all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease. Matthew 10:8 "Heal the sick, cleanse
the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give."
Matthew 10:24 "A disciple is not above his Teacher, nor a servant above his Master.
Matthew 10:25 It is enough for a disciple that he be like his Teacher, and a servant
like his Master. Matthew 10:28 And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot
kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell."
Matthew 11:5 "The blind see, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and
the deaf hear; the dead are raised up, and the poor have the Gospel preached to them."
Matthew 11:28 "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give
you rest. Matthew 11:29 Take My Yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle

Matthew 18:2 Then Yeshua called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them, Matthew 18:3 and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Matthew 18:4 Therefore whoever **humbles himself** as this little child is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven." Matthew 18:18 "Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in Heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in Heaven. Matthew 18:19 Again I say to you that **if two of you agree on earth** concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in Heaven. Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them." Matthew 19:30 "But many who are first will be last, and the last first." Matthew 20:16 "So the last will be first, and the first last. For many are called, but few chosen." (Mk10:31) Matthew 20:26 "Yet it shall not be so among you: but whoever desires to become great among you, **let him be your servant**. Matthew 20:27 And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave. Matthew 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many." Matthew 21:22 "And whatever things you ask in prayer, **believing**, you will receive." Matthew 22:37 Yeshua said to him, "'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' Matthew 22:38 This is the first and great Commandment. Matthew 22:39 And the second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' Matthew 22:40 On these two Commandments hang all the Law (Torah) and the Prophets." (also found in Mark 12:29-31) Matthew 23:11 "But he who is greatest among you shall be your servant. Matthew 23:12 And whoever exalts himself will be humbled, he who humbles himself will be exalted." Matthew 24:4 And Yeshua answered and said to them, "Take heed that no one deceives you. Matthew 24:5 For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am Christ,' " (the Pope) Matthew 25:1 "Then the Kingdom of Heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the Bridegroom. Matthew 25:2 Now five of them were wise, and five were foolish. Matthew 25:3 Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them. Matthew 25:4 but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. Matthew 25:5 But while the Bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. Matthew 25:6 And at Midnight a cry was heard, 'Behold, the Bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!' Matthew 25:7 Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. Matthew 25:8 And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' Matthews 25:9 But the wise answered, saying, 'No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' Matthew 25:10 And while they went to buy, the Bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with Him to the Wedding; and the Door was shut! Matthew 25:11 "Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!' Matthew 25:12 But He answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.' Matthew 25:13 Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming." Matthew 26:40 Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, "What! Could you not watch with Me one hour?" Matthew 28:18 And Yeshua came and spoke to them, saying, "All Authority has been given to Me in Heaven and on earth. Matthew 28:19 "Go therefore and make disciples

of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Matthew 28:20 teaching them to observe all things that I have Commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the Age." Amen. Mark 1:35 Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed. (also found in Luke 5:16) Mark 3:33 But He answered them, saying, "Who is My mother, or My brothers?" Mark 3:34 And He looked around in a circle at those who sat about Him, and said, "Here are My mother and My brothers! Mark 3:35 For whoever does the will of God is My brother and My sister and mother."

Mark 8:29 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered and said to Him, "You are **the Messiah**." Mark 8:32 Then Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him. Mark 8:33 But when He had turned around and looked at His disciples, He rebuked Peter, saying, "Get behind Me, Satan! For you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men." Mark 8:34 When He had called the people to Himself, with His disciples also, He said to them, "Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. Mark 8:35 For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the Gospel's will save it! Mark 8:36 For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Mark 8:37 Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?" Mark 9:35 And He sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, "If anyone desires to be first, he shall be last of all and servant of all." Mark 10:14 But when Yeshua saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the Kingdom of God. Mark 10:15 Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the Kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." Mark 10:21 Then Yeshua, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, "One thing you lack. Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in Heaven. And come, take up the cross, and follow Me." Mark 10:31 "But many who are first will be last, and the last first." Mark 10:43 "Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant. Mark 10:44 And whoever of you desires to be first **shall be slave of all**. Mark 10:45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His Life a ransom for many." Mark 12:29 Yeshua answered him, "The first of all Commandments is, 'Hear, O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is One. Mark 12:30 And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first Commandment. Mark 12:31 And the second, like it, is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other Commandments greater than these."

Mark 16:15 And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature. Mark 16:16 He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; Mark 16:18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." Mark 16:20 And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the Word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

Luke 1:41 And it happened, when Elisheva heard the greeting of Miriam, that the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisheva was filled with the Holy Spirit. Luke 1:67 Now his father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit, and prophesied, saying: 1:76 "And you child (Yochanan) will be called the prophet of the Highest ..." Luke 2:40 And the Child (Yeshua) grew and became strong in Spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him. Luke 4:1 Then Yeshua, being filled with the **Holy Spirit**, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness ... Luke 6:13 And when it was day, He called His disciples to Himself; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles: Luke 6:37 "Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven." Luke 6:40 "A disciple is not above his Teacher, but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his Teacher." Luke 6:41 "And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the plank in your own eye? Luke 6:42 Or how can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove the speck that is in your eye,' when you yourself do not see the plank that is in your own eye? Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck that is in your brother's eye." (Matthew 7:3-5) Luke 8:21 But He answered and said to them, "My mother and My brothers are these who hear the Word of God and do it!" Luke 9:1 Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them **Power and Authority** over all demons, and to cure diseases. Luke 9:23 Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me." Luke 10:19 "Behold, I give you the Authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and **nothing** shall by any means hurt you. Luke 10:20 Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in Heaven." Luke 11:2 So He said to them, "When you pray, say, 'Our Father in Heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your Kingdom **come!** Your will be done on earth as it is in Heaven! Luke 11:3 Give us day by day our daily bread. Luke 11:4 And forgive us our sins, as we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one." Luke 12:22 Then He said to His disciples, "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; nor about the body, what you will put on. Luke 12:23 Life is more than food, and the body is more than clothing." Luke 13:24 "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I say to you, will seek to enter and will not be able. Luke 13:25 When once the Master of the House has risen up and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open for us,' and He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know you, where you are from.' Luke 13:26 Then you will begin to say, "We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets.' Luke 13:27 But He will say, 'I tell you I do not know you, where you are from. Depart from Me, all you workers of iniquity!' Luke 13:28 There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob, and all the prophets in the Kingdom of God, and yourselves thrust out. Luke 13:29 They will come from the east and the west, from the north and the south, and sit down in the Kingdom of God. Luke 13:30 And indeed there are last who will be first, and there are first who will be last." Luke 14:11 "For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who **humbles himself** will be exalted." Luke 14:26 "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters,

yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple! Luke 14:27 And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple! Luke 14:33 So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has, he cannot be My disciple!"

Luke 18:14 "... for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted." Luke 22:42 "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done!" (Mt 26:39; Mark 14:36)

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His Glory, the Glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of Grace and Truth.

John 3:3 Yeshua answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless

one is **born again**, **he cannot see the Kingdom of God!**" John 3:5 Yeshua answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is **born of Water** and **the Spirit**, **he cannot enter the Kingdom of God!** John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh **is flesh**, and that which is **born of the Spirit is Spirit!** John 3:7 Do not marvel that I said to you, "You must be **born again!**" John 3:8 The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is **born of the Spirit.**" John 3:11 Most assuredly, I say to you, **We speak** what **We know** and testify what **We have seen**, and you do not receive **Our witness**. John 3:12 If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you Heavenly things? John 3:13 No one has ascended to Heaven but He who came down from Heaven, that is, **the Son of Man** who is in Heaven."

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have Everlasting Life. John 3:17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. John 3:18 He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. John 3:20 For everyone practicing evil hates the light, and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. John 3:21 But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God." John 3:27 John answered and said, "A man can receive nothing unless it has been given to him from Heaven." John 4:23 "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship My Father in Spirit and Truth; for My Father is seeking such to worship Him. John 4:24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in Spirit and Truth." John 4:34 Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His Work."

John 5:19 Then Yeshua answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner. John 5:20 For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him Greater Works than these, that you may marvel. John 5:21 For as the Father raises the dead and gives Life to them, even so the Son gives Life to whom He will. John 5:22 For the Father Judges no one, but has committed all Judgment to the Son, John 5:23 that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him. John 5:30 I can of Myself do nothing! As I hear, I Judge; and My Judgment is Righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of My Father who sent Me. John 5:31 If I bear witness of Myself, My witness is not true. John 5:32 There is another who bears witness of Me, and I know that the witness which He witnesses of Me is True." John 5:39 "You search the Scriptures, for in them

```
you think you have Eternal Life; and these are they which testify of Me. John 5:40
But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have Life. John 5:41 I do not
receive honor from men. John 5:43 I have come in My Father's name, and you do not
receive Me; if another comes in his own name (Pope), him you will receive. John 5:44
* How can you believe, who receive honor from one another, and do not seek the honor
that comes from the only God?" John 6:29 Yeshua answered and said to them,
"This is the work of God, that you believe in Him (Yeshua) whom He (My Father) sent."
John 6:38 "For I have come down from Heaven, not to do My own will,
but the will of Him who sent Me." John 6:63 "It is the Spirit who gives Life; the flesh
profits nothing! The Words that I speak to you are Spirit, and they are Life!"
John 6:68 But Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go?
You have the Words of Eternal Life. John 6:69 Also we have come to believe
and know that You are the Messiah, the Son of the Living God."
* John 7:18 He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who seeks
the Glory of the One who sent Him is True, and no unrighteousness is in Him."
John 7:38 "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart
will flow rivers of Living Water." John 8:15 "You judge according to the flesh;
I Judge no one. John 8:16 And yet if I do Judge, My Judgment is True; for I am not
alone, but I am with My Father who sent Me." John 8:21 Then Yeshua said to them
again, "I am going away, and you will seek Me, and you will die in your sins. Where
I go you cannot come." John 8:24 Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins;
for if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins!"
John 8:28 Then Yeshua said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you
will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me,
I speak these things. John 8:29 And He who sent Me is with Me. My Father has not
left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him!" John 8:31 Then Yeshua
said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples
indeed. John 8:32 And you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free!"
John 8:34 Yeshua answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin
is a slave of sin. John 8:35 And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son
abides forever. John 8:36 Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed."
John 8:38 "I speak what I have seen with My Father."
John 8:50 "And I do not seek My own Glory; there is One who seeks and Judges."
John 8:51 "Most assuredly, I say to you, if anyone keeps My Word he shall never see
death." John 8:52 Then the Jews said to Him, "Now we know that You have a demon!
Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and You say, 'If anyone keeps My Word he shall
never taste death.' "John 8:54 Jesus answered, "If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing.
It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your God."
John 10:10 "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy.
I have come that they may have Life, and that they may have Life more abundantly!"
John 10:15 "As My Father knows Me, even so I know My Father; and I lay down
My Life for the sheep. John 10:16 And other sheep I have which are not of this fold;
them also I must bring, and they will hear My Voice; and there will be one flock
and one Shepherd." John 10:25 Yeshua answered them, "I told you, and you do not
believe. The Works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me."
John 10:30 "I and My Father are One!" John 10:37 "If I do not do the Works of My
Father, do not believe Me; John 10:38 but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe
the Works, that you may know and believe that My Father is in Me, and I (am) in Him."
John 11:42 "And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the people who are
```

standing by I said this, that they may believe that You sent Me." John 12:24 Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but **if it dies**, it produces much grain! John 12:25 "He who loves his life **will lose** it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for Eternal Life. John 12:26 If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honor." John 12:28 "Father, Glorify Your name." Then a Voice came from Heaven, saying, "I have both Glorified it, and will Glorify it again." John 12:36 "While you have the light, believe in the light, that you may become **sons of light**." John 12:45 "And he who sees Me **sees Him** who sent Me." John 12:48 "He who rejects Me, and does not receive My Words, has that which Judges him, the Word that I have spoken will Judge him in the last Day. John 12:49 For I have not spoken on My own Authority; but My Father who sent Me gave Me a Command, what I should say and what I should speak. John 12:50 And I know that His Command is **Everlasting Life!** Therefore, whatever I speak, just as My Father has told Me, so I speak." John 13:13 "You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. John 13:14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. John 13:15 For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you. John 13:16 Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his **Master**; nor is he who is sent greater than He who sent him. (John 15:20) John 13:17 If you know these things, **blessed are you if** you do them." John 13:35 "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." John 14:7 If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him, and have seen Him." John 14:9 Yeshua said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen My Father; so how can you say, 'Show us Your Father' "? John 14:12 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and Greater Works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. John 14:13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that My Father may be Glorified in His Son. John 14:14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it! John 14:15 If you love Me, keep My Commandments. John 14:16 And I will pray to My Father, and He will give you another **Helper**, that He may abide with you **forever**. John 14:17 **the Spirit of Truth**, whom the world cannot receive. because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. But you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. John 14:18 I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. John 14:20 At that Day you will know that I am in My Father, and you (are) in Me, and I (am) in you. John 14:21 He who has My Commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by Mv Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him." John 14:23 Yeshua answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and My Father will Love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him!" John 14:28 "You have heard Me say to you. 'I am going away and coming back to you.' If you loved Me, you would rejoice because I said, 'I am going to My Father,' for My Father is Greater than I." John 15:4 "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. John 15:5 I am the Vine. you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing!"

John 15:7 "If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you

desire, and it shall be done for you. John 15:8 By this My Father is Glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. John 15:9 As My Father Loved Me, I also have Loved you; abide in My Love. John 15:10 If you keep My Commandments, you will abide in My Love, just as I have kept My Father's Commandments, and abide in His Love. John 15:11 These things I have spoken to you, that My Joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full. John 15:12 This is My Commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. John 15:14 You are My friends if you do whatever I Command you. John 15:15 No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his Master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you. John 15:16 You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask My Father in My name He may give you. John 15:17 These things I Command you, that you love one another!"

John 15:23 "He who hates Me hates My Father also!"

John 15:26 "But when **the Helper** comes, whom I shall send to you from My Father, the Spirit of Truth who proceeds from My Father. He will testify of Me." John 16:7 "Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. John 16:8 And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of Righteousness, and of Judgment: John 16:9 of sin, because they do not believe in Me; John 16:10 of Righteousness, because I go to My Father, and you see Me no more; John 16:11 **of Judgment**, because the ruler of this world is Judged. John 16:12 I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. John 16:13 However, when He, the Spirit of Truth, has come. He will guide you into all Truth: for He will not speak on His own Authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. John 16:14 He will Glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you! John 16:15 All things that My Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you." John 16:24 "Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full." John 16:27 "... for My Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God. John 16:28 I came forth from My Father and have come into the world. Again, I leave the world and go to My Father." John 16:29 His disciples said to Him, "See, now You are speaking plainly, and using no figure of speech! Romans 7:14 For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am carnal, sold under sin. Romans 7:15 For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do. Romans 7:16 If, then, I do what I will not to do. I agree with the law that it is good. Romans 7:17 But now, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me. Romans 7:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find. Romans 7:22 For I delight in the law of God according to the inward man. Romans 7:23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. Romans 7:24 O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? Romans 7:25 I thank God, through Messiah Jesus our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin. Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Messiah Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but walk according to the Spirit. Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of Life in Messiah Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. Romans 8:3 For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh. Romans 8:4 that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the **Spirit**. Romans 8:5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. Romans 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Romans 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. Romans 8:8 So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. Romans 8:9 But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Messiah, he is not His. Romans 8:10 And if Messiah is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is Life because of righteousness. Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Messiah from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. Romans

8:12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. Romans 8:13 For if you live according to the flesh **you will die**; but if **by the Spirit** you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live! Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of Adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, Romans 8:17 and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together. Romans 8:18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the Glory which shall be revealed in us. Romans 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the Creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. Romans 8:28 We know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. Romans 8:29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Romans 11:29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but **be transformed** by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good & acceptable and perfect will of God. 1 Corinthians 2:1 And I, brethren, when I came to you, did not come with excellence of speech or of wisdom declaring to you the testimony of God. 1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus the Messiah and Him Crucified. 1 Corinthians 2:3 I was with you in weakness, in fear, and in much trembling. 1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power, 1 Corinthians 2:5 that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the Power of God. 1 Corinthians 2:9 But as it is written, "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered in the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." 1 Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? 1 Corinthians 6:20 You were bought at a price: therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit. which are God's. 1 Corinthians 8:1 ... We know that we all have knowledge. * Knowledge puffs up, but love edifies. 1 Corinthians 14:18 I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all; 1 Corinthians 14:32 And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets. 1 Corinthians 15:44 It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body. 1 Corinathians 15:45 And so it is written, "The first Man Adam became a Living Being." The last Adam became a Life-giving **Spirit**. 1 Corinthians 15:46 However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual. 1 Corinthians 15:47 The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from Heaven. 1 Corinthians 15:48 As was the man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust; & as is the Heavenly Man, so also are those who are heavenly. 1 Corinthians 15:49 And as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the Heavenly Man. 1 Corinthians 15:50 Now this I say. brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the Kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. 1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I tell you a mystery, we shall not all

sleep, but we shall all be changed, 1 Corinthians 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the Last Trumpet. For the Trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised

incorruptible, and we shall be changed. 1 Corinthians 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. 1 Corinthians 15:54 So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, "Death is swallowed up in Victory." 1 Corinthians 15:55 "O death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?" 1 Corinthians 15:56 The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. 1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the Victory through our Lord Jesus the Messiah. 1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. 2 Corinthians 3:5 Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God, 2 Corinthians 3:6 who also made us sufficient as ministers of the New Covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives Life. 2 Corinthians 4:7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the Power may be of God and not of us. 2 Corinthians 4:8 We are hard-pressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; 2 Corinthians 4:9 persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed. 2 Corinthians 4:10 always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the Life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. 2 Corinthians 4:11 For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. 2 Corinthians 4:12 So then death is working in us, **but life in vou!** 2 Corinthians 10:1 Now I, Paul, myself am pleading with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ—who in presence am lowly among you, but being absent am bold toward you. 2 Corinthians 10:2 But I beg you that when I am present I may not be bold with that confidence by which I intend to be bold against some, who think of us as if we walked according to the flesh. 2 Corinthians 10:3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. 2 Corinthians 10:4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but **Mighty in God** for pulling down strongholds, 2 Corinthians 10:5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God. bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Messiah ... 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said to me, "My Grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities. that the Power of the Messiah may rest upon me. 2 Corinthians 12:10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for the Messiah's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong! Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with the Messiah; it is no longer I who live, but the Messiah who lives in me. And the life which I now live in the flesh I live by (the) faith (of) in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. Galatians 3:13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), Galatians 5:6 For in Messiah Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love. Galatians 5:16 I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, Galatians 5:23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. Galatians 5:24 And those who are Messiah's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. Galatians 5:25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Galatians 5:26 Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. Galatians 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Messiah. Galatians 6:3 * For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing.

he deceives himself. Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should boast except in the Cross of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Ephesians 1:20 ... which He worked in Messiah when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His Right Hand in the Heavenly places. Ephesians 1:21 far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this Age but also in that which is to come. Ephesians 1:22 And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be Head over all things to the Church, Ephesians 1:23 which is **His Body**, the fullness of Him who fills all in all. Ephesians 2:4 But God, who is rich in Mercy, because of His great Love with which He loved us. Ephesians 2:5 even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Messiah (by grace you have been saved). Ephesians 2:6 and raised us up together. and made us sit together in the Heavenly places in Messiah Jesus, Ephesians 2:7 that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His Grace in His Kindness toward us in Messiah Jesus. Ephesians 2:8 For by Grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, Ephesians 2:9 not of works, lest anyone should boast. Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Messiah Jesus for **good works**, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. Ephesians 3:8 To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this Grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Messiah. Ephesians 3:16-19 That he would grant you, according to the riches of His Glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, & height; and to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God. Ephesians 5:18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but **be filled** with the Spirit ... Ephesians 5:22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. Ephesians 5:23 For the husband is head of the wife, as also Messiah is Head of the Church; and He is the Savior of the Body. Ephesians 5:24 Therefore, just as the Church is subject to Messiah, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything. Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Messiah also loved the Church and gave Himself for her, Ephesians 5:26 that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the Word, Ephesians 5:27 that He might present her to Himself a Glorious Church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. Ephesians 5:28 So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. Ephesians 5:29 For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the Church. Ephesians 5:30 For we are members of **His Body**, of His flesh and of His bones. Philippians 1:6 ... being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the Day of Messiah Jesus:

Philippians 2:3 Let nothing be done through <u>selfish ambition or conceit</u>, but in lowliness of mind <u>let each esteem others better than himself</u>. Philippians 2:4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but <u>also for the interests of others</u>. Philippians 2:5 <u>Let this Mind be in you</u> which was also in Messiah Jesus, Philippians 2:6 who, <u>being in the form of God</u>, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, Philippians 2:7 <u>but made Himself of no reputation</u>, <u>taking the form of a bondservant</u>, and coming in the likeness of men. Philippians 2:8 And being found in appearance as a Man, <u>He humbled Himself</u> and **became <u>obedient to the point of death</u>**, <u>even the death of the cross!</u> Philippians 2:9 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him, and given Him <u>the Name which is above every name</u>, Philippians 2:10 that at the name of Jesus <u>every knee should bow</u>,

of those in Heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, Philippians 2:11 and that <u>every tongue should confess that **Jesus the Messiah is Lord**</u>, to the Glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, * <u>work out your own Salvation</u> with fear and trembling; Philippians 2:13 for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.

Philippians 3:7 But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Messiah. Philippians 3:8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Messiah Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Messiah, Philippians 3:9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Messiah, the righteousness which is from God by faith; Philippians 3:10 That I may know Him, and the Power of His Resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, Philippians 3:11 if, by any means, I may attain to the **Resurrection** from the dead. Philippians 3:12 Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Messiah Jesus has also laid hold of me. Philippians 3:13 Brethren. I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead. Philippians 3:14 I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Messiah Jesus! Colossians 1:13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the Kingdom of the Son of His Love, Colossians 1:14 in whom we have **Redemption through His Blood**, the forgiveness of sins. Colossians 1:27 To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the Glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is **Messiah in you**, the hope of Glory! Colossians 3:1 If then you were raised with Messiah, seek those things which are above, where Messiah is sitting at the right Hand of God. Colossians 3:2 Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. Colossians 3:3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Messiah in God. Colossians 3:4 When Messiah who is our Life appears, then you also will appear with Him in Glory. Colossians 3:5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. 1 Timothy 1:15 This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Yeshua the Messiah came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief.

1 Thessalonians 5:3 For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction ...

1 Thessalonians 5:16 Rejoice always, 1 Thessalonians 5:17 pray without ceasing ...

1 Thessalonians 5:18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in the Messiah Jesus for you. 1 Thessalonians 5:23 Now may the God of Peace, Himself, sanctify you completely; and <u>may your whole **spirit**</u>, <u>soul</u>, <u>and body</u> <u>be preserved blameless</u>, at the coming of our Lord Jesus the Messiah.

Hebrews 2:9 But we see Yeshua, who was made a little lower than (God) the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with Glory and Honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone. Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to Glory, to make the Captain of their Salvation perfect **through Sufferings**. Hebrews 2:11 For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of One, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren, Hebrews 2:13 And again: "I will put my trust in Him." And again, "Here am I and the children who God has given Me." [Isaiah 8:18] Hebrews 2:14 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might **destroy him**

who had the power of death, that is, the devil, Hebrews 2:15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. Hebrews 2:16 For indeed He does not give aid to angels, but He does give aid to the seed of Abraham. Hebrews 5:7 ... who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear, Hebrews 5:8 though He was a Son, yet He learned (was) obedience by the things which He suffered. Hebrews 5:9 And having been **perfected**. He became the Author of Eternal Salvation to all who obey Him, Hebrews 5:10 called by God as **High Priest** "according to the Order of Melchi Zedek," Hebrews 6:1 Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Messiah, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God, Hebrews 6:2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of Eternal Judgment. Hebrews 6:17 Thus God, determining to show more abundantly to the heirs of promise the immutability of His counsel, confirmed it by an oath, Hebrews 6:18 that by two immutable things, in which (1) it is impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of **the hope** set before us. Hebrews 6:19 (2) **This hope** we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil, Hebrews 6:20 where the Forerunner has entered for us, even Yeshua, having become **<u>High Priest forever</u>** according to **the Order of Melchizedek**. (Psalm 110:1, 4) Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works. Hebrews 10:25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching. Hebrews 10:38 "Now the just shall live by faith; but if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him." Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. Hebrews 12:1 Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us. Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Yeshua, the Author and Finisher of our faith, who for the Joy that was set before Him endured the Cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right Hand of the Throne of God. Hebrews 12:5 And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons, "My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him; Hebrews 12:6 For whom the LORD loves He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives." Hebrews 12:7 If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? Hebrews 12:9 Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of Spirits and live?

James 2:14 What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? James 2:15 If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, James 2:16 and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? James 2:17 Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. James 2:18 But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. James 2:19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe and tremble! James 2:20 But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead? James 2:21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar? James 2:22 Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect? James 2:23 And the Scripture was fulfilled

which says, "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." And he was called the friend of God. James 2:24 You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only. James 2:26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also. James 4:8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up. James 4:11 Do not speak evil of one another, brethren. He who speaks evil of a brother and judges his brother, speaks evil of the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge. James 4:12 There is one Lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy. Who are you to judge another? James 4:13 Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit"; James 4:14 whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away. James 4:15 Instead you ought to say, "If the Lord wills, we shall live and do this or that." James 4:16 But now you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil.

1 Peter 1:23 ... <u>having been **born again**</u>, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through **the Word of God** which Lives and abides forever,

1 Peter 3:6 ... as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, whose daughters you are if you do good, and are not afraid with any terror. 1 Peter 3:17 For it is better, if it is the will of God, to suffer for doing good than for doing evil.

1 Peter 5:5 Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists **the proud**, but gives grace to the humble." 1 Peter 5:6 Therefore humble yourselves under the Mighty Hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, 1 Peter 5:7 casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you. 1 John 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the Truth. 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another. And the Blood of the Messiah Yeshua His Son cleanses us from all sin. 1 John 2:15 **Do not love the world** or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father **is not in him**. 1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 1 John 2:17 And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever. 1 John 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. 1 John 4:14 And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent His Son as Sayior of the world. 1 John 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world, our faith. 1 John 5:5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Yeshua is the Son of God? 3 John 1:2 Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. Revelation 2:3 "... and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. Revelation 2:4 Nevertheless I have this against you, that **you have left your first love**. Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent." Revelation 2:7 "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the Churches. To him **who overcomes** I will give to eat from **the Tree of Life**, which is in the midst

Revelation 3:5 He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels. I will write on him the name of My God (My Father's name) and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of Heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name. Revelation 3:17 Because you say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing,' and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked. Revelation 3:18 I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My Voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. Revelation 3:21 To him **who overcomes** I will grant to sit with Me on My Throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His Throne. Revelation 5:5 But one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has **prevailed** to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals." Revelation 5:6 And I looked. and behold, in the midst of the Throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth. Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him (Satan) by the Blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their (self) lives to the death! Revelation 14:1 Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads. Psalm 34:18 The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit. Psalm 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Psalm 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, a broken and a contrite heart, these, O God, You will not despise. Psalms 82:6 I said, "You are gods, and all of you are children of the Most High. Psalms 82:7 But you shall die like men ..."

Psalm 119:89 Forever, O LORD, Your Word is settled in Heaven!

Psalms 119:105 Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Psalms 133:1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is <u>for brethren to dwell together</u> <u>in unity</u>! Psalms 133:2 It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down on the beard, the beard of Aaron, running down on the edge of his garments.

Psalms 133:3 It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; for there the LORD commanded the Blessing — <u>Life forevermore!</u>

Psalm 136:1 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for He is Good! For His mercy endures forever!

Psalm 138:2 For You have magnified Your Word above all Your name!

Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; Proverbs 3:6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. Proverbs 15:33 The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom, and before honor is humility. Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall. Proverbs 16:19 Better to be of a humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud. Proverbs 18:12 Before destruction the heart of a man is haughty, and before honor is humility.

Proverbs 18:16 A man's gift makes room for him, and brings him before great men.

Proverbs 22:4 By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches and honor and life.

Isaiah 8:16 Bind up the testimony, seal the Torah among My disciples. Isaiah 8:17 And <u>I will wait on the LORD</u>, who hides His face from the House of Jacob; and <u>I will hope in Him</u>. Isaiah 8:18 Here am I, and <u>the children</u> whom the LORD has given me! We are for signs and wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, who dwells in Mt Zion.

Isaiah 42:18 "Hear, you deaf; and look, you blind, that you may see." Isaiah 43:18 "Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old. Isaiah 43:19 Behold, I will do a new thing! Now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." Isaiah 57:15 For thus says the High and Lofty One who inhabits Eternity, whose name is Holy, "I dwell in the High and Holy Place, with him who has a contrite and **humble spirit**, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones." Isaiah 58:5 "Is it a fast that I have chosen, a day for a man to afflict his soul? Is it to bow down his head like a bulrush, and to spread out sackcloth and ashes? You shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. Isaiah 58:12 Those from among you shall build the old waste places; you shall raise up the foundations of many generations; and you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, the Restorer of streets to dwell in. Isaiah 58:13 If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My Holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the Holy day of the LORD honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, nor speaking your own words. Amos 9:11 "On that Day I will raise up the Succah of David, which has fallen down, and repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins, and rebuild it as in the days of old; Amos 9:12 That they may possess the remnant of Edom (Adam), and all the Gentiles who are called by My name," says the LORD who does this thing.
