

God's Eternal Covenant Promises to Abraham

Now the LORD said to Abram ...

Get to <u>a land</u> that I will show you. I will make you a great nation;

I will bless you and make your name great;

and you shall be a blessing.

I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you;

And in you (**your Seed**) <u>all the families of the earth shall be blessed</u>. Genesis 12:1, 2, 3

Genesis 13:14-18 And the LORD said to Abram, after Lot had separated from him, "Lift your eyes now and look from the place where you are, northward, southward, eastward, and westward; for all the land which you see I give to you and your descendants forever. And I will make your descendants as the dust of the earth; so that if a man could number the dust of the earth, then your descendants also could be numbered. Arise, walk in the land through its length and its width, for I give it to you." Then Abram moved his tent, and went and dwelt by the terebinth trees of Mamre, which are in Hebron, and built an altar there to the LORD.

Genesis 15:5, 6, 18-21 "Look up at the heavens and count the stars, if indeed you can count them." "Then He said to him, "So shall your offspring be." Abram believed the LORD, and He credited it to him as righteousness. On that day the LORD made <u>a Covenant with Abram</u>, and said, "<u>To your descendants I give this land</u>, <u>from the river of Egypt to the great river</u>, the Euphrates, the land of the Kenites, the Kenizzites, the Kadmonites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Rephaites, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Girgashites, and the Jebusites.

Genesis 17:7-8, 21 (God's Eternal Covenant with Abraham, Isaac, ...), "And I will establish My Covenant between Me and you, and your descendants after you in their generations, for an Everlasting Covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you. Also I give to you and your descendants after you the land in which you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, as an Everlasting possession; and I will be their God. ... My Covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah shall bear to you at this set time next year."

Genesis 22:16-18

The Angel of the LORD called <u>to Abraham</u> from Heaven a second time, and said, "I swear by Myself, declares the LORD, that because you have done this, and have not withheld <u>your son</u>, <u>your only son</u>, I will surely bless you, and make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as the sand on the seashore. <u>And your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies</u>. <u>In your Seed all nations of the earth shall be blessed</u>, **because you have obeyed My voice**."

Genesis 26:2-5 Then the LORD appeared to him (<u>Isaac</u>) and said, ... "Dwell in this land, and I will be with you and bless you; for <u>to you and your descendants I give all these lands</u>, and I will perform <u>the oath which I swore to Abraham your father</u>. And I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of heaven. <u>I will give to your descendants all these lands</u>; and <u>in your Seed</u> all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because Abraham <u>obeyed My voice</u>, and kept My requirements, My commands, My decrees, and My laws."

Genesis 28:1-4 Then <u>Isaac called Jacob</u> and blessed him, and charged him, and said to him,

"You shall not take a wife from the daughters of Canaan. Arise, go to Paddan Aram, to the house of Bethuel your mother's father; and take yourself a wife from there of the daughters of Laban, your mother's brother. May God Almighty bless you, and make you fruitful and multiply you, that you may become a multitude of peoples; and give you 'the blessing of Abraham', to you and your descendants with you, that you may inherit the land in which you are a stranger, which God gave to Abraham."

Genesis 28:13, 14, 15

He (<u>Jacob</u>) had a dream in which he saw a stairway resting on the earth, with its top reaching to heaven, and the angels of God were ascending and descending on it. And behold, the LORD standing above him, and said, "I Am the LORD, the God of your father Abraham, and the God of Isaac. I will give you and your descendants the land on which you are lying.

Your descendants will be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and to the east, to the north and to the south. And <u>in you and in your Seed</u> all the families of the earth shall be blessed. I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you."

Genesis 48:3-5

Then <u>Jacob said to Joseph</u>, "God Almighty appeared to me at Luz in the land of Canann, and blessed me, and said to me, 'Behold, I will make you fruitful and multiply you, and I will make of you a multitude of people, and give <u>this land</u> to your descendants after you as <u>an everlasting possession</u>.'"

Exodus 6:2-4, 8

And <u>God spoke to Moses</u> and said to him, "I Am the LORD! I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, <u>as God Almighty</u>, but by My name, <u>LORD</u>, I was not known to them. I have also established <u>My Covenant with them</u>, <u>to give them **the land of Canaan**</u>, the land of their pilgrimage, in which they were strangers. And I will bring you into **the land** which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; <u>and I will give it to you as a heritage</u>: I Am the LORD!"

Exodus 32:13 "Remember <u>Abraham, Isaac, and Israel</u>, Your servants, to whom You swore by Your own self, and said to them, 'I will multiply your descendants as the stars of heaven; <u>and all this land</u> that I have spoken of I give to your descendants, <u>and they shall inherit it forever!</u>"

Deuteronomy 11:24

"Every place on which the sole of your feet shall tread shall be yours; from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even to the Western Sea (Mediterranean), shall be your territory."

Joshua 1:3, 4

"Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, I have given to you, as I said unto Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon even to the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the Great Sea (Mediterranean) toward the going down of the sun, shall be your territory."

Joshua 13:6

"All the inhabitants of the hill country from Lebanon as far as the Brook Misrephoth Maim, and all the Sidonians, them will I drive out from before the children of Israel: only divide it by lot to Israel as an inheritance, as I have commanded you."

Joshua 15:1-2, 21, 45-47

So this was the lot of the tribe of the children of Judah according to their families: The border of Edom at the Wilderness of Zin southward was the extreme southern boundary. And their southern border began at the shore of the Salt Sea... The cities at the limits of the tribe of the children of Judah, toward the border of Edom in the South... Ekron, with its towns and villages; from Ekron to the sea, all that lay near Ashdod, with their villages; Ashdod with its towns and villages, Gaza with its towns and villages, as far as the Brook of Egypt and the Great Sea with its coastline.

Judges 1:18

Also Judah took Gaza with its territory, Ashkelon with its territory, and Ekron with its territory.

Psalm 69:35, 36 For God will save Zion, <u>and will build the cities of Judah</u>; that they may dwell there, and have it in possession. Also, the descendants of His servants shall inherit it, and those who love His name shall dwell in it.

Psalm 105:7-11

He is the LORD our God. His judgments are in all the earth. He has remembered His Covenant forever, the Word which He commanded to a thousand generations. Which Covenant He made with Abraham, and His oath to Isaac; and confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, to Israel for an Everlasting Covenant. Saying, "To you will I give the land of Canaan, as the allotment of your Inheritance ..."

Isaiah 27:6

Those who come (to Israel) <u>He shall cause to take root in Jacob;</u> Israel shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit.

Jeremiah 24:6-7

"For I will set My eyes on them for good, and I will bring them back to this land. I will build them and not pull them down, and I will plant them and not pluck them up. Then I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the LORD; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, for they shall return to Me with their whole heart."

Jeremiah 31:28, 31-34

"And it shall come to pass, that as I have watched over them to pluck up, to break down, to throw down, to destroy, and to afflict, so I will watch over them **to build and to plant**," says the LORD.

"Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, that I will make

a New Covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah, not according to the Covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which My Covenant they broke, although I was **a Husband** to them, says the LORD.

But this shall be the Covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD, I will put My Torah in their inward parts, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD'; for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

Jeremiah 32:38-42

"They shall be My people, and I will be their God; then I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them and their children after them. And I will make an Everlasting Covenant with them, that I will not turn away from doing them Good; but

<u>I will put My fear in their hearts</u>, so that they will not depart from Me. Yes, I will Rejoice over them to do them good, and <u>I will assuredly plant them in this land, with all My heart and with all My soul.'</u>

"For thus says the LORD: 'Just as I have brought all this great calamity on this people, so I will bring on them all the good that I have promised them."

Jeremiah 42:9-12

"Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, to whom you sent me to present your petition before Him: 'If you will still remain in this land, then I will build you and not pull you down, and I will plant you and not pluck you up. For I relent concerning the disaster that I have brought upon you.

'Do not be afraid of the king of Babylon, of whom you are afraid; do not be afraid of him,' says the LORD, 'for I am with you, to save you and deliver you from his hand. And I will show you mercy, that he may have mercy on you and cause you to return to your own land.' "

Ezekiel 28:25-26 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "When I have gathered the House of Israel from the peoples among whom they are scattered, and am hallowed in them in the sight of the nations, then they will dwell in their own land which I gave to My servant Jacob. And they will dwell safely there, build houses, and plant vineyards; yes, they will dwell securely, when I execute judgments on all those around them who despise them. Then they shall know that I am the LORD their God." '

Ezekiel 34:13-16, 26 "And I will bring them out from the people, and gather them from the countries, and will bring them into their own land, and I will feed them on the mountains of Israel, in the valley, and in all the inhabited places of the country. I will feed them in a good pasture, and their fold shall be upon the high mountains of Israel: there shall they lie in a good fold, and in rich pasture shall they feed on the mountains of Israel. I will feed My flock, and I will cause them to lie down, says the Lord GOD. I will seek that which was lost, and bring back that which was driven away, and will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick: but I will destroy the fat and the strong; I will feed them in Judgment."

"And I will make them and the places all around My Hill a blessing; and I will cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing!"

Ezekiel 36:21-29

"But I had concern for My holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the nations wherever they went. Therefore say to the house of Israel, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "I do not do this for your sake, O house of Israel, but for My holy name's sake, which you have profaned among the nations wherever you went. And I will sanctify My great name, which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst; and the nations shall know that I am the LORD," says the Lord GOD, "when I am hallowed in you before their eyes.

- (1) For I will take you from among the nations, gather you out of all countries, **and bring you into your own land**.
- (2) Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and <u>you shall be clean</u>; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. <u>I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you</u>; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and <u>give you a heart of flesh</u>. <u>I will put My Spirit within you</u> and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them. Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; you shall be My people, and I will be your God.

I will deliver you from all your uncleannesses."

Notice this two fold Promise of God, that first He would bring us back to the land of Israel. And second, that He would then bless us, by <u>cleansing us</u> and giving us a new heart of flesh, and then put His own Spirit inside of us, to make it easier for us to obey Him. This is <u>God's New Covenant</u>, promised to His people Israel, which is also found in Jeremiah 31:31-34!

Ezekiel 37:14

"I will put My Spirit in you, <u>and you shall live</u>, and <u>I will place you in your own land</u>. Then you shall know that I, the LORD, have spoken it and performed it," says the LORD.

Ezekiel 39:21, 22, 29 "And I will set **My Glory** among the nations, and all the nations shall see My Judgment that I have executed, and My hand which I have laid upon them. So the house of Israel shall know that I am the LORD their God from that day and forward. 'Neither will I hide My face from them anymore; for I shall have poured out My Spirit upon the House of Israel,' says the Lord GOD."

Ezekiel 47:13-20

Thus says the Lord GOD, "These are the borders by which you shall divide **the land** as an inheritance among the twelve tribes of Israel... Joseph shall have two portions. You shall inherit it equally with one another; for <u>I raised My Hand in an oath to give it to your fathers</u>; and this land shall fall to you as your inheritance.

And this shall be the border of the land toward the north side, from the Great Sea, the way of Hethlon, as one goes to Zedad; Hamath, Berothah, Sibraim, which is between the border of Damascus and the border of Hamath; Hazarhatticon, which is by the coast of Hauran. And the border from the sea shall be Hazarenan, the border of Damascus, and the north northward, and the border of Hamath. And this is the north side. And the east side ye shall measure from Hauran, and from Damascus, and from Gilead, and from the land of Israel along the Jordan, from the border to the eastern side of the sea. This is the east side. And the south side southward, from Tamar even to the waters of strife in Kadesh, the Brook to the Great Sea. And this is the south side southward. The west side also shall be the Great Sea from the border, till one comes over against Hamath. This is the west side."

Ezekiel 47:21-23

"Thus you shall divide this land among yourselves according to the tribes of Israel. It shall be that you will divide it by lot as an inheritance for yourselves, and for <u>the strangers</u> who dwell among you and who bear <u>children among you</u>. They shall be to you <u>as native-born</u> among the children of Israel; they shall have an inheritance with you among the tribes of Israel. And it shall be that in whatever tribe the stranger dwells, there you shall give him his inheritance," says the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 48:1-35

"Now these are the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus northward, to the coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east and west; a portion for Dan. And by the border of Dan, from the east side unto the west side, a portion for Asher. And by the border of Asher, from the east side even unto the west side, a portion for Naphtali. And by the border of Naphtali, from the east side to the west side, a portion for Manasseh. And by the border of Manasseh, from the east side unto the west side, a portion for Ephraim. And by the border of Ephraim, from the east side even to the west side, a portion for Reuben. And by the border of Reuben, from the east side to the west side, a portion for Judah. And by the border of Judah, from the east side unto the west side, shall be the offering which you shall offer of five and twenty thousand reeds in breadth, and in length as one of the other parts, from the east side unto the west side: and the sanctuary shall be in the midst of it. The district that you shall set apart for the LORD shall be of five and twenty thousand in length and of ten thousand in breadth. And to these, even for the priests, shall be this holy district; toward the north five and twenty thousand in length, and toward the west ten thousand in breadth, and toward the east ten thousand in breadth, and toward the south five and twenty thousand in length: and the Sanctuary of the LORD shall be in the center. It shall be for the priests that are sanctified of the sons of Zadok; which have kept my charge, which went not astray, when the children of Israel went astray, and the Levites went astray. And this district of the land that is set apart shall be to them a thing most holy by the border of the Levites. And over against the border of the priests, the Levites shall have five and twenty thousand in length, and ten thousand in breadth: all the length shall be five and twenty thousand, and the breadth ten thousand. And they shall not sell of it, neither exchange, nor alienate the firstfruits of the land: for it is holy to the LORD. And the five thousand, that are left

in the breadth over against the five and twenty thousand, shall be a profane place for the city, for dwelling, and for suburbs: and the city shall be in the midst thereof. And these shall be the measures thereof; the north side four thousand and five hundred, and the south side four thousand and five hundred, and on the east side four thousand and five hundred, and the west side four thousand and five hundred. And the suburbs of the city shall be toward the north two hundred and fifty, and toward the south two hundred and fifty, and toward the east two hundred and fifty, and toward the west two hundred and fifty. And the rest in length over against the district of the holy portion shall be ten thousand eastward, and ten thousand westward: and it shall be over against the district of the holy portion; and the increase thereof shall be for food to workers that serve the city. And they that serve the city shall serve it out of all the tribes of Israel. All the district shall be five and twenty thousand by five and twenty thousand: ye shall set apart the holy district foursquare, with the possession of the city. And the rest shall be for the prince, on the one side and on the other of the holy district, and of the possession of the city, over against the five and twenty thousand of the district toward the east border, and westward over against the five and twenty thousand toward the west border, over against the portions for the prince: and it shall be the holy district; and the Sanctuary of the Temple shall be in the center. Moreover from the possession of the Levites, and from the possession of the city, being in the midst of that which is the prince's, between the border of Judah and the border of Benjamin, shall be for the prince.

As for the rest of the tribes, from the east side unto the west side, Benjamin shall have a portion. And by the border of Benjamin, from the east side unto the west side, Simeon shall have a portion. And by the border of Simeon, from the east side unto the west side, Issachar a portion. And by the border of Issachar, from the east side unto the west side, Zebulun a portion. And by the border of Zebulun, from the east side unto the west side, Gad a portion. And by the border of Gad, at the south side southward, the border shall be even from Tamar unto the waters of strife in Kadesh, and to the river toward the Great Sea. This is the land which ye shall divide by lot to the tribes of Israel for inheritance, and these are their portions, says the Lord GOD. And these are the goings out of the city on the north side, four thousand and five hundred measures. And the gates of the city shall be after the names of the tribes of Israel: three gates northward; one gate of Reuben, one gate of Judah, one gate of Levi. And at the east side four thousand and five hundred: and three gates; and one gate of Joseph, one gate of Benjamin, one gate of Dan. And at the south side four thousand and five hundred

measures: and three gates; one gate of Simeon, one gate of Issachar, one gate of Zebulun. At the west side four thousand and five hundred, with their three gates; one gate of Gad, one gate of Asher, one gate of Naphtali. It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that Day shall be, 'The LORD is There!' "

Amos 9:13-15

"Behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "When the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him who sows seed; the mountains shall drip with sweet wine, and all the hills shall flow with it. I will bring back the captives of My people Israel; they shall build the waste cities and inhabit them; they shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them; they shall also make gardens and eat fruit from them.

<u>I will plant them in their land</u>, <u>and no longer shall they be</u> <u>pulled up from the land</u> I have given them," says the LORD your God. Zephaniah 2:5, 7 (also see Isaiah 14:29-32)

Woe to the inhabitants of the seacoast, the nation of the Cherethites! The Word of the LORD is against you, O Canaan, <u>land of the Philistines</u>: "I will destroy you; so there shall be no inhabitant."

The coast shall be for the remnant of **the house of Judah**; they shall feed their flocks there; in the houses of Ashkelon they shall lie down at evening. For the LORD their God **will intervene for them**, and return their captives.

Joel 3:1-4, 12, 13, 14

"For behold, in those days and at that time, when I bring back the captives of Judah and Jerusalem, I will also gather all nations, and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat; and I will enter into Judgment with them there on account of My people, My heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations;

they have also divided up My land!

They have cast lots for My people, have given a boy as payment for a harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they may drink. Indeed, what have you to do with Me, O Tyre and Sidon, and all the coasts of Philistia? Will you retaliate against Me? But if you retaliate against Me, swiftly and speedily I will return your retaliation upon your own head.

Let the nations be wakened, and come up to the Valley of Jehoshaphat; for there I will sit to Judge all the surrounding nations. Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe ... Multitudes, multitudes in the Valley of decision! For 'the Day of the LORD' is near in the Valley of decision."

"Israel was holiness to the LORD, the firstfruits of His increase. All that devour him will offend; Disaster will come upon them," says the LORD. Jeremiah 2:3

Zechariah 8:7, 8 "Thus says the LORD of hosts, 'Behold, I will save **My people** from the east country, and from the west country. And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. They shall be My people, and I will be their God, in Truth and in Righteousness.'"

Deuteronomy 32:43 "Rejoice, O Gentiles with His people. For He will avenge the blood of His servants, and render vengeance to His adversaries. **He will provide <u>Atonement</u> for His land and His people.**" [That Atonement was **the shed Blood** of Messiah Yeshua!]

There is nothing more powerful than the Word of God!

It is the greatest tool God has given His Jewish people for victorious living. God will keep every Promise in His Word that He has made with Israel. If we give away any part of our land of Israel, it would be opposing who we really are as His Israeli Jews! And it will only hinder God's blessings on us. We are His stewards, and all the land of Israel is the LORD's!

Joel 2:28-32 "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out My Spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions.

And also on My menservants and on My handmaids in those Days I will pour out My Spirit. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be delivered (Saved); for in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD has said, and among the remnant whom the LORD calls."

Location of God's coming Great Outpouring over Jerusalem

Jeremiah 31:38, 40

"Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, that the city (Jerusalem) shall be built for the LORD ...

And the whole valley of the dead bodies, and of the ashes [the ben Hinnom Valley], and all the fields unto the brook of Kidron, to the corner of the horse gate toward the east, shall be holy unto the LORD!

It shall not be plucked up or thrown down forever."

The Ben Hinnom Valley is located just south of Jaffa Gate, just outside Mount Zion hill, just below Mount Zion Hotel.

Amos 9:11-13 "On that Day I will raise up the Tabernacle of David that has fallen, and close up its breaches; and I will raise up its ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old. That they may possess the remnant of Edom (Adam or mankind), and of all the nations who are called by My name," says the LORD who does this thing. "Behold, the days come," says the LORD, "that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that sows seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt." Joel 3:18 [The coming Great Harvest of souls!]

Hosea 6:1-3 Come, and let us return to the LORD: for He has torn, and He will heal us; He has smitten, and He will bind us up. After two days He will revive us. In the third day He will raise us up, and we shall live in His sight. Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD; His going forth is established as the morning; He shall come to us as the rain, like the latter and former rain to the earth.

Joel 2:23, 24 Be glad then, you children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for He has given you the former rain faithfully, and **He will** cause the rain to come down for you, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month. And the threshing floor shall be full of wheat, and the vats shall overflow with new wine and oil.

Zechariah 10:1 Ask of the LORD for rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.

Haggai 2:7, 9 "'And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this House with Glory, says the LORD of hosts. The Glory of this latter House shall be greater than of the former,' says the LORD of hosts. 'And in this place will I give Peace,' says the LORD of hosts."

Zechariah 13:1 "In that Day a Fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness."

Malachi 4:2 "But to you that fear My name shall the Sun of Righteousness arise with healing in His wings;"

Zechariah 9:16, 17 And the LORD their God shall save them in that Day as the flock of His people: for they shall be as the stones of a crown, lifted up as an ensign upon His land. For how Great is His Goodness, and how Great is His Beauty! Grain shall make the young men thrive, and new wine the young women.

"And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of Grace and of Supplications:

and they shall look upon Me whom they have pierced!

And they shall mourn for Him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for Him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn." Zechariah 12:10

Joel 2:18, 19 Then the LORD will be zealous for His land and pity His people. Yes, the LORD will answer and say to His people, "Behold, I will send you corn, and wine, and oil, and you shall be satisfied therewith, and I will no more make you a reproach among the nations."

Ezekiel 37:24-28 "David my servant shall be shepherd over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in My Judgments, and observe My statutes, and do them. Then they shall dwell in the land that I have given to Jacob My servant, where your fathers dwelt; and they shall dwell there, they, and their children, and their children's children forever: and My servant David shall be their prince forever.

Moreover I will make a Covenant of Peace with them; it shall be an Everlasting Covenant with them: and I will establish them, and multiply them, and will set My Sanctuary in the midst forevermore. My tabernacle also shall be with them: yes, I will be their God, and they shall be My people. And the nations shall know that I, the LORD, sanctify Israel, when My Sanctuary is in their midst forevermore."

Ezekiel 39:21, 22, 25 "And I will set My Glory among the nations, and all the nations shall see My Judgment which I have executed, and My hand which I have laid on them. So the house of Israel **shall know that I am the LORD their God from that day and forward**." "Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, 'Now I will bring back the captives of Jacob, and have mercy on the whole house of Israel; and I will be Jealous for My holy name.'"

Ezekiel 39:27-29 "'When I have brought them again from the people, and gathered them out of their enemies' lands, and am sanctified in them in the sight of many nations. Then shall they know that I am the LORD their God, which caused them to be led into captivity among the nations, but I have brought them back to their own land, and have left none of them captive any longer. And I will not hide My face from them any more: for I shall have poured out My Spirit on the house of Israel,' says the Lord GOD."

Zechariah 1:14, 16, 17 So the angel who spoke with me said to me, "Proclaim, saying, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, "I am zealous for Jerusalem and for Zion with a great zeal." 'Therefore thus says the LORD, "I am returning to Jerusalem with Mercy. My House shall be built in it," says the LORD of hosts, 'and a line shall be stretched out over Jerusalem.' "Proclaim, saying, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, "My cities shall again

spread out through prosperity; the LORD will again comfort Zion, and will again choose Jerusalem." '"

Zechariah 2:4, 5, 8-12 "Run, speak to this young man, saying, 'Jerusalem shall be inhabited as towns without walls because of the multitude of men and livestock in it. For I,' says the LORD, 'will be **a wall of fire** all around her, and I will be the Glory in her midst.' " For thus says the LORD of hosts, "He sent Me after glory, to the nations which plunder you; for he who touches you touches the apple of His eye. For surely I will shake My hand against them, and they shall become spoil for their servants. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent Me. Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion! For behold, I am coming and I will dwell in your midst," says the LORD. "Many nations shall be joined to the LORD in that Day, and they shall become My people. And I will dwell in your midst. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent Me to you. And the LORD will take possession of Judah as His inheritance in the Holy Land, and will again choose Jerusalem."

Zechariah 8:1-3 Again the Word of the LORD of hosts came to me, saying, "Thus says the LORD of hosts, 'I was zealous for Zion with great zeal; with great fervor I am zealous for her.' "Thus says the LORD, 'I am returning to Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be called **the City of Truth,** the Mountain of the LORD of hosts, **the Holy Mountain**.'"

Hosea 3:5 Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king. They shall fear the LORD and His Goodness in the latter days.

Zechariah 14:3-5 Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when He fought in the day of battle. And <u>His feet shall stand in that Day upon the Mount of Olives</u>, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, from east to west, and there shall be a very great valley. And half of the mountain shall move toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

And you shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yes, you shall flee, like as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah.

Thus the LORD my God shall come, and all the saints with Him!

Zechariah 14:8-11 And it shall be in that Day, that **Living Waters** shall flow from Jerusalem; half of them toward the eastern sea, and half of them toward the western sea; in both summer and in winter it shall be.

And the LORD shall be King over all the earth! In that Day it shall be, "The LORD is One," & His name One.

All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and from the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses. And people shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction. But Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.

Hosea 10:12 Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek the LORD, till He comes and rains righteousness on you.

I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be your plagues; O grave, I will be your destruction ... Hosea 13:14

Isaiah 1:26 You shall be called the City of Righteousness, (Jerusalem) the Faithful City!

Isaiah 4:2-6 In that Day the Branch (Tzemach) of the LORD shall be Beautiful and Glorious, and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and comely for them that have escaped of Israel. And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remains in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem. When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the Spirit of Judgment and by the Spirit of burning. And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of Mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night; for upon all the Glory shall be a defence. And there shall be a Tabernacle for a shadow in the daytime from the heat, and for a place of refuge, and for a covert from storm and from rain.

Isaiah 65:13, 14 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, Behold, **My servants shall eat**, but you shall be hungry. Behold, **My servants shall drink**, but you shall be thirsty. Behold, **My servants shall Rejoice**, but you shall be ashamed. Behold, **My servants shall sing for Joy of heart**, but you shall cry for sorrow of heart, and shall howl for vexation of spirit.

Isaiah 65:17-25

For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; and the former shall not be remembered, nor come to mind. But be glad and rejoice forever in that which I create: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a Rejoicing, and her people a Joy. And I will Rejoice in Jerusalem, and Joy in My people. And the voice of weeping shall be no more heard in her, nor the voice of crying. There shall be no more an infant of days, nor an old man that has not filled his days. For the child shall die a hundred years old; but the sinner being an hundred years old shall be accursed. And they shall build houses, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them. They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat; for as the days of a tree are the days of My people, and My elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands. They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their off-spring with them. And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My Holy Mountain, says the LORD.

Isaiah 66:10-13 **Rejoice with Jerusalem**, and be glad with her, all you that love her; rejoice for joy with her, all you that mourn for her. That you may suck, and be satisfied with the breasts of her consolations; that you may milk out, and be delighted with the abundance of her Glory. For thus says the LORD, "Behold, I will extend **Peace to her** like a river, and the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream. Then shall you suck, you shall be carried upon her sides, and be dandled upon her knees.

As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you; and you shall be comforted in Jerusalem!"

For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before Me, says the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain. Isaiah 66:22

And saviors shall come up on mount Zion to judge the Mountain of Esau; and the Kingdom shall be the LORD's!

Obadiah 1:21

Zephaniah 3:11-17 In that Day ... I will take away out of the midst of you them that rejoice in their pride, and you shall no more be haughty because of My Holy Mountain. I will also leave in the midst of you a meek and humble people, and they shall trust in the name of the LORD. The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid. Sing, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel; be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem. The LORD has taken away your judgments. He has cast out your enemy. The King of Israel, the LORD, is in the midst of you: you shall not see disaster any more. In that Day it shall be said to Jerusalem, 'Fear not', and to Zion, 'Let not your hands be slack.' **The LORD** your God in the midst of you is Mighty to save, He will Rejoice over you with Gladness; He will quiet you with His Love, He will Rejoice over you with Singing!

Ruth 1:16 But Ruth replied, "Do not urge me to leave you or turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people shall be my people, and your God shall be my God ..."

Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another; And the LORD listened and heard them,

So a Book of Remembrance was written before Him for them that feared the LORD and who meditate on His name.

"They shall be Mine, says the LORD of hosts, on the day that I make them My Jewels; and I will spare them,

as a man spares his own son that serves him."

Then shall you again discern between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who doesn't serve Him.

Malachi 3:16-18


