How Is It that Jewish Israel does Not Know Their God?

The Messianic Jewish believers in Yeshua wholeheartedly believe in the unbreakable Word of God found in the Torah and Tanakh, which clearly and loudly reveals the Messiah Yeshua. For almost 2000 years Rabbinical Judaism and the commentaries of Rabbis have replaced the deep belief <u>in only the Word of God</u>, which our forefathers gave their lives to protect.

Also many of the religious Jews who follow the Rabbis have been told that only the Rabbis can understand the 'real meanings' of the Holy Scriptures; that they cannot understand the Scriptures by themselves, and that they need to go to the Rabbis' for the correct meaning of the Scriptures.

Wake Up religious Israel! Do not leave your Eternal future in the hands of a Rabbi who does not really know God. Study the Holy Scriptures for yourself and make your own decisions. The Jewish religious communities also even skip over certain Messianic prophetic Scripture passages from their weekly Haftorah Shabbat readings, such as Isaiah 53, and probably many other selected Scriptures passages in the Tanakh, according to the rabbis' decisions, for fear that their zealous religious followers might clearly see 'someone' in these selectively skipped-over writings, who, God forbid, resembles 'you know who!'

So no wonder, how can we be surprised when we see the Jewish world so collectively **deceived**, because even secular Jews, though they would hesitate to admit it, are greatly influenced by the false beliefs and prejudices passed down from their religious Jewish heritage. "The sins of the fathers are passed down to the children to the third and fourth generations." Exodus 20:5

The Jewish community has become blinded to know their own God and His Messiah, for God Himself prophesied to us that this would happen, in Isaiah 6: 9,10 And He said, "Go, and tell this people, 'Keep on hearing, but do not understand; and keep on seeing, but do not perceive. Lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and return, and be healed." "But on this one will I look, ... on him who trembles at My Word." Isaiah 66:2 "I will go and return to My place, until they acknowledge their sin, and seek My face. In their affliction they will seek Me earnestly..." Hosea 5:15

Yeshua, Himself also told the Jewish community this same truth ... "You search the scriptures, for in them you think you have Eternal Life: and these are they which testify of Me. But you will not come to Me, that you might have Life!" John 5:39,40

And He (Yeshua) said to them... "I said therefore to you, that you shall die in your sins: for if you do not believe that I am He (your Savior and your promised Messiah), you shall die in your sins!" John 8:23,24

And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself. Luke 24:27

And He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you, while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning Me."

Then He opened up their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures. And He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Messiah to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem." Luke 24:44,45,46
