Revealing the Mysteries of Yeshua's Bride To be Yeshua's Bride is our Father's Greatest Reward!

As Eve was taken from Adam's body, Yeshua's Bride comes from His Body Hebrews 12:14 ... **Holiness**, without which no one will see the Lord.

- 1) Weddings generally have **one bridegroom** and **one bride**, <u>along</u> <u>with many **guests**</u>. The Marriage of **King Priest Yeshua** to His **Bride**, His **Wife**, will be no exception to this pattern. Revelation 11:18; 19:7, 8
- 2) The Church is not Yeshua's Bride! The Church is Yeshua's Body!
- a) **Ephesians 1:22, 23** And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to **the Church**, which is **His Body**, the fullness of Him who fills all in all. (**Yeshua deeply Loves** each person in His Body!)
- b) Colossians 1:17-20, 24 And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. And <u>He is Head of the Body</u>, the Church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of **His Body**, which is the Church ...
- c) Ephesians 4:11-16 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the Body of Christ, until we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the Head, Messiah, from whom the whole Body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the Body for the edifying of itself in love.
- d) 1st Corinthians 12:27-31 Now you are the Body of Messiah, & members individually. And God has appointed these in the Church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues. Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles? Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way ...
- e) 1st Corinthians 13:1-13 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.

Though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, <u>but have not love</u>, it profits me nothing. Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails! But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away. When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things. For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part, but then I shall know just as I also am known. And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love!

f) **Ephesians 5:25-30** Husbands, love your wives, just as Messiah also loved the Church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the Word, that He might present her to Himself a Glorious Church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the Church. For we are members of His Body, of His flesh & of His bones.

He who has the Bride is the Bridegroom! John 3:29

3) But within **Yeshua's Body** you will find **Yeshua's Mystery Bride!** The Bridal place in Yeshua's Body is one of Great Grace but also our works! This Bridal place is open to all believers. God's heart knows those who really desire this intimate closeness with their Bridegroom Lover! Living daily within the very Heart of Yeshua, letting God mature us in real intimacy, obedience, surrender, love, sacrifice, perseverance, servanthood, faithfulness, humility, honor, and holiness. Yeshua's true disciples are His best soldiers. They put Him first in all things and prefer others above themselves, giving their lives to help & save others. Their delight is in the fear of the LORD!

[This Bridal position is available for all believers to press into ... 2nd Corinthians 11:2]

4) Yeshua gave one parable about the Bridegroom & His Bride, Matthew 25:1-10; verse 10, five of ten virgins were ready to go into the Marriage. Revelation 19:7, 8 Yeshua's Wife was ready in fine linen, by righteous acts. Almost all of Yeshua's other Wedding parables were about Guests at the Marriage Supper, the Wedding Banquet. Matthew 25:11, the five virgins who were not ready; Matthew 22:1-14; Luke 12:34-44 "... you ourselves be like men who wait for their Master, when He will return from the Wedding;" Rev 3:20; Mat 24:44-46; Luke 14:8-24; 19:13; The Guests:Revelation 19:9, "Blessed are those who are called to the Marriage Supper of the Lamb."

5) There is a major difference between a Marriage Ceremony (the Wedding), and the Marriage Supper (the Banquet Celebration where food is served).

The Marriage of the Lamb will be in Heaven on Yom Teruah! John 14:3; 17:24; Revelation 11:15,18 Then after a one year Honeymoon in Heaven (Deuteronomy 24:5) where Yeshua's Wife learns about 'as it is in Heaven, so be it on the earth'. (Isaiah 34:8; 63:4) Yeshua will return to earth with His armies, as He destroys all His enemies on the Feast of Battle, on Yom Kippur.

The <u>Marriage Supper of the Lamb</u> will be held <u>in Jerusalem</u> with <u>His Guests on Yeshua's Birthday</u>, Succoth, Feast of Tabernacles. This <u>begins His Millennial Reign</u>. (Isaiah 25:6-10; Matthew 22:7;10; Revelation 19:9, 14)

- 6) Yeshua is the fulfillment of the First Fruits of barley harvest during the Feast of Passover and Unleavened Bread. Yeshua's Wife (Bride) will be fulfillment of First Fruits of spring wheat harvest, Shavuot. These 2 feasts of God are always connected by the counting of the omer for 50 days. There are three harvest feast seasons each year in Israel: the barley harvest, during the time of Passover and Unleavened Bread, followed by the spring wheat harvest, first fruits of wheat, Shavuot, and then the great fall wheat harvest celebration, which is held on Succoth, the Feast of Tabernacles.
- 7) **Passover** has <u>unleavened</u> bread, matzah. Whereas <u>Shavuot</u> is a two loaf <u>firstfruits offering of leavened</u> bread. The two loaves are seen in Revelation 7:1-8, <u>144,000</u> from the 12 tribes of <u>Israel</u>, and Revelation 14:1-5; <u>144,000</u>, redeemed from all <u>nations</u> of the earth. (Song of Solomon 6:13: two camps) I believe these two loaves of 144,000 are the actual numbers, & not symbolic.
- 8) The Fullness of Yeshua's Bride will be taken to Heaven on Shavuot at the Midnight Hour. For 2000 years believers who have died have been taken up to Heaven. For to be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord. 2nd Corinthians 5:8 And among this group are Yeshua's Bride. But there will come a time when the completion of Yeshua's Bride will be taken to Heaven; it will happen exactly when Yeshua said, at the Midnight Hour! So then what is the Midnight Hour? It is just before the release of God's Wrath, 3 months later & for one year (Isaiah 13:9-16; 34:8; 61:2; 65:14) in the Day of the LORD! This occurs near the end of the 7 Tribulation years. (Matthew 24:13-(22)–31; Rev 6:15-17; 11:15-18; Isaiah 13:4-11; Joel 2:1-11)
- 9) Is there any place in Scripture where we see Yeshua's Bride being taken up into Heaven, besides Matthew 25:10? In Matthew 25:5, the Bridegroom delayed. In Revelation 10:1-7, after this Mighty Angel, Yeshua, Himself, Roars like a Lion, then He says that there will be delay no longer! His Roar (on Shavuot) takes His Bride to Heaven, & is the key that brings forth the Marriage of the Lamb; which after a preparation time, this Marriage will be held three months later, 1st of Tishri, Zichron Teruah (Yom Teruah) when the seventh angel sounds the 7th silver trumpet. Revelation 11:15, 18 I believe this Mystery of God (Revelation 10:7) is Yeshua's Marriage!

The first Shavuot began at Mount Sinai (Exodus 19) with the sounding of the Shofar of God, when God announced His Marriage Betrothal Covenant with Israel and with the nations. Exodus 12:28 and Deuteronomy 29:9-15; And then God divorced Israel. (Jeremiah 3:1-8) But God still cried out for Israel to return to Him, saying, "I am Married to you!" (Jeremiah 3:12-14) For your Maker is your Husband, the LORD of hosts is His name. Isaiah 54:5 God told Israel and Judah that He was a Husband to them. (Jeremiah 31:32) Then in Acts 2:1-6, in the the Upper Room on Shavuot, God re-entered into His Marriage Betrothal call to Israel, but now through God's New Covenant. God's One New Man, Jew and Gentile, were called into Marriage Betrothal. Marriage Betrothal of Yeshua to His Wife (Bride) begun at Mount Sinai, on Shavuot, will be consummated in Heaven in Marriage on Zichron Teruah.

10) All believers in Yeshua: <u>kings</u> & <u>priests</u> in the Melchi Zedek Priesthood, under our **King** and **Great High Priest Yeshua**. However Yeshua's Bride, those who have made it into <u>the very Heart of God</u>, will be <u>His **high priests**</u> and also **kings** in the Melchi Zedek priesthood. Yeshua is our Great King, the King of Glory, the KING of kings and the LORD of Lords, and Yeshua is also our Great High Priest, Melchi Zedek (my King of Righteousness)!

Yeshua's Bride <u>are being trained</u> as **high priests** in <u>prayer and intercession</u>, & as **kings** in use of <u>divine authority</u> in many areas, i.e. over demonic forces.

- 11) Yeshua's Bride is <u>sealed in her forehead!</u> See Ezekiel 9:4-6; Revelation 3:7-12; Revelation 7:3, 4; Revelation 14:1, 3, 4; Rev 21:9, 10; & Rev 22:3, 4
- These are all just Church theories which are all <u>missing Biblical keys</u> found in <u>the Mystery Shofar of God</u>: **the 10 places** where Yeshua sounds the Shofar in the Bible. These places are actually <u>two different events</u>, the first one is at Mount Sinai, which is called **the First Trump**. Exodus 19:16-19 The other events are different scenes of **the Last Trump**, called **the Great Trumpet!** 1st Corinthians 15:51-54; Isaiah 18:3; Isaiah 27:13; Zechariah 9:14-16; 1st Thessalonians 4:16-17; Ephesian 1:10; Matthew 24:30, 31; Mark 13:26, 27; Leviticus 25:8-10; Psalm 50:4-6; Micah 2:12, 13; [Revelation 1:10 and 4:1].

When we talk about **Rapture**, is this <u>the Rapture of Yeshua's Bride</u>? Or is this <u>the **Rapture** when Yeshua sounds the Great Shofar, when He is <u>returning</u> to earth with His Wife and all the rest of His Armies to destroy all <u>of His enemies</u>? This **Great Shofar** call will cause the rest of His Body on the earth to be instantly <u>gathered together to Himself</u> in the air! (Mark 13:27)</u>

God referred to **His First Trump** on Shavuot as a Jubal (Jubilee)! Ex 19:13 Yeshua will be returning in **the Year of Jubilee!** Leviticus 25:8-10; #3104

How does Yeshua's Bride make Herself Ready?

Yeshua came to earth to set us free <u>from wrong choices with our self will</u> & from <u>our independent nature</u> of living as our own god, doing our own thing, having our own way, separate from our God. He came to free us <u>from sin & death</u>, & bring us <u>into **Eternal Life**</u>.

Yeshua told us that we must be **born again**, born of the Spirit. That meant our spirit needed to be reconnected to the Holy Spirit of the Living God. That connection which Adam, the son of God had before his fall, was lost when Adam & Eve sinned & fell. But when Yeshua died on the Cross for all of our sins, by taking all of our sins upon Himself, then God's Grace allowed us to be able to confess & repent for our sins, and be brought back into fellowship with God. Then **our spirit** was **born again**, reconnected with the Holy Spirit of God. We were born from above. But this was only the beginning, our first step as new born babes in our walk with the Holy Spirit of the Living God toward the Kingdom of Heaven.

God created us as human beings with a **spirit**, **soul**, and **body**. Our soul is made up of our mind will and emotions. We were all created in God's own image. **God Loves us!** He Loves our spirit, soul, and body, & He Loves our mind, will, and emotions. Before Adam sinned and fell, he had relationship and fellowship with his Father through his spirit. Adam's spirit had control over his soul, over his mind, will, and emotions, and over his body. When he fell, being tricked by the devil, then his spirit became disconnected from God, his Father, through sin. His soul (his mind, his self will, and his emotions) now came under direct evil influence of the devil. And the soul of man took over the control of his being to survive.

This is how most of lost man lived for 1000's of years, disconnected from his God, since Adam and Eve's fall, until God sent Yeshua, His Son, to earth, to restore lost mankind back to their Father God. For God so Loved the world that He sent His only begotten Son.

Yeshua also came to make those who were saved <u>into disciples</u>, who would be taught how to follow their Loving Lord and Savior.

He would teach them <u>how to walk in the Spirit</u>, and how to be led by the Spirit. Man, who had been functioning from <u>his soul</u>, that is from his mind, self will, emotions, would now become disciples of God's own Son, taught by the One who had Saved them. He would teach them <u>the Way of the Cross</u>, so that they would be able to return to their Creator, Abba Father! They would learn to use their self will, choosing obedience to God's Word, and God's will, taking up their cross daily & following Him into Everlasting Life.

Today, all of us, as true born again believers are on this walk of discipleship. We need to make a shift from ourselves as the center of our lives, the ones in charge of our lives, into surrendering the controls, and allowing the Holy Spirit to be the Center of our life. We need to let go and let God be the One in control, to lead us, and to guide us back to our Loving Father. We need to daily, better yet moment by moment decide not to be in control with our minds and our own self will, but to allow our spirit & the Holy Spirit to be in charge of our lives. We need to take up our Cross daily, & follow Yeshua. We need to be more aware of the promptings of the Comforter, the Holy Spirit. For we are being matured by the Holy Spirit of Truth into all Truth.

Satan has been influencing our soul, with his negative thoughts and feelings, which we have believed were ours, but they are not. Once we started learning the Word of God, his attacks were more obvious to us. And God has been training us to use His Word as a Sword against our adversary. This battle has been at our minds, & only through declaring the Word of God can we win this battle. God's Word is true, and He gives us Victory in this battle. But we must continually surrender and allow the Holy Spirit and our spirit to be in control, not our minds & misuse of self will and emotions.

So as Yeshua's disciples, seeking to get closer to our Lord, here are <u>some helpful steps</u> that we can each apply in our daily life.

One good way for us **not to be in control** is <u>to ask the Lord's</u> <u>direction</u> in almost everything we do, in the decisions that we make daily, to learn to shift our focus from ourselves <u>to the Lord</u>, to learn to let the Lord lead more, as we just humbly follow. Also to not be

driven by the devil; to stop allowing him to have control of our thoughts and feelings; to refocus our attention from ourself as the center, to the Lord as our Center. Other good ways are to worship Yeshua more, to just sit quietly before the Lord a lot more than we do. This will be helpful in allowing the Lord to change us in many areas, such as in crucifying our flesh with its desires and drives for attention, recognition & approval of man; our selfish, judgmental, and critical behavior toward others, and any perfectionist behavior, just to mention a few common areas that need to be overcome by many of us. To be able to live a life of really staying humble, with regular repentance for our sins, and praying a lot more in the Spirit.

Are we quickly obeying God when God tells us to do, or not to do something? We do not have to talk and give our point of view, unless we have the Spirit's unction. Just to be nobody special! It would also be good to ask the Holy Spirit to order our steps daily.

The Words listed below, spoken by Yeshua and His disciples have been of great help to me, and perhaps they will also be to you.

Go your way, <u>sell whatever you have and give to the poor</u>, and you will have <u>treasure in Heaven</u>. And come, <u>take up the cross</u>, <u>and follow Me</u>."

Mark 10:43 "Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great

Mark 10:43 "Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant. Mark 10:44 And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. Mark 10:45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His Life a ransom for many."

Mark 16:17 "And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; Mark 16:18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

Luke 4:1 Then Yeshua, **being filled with the Holy Spirit**, returned from the Jordan River and was <u>led by the Spirit</u> ... Luke 9:23 Then He said to them all, "<u>If anyone desires to come after Me</u>, <u>let him **deny himself**</u>, and **take up his cross daily**, and follow <u>Me</u>."

Luke 11:2 So He said to them, "When you pray, say: Our Father in Heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your Kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in Heaven!" Luke 12:22 Then He said to His disciples, "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; nor about the body, what you will put on.

Luke 12:23 Life is more than food, and the body is more than clothing."

Luke 14:26 "If anyone comes to Me <u>and does not hate</u> his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, <u>yes</u>, <u>and his own life also</u>, he cannot be My disciple! Luke 14:27 And <u>whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me</u>, he cannot be My disciple! Luke 14:33 So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has,

he cannot be My disciple!"

John 4:24 "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

John 6:63 "It is the Spirit who gives Life; the flesh profits nothing!

The Words that I speak to you are Spirit, and they are Life!"

John 8:15 "You judge according to the flesh; I Judge no one. John 8:16 And yet if I do Judge, My Judgment is True; for I am not alone, but I am with My Father who sent Me." John 8:28 Then Yeshua said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things. John 8:29 And He who sent Me is with Me. My Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him!" John 8:31 Then Yeshua said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. John 8:32 And you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free!" John 13:14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet." John 13:35 "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

John 14:12 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the Works that I do he will do also; and <u>Greater Works</u> than these he will do, because I go to My Father." John 14:14 "If you ask anything in My name, <u>I will do it</u>. John 14:15 <u>If you love Me</u>, <u>keep My Commandments</u>." John 14:23 Jesus answered and said to him, "<u>If anyone loves Me</u>, he will keep My Word; and My Father <u>will love him</u>, and <u>We will come</u> to him and make Our home with him!"

- John 15:9 "As My Father Loved Me, I also have Loved you; abide in My Love.
- John 15:10 **If you keep My Commandments**, <u>you will abide in My Love</u>, just as I have kept My Father's Commandments, and abide in His Love.

- John 21:17 He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?" Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, "Do you love Me?" And he said to Him, "Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You." Yeshua said to him, "Feed My Sheep!"
- John 21:19 This He spoke, signifying by what death he would glorify God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him, "Follow Me!" John 21:22 Yeshua said to him, "If I will that he remain till I come, what is that to you? You follow Me!" Acts 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance ...
- Acts 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the Word of God with boldness.
- Romans 8:1 There is therefore now <u>no condemnation to those who are in Messiah Jesus</u>, <u>who do not walk according to the flesh</u>, **but according to the Spirit**. Romans 8:2 For <u>the law of the Spirit of Life in Messiah Jesus</u> has made me free from the law of sin and

death. Romans 8:3 For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, Romans 8:4 that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the **Spirit**. Romans 8:5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. Romans 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Romans 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. Romans 8:8 So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. Romans 8:9 But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Messiah, he is not His. Romans 8:10 And if Messiah is in you, the body is dead because of sin. but the Spirit is Life because of righteousness. Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you. He who raised Messiah from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. Romans 8:12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors—not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. Romans 8:13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

1 Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that <u>your body is **the temple of the Holy Spirit**</u> who is in you, whom you have from God, and <u>you are not your own</u>? 1 Corinthians 8:1 We know that we all have knowledge. <u>Knowledge puffs up</u>, but **love edifies**.

1 Corinthians 14:18 I thank my God <u>I speak with tongues more</u> than you all;

2 Corinthians 10:5 ... casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Messiah,

Galatians 2:20 <u>I have been crucified with the Messiah</u>; **it is no longer I who live**, but the Messiah who lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by (the) faith (of) in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. Galatians 5:16 I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Galatians 5:22 But **the fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, Galatians 5:23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. Galatians 5:24 And those who are Messiah's <u>have crucified the flesh</u> with its passions and desires.

Ephesians 2:6 ... and <u>raised us up</u> together, <u>and made us sit together in the Heavenly</u> <u>places in Messiah Jesus</u>, Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, <u>created in Messiah Jesus for good works</u>, which God prepared beforehand <u>that we should walk in them</u>.

Ephesians 5:18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but **be filled with the Spirit** ...

Philippians 2:8 And being found in appearance as a Man, **He humbled Himself and** (was) became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross! Philippians 2:12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own Salvation with fear and trembling; Philippians 2:13 for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His pleasure. Philippians 3:7 But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Messiah.

Philippians 3:8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Messiah Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Messiah, Philippians 3:9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Messiah, the righteousness which is from God by faith; Philippians 3:10

That I may know Him, and the Power of His Resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, Philippians 3:11 if, by any means, I may attain to the Resurrection from the dead. Philippians 3:12 Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Messiah Jesus has also laid hold of me. Philippians 3:13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended. But one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, Philippians 3:14

I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Messiah Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and <u>may your whole **spirit**</u>, <u>soul</u>, <u>and body</u> be preserved blameless, at the coming of our Lord Jesus the Messiah.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. Hebrews 12:1 Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us. Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Yeshua, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the Cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right Hand of the Throne of God.

James 4:8 <u>Draw near to God</u> and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

1 John 1:7 But <u>if we walk in the light</u> as He is in the light, <u>we have fellowship</u> with one another. And the blood of Messiah Jesus His Son <u>cleanses</u> us from all sin.

Revelation 2:7 "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes <u>I will give to eat from **the Tree of Life**</u>, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God." 'Revelation 3:5 He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and <u>I will not blot out his name from **the Book of Life**</u>; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.

Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him (Satan) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their (self) lives to the death!

Revelation 14:1 Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads. Revelation 14:2 And I heard a voice from Heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps. Revelation 14:3 They sang as it were a new song before the Throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred and forty-four thousand who were redeemed from the earth. Revelations 14:4 These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men,

being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb.

Revelation 17:14 "The Lamb will overcome them, for He is <u>Lord of lords</u> and <u>King of kings</u>; and those who are with Him are <u>called</u>, <u>chosen</u>, and <u>faithful</u>." Revelation 21:7 **He who overcomes** <u>shall inherit all things</u>, and I will be his God and **he shall be My son!**

2 Chronicles 26:5 ... and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper. 1 Samuel 15:22 So Samuel said, "Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as **in obeying** the voice of the LORD? Behold, **to obey** is better than sacrifice, and to heed than the fat of rams. 1 Samuel 15:23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Psalms 119:105 **Your Word** is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. Isaiah 8:18 Here am I, and the children whom the LORD has given me! We are for signs and wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, who dwells in Mount Zion. Isaiah 30:20 And though the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, yet your teachers will not be moved into a corner anymore, but your eyes shall see your teachers. Isaiah 30:21 Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the Way, walk in it," whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left. Isaiah 40:31 But those who wait on the LORD **shall renew their strength**; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint. Isaiah 57:15 For thus says the High and Lofty One who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy, "I dwell in the high and holy place, with him who has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones." Isaiah 62:5 For as a young man marries a virgin, so shall your sons marry you; And as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God Rejoice over you.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all like **an unclean thing**, and all our righteousnesses are like **filthy rags**; We all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Jeremiah 3:15 "And <u>I will give you **shepherds** according to My heart</u>, who will feed you with **knowledge** and **understanding**."

Jeremiah 23:4 "I will set up **shepherds** over them who will feed them; and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, nor shall they be lacking," says the LORD. Micah 6:8 He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you, but to <u>do justly</u>, to <u>love mercy</u>, and **to walk humbly with your God**? Zephaniah 3:17 "The LORD your God in your midst, the Mighty One, will Save;

He will Rejoice over you with Gladness. He will quiet you with His Love, He will Rejoice over you with Singing!"
