I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. **I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you.** And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed (through Messiah Yeshua!).

Genesis 15:5, 6, 18 “Look up at the heavens and count the stars, if indeed you can count them.” “Then He said to him, “So shall your offspring be.” Abram believed the LORD, and He credited it to him as righteousness. On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, and said, “**To your descendants I give this land**, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the Euphrates ...

And *He shall build the Temple* of the LORD; Yes, **He shall build the Temple of the LORD.** **He shall bear the Glory!** And He shall sit and rule (King) on His throne; and He shall be a Priest on His throne!” [**King - Priest**] Zechariah 6:12, 13

Ezekiel 37:26 “Moreover I will make a **Covenant of Peace** with them, and it shall be **an Everlasting Covenant** with them; I will establish and multiply them, and **I will set My Sanctuary** in their midst forevermore.”

Psalm 2:6 “ ... **I have set My King on Zion, My Holy Mount.**”

Psalm 68:16, 17 Why do you fume with envy, you mountains of many peaks? This is the Mountain which God desires to dwell in; Yes, the LORD will dwell in it forever. The chariots of God are twenty thousand, even thousands of thousands. The Lord is among them ... in the Holy Place.

Psalm 76:2 In **Shalem** is His Succah, and His dwelling place in Zion.

Psalm 102:13 You shall Arise and have Mercy on Zion, for the time to favor her, yes, the set time has come!

For the LORD shall build up Zion; **He shall appear in His Glory!**
Psalm 102:16

Great is the LORD and greatly to be praised in **the City of our God**, in His Holy Mountain. Beautiful for situation, **the Joy of the whole earth is Mount Zion** on the sides of the north (in Jerusalem),
the city of the Great King ... the LORD of hosts!

In the City of our God; God will establish it forever! Psalm 48:1, 2, 8

Isaiah 11:9, 10 “They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My Holy Mountain, for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the sea. And in that Day there shall be a Root of Jesse (Yeshua), who shall stand as a banner to the people. For the nations shall seek Him, and **His resting place shall be Glorious.**”

Psalm 132:8, 13, 14 **Arise O LORD, to Your resting place ... For the LORD has chosen Zion; He has desired it for His habitation. This is My resting place forever! Here will I dwell, for I have desired it.**

See how good and pleasant for brethren to dwell together in unity. As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there (by dwelling in unity) the LORD **commanded the Blessing, even Life forevermore!** Psalm 133:1, 3

Isaiah 1:26 “Afterward you shall be called **the City of Righteousness, the Faithful City.**” Isaiah 2:3 ... **for out of Zion shall go forth the Torah, and the Word of the LORD from Jerusalem.** (also written in Micah 4:2)

Isaiah 4:2-4 In that day **the Branch (Tzemach) of the LORD** shall be Beautiful and Glorious; and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and appealing for those of Israel who have escaped. And it shall come to pass that he who is left in Zion and remains in Jerusalem will be called holy, everyone who is recorded among the living in Jerusalem. When the LORD has washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and purged the blood of Jerusalem from her midst, by the Spirit of Judgment and by the Spirit of Burning ...

“**The LORD of hosts**, Him you shall hallow; let Him be your fear, and let Him be your dread. He will be as a Sanctuary, but **a Stone of stumbling** and **a Rock of offense** to both the houses of Israel, as a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And many among them shall stumble; they shall fall and be broken, be snared and taken.” Isaiah 8:13-17
Isaiah 8:16-18 “Bind up the testimony, seal the Torah among my disciples. And I will wait on the LORD, who hides His face from the house of Jacob; and I will hope in Him. Here am I and the children whom the LORD has given me! We are for signs and wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, **who dwells in Mount Zion**. [Coming Great Harvest - ben Hinnom Valley!]

**And in Mercy shall the Throne be established (Jerusalem).
And One shall sit upon it in Truth, in the Tent of David,
Judging, and seeking Judgment, and hastening Righteousness.**

Isaiah 16:5 (see also Isaiah 11:10 and Daniel 9:24)

Isaiah 10:20-22 And it shall come to pass in that Day that the remnant of Israel, and such as have escaped of the house of Jacob, will never again depend on him who defeated them, but will depend on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel ... The remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the Mighty God. For though your people, O Israel, be as the sand of the sea, a remnant will return; the destruction decreed shall overflow with righteousness.

Isaiah 27:13 In that Day **the Great Shofar** will be blown! They shall come who are about to perish in the land of Assyria, and they who are outcasts in the land of Egypt. And they shall worship the LORD in the Holy Mount at Jerusalem. [The LORD of hosts shall blow that Shofar! Zechariah 9:14, 15]

Who is this King of Glory? The LORD of hosts, He is the King of Glory!

Psalm 24:10

Isaiah 24:23 ... **the LORD of hosts shall Reign in Mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before His elders Gloriously.**

Isaiah 28:14-16 Therefore hear the word of the LORD, you scornful men, who rule this people who are in Jerusalem. Because you have said, “We have made a covenant with death, and we are in agreement with Sheol. When the overflowing scourge passes through, it will not come to us, for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood we have hidden ourselves.”

Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, “**Behold, I lay in Zion a Stone for a foundation, a tried Stone, a precious Cornerstone, a sure Foundation**; Whoever believes will not act hastily.” (Daniel 2:34, 44, 45)

Isaiah 28:17-19, 21, 22 Also I will make Justice the measuring line, and righteousness the plummet; The hail will sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters will overflow the hiding place. Your covenant with death will be annulled, and your agreement with Sheol will not stand. When the overflowing scourge passes through, then you will be trampled down by it. As often as it goes out it will take you; for morning by morning it will pass over, and by day and by night. It will be a terror just to understand the report.” For the LORD will rise up as at Mount Perazim. He will be angry as in the Valley of Gibeon, that He may do His work, His awesome work, and bring to pass His act, His unusual act. Now therefore, do not be mockers, lest your bonds be made strong; For I have heard from the Lord GOD of hosts, a destruction determined even upon the whole earth.

Isaiah 29:1, 2, 5-8 “Woe to Ariel, to Ariel, the city where David dwelt! ... Yet I will distress Ariel; there shall be heaviness and sorrow ... Moreover the multitude of **your foes shall be like fine dust, and the multitude of the terrible ones like chaff** that passes away. Yes, it shall be in an instant, suddenly. You will be punished by the LORD of hosts with thunder and earthquake, and great noise, with storm and tempest, and the flame of devouring fire. The multitude of all the nations who fight against Ariel, even all who fight against her and her fortress, and distress her, shall be as a dream of a night vision. It shall even be as when a hungry man dreams, and look—he eats; but he awakes, and his soul is still empty. Or as when a thirsty man dreams, and look—he drinks; but he awakes, and indeed he is faint, and his soul still craves. So the multitude of all the nations shall be, who fight against Mount Zion.”

... so the **LORD of hosts will come down to fight for Mount Zion and for its hill**... so will the LORD of hosts defend **Jerusalem**. (Isaiah 31:4, 5, 9) Defending, He will also deliver it; passing over, He will preserve it ... says the LORD, **whose fire is in Zion, and whose furnace is in Jerusalem**.

Isaiah 33:20, 21 Look on **Zion**, the City of our appointed feasts: your eyes shall see **Jerusalem** a quiet habitation, **a Tent (Ohel) that shall not be taken down; not one of its stakes shall ever be removed, neither shall any of its cords be broken**. But there the Majestic LORD shall be for us...

A Highway shall be there, and a road, and it shall be called '**the Highway of Holiness**'. The unclean shall not pass over it, but it shall be for others...

And **the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs**, and **Everlasting Joy upon their heads**. They shall obtain **joy and gladness**, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away. Isaiah 35:8, 10

Isaiah 46:13 I bring near My Righteousness; It shall not be far off, and **My Salvation** shall not tarry; **and I will place Salvation (Yeshuah) in Zion, for Israel My Glory!**

Isaiah 51:3 For the LORD **will comfort Zion**, He will comfort all her waste places. He will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD. **Joy and gladness** will be found in it, thanksgiving and the voice of melody.

Isaiah 52:1 Awake, awake; put on your Strength, **O Zion**; put on **your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the Holy City**;

Isaiah 62:1-5 For Zion's sake I will not hold My peace, and **for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest**, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a lamp that burns. The Gentiles shall see your righteousness, and all kings your glory. You shall be called by a new name, which the mouth of the LORD will name. You shall also be **a crown of glory** in the hand of the LORD, and **a royal diadem** in the hand of your God. You shall no longer be termed forsaken, nor shall your land any more be termed desolate. But you shall be called Hephzibah, and your land Beulah;

For the LORD delights in you, and **your land shall be married**. For as a young man marries a virgin, so shall your sons marry you; and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, **so shall your God rejoice over you**.

Isaiah 62:12 And they shall call them **the Holy People, the Redeemed** of the LORD. And you shall be called Sought Out, **a City not forsaken**.

“For behold, **I create new heavens and a new earth**; and the former shall not be remembered or come to mind. But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create. For behold, **I create Jerusalem as a Rejoicing, and her people a Joy. I will Rejoice in Jerusalem, and Joy in My people**. The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, nor the voice of crying. For as the days of a tree, so shall be the days of My people, and My elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands. For they shall be the descendants of the blessed of the LORD. It shall come to pass that before they call, I shall answer; and while they are still speaking, I will hear. The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, the lion shall eat straw like the ox ... They shall not hurt nor destroy in all **My Holy Mountain**,” says the LORD.

Isaiah 65:17-19, 22, 23, 24, 25

Isaiah 66:10-14 “Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad with her, all you who love her; Rejoice for joy with her, all you who mourn for her. That you may feed and be satisfied with the consolation of her bosom, that you may drink deeply and be delighted with the abundance of her glory.” For thus says the LORD, “Behold, I will extend Peace to her like a river, and the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream. Then you shall feed; on her sides shall you be carried, and be dandled on her knees. As one whom his mother comforts, so **I will comfort you. And you shall be comforted in Jerusalem**.” When you see this your heart shall rejoice, and your bones shall flourish like grass.

The hand of the LORD shall be known to His servants,
and His indignation to His enemies.

Isaiah 66:20-24 “Then they shall bring all your brethren for an offering to the LORD out of all nations, on horses and in chariots and in litters, on mules and on camels, to My Holy Mountain Jerusalem,” says the LORD, “as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the House of the LORD. And I will also take some of them for priests and Levites,” says the LORD. “For as the new heavens and the new earth which I will make shall remain before Me,” says the LORD, “so shall your descendants and your name remain. And it shall come to pass that from one New Moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another, **all flesh shall come to worship before Me**,” says the LORD.

Isaiah 60:13, 14, 15 “...I will make the place of My feet **Glorious!**”
And they shall call you, (**Jerusalem**) **the City of the LORD, the Zion of the Holy One of Israel.** Instead of your being forsaken and hated ...
I will make **you an Everlasting Excellency, a Joy of many generations.**

At that time **Jerusalem** shall be called ‘**The Throne of the LORD**’,
and **all nations shall be gathered to it**, to the name of the LORD,
to Jerusalem. Jeremiah 3:17

Jeremiah 31:12, 13, 14 Therefore **they shall come and sing in the height of Zion**, and be radiant over **the Goodness of the LORD**, for wheat and for new wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and the herd. **Their souls shall be like a well-watered garden**, and they shall sorrow no more...
“Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, and the young men and the old, together. For I will turn their mourning into **joy**, will comfort them, and make them **rejoice** rather than sorrow. I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance. And My people shall be satisfied with **My Goodness**, says the LORD.” 23 Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel,
“The LORD bless you O **Home of Justice and Mountain of Holiness!**”
40 “And the whole valley of the dead bodies and of the ashes ...
(the ben Hinnom Valley at base of Mount Zion hill) ...
as far as the brook Kidron, shall be Holy to the LORD!”

“Behold, the days are coming that I will perform **that Good Thing** which I have promised to the house of Israel and to the house of Judah. In those days and at that time I will cause to grow up to David a Branch (Tzemach) of Righteousness; He shall execute Judgment and Righteousness in the earth. In those days Judah will be saved, and **Jerusalem** will dwell safely. And this is the name ... ‘**THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.**’ ”
Jeremiah 33:14-16 (also see **Tzemach** in Jeremiah 23:5, 6)

Jerusalem, “Is this the city that is called ‘**The Perfection of Beauty, the Joy of the whole earth**’...” Lamentations 2:15

Ezekiel 5:5 “Thus says the Lord GOD, “This is **Jerusalem**;
I have set her in the midst of the nations and the countries all around her. ’ ”

Ezekiel 9:4-10 The LORD said to him, “Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and **put a mark on the foreheads of the men who sigh and cry over all the abominations** that are done within it.” To the others He said in my hearing, “Go after him through the city and kill; do not let your eye spare, nor have any pity. Utterly slay old and young men, maidens and little children and women; but do not come near anyone on whom is the mark; and begin at My sanctuary.” So they began with the elders who were before the temple. Then He said to them, “Defile the Temple, and fill the courts with the slain. Go out!” And they went out and killed in the city. So it was, that while they were killing them, I was left alone; and I fell on my face and cried out, and said, “Ah, Lord GOD! Will You destroy all the remnant of Israel in pouring out Your fury on Jerusalem?” Then He said to me, “The iniquity of the House of Israel and Judah is exceedingly great, and the land is full of bloodshed, and the city full of perversity; for they say, ‘The LORD has forsaken the land, and the LORD does not see!’ And as for Me also, My eye will neither spare, nor will I have pity, but I will recompense their deeds on their own head.”

Ezekiel 34:23-26 “I will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them. **My servant David**, he shall feed them and be their shepherd. And I the LORD shall be their God, and **My servant David** a Prince among them, I the LORD have spoken. I will make a Covenant of Peace with them. **I will make them and the places all around My hill (of Zion) a blessing**; and I will cause **showers** to come down in their season; **there shall be showers of blessing!**”

Ezekiel 37:24-28 “**David My servant** shall be king over them, and they shall all have one shepherd; they shall also walk in My Judgments and observe My Statutes, and do them. Then they shall dwell in the land that I have given to Jacob My servant, where your fathers dwelt; and they shall dwell there, they, their children, and their children’s children, forever. And **My servant David** shall be their prince forever. Moreover I will make a Covenant of Peace with them, and it shall be **an Everlasting Covenant** with them. I will establish them and multiply them, and I will set **My Sanctuary** in their midst forevermore. My dwelling place also shall be with them; indeed I will be their God, and they shall be My people. The nations also will know that I, the LORD, sanctify Israel, when **My Sanctuary** is in their midst **forevermore**.”

Ezekiel 20:40 “For on My Holy Mountain (Zion), on the mountain height of Israel,” says the LORD God, “there **all the house of Israel, all of them in the land shall serve Me;**”

Ezekiel 43:7 And He said to me, “Son of man, **this is the Place of My Throne and the place of the soles of My feet, (Mount Moriah)** where **I will dwell** in the midst of the children of Israel forever!”

Ezekiel 48:35 “... and the name of the City from that day shall be, **THE LORD IS THERE!**”

Hosea 11:10, 11 (also read Isaiah 11:9-12, and also read Isaiah 27:13)
“They shall walk after the LORD. **He will roar like a lion! When He roars,** then **His sons shall come trembling from the west,** they shall come trembling like a bird **from Egypt,** like a dove **from land of Assyria.**”

Joel 2:23-26, 27, 32

Be glad then, you children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God. For He has given you the **former rain** faithfully, and He will cause the rain to come down for you, **the former rain and the later rain in the first month.** The treshing floors shall be full of **wheat**, and the vats shall overflow with **new wine and oil.** So **I will restore to you the years that the ... locusts have eaten** ... My great army which I sent among you. You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied, and praise the name of the LORD your God, who has dealt wondrously with you... And My people shall never be put to shame ...

My people shall never be put to shame ...

“And it shall come to pass, that **whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be saved:** **for in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem** shall be **deliverance** (and **salvations**, and **healings**), as the LORD has said, and among **the remnant** whom the LORD shall call.”[**The Great Harvest!**]

Assemble and come, **all you nations**, and gather together all around. Cause Your mighty ones to go down there, O LORD. Let the nations be wakened, and come up to **the Valley of Jehoshaphat;** for there I will sit to **Judge** all the surrounding nations. Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, go down; for the winepress is full, the vats overflow, for their wickedness is great. **Multitudes, multitudes in the Valley of decision!** Joel 3:11-14

The sun & moon will grow dark, & the stars will diminish their brightness. **The LORD also will roar from Zion,** and utter **His voice** from **Jerusalem**; the heavens and earth will shake. But the LORD will be a shelter for His people, and the strength of the children of Israel. “So you shall know that I am the LORD your God, dwelling in **Zion, My Holy Mountain**. Then **Jerusalem shall be Holy**, and no aliens shall ever pass through her again.” And it will come to pass in that Day that the mountains shall drip with new wine, the hills shall flow with milk, and all the brooks of Judah shall be flooded with water. A fountain shall flow from the House of the LORD and water the Valley of Acacias. Joel 3:15-18

Amos 1:2 “**The LORD will roar from Zion,** and utter His voice from **Jerusalem**,”

Amos 9:11, 12, 13 “In that day **I will raise up the Succah of David that has fallen** and wall up its breaches. And I will raise up its ruins and I will rebuild it as the days of old. That they may possess the remnant of mankind, and all the peoples who are called by My name, says the LORD ...”

“Behold, the days are coming,” says the LORD, “when the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him who sows seed; the mountains shall drip with sweet wine, and all the hills shall flow with it.”

[The coming Great Jerusalem Harvest of souls!]

Zephaniah 3:14-17 Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! The LORD has taken away your judgments, He has cast out your enemy. The King of Israel, the LORD, is in your midst; you shall see disaster no more. In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem, “Do not fear; Zion, let not your hands be weak. The LORD your God in your midst, the Mighty One, will save; **He will Rejoice over you with Gladness, He will quiet you with His Love, He will Rejoice over you with Singing.**”

Zechariah 1:14-16 So the angel who spoke with me said to me, “Proclaim, saying, ‘Thus says the LORD of hosts: “**I am zealous for Jerusalem and for Zion with great zeal**. I am exceedingly angry with the nations at ease; For I was a little angry, and they helped—but with evil intent.” ‘Therefore thus says the LORD, “**I am returning to Jerusalem with Mercy; My House shall be built in it**,” says the LORD of hosts,” “Again proclaim, saying, ‘Thus says the LORD of hosts, “**The LORD will again comfort Zion, and will again choose Jerusalem.**” ’ ’ ”

Zechariah 2:5 “For,” says the LORD, “**I will be a wall of fire all around her (Jerusalem), and I will be the Glory in her midst.**”

Zechariah 2:10-12 “Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion! For behold, I am coming and **I will dwell in your midst,**” says the LORD. “Many nations shall be joined to the LORD in that day, and they shall become My people. And I will dwell in your midst. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent Me to you. And **the LORD will take possession of Judah as His inheritance** in the Holy Land, and will again choose Jerusalem.”

Zechariah 6:11-13 “Take the silver and gold, make elaborate (king’s) crowns, and set them on the head of **Yeshua** the son of Jehozadak, the high priest. Then speak to him, saying, ‘Thus says the LORD of hosts, saying, “Behold, **the Man** whose name is **the BRANCH (Tzemach)**! From His place He shall branch out, and He shall build the Temple of the LORD! Yes, **He shall build the Temple of the LORD!** He shall bear the Glory, and shall sit and Rule on His Throne; So He shall be **a Priest on His Throne,** and the counsel of peace shall be between them both (between Yeshua as both King and Priest).” [also see the Branch (**Tzemach**) in Zechariah 3:1, 8]

Again the word of the LORD of hosts came, saying, “Thus says the LORD of hosts: ‘I am zealous for **Zion** with great zeal; I am zealous for her with great fervor.’ “Thus says the LORD: ‘I will return to Zion, and dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. **Jerusalem shall be called the City of Truth, the Mountain of the LORD of hosts, the Holy Mountain!**” Zechariah 8:1-3

All the land shall be turned into a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be raised up and inhabited in her place from Benjamin’s Gate to the place of the First Gate and the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel to the king’s winepresses. The people shall dwell in it; and no longer shall there be utter destruction, but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited. And this shall be the plague with which the LORD will strike all the people who fought against Jerusalem: Their flesh shall dissolve while they stand on their feet, their eyes shall dissolve in their sockets, and their tongues shall dissolve in their mouths. It shall come to pass in that Day that a great panic from the LORD will be among them. Everyone will seize the hand of his neighbor, and raise his hand against his neighbor’s hand; Judah also will fight at Jerusalem. And the wealth of all the surrounding nations shall be gathered together; gold, silver, and apparel in great abundance. Such also shall be the plague on the horse and the mule, on the camel and the donkey, and on all the cattle that will be in those camps. So shall this plague be. TWO PHOTOS OF MOUNT ZION HILL SUDDENLY TURN GOLD

[this is a possible prophetic sign of New Jerusalem as described in Revelation 21:18, "...**the City was pure gold**, like clear glass."]

On April 7th, 2005, I was at my home with my wife in Kesalon, Israel, (15 miles from Jerusalem) scanning two rolls of normal negatives pictures which I had taken just outside Succat Hallel on a cloudy and overcast day, of the Mount Zion hills and ben Hinnom Valley area below, when **suddenly** a photo of this Mount Zion hill area came up golden on my computer screen. First lab report on the Golden Photos: Emailed to me on May 5th, 2005
Dear Mr. Richard,

Thank you very much for sharing this unique phenomenon with me. As a technician with 20 years experience at optics these two photos are really extraordinary. Such phenomena, especially at the holy city Jerusalem, near to a worship watch, shows to all of us that God has never left us.

Below is the English translation of the Hebrew of David Bahar's email lab report on the Golden Photos, May 5th, 2005. (translator Rebekah F.)

Mr. Richard, Shalom

Many thanks for sharing so kindly with me the two very interesting incidents that happened to you with the two photographs. In my twenty years of experience as an electronics technician specializing in optics, I find no logical explanation to this phenomenon. Considering the uniqueness of the location (Mt. Zion), the presence of a worship watch of believers, and the lack of traces of computer processing, we must, indeed, view this as **a sign from Heaven**.

Dear Mr. Richard,

About the golden pictures, as I showed you at the lab there is **a missing of the blue level** at those pictures. The blue level is one of the three levels that every picture has. Every picture should have the three levels: red, green and blue (RGB). If one the levels is missing we do not get a picture. This is the fascinating thing about these two pictures, that even though one of levels is missing, we still got a golden picture.

More than this, the fact that the pictures coming with a larger sky than the negatives **leaves me without any explanation**. All the events that I wrote above are not done on any software. And I am very sure about that.

Below is the English translation of the Hebrew section of David Bahar's 2nd lab report emailed to me on the Golden Photos, June 1st, 2005.

Dear Mr. Richard, Shalom

June 1, 2005

To continue our conversation in the lab, the test was done using Photoshop, and **found no trace of the blue level** in those pictures.

To clarify the matter, here is a more detailed explanation. Every picture is made of three primary colors: red, green and blue (RGB).

This system of three rays is used for TV as well as Photography. This combination of three primary colors creates all the colors we see in each picture. Using Photo Processing software, we can see the ratio of each of the three colors in every picture. Using the software, we can change the ratio to improve the visual quality of the picture.

Also, using the software we can determine whether the picture was somehow processed.

To summarize, as I have stated earlier, the test that was done using Photoshop found 1) **no trace of any sort of processing**. 2) The interesting finding with regard to those pictures is **the absolute absence of the third primary color (blue)**. This is an interesting finding indeed because this is a rare phenomenon, and because of the final fascinating result which is 3) **golden color only in some sections** of the picture.

4) Another interesting unexplainable fact about those pictures is that when comparing them with the negatives, it appears that **the lower sections do not appear in the pictures, and the part of the sky is bigger than what appears in the negatives**. David Bahar, Aloda Company, Tel Aviv


