I will cleanse their blood** that I have not cleansed: for the LORD dwells in Zion.
- Amos 1:2 And he said, <u>The LORD will Roar from Zion</u>, and utter <u>His Voice from Jerusalem</u>; and the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither.
- Amos 6:1 Woe to them that are at ease in Zion, and trust in the mountain of Samaria, which are named chief of the nations, to whom the house of Israel came!
- Amos 9:11,12 In that day <u>I will raise up the Succah (Tent) of David</u> that has fallen and wall up its breaches. And its ruins I will raise up and I will rebuild it as the days of old. That they may possess the remnant of Edom (mankind), and all the goyim (Peoples) who are called by My name, says the LORD who does this. [The true location of the Tent of David was right by the Gihon Springs area in the city of David, in Jerusalem.]

Obadiah 1:17 <u>But upon Mount Zion shall be deliverance</u>, and **there shall be Holiness**; and the house of Jacob shall possess their possessions.

Obadiah 1:21 And saviours shall come up on Mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the Kingdom shall be the LORD's. (also see Revelation 14:1)

Micah 1:13 O you inhabitant of Lachish, bind the chariot to the swift beast: she is the beginning of the sin to the daughter of Zion: for the transgressions of Israel were found in you.

Micah 3:10,12 They build up Zion with blood, and Jerusalem with iniquity. Therefore shall Zion be plowed as a field for your sake, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the Mountain of the House as the high places of the forest.

Micah 4:2 And many nations shall come, and say, <u>Come, and let us go up to the Mountain of the LORD</u>, and to the House of the God of Jacob; and He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths.

For the Torah shall go forth from Zion, and the Word of the LORD from Jerusalem. (same scripture also found in Isaiah 2:3)

Micah 4:7 And I will make her that halted a remnant, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the LORD shall Reign over them in Mount Zion from henceforth, even forever.

Micah 4:8 And thou, O tower of the flock, the strong hold of the daughter of Zion, to you shall it come, even the first dominion; the Kingdom shall come to the daughter of Jerusalem.

Micah 4:10 Be in pain, and <u>labour to bring forth</u>, O daughter of Zion, like a woman in travail: for now shall <u>you go forth out of the city</u>, and you shall <u>dwell in the field</u>, and <u>you shall go even to Babylon</u>; there (Babylon) shall you be delivered; there the LORD shall redeem you from the hand of your enemies.

Micah 4:13 Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion: for I will make your horn iron, and I will make your hoofs brass: and you shall beat in pieces many people: and I will consecrate their gain to the LORD, and their substance to the Lord of the whole earth.

Micah 4:11 Now also many nations are gathered against you, that say, 'Let her be defiled, and let our eye look upon Zion'.

Zephaniah 3:14 Sing, O daughter of Zion; Shout, O Israel; be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem.

Zephaniah 3:16 In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem, 'Fear not,' and to Zion, 'Let not your hands be slack.'

Zechariah 1:14 So the angel that communed with me said to me: Cry, saying, Thus says the LORD of hosts; <u>I am Jealous for Jerusalem</u>, <u>and for Zion with a Great Jealousy!</u>

Zechariah 1:17 Cry yet, saying, Thus says the LORD of hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and the LORD shall yet **comfort Zion**, and shall yet **choose Jerusalem**.

Zechariah 2:7 Deliver yourself, O Zion, that dwells with the daughter of Babylon.

Zechariah 2:10 **Sing and rejoice**, O daughter of Zion; for behold, I Come, and I will dwell in the midst of you, says the LORD.

Zechariah 8:2 Thus says the LORD of hosts; I was Jealous for Zion with Great Jealousy, and I was Jealous for Her with Great Fury.

Zechariah 8:3 Thus says the LORD; I have returned to Zion, <u>and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem</u>: and <u>Jerusalem shall be called a City of Truth</u>; and <u>the Mountain of the LORD of hosts</u>, <u>the Holy Mountain</u>.

Zechariah 9:9 **Rejoice greatly**, O daughter of Zion; **shout**, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, **your King comes to you**: He is just, and having Salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Zechariah 9:13,14 When <u>I have bent Judah for Me, filled the bow with Ephraim</u>, and raised up your sons, O Zion, against your sons, O Greece, and made you as the sword of a mighty man.

Then **Jehovah will appear over them**, and <u>His arrow shall go forth as lightning</u>; and **the Lord Jehovah shall blow the shofar**, and shall go forth...

Matthew 21:5 Tell the daughter of Zion, <u>Behold, your King comes to you</u>, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

John 12:15 Fear not, daughter of Zion: behold, <u>your King comes</u>, sitting on an ass's colt.

Romans 9:33 As it is written, <u>Behold, I lay in Zion a stumbling Stone</u> and Rock of offence: and whosoever believes on Him shall not be ashamed.

Romans 11:26 And so **all Israel shall be saved**: as it is written, <u>There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer</u>, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

Hebrews 12:22 But you are come to <u>Mount Zion</u>, <u>and to the city</u> <u>of the living God</u>, <u>the heavenly Jerusalem</u>, and to an innumerable company of angels,

1 Peter 2:6 Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Zion <u>a chief corner Stone</u>, <u>elect</u>, <u>precious</u>; and he that believes on Him shall not be confounded.

Revelation 14:1 And I looked, and

Behold, <u>a Lamb standing on the Mount Zion</u>, and with Him <u>a hundred forty and four thousand</u>, having His Father's name written in their foreheads. [the Bridegroom and the Bride!]
