God gave us all Authority; Satan has no authority over us over Satan: Luke 10:18, 19; he can't accuse us in Heaven

New Covenant: I will remember your sins no more! Our sins nailed to Cross: we never have to face any of our sins or hidden generational sins in a Court in Heaven.

Good Works is by Grace alone: We don't need to try to help God to get our own good works; that is idolatry!

This teaching, 'Operating in the Courts of Heaven' is a big deception to God's Word; built by <u>adding</u> and <u>taking away</u> from God's Holy Word. It's strong non biblical <u>deception!</u>

Proverbs 30:5, 6 Every Word of God is pure; He is <u>a shield</u> to those who put their trust in Him. 30:6 <u>Do not add to His Words</u>, <u>lest He rebuke you</u>, <u>and you be found a liar</u>.

No liars are allowed into the Kingdom of Heaven!

Revelation 21:7, 8 "He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son! 21:8 But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second Death."

Isaiah 5:20 Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; who put darkness for light, and light for darkness; You become what you think and feed upon ... Proverbs 23:7

2 Timothy 4:3, 4 For **the time will come** when <u>they will not</u> endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have <u>itching ears</u>, they will heap up for themselves teachers; 4:4 and <u>they will turn their ears away from the Truth</u>, and be turned aside to fables.

Galatians 1:6 I marvel that you are turning away so soon <u>from</u> Him who called you in the grace of Christ, <u>to a different gospel</u>, 1:7 which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and <u>want to pervert the Gospel of Christ</u>. 1:8 But <u>even if we, or an angel from Heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed!</u>

Luke 10:18, 19 And He said to them, "I saw <u>Satan fall like</u> <u>lightning from Heaven</u>. 10:19 Behold, <u>I give you the Authority</u> to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you."

Hebrews 4:16 <u>Let us therefore come boldly **to the Throne**</u> **of Grace** (that Jesus died to give us), that we may <u>obtain Mercy</u> and find Grace to help in time of need. [not Courts of Heaven]

means; for that Day will not come unless **the falling away comes first**, and **the man of sin is revealed**, the son of perdition, 2:9 The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, 2:10 and with all unrighteous **deception** among **those who perish**, because they did **not receive the love of the Truth**, that they might be Saved. 2:11 And for this reason God will send them **strong delusion**, **that they should believe the lie**, 2:12 that they all may be condemned who did not believe the **Truth** but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

1 Timothy 4:1, 2, 7 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times **some will depart** from the faith, giving heed to **deceiving spirits** and **doctrines of demons**, 4:2 <u>speaking lies in hypocrisy</u>, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron, 4:7 But reject profane & old wives' fables, & exercise yourself toward godliness.

Galatians 6:1 Brethren, <u>if a man is overtaken in any trespass</u>, <u>you who are spiritual **restore such a one** in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself <u>lest you also be tempted</u>.</u>

James 5:19 Brethren, if anyone among you <u>wanders from</u> the Truth, and someone turns him back, 5:20 let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.

Ephesians 2:8 For by Grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 2:9 not of works, lest anyone should boast. 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Revelation 22:18 "For I testify to everyone who hears the Words of the prophecy of this Book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this Book; 22:19 and if anyone takes away from the Words of the Book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the Holy City, and from the things which are written in this Book (of Revelation)."

1 John 1:7-9 But if we walk in the Light as He is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the Blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us **from all sin**. 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the Truth is not in us. 1:9 **If we confess our sins**, He is Faithful and Just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

2nd John 1:9-11 Whoever transgresses and <u>does not abide in</u> **the doctrine** of the Messiah does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of the Messiah <u>has both the Father and the Son</u>.
1:10 If anyone comes to you and <u>does not bring **this doctrine**</u>, **do not receive him** into your house nor greet him; 1:11 for he who greets him shares in his evil deeds.

John 8:31, 32 Then Yeshua said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. 8:32 And you shall know the Truth, & the Truth shall make you free." John 8:34-36 Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. 8:35 And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. 8:36 Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed!"

2 Timothy 2:24, 25-26 And a servant of the Lord ... be patient, 2:25 in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God will grant them repentance, so that they may know the Truth, 2:26 and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will.

Matthew 7:15,17,19-23 "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. 7:17 ... every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. 7:19 Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down & thrown into the fire. 7:20 Therefore by their fruits you will know them. 7:21 Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the Kingdom of Heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in Heaven. 7:22 Many will say to Me ..., 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' 7:23 ... I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!""

Colossians 2:9-15 For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; 2:10 and **you are complete in Him**, who is the Head of all principality and power. 2:11 In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, 2:12 buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. 2:13 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having **forgiven you all trespasses**, 2:14 having wiped out the handwriting of **requirements that was against us**, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, **having nailed** it to the cross. 2:15 Having **disarmed** principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, **triumphing over them** in it.

Messiah's Bride from the nations ...
Revelation 14:5 And in their mouth was found **no deceit**, for they are without fault before the Throne of God.

- 2 Corinthians 4:3, 4 But even if our Gospel is veiled, <u>it is veiled</u> to those who are perishing, 4:4 <u>whose minds the god of this Age</u> has blinded, who do not believe, lest the Light of the Gospel of the Glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4-7 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for <u>pulling down strongholds</u>, 10:5 <u>casting down arguments</u> and <u>every high thing that exalts itself against</u> the <u>knowledge of God</u>, <u>bringing every thought into captivity</u> to the obedience of Christ, 10:6 and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled. 10:7 Do you look at things according to the outward appearance?
- 2 Peter 2:19-22 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are slaves of corruption; for by whom a person is overcome, by him also he is brought into bondage. 2:20 For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning. 2:21 For it would have been better for them not to have known the Way of Righteousness, than having known it, to turn from the Holy Commandment delivered to them. 2:22 But it has happened to them according to the true proverb, "A dog returns to his own vomit," and, "a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire."

Galatians 5:9 A little leaven leavens the whole lump;

1 Peter 5:8, 9 <u>Be sober, be vigilant;</u> because your adversary the <u>devil walks about (earth) like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.</u> 5:9 **Resist him, steadfast <u>in the faith</u>**, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

Act 17:11 These (Bereans) were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the Word with all readiness, & searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so.

Psalm 85:8 I will hear what God the LORD will speak, for He will speak Peace to His people and to His saints; but let them not turn back to folly. 85:9 Surely His Salvation is near to those who fear Him, that Glory may dwell in our land. 85:10 Mercy and Truth have met together; Righteousness and Peace have kissed.
