### For I am the LORD who heals you!"

Exodus 15:26

"The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has Anointed Me to proclaim the Gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable Year of the LORD." Yeshua then said, "TODAY this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing!" Luke 4:16-21 (Isaiah 61:1, 2)

Surely **He has borne our sicknesses** and **carried our sorrows**; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. **But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities**; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and **by His Stripes we are healed**. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

#### [... by His (Yeshua's) Stripes we are healed! ]

Isaiah 53:4-6

Then they cried out to **the LORD** in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. **He sent His Word and healed them**, and delivered **them** from their destructions. Oh, that men would give thanks to the LORD for His unfailing Love, and for His wonderful Works to the children of men! Psalm 107:19-21

"And these signs will follow those who believe. In My Name (Yeshua) they will cast out demons. They will speak with new tongues. They will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them.

They will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover!" Mark 16:17,18

When evening had come, they brought to Yeshua many who were demonpossessed. And He cast out the spirits with a Word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses!"

Revelation 3:5 "**He who overcomes** shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels. 3:12 **To him who overcomes** I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. I will write on him the name of My God (Father's name) and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of Heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name. 3:21 **To him who overcomes** I will grant to sit with Me on My Throne, as **I also Overcame** and sat down with My Father on His Throne."

Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.

Matthew 8:13, 16 Then Yeshua said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you." His servant was healed that hour. They brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a Word, and healed all who were sick ...

Matthew 9:29 Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith let it be to you."

Matthew 9:35 Then Yeshua went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, and <u>healing</u> every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew 10:1 And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them **Power** over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and (Power) to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

Matthew 15:30, 31 Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Yeshua's feet, and He healed them. So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

- Matthew 10:7, 8 "And as you go, preach, saying, 'The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give."
- Matthew 11:5, 6 "<u>The blind see</u> and <u>the lame walk</u>; <u>the lepers are cleansed</u> and <u>the deaf hear</u>; <u>the dead are raised up</u> and the poor have the Gospel preached to them. And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me."
- Matthew 17:19-21 Then the disciples came to Yeshua privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."
- Matthew 21:21, 22 So Jesus answered and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you, <u>if you have faith and do not doubt</u>, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' it will be done. And <u>whatever things you ask in prayer, believing</u>, **you will receive**."
- Mark 6:12, 13 So <u>they went out</u> and preached that people should repent. And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them.
- Mark 6:56 Wherever He entered, into villages, cities, or the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the hem of His garment. As many as touched Him were made well.
- Luke 7:22, 23 Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things you have seen and heard: that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have the Gospel preached to them. And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me."
- Luke 9:1, 2 Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them **Power and Authority** over all demons, and to cure diseases. He sent them to proclaim the Kingdom of God and to heal the sick.
- Acts 19:11, 12 Now God worked unusual <u>miracles by the hands of Paul</u>, so that even <u>handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body to the sick</u>, and the diseases left them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

Acts 3:6, 7 Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I have I give you. In the name of Yeshua the Messiah of Nazareth, <u>rise up and walk!</u>" And he took him by the right hand and lifted him up, and <u>immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength</u>.

Acts 5:15, 16 ... so that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

Acts 9:37-41 But it happened in those days that she (Dorcas) became sick and died. ... Peter put them all out, and knelt down and prayed. And turning to the body he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter she sat up. Then he gave her his hand and lifted her up; and when he had called the saints and widows, he presented her alive.

1 John 3:1, 2 Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called **children of God!** Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. Beloved, now we are **children of God**; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

"So you shall serve the LORD your God.
And He will bless your bread and your water.
And <u>I will take sickness away</u> from the midst of you!"
Exodus 23:25

Jeremiah 30:17 "For <u>I will **restore health to you**</u> and **heal you** of your wounds," says the LORD, ... "This is Zion; no one seeks her."

Acts 5:12 And through the hands of the apostles many <u>signs and wonders</u> were done among the people. And they were all with one accord ...

Hebrews 10:19-23 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the Blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, and having a High Priest over the house of God, **let us draw near** with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Messiah who strengthens me.

Romans 5:17 ... those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Yeshua the Messiah.

Romans 8:37-39 Yet in all these things we are **more than conquerors through Him** who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the Love of God which is in Messiah Yeshua our Lord.

Ephesians 1:17-20 ... the God of our Lord Jesus the Messiah, the Father of Glory, may give to you the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding Greatness of His Power toward us who believe, according to the working of His Mighty Power which He worked in the Messiah when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the Heavenly places ...

Isaiah 58:6-12, 14 "Is this not the fast that I have chosen, to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out. When you see the naked, that you cover him, and not hide yourself from your own flesh?

Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you. The glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard. Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer; You shall cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.' "If you take away the yoke from your midst, the pointing of the finger, and speaking of wickedness. If you extend your soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul, then your light shall dawn in the darkness, and your darkness shall be as the noonday. The LORD will guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones. You shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. "If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the holy day of the LORD honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, nor speaking your own words, then you shall delight yourself in the LORD; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the LORD has spoken."

John 3:16-18 "For **God so Loved the world** that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have **Everlasting Life**. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten **Son of God**."

Matthew 25:35-46 "For I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me." "Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You? Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?"

And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My (Jewish and Gentile) brethren, you did it to Me.'

"Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the Everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink; I was a stranger and you did not take Me in, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.' "Then they also will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to You?'

Then He will answer them, saying, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, (My Jewish and Gentile brethren) you did not do it to Me.' And these will go away into Everlasting punishment, but the righteous into Eternal Life."

A merry heart does good, <u>like medicine</u>, but a broken spirit dries the bones. Proverbs 17:22

Acts 4:29, 30 "Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all **boldness** they may speak Your Word, by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Yeshua."

1 John 4:17 Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the Day of Judgment; <u>because **as He is**</u> (the Resurrected Lord of Glory as seen in Revelation 1:13-18), <u>so are we in this world!</u>

Isaiah 40:31 But **those who wait on the LORD** <u>shall renew their strength;</u> They shall mount up with wings like eagles, <u>they shall run</u> and not be weary, <u>they shall walk</u> and not faint.

Joshua 24:15 "And if it seems evil to you to serve the LORD, <u>choose</u> <u>for yourselves this day whom you will serve</u>, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. <u>But as for me and my house</u>, we will serve the LORD!"

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Yeshua from the dead dwells in you, He who raised the Messiah from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

"Ask, and you shall receive ..." Matthew 21:22; Mark 11:24; John 16:24

John 14:13, 14 "And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that My Father may be Glorified in His Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it!"

John 15:7 "If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you!"

John 15:16 "... whatever you ask My Father in My name, He will give you."

Philippians 4:6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything with prayer and thanksgiving let your requests be made to God; and the Peace of God that passes all understanding will guard your heart and mind through the Messiah.

1 John 5:14, 15 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, **whatever we ask**, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

John 6:53-56 Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of **the Son of Man** and drink His Blood, **you have no life** in you. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My Blood has **Eternal Life**, and I will raise him up at the last day. For **My flesh** is food indeed, and **My Blood** is drink indeed. He who eats My flesh and drinks My Blood abides in Me, and I in him."

Galatians 2:20 **I have been crucified with the Messiah**; it is no longer I who live, but **the Messiah** who lives in me. And the life which I now live in the flesh <u>I live by faith</u> **in the Son of God**, who Loved me and gave Himself for me.

John 16:24 "Ask and receive, that your joy may be full ..."

Mark 9:23 "All things are possible for him who believes ..."

Matthew 6:25, 27 "Do not worry (take no thought) about your life ..." "Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?"

Matthew 19:26 "With God all things are possible!"

2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in the Messiah, <u>he is a new</u> <u>creation</u>; old things have passed away; <u>behold</u>, all things have become new.

Philippians 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that <u>He who has begun</u> a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus the Messiah ...

John 14:21 "He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

Isaiah 43:19 <u>Behold</u>, <u>I will do a new thing</u>. Now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.

Revelation 21:5 Then He who sat on the Throne said, "**Behold**, **I make all things new!**" And He said to me, "Write, for these words are True and Faithful."

1<sup>st</sup> Samuel 17:45-47 Then David said to the Philistine (Goliath), "You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of **the LORD of hosts**, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. This day the LORD will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you, and take your head from you. And this day I will give the carcasses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of the air and the wild beasts of the earth, that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel. Then all this assembly shall know that the LORD does not save with sword and spear; for **the battle is the LORD's**, and He will give you into our hands."

John 15:2, 4-7, 16 "Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit. For without Me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. 15:16 You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask My Father in My name He may give you."

John 5:19, 30 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **the Son can do nothing of Himself**, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner." "I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I Judge; and My Judgment is Righteous, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of My Father who sent Me."

Romans 6:13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but <u>present yourselves to God</u> as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, <u>let him deny himself</u>, <u>and take up his cross</u>, **and follow Me**." Mark 8:34 When He had called the people to Himself, with His disciples also, He said to them, "Whoever desires to come after Me, <u>let him deny himself</u>, <u>and take up his cross</u>, **and follow Me**."

Luke 9:23 Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, **and follow Me**."

Matthew 5:44 "But I say to you, <u>love your enemies</u>, <u>bless those who curse</u> you, <u>do good to those who hate you</u>, and <u>pray for those who spitefully use</u> you and <u>persecute you</u>," (see Luke 6:27, 35) **Forgive**: Matthew 6:14, 15

Hebrews 9:13, 14 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall **the Blood of the Messiah**, who through **the Eternal Spirit** offered Himself without spot to God, <u>cleanse your conscience from dead works</u> to serve the living God?

1 Peter 1:18, 19 ... knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious Blood of the Messiah, as of a Lamb without blemish and without spot.

1 John 3:21, 22 If our heart does not condemn us ... whatever we ask we receive from Him ... because we keep His Commandments.

Matthew 10:28 "And **do not fear** those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell."

Matthew 26:28 "For this is **My Blood of the New Covenant**, which is shed for many for the remission of sins." (repeated in Mark 14:24)

Luke 22:20 Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is **the New Covenant in My Blood**, which is <u>shed for you</u>."

Acts 20:28 Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the Church of God which He purchased with **His own Blood**.

Romans 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His Blood, we shall be saved from Wrath through Him.

Isaiah 1:18 "Come now, and let us reason together," says the LORD, "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool."

1 Corinthians 10:16 The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of **the Blood of Messiah**? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of **the Body of Messiah**?

1 Corinthians 11:25, 27 In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is **the New Covenant** in My Blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, will be guilty of the body and Blood of the Lord.

Ephesians 1:7 In Him we have redemption through **His Blood**, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace. (Colosians 1:14)

John 14:19, 20 "... **Because I Live**, <u>you will Live also</u>. At that Day you will know that <u>I am in My Father</u>, and <u>you are in Me</u>, and <u>I in you</u>."

Colosians 1:20 ... and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made Peace through **the Blood** of His Cross.

Hebrews 2:14 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death <u>He might</u> <u>destroy him who had the power of death</u>, that is, the devil ...

Psalm 118:17 I shall not die, **but live**, and declare the works of the LORD.

Hebbrews 9:22 And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.

Hebrews 12:24 ... to Yeshua the Mediator of the New Covenant, and to **the Blood of sprinkling** that speaks better things than that of Abel.

Hebrews 13:20, 21 Now may the God of Peace who brought up our Lord Yeshua from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through **the Blood of the Everlasting Covenant**, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Yeshua the Messiah, to whom be Glory forever and ever. Amen.

1 John 1:7 But <u>if we walk in the light</u> as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, <u>and the Blood of Yeshua the Messiah</u>, His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Revelation 1:5, 6, 8 Yeshua the Messiah, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the Ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him **who Loved us** and washed us from our sins **in His own Blood**, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be Glory and Dominion forever and ever. Amen. "I am the Aleph and the Tav, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

Revelation 7:14 And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the Great Tribulation, and washed their robes, and made them white in the Blood of the Lamb.

Revelation 5:9 And they sang a new song, saying, "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by **Your Blood** out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,

"and (You) have made us <u>kings and priests</u> to our God; and <u>we shall reign on the earth!</u>" Revelation 5:10

And they overcame him (the devil) by **the Blood** of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death. Revelation 12:11

Revelation 19:11-16 Now I saw Heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in Righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself.
