### 100 + TOP MESSIANIC SCRIPTURES FOUND IN THE TANAKH!

This paper contains over a hundred most important Messianic Scripture prophesies found in the Torah and the Tanakh, the Hebrew Holy Scriptures, the Old Testament of the Bible. These reveal the identity of the Messiah!

### **Isaiah 9:6,7**

For unto us <u>a Child</u> is born, unto us <u>a Son</u> is given. And the Government shall be upon His shoulder. And His Name shall be called <u>Wonderful</u>, <u>Counsellor</u>, <u>The Mighty God</u>, <u>The Everlasting Father</u>, <u>The Prince of Peace</u>. Of the increase of His Government and Peace there shall be no end upon the Throne of David</u>, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with Judgment and Justice from henceforth, even forever.

The zeal of **the LORD of hosts** will perform this.

### Micah 5:2,4

But you, <u>Bethlehem Ephratah</u>, though you be little among the thousands of Judah, <u>yet out of you He shall come forth to Me who is to be Ruler in Israel</u>; whose goings forth have been from of old, from <u>Everlasting</u>. And <u>He shall stand and feed</u> in the <u>Strength of the LORD</u>, in the <u>Majesty</u> of the name of the LORD <u>His God</u>; and <u>They shall abide</u>.

For now **He shall be Great** to the ends of the earth.

#### Genesis 18:13,14

And the LORD said to Abraham, Why did Sarah laugh, saying, <u>Shall I really bear a child when I am old?</u> <u>Is anything too hard for the LORD?</u> At the time appointed I will return to you, according to the time of life, and <u>Sarah shall have a son</u>.

#### Isaiah 7:14

Therefore the LORD Himself shall give you <u>a sign</u>; Behold, <u>a virgin</u> shall conceive, and <u>bear a Son</u>, and shall call <u>His name Immanuel</u> (<u>God with us</u>).

### Isaiah 59:1,2

Behold, **the LORD'S Hand** <u>is not too short, that it cannot save</u>; neither His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. But **your iniquities** <u>have separated you</u> from your God, and **your sins** <u>have hidden His face from you</u>, so that He will not hear.

### **Deuteronomy 24:16**

Fathers shall not be put to death for their children, nor shall children be put to death for their fathers; a person shall be put to death for his own sin.

#### Ezekiel 18:4

Behold, all souls are mine; the soul of the father as well as the soul of the son is Mine. The soul that sins shall die!

### **Deuteronomy 27:26**

<u>Cursed</u> is the one <u>who does not keep (all) the words of this Torah</u>, to do them ... Then all the people shall say Amen.

### Isaiah 64:6

But we are all like an unclean thing, and <u>all our righteousnesses</u> are like filthy rags. We all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. (see also Psalm 53:1,3; Ecclesiastes 7:20)

### Isaiah 6:9,10

And He said, "Go, and tell this people, 'Keep on hearing, but do not understand; Keep on seeing, but do not perceive.' "<u>Make the heart of this people dull</u>, and their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and return (to Me), **and be healed**."

**Isaiah 1:18,19** (see also Psalm 32:1,2; Psalm 103:12; Micah 7:19) Come now, and let us reason together, says the LORD: though **your sins** be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be <u>as wool</u>. **If you are willing and obedient**, you shall eat the good of the land:

## **Daniel 12:2** (see also Hosea 13:14)

And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall Awake, some to Everlasting Life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

**Job 19:26** (also see Isaiah 26:19) And after my skin is destroyed, I know that in my flesh I shall see God;

### **Second Chronicles 20:20**

Hear me, O Judah, and you inhabitants of Jerusalem: Believe in the LORD your God, so you shall be established; **believe in His prophets**, and you shall prosper.

### **Amos 3:7**

Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, unless <u>He reveals His secret</u> to His servants **the prophets**.

Isaiah 59:16-20 (see also Isaiah 63:5,6; Ezekiel 22:30)
And He saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor. Therefore His Arm brought Salvation to Him; and His Righteousness, it sustained Him. For He put on Righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of Salvation upon His head; and He put on the garments of Vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloke.

According to their deeds, accordingly He will repay, wrath to His enemies, retribution to His foes; to the islands He will repay recompence. And they will fear the name of the LORD from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun. When He will come like a pent-up flood, like the Spirit of the LORD drives along. And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and to them that turn from their sins in Jacob, says the LORD.

### Zechariah 13:1

In that Day **a Fountain** shall be opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.

### Leviticus 17:11

For the life of the flesh is in **the blood**: and I have given it to you upon the altar

# to make **Atonement for your souls**:

for it is **the blood** that **makes atonement for the soul**.

#### Isaiah 52:13-15

Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently, He shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high. As many were astonished at Him; His visage was so marred more than any man, and His form more than the sons of men. So shall He sprinkle many nations (with His Blood); kings shall shut their mouths at Him: for that which had not been told them they shall see; and that which they had not heard shall they consider.

### **Isaiah 53:1**

Who has believed our report?

And to whom has **the Arm of the LORD** been revealed?

**Isaiah 53:11** He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied.

By His knowledge My Righteous Servant (the Messiah) shall justify many; for He shall bear their iniquities.

### Isaiah 53:4-6

Surely <u>He has borne our griefs</u>, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem <u>Him stricken</u>, <u>smitten of God, and afflicted</u>. But <u>He was wounded for our transgressions</u>, <u>He was bruised for our iniquities</u>: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and <u>with His stripes (Blood)</u> <u>we are Saved</u> (healed)! All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

#### **Isaiah 52:10**

The LORD has made bare <u>His Holy Arm</u> in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the Salvation of our God.

### **Psalm 98:1,2**

O sing to the LORD a new song. for He has done marvelous things! **His right Hand and His Holy Arm** have gained Him the Victory. The LORD has made known **His Salvation**; **His Righteousness** He has revealed in the sight of the nations.

#### Jeremiah 31:31-34

Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, that I will make

a New Covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah,
not according to the Covenant that I made with their fathers in the day
that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt;
which My (blood) Covenant they broke, although I was a Husband to them,
says the LORD. But this shall be the (New) Covenant that I will make with
the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD. I will put My Torah
in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and I will be their God,
and they shall be My people. And they shall teach no more every man
his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, "Know the LORD";
for they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them,
says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin
I will remember no more. [... through a new Blood Covenant!]

### Zechariah 9:9-11

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem. Behold, <u>your King comes to you</u>; He is Just, and having Salvation; lowly, and <u>riding on an ass</u>, upon a colt, the foal of an ass.

<u>He shall speak Peace</u> to the nations: and <u>His Dominion shall be from sea even to sea</u>, and from the river even to the ends of the earth. As for you also, by <u>the (Messiah's) Blood of your (New) Covenant</u> I have sent forth your prisoners...

Ezekiel 36:25-28 (see also Ezekiel 11:19,20; 16:60; 18:31,32)
Then I will sprinkle <u>clean water</u> upon you, and you shall be clean.

<u>I will cleanse you</u> from all your filthiness and from all your idols. <u>I will also give you a new heart</u>, and <u>I will put within you a new spirit</u>; and <u>I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh</u>, and <u>I will give you a heart of flesh</u>.

And <u>I will put My Spirit within you</u>, and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you shall keep My judgments, and do them. Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be My people, and I your God.

Psalm 138:2 For You have magnified **Your Word** above all Your name!

### **Deuteronomy 18:15, 18, 19**

The LORD your God will raise up for you <u>a PROPHET</u> from the midst of you, of your brothers, like unto me (Moses); <u>Him you shall hear</u>. I will raise up <u>a Prophet from among their brothers</u>, like unto you (Moses), and I will put <u>My Words in His mouth</u>; and He shall speak to them <u>all that I command Him</u>. And it shall come to pass, that <u>whosoever will not listen to My Words</u> which He shall speak in My name, <u>I will require it of him!</u>

### Isaiah 61:1,2

The **Spirit** of the Lord GOD is upon **Me**; because the LORD has anointed **Me** to preach good tidings to the meek; <u>He has sent **Me**</u> to bind up the brokenhearted, <u>to proclaim liberty to the captives</u>, and <u>the opening of the prison</u> to those who are bound; <u>to proclaim the acceptable Year</u> of the LORD, and <u>the Day of Vengeance of our God</u>; to comfort all that mourn ...

#### Isaiah 35:4-6

Behold, **your God** will come... and save you. Then <u>the eyes of **the blind**</u> will be opened, the ears of the **deaf** shall be unstopped, the **lame** shall leap; tongue of the **dumb** sing;

### **Jeremiah 23:5,6**

Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that I <u>will raise up to David</u> a Righteous Branch (Son), and a KING shall Reign and Prosper, and shall execute Judgment and Justice in the earth. In His days <u>Judah shall be saved</u>, and Israel shall dwell safely: and <u>this is His name</u> whereby **He** shall be called, **THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS!** 

#### Isaiah 4:2

In that Day <u>the Branch (Son) of the LORD</u> shall be Beautiful and Glorious, and the fruit of the earth (<u>the saved remnant</u>) shall be excellent and comely for those of Israel who have escaped.

### **Jeremiah 33:14-18**

Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that I will perform that good thing which I have promised to the house of Israel and to the house of Judah. In those days, and at that time, I will cause the BRANCH of Righteousness to grow up unto David; and He shall execute Judgment and Righteousness in the land. In those days Judah shall be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely. And this is what that shall be proclaimed in her (Jerusalem), The LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS! For thus says the LORD, David shall never want a Man to sit upon the Throne of the House of Israel; Neither shall the Priests, the Levites, want a Man before Me to offer burnt offerings, and to kindle meat offerings, and to do sacrifice continually. [Messiah is KING PRIEST from lines of David and High Priest Zadok!]

### Zechariah 3:8

Hear now, O <u>Yeshua</u>, <u>the High Priest</u>, <u>you and your fellows that sit before you</u>; for <u>they are men wondered at</u>. For, behold, I will bring forth <u>My servant 'the BRANCH'</u> (<u>Messiah</u>).

### Isaiah 8:17,18

And I will wait for the LORD, who hides His face from the house of Jacob, and I will look for Him. Behold, <u>I and the children</u> whom the LORD has given Me are for signs and wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, who dwells in Mount Zion.

### Psalm 45:6,7

Your Throne, O God, is forever and ever; the Scepter of Your Kingdom is a Scepter of Justice. You love righteousness, and hate wickedness. Therefore God, Your God, has Anointed You with the oil of gladness above Your companions.

### Isaiah 49:5-9

And now, says the LORD that formed Me from the womb to be His Servant, to bring Jacob to Him again, though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be glorious in the eyes of the LORD, and My God shall be My Strength.

And He said, It is a light thing that **You should be My Servant** to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel. I will also give **You** as a light to the Gentiles, that You may be **My Salvation** to the ends of the earth. Thus says the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and His Holy One, to Him whom man despises, to Him whom the nation abhors, to a **Servant of rulers**. Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD who is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and **He shall choose You**.

Thus says the LORD, In an acceptable time I have heard **You**, and in a Day of Salvation I have helped **You**; and I will preserve **You**, and give **You** for a (New) Covenant for the people, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages; that You may say to the prisoners, Go forth; to them that are in darkness, Shew yourselves.

### Isaiah 42:6,7

I the LORD have called **You** in Righteousness, and will hold Your hand, and I will keep **You**, and **give You for a (New) Covenant** of the people, for a light of the Gentiles; to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

### Isaiah 8:14,15

And **He shall be for a Sanctuary**; but for <u>a STONE</u> of stumbling and <u>for a Rock of offence to both the houses of Israel</u>, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And many among them shall stumble, and fall, and be broken, and be snared, and be taken.

#### Psalm 118:22-26

<u>The STONE</u> which the builders rejected <u>has become</u> the CORNERSTONE! This is the LORD'S doing; it is marvellous in our eyes. This is the Day which the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD. O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity. <u>Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!</u> We have blessed you out of the house of the LORD.

**Isaiah 28:16** Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation <u>a STONE</u>, <u>a tried STONE</u>, <u>a precious CORNERSTONE</u>, <u>a sure Foundation</u>: he that believes shall not make haste.

### **Daniel 2:34,35**

You watched until <u>a STONE</u> was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and broke them to pieces. Then the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, was broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and <u>the STONE</u> (Messiah) that smote the image <u>became a Great Mountain</u>, <u>and filled the whole earth</u>.

#### **Genesis** 49:24

But his (Joseph's) bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by **the Hands of the Mighty God of Jacob**; (from thence is **the Shepherd**, **the STONE of Israel**.)

### **Zechariah 6:12,13**

Speak to him (**Yeshua, high priest**), saying, Thus says the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold **the Man** whose name is **The BRANCH**; and He shall grow up out of His place, and **He shall build the Temple of the LORD**. Even **He** shall build the Temple of the LORD; **and He shall bear the Glory**, and shall sit and rule upon His Throne; and He shall be a Priest upon His Throne; and the counsel of **Peace** shall be between **Them both**. **[KING PRIEST!]** 

### **Isaiah 42:8**

**I am the LORD,** that is My name.

My Glory I will not give to another, neither My praise to graven images.

### **Daniel 7:13,14**

I saw in the night visions, and, behold, <u>one like **the Son of man**</u> came with the clouds of heaven, <u>and came to **the Ancient of days**</u>, and they brought Him near before Him. And **there was given Him Dominion**, and <u>Glory</u>, <u>and a Kingdom</u>, that all people, nations, and languages should serve Him. **His Dominion** is an everlasting Dominion, which shall not pass away, and **His Kingdom** that which shall not be destroyed.

### Isaiah 48:11 And I will not give My GLORY to another!

#### **Daniel 9:26**

And after sixty two weeks <u>Messiah shall be cut off</u>, but not for Himself; and the people of the prince that shall come (the Romans) shall destroy the city (Jerusalem) and the Temple... [This was almost 2000 years ago!]

**Psalm 16:10** For You will not leave my soul in hell; You will not let **Your Holy One** see decay.

Psalm 110:1 (written by King David) The LORD said to my Lord, Sit at My right hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool.

#### Hosea 5:15

I will go and return to My place, <u>until they acknowledge **their sin**</u>, and seek My face. <u>In their affliction</u> they will seek Me earnestly...

## **Malachi 4:2,3**

But to you that fear My name **the Sun of Righteousness** shall arise <u>with healing</u> in His wings; and you shall go out, and grow fat like calves of the stall. You shall trample the wicked, for <u>they shall be ashes under the souls of your feet</u> on the Day that I do this, says the LORD of hosts.

### Psalm 24:7-10

Lift up your heads, O you gates; and be lifted up, you Everlasting doors; and the KING of GLORY shall come in. Who is this KING of GLORY? The LORD Strong and Mighty, the LORD Mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you gates; even lift them up, you everlasting doors; and the KING of GLORY shall come in. Who is this KING of GLORY? The LORD of hosts, He is the KING of GLORY! Selah.

### Zechariah 9:14-16

And **the LORD** shall be seen over them, and His arrow shall go forth as the lightning: and **the Lord GOD** shall blow **the Shofar**, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south. **The LORD of hosts** shall defend them; and they shall devour, and subdue with sling stones; and they shall drink, and make a noise as through wine; and they shall be filled like bowls, and as the corners of the altar. And **the LORD their God** shall save them in that Day <u>as the flock of His people</u>...

### Zechariah 12:10

And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of Grace and of supplications,

and they shall look upon Me whom they have Pierced, and they shall mourn for Him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for Him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

### **Genesis** 49:10

<u>The scepter shall not depart from **Judah**</u>, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, <u>until **Shiloh** come</u>; and to Him shall be the gathering of the people.

**Proverbs 30:4** Who has ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth?

What is His name, and what is His son's name, if you can tell?

#### **Psalm 16:11**

You will show me the path of Life. In Your Presence is fulness of joy; At **Your right Hand** are pleasures forevermore!

### Genesis 14:18-20

And Melchi Zedek, King of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and He was Priest of God Most High. And He blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of God Most High, possessor of heaven and earth. And blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand. And he (Abram) gave Him (Melchi Zedek) tithes of all.

### Joshua 5:13-15

And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a Man over against him with His sword drawn in His hand: and Joshua went to Him, and said to Him, Are You for us or for our adversaries? And He said, No; but as Prince of the Army of the LORD I am now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said to Him, What says my Lord to His servant? And the Prince of the Army of the LORD said to Joshua, Loose your shoe from off your foot; for the place where you stand is holy. And Joshua did so.

### **Daniel 3:24, 25**

Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spoke, and said to his counsellors, "Did we not cast three men bound into the midst of the fire?" They answered and said to the king, "True, O king." He answered and said, "Oh, I see four men loose and walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God!"

### **Daniel 10:5,14,21**

Then I lifted up my eyes, and looked, and behold <u>one Man clothed</u> in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz. His body also was like beryl, and <u>His face as the appearance of lightning</u>, and <u>His eyes as lamps of fire</u>, and His arms and His feet like in color to polished brass, and the Voice of His Words like the Voice of a multitude. [Messiah!] Now I have come to make you understand what shall befall your people in the latter days: for the vision is yet for many days. But I will shew you what is noted in the Scripture of Truth: and there is none that stands with Me in these things, but Michael your prince.

#### Isaiah 16:5

In Mercy the Throne will be established, <u>and One</u> [KING PRIEST, Messiah, Son of David] shall sit on it in Truth within the Tent of David, **Judging** and seeking **Justice**, and hastening **Righteousness**.

### **Daniel 12:6,7**

And he said to <u>the Man clothed in linen</u>, who was above the waters of the river, How long shall it be to the fulfillment of these wonders? And I heard <u>the Man clothed in linen</u>, who was above the waters of the river, when <u>He held up His right hand and His left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever</u> that it shall be for a time, times, and an half; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered, all these things shall be finished.

### **Deuteronomy 32:39-41**

See now that **I**, **even I**, **am He**, and there is no God with Me. I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of My hand. For I lift up My hand to heaven, and say, **I live forever!** If I wet My glittering sword, and My hand takes hold on Judgment, I will render vengeance to My enemies, and will reward them that hate me.

### Genesis 1:26, Genesis 3:22, Genesis 11:7

"Let 'Us' make man in 'Our' image, after 'Our' likeness..."

"Behold, the man has become **like one of 'Us'**, to know good and evil!"

"Come, let 'Us' go down and let 'Us' confuse their language..."

### Isaiah 6:8

"Whom shall I send, and who will go for 'Us'?"

### **Deuteronomy 6:4**

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God (plural), the LORD is One!

### **Ecclesiastes 12:1**

Remember now **your** <u>Creator</u> (**plural**) in the days of your youth, before the evil days come, and the years draw near, when you say, "I have no pleasure in them."

Psalm 119:89 Forever, O LORD, Your Word is settled in Heaven!

## **Deuteronomy 33:3**

Yes, <u>He loves the people</u>; all His saints are in **Your Hand**. They sit down at Your feet; everyone receives Your Words.

## Psalm 89:20,21, 26-29,35,36

I have found **My servant David**; with My holy oil have I have anointed him. With whom My Hand shall be established; My Arm shall also strengthen him. He shall cry to Me, <u>You are my Father</u>, my God, and the rock of my Salvation. <u>I will also make him **My firstborn**, **highest of the kings of the earth**. My mercy I will keep for him forevermore, and My (New) Covenant shall stand firm with him. <u>I will also make to endure **forever His Seed**</u> (**Messiah**) and **his Throne** as the days of heaven. Once again I have sworn by My holiness; I will not lie to David. <u>**His Seed**</u> shall endure forever, and **his Throne** as the sun before Me; it shall be established forever ...</u>

### Genesis 22:8,10-14,15-18

And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb **for a burnt offering**. So they went both of them together... And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. And the **Messenger** of the LORD called to him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I. And He said, Do not lay your hand upon the lad, neither do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God, seeing that you have not withheld your son, your only son from Me. And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by **his horns**. And Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering instead of his son. And Abraham called the name of that place 'Jehovah Jireh'... And the Messenger of the LORD called to Abraham out of heaven the second time, and said, "By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son, that in blessing I will bless you, and in multiplying I will multiply your seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and your seed shall possess the gate of your enemies.

And in **you Seed** (**Messiah**) all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.

### Zechariah 13:7-9

Awake, O sword, against **My Shepherd**, and against **the Man** that is close to Me, says the LORD of hosts. **Strike the Shepherd**, and the sheep shall be scattered; and I will turn My hand upon the little ones. And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, says the LORD, two parts shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left. And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried. They shall call on My name, and I will answer them. I will say, 'This is my people', and they shall say, 'The LORD is my God!'

## Isaiah 40:10,11

## 1st Chronicles 17:10-15

Furthermore, I tell you (David) that the LORD will build you a house. And it shall come to pass, when your days for fulfilled and you must go to be with your fathers, that I will raise up **your Seed** after you, which shall be from your sons; and I will establish **His Kingdom**. He shall build Me a House, and I will stablish **His Throne forever**. I will be His Father, and He shall be **My Son**: and I will not take My mercy away from Him, as I took it from him that was before you.

But I will settle **Him** in **My House** and in **My Kingdom forever**: and **His Throne shall be established forevermore!** According to all these words, and according to all this vision,

For there is not a just man on the earth, that does good, and does not sin.

### Psalm 2:6,7,12

Yet have I set My King upon My holy hill of Zion.

I will declare the decree, the LORD has said unto me, "You are My Son; this day I have begotten You." **Kiss the Son**, lest He be angry, and you perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in Him (in the Son).

## Isaiah 11:1,2,4

And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse (David's father), and a Branch shall grow out of his roots. And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD. But with Righteousness He shall judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth. And He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.

What is man, that You are mindful of him? And the son of man, that you visit him? For You have made him a little lower than Elohim, and have crowned him with glory and honor. You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet ...

### **Hosea 13:4**

Yet I am the LORD your God from the land of Egypt, and you shall know **no God** but Me: for **there is no Saviour** besides Me.

### **Exodus 3:2-6**

And the Angel of the LORD appeared unto him (Moses) in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush; and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here I am. And He said, Do not draw near this place; Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground. Moreover He said, I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.

#### Exodus 20:5

You shall not make for yourself a carved image, any likeness of anything... You shall not bow down to them nor serve them, for <u>I the LORD your God</u> am a Jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; (and Deuteronomy 5:9)

In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the Angel of the LORD before them.

### Judges 13:3,18,20,22

And <u>the Angel</u> of the <u>LORD</u> appeared to the woman, and said to her, Behold you are sterile and childless: but you shall conceive and bear a son. And <u>the Angel</u> of the <u>LORD</u> said to him, Why do you ask Me what is My name, seeing that <u>it is **Wonderful**</u>? For it came to pass, when the flame went up toward heaven from off the altar, that <u>the Angel</u> of the <u>LORD</u> ascended in the flame of the altar. And Manoah and his wife looked on it, and fell on their faces to the ground. ...<u>we have seen God</u>. [See Isaiah 9:5]

## Isaiah 63:4,5

For the Day of Vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed is come. And I looked, and there was none to help; and I wondered that there was none to uphold. Therefore My own Arm brought Salvation to Me; and My fury, it upheld me.
