THE DAY GOD SHOWED UP IN THE ISRAELI KNESSET!

This is a short story about an American Israeli Jewish man named Aaron whose rights to Israeli citizenship had been challenged, because besides believing in the God of Israel, he also believed that Yeshua is his Messiah.

Aaron's claim, after over thirty years of study in the Tanakh, is that **there is only One God, the Holy One of Israel!** And that this Great and Awesome God of all the Universe is also **our Loving Father!**

This One God exists with many different Faces and Expressions of Himself, as revealed throughout the Hebrew Holy Scriptures.

Yeshua is that unique manifestation of God Himself who became 'the Salvation of mankind'. Yeshua appears throughout the entire Holy Scriptures under many different titles. Some of these different titles are: 'The Messenger of the LORD', 'My Servant', 'My Righteous Servant', 'The Mighty Hand and Mighty Arm of the LORD', 'The LORD of hosts', 'The LORD of lords', 'My King of Righteousness' ('Melchi Zedek'), 'The Branch', 'The King of Glory', 'The Messiah', and 'The Son of God!'

By current existing Israeli laws, Aaron had been accused of being disloyal to Judaism and Torah, by believing in Yeshua as God, and dishonoring his God, who said: **"You shall have no other gods before Me!"**

(Exodus 20:3 and Deuteronomy 5:7)

In the Israeli Court system, Aaron had been accused of no longer being a Jew because of his belief in Yeshua as God, and he was told that his Israeli citizenship would be taken away and that he would have to leave Israel.

However, Aaron claimed that **he had not violated the Torah**, but that on the contrary **he had obeyed Torah, by accepting and believing in the complete Word of God from the Tanakh concerning the identity of the Holy One of Israel**. Aaron is not believing or worshiping another god when he believes in Yeshua, as a true expression of the Living God, 'the Salvation of mankind'. It is the Jewish community who on the contrary does not know or understand the deeper truths of the deity of their One God, as God has clearly shown us in the sacred writings of the Hebrew Holy Scriptures.

A veil of Spiritual Blindness is over the hearts and minds of most of the Jewish world concerning the Truth of the identity of their own God.

It is the Jewish religious communities who have diluted the clear messages of Truth about our God from the Tanakh, by bringing into Judaism so much attention on man's teachings from **oral** religious traditions, rather than focusing on God's written Word from the Scriptures. Also, in selective Sabbath Haftorah portions, most prophetic passages which would reveal the Messiah Yeshua have been omitted. (see Isaiah 6:9,10; 29:13,14; Proverbs 30:6.)

God has strongly warned us not to add to, or take away from His written Word in both the Torah and the Tanakh! (Deuteronomy 4:2)

The Main Issue is that we are denying our God, the God of Israel, when we fail to recognize all that the Tanakh says about Him, including His many Faces, Expressions, and Manifestations.

The Secondary Issue of **who is, or who is not a Jew**, is based on new and **very unrighteous** Israeli laws, which state that 'you are no longer a Jew if you believe in Yeshua as your Messiah and God'. These laws violate a Jewish person's rights to religious freedom, i.e. the belief in the deity of Yeshua, **as evidenced and proven from the Hebrew Scriptures.**

This Secondary Issue **only masks not having to face and accept the real Truth: Yeshua is God's Messiah, who has already fulfilled most of the prophesied Hebrew Scriptures on the Messiah!**

THE TIME FRAME:

This event takes place during the coming years of greatest persecution against world Jewry, even much worse than in the days of Nazi Germany. Anti-semitism has now reached its greatest and most terrifying heights world wide for millions of Jewish people in the Diaspora. Multitudes of Jews are now fleeing for their lives to Israel, from persecution in their own countries, barely escaping, and having to leave behind all their possessions.

Israel represents for the Jewish people a safe haven, an asylum from world persecution, where Jew's have God's Promise of protection from the ever increasing resurgence of anti-semitism and great world hatred both toward themselves and their God.

A brief history of this legal case: Aaron's case first began in the Aliyah Office of the Ministry of Interior, in Jerusalem. Aaron was initially speaking out for the rights of his new Gentile bride, whom the Aliyah Office knew was a Christian believer in Yeshua. Under Israel's 'Law of Return' for Jews,

the Gentile spouse of a Jew is normally guaranteed the right to have Israeli citizenship, regardless of that Gentile spouse's religious beliefs.

However, in the Aliyah Office it was also discovered that Aaron was a dedicated believer in Yeshua, and also a bible teacher of the Tanakh.

This case had gone all the way to the High Court of Justice of Israel. Here the case had been tried by all nine of the residing Court Judges.

The **new evidence** that Aaron had presented from the Hebrew Scriptures in his own Court defense was so compelling, that reasonable doubt arose concerning the validity and efficacy of Israel's current Aliyah laws regarding Citizenship for Jewish believers in Yeshua. This caused the decision of Israel's High Court of Justice to be made **in favor** of Aaron's case. Five of the High Court Judges had voted in favor and four were opposed to Aaron being able to keep his Israeli citizenship and remain in Israel as a Jew.

Aaron had presented new evidence from the Hebrew Holy Scriptures, not addressed in any of the previous cases tried by the High Court, proving that Yeshua is so many of the divine expressions of God Himself, written in the Holy Scriptures: That He is both 'The Hand and Arm of Almighty God', 'The Messenger of the LORD', 'The King of Righteousness', 'The Branch', 'The Righteous Servant', 'The King of Glory', 'The Messiah', etc...

It was even reported by some of the Judges on the High Court of Justice that **the Presence and the Glory of God was experienced** both in the Courtroom proceedings and also while they privately read and studied the many pages of Aaron's legal defense, which were primarily biblical quotations taken entirely from the Hebrew Scriptures.

However, because of this most unexpected and surprising decision of the High Court of Justice, many of the Knesset members quickly came together, infuriated as to how this unfavorable verdict could ever have happened.

They decided that stronger and tougher legislation on the Aliyah laws needed to be enacted immediately, to put a damper on the precedence that this High Court of Justice decision had now made. Their intentions were to now make the current Aliyah 'Law of Return' even radically stricter and much more inflexible for the large numbers of Jewish believers in Yeshua now escaping to Israel from the United States and from many other nations, frantically making application for Israeli citizenship at the Aliya offices.

THE SETTING FOR THIS STORY:

WE ARE NOW ON THE MAIN FLOOR OF THE ISRAELI KNESSET.

New legislation amending Israel's 'Law of Return' has now just been introduced on the Knesset floor to the whole Knesset Body, almost all 120 members present. This new legislation is about to be finalized and quickly voted on. In the minds of most Knesset members a decision has already been reached in favor of these new amendments and changes in the law.

Most members of the Knesset are in agreement that this new legislation amending the current 'Law of Return' will now leave no room for any new evidence concerning Yeshua as God and Messiah. Their joint decision is to quickly dismiss this offensive problem regarding Yeshua with a speedy vote, and to get on to the more urgent and pressing matters now facing Israel.

Aaron had received permission to sit in on this special Knesset meeting, to hear the discussions and the final decisions to be reached on this new Aliyah legislation, amending the existing 'Law of Return'.

Sensing the Knesset's unanimous unfavorable decision, and looking ahead at the new wave of persecutions that will now be released against other Jewish believers in Yeshua, with these new amendments, Aaron suddenly **uncontrollably cries out to God** for help.

In disbelief, the whole Assembly hearing Aaron's loud cry to God, angrily turn their focus on him. And just then

The Knesset members are frozen in shock; some are still seated, but most are now prostrate on the floor in awe and fear, and wonder at what has just happened, and at what is about to happen next...

‘THE KING OF GLORY’ STEPS FORWARD!

**THE BRILLIANT BLINDING LIGHT OF HIS PRESENCE
FILLS BOTH HEAVEN AND EARTH!
HIS FACE CANNOT BE SEEN THROUGH HIS GLORY.
ONLY HIS GOLDEN CROWN IS VISIBLE ON HIS HEAD.**

HIS GLORY FILLS THE WHOLE KNESSET.

He Begins To Speak to the Knesset Below:

**“PRIME MINISTER,
AND MEMBERS OF THE ISRAELI KNESSET,”**

His Voice Resounds As The Sound Of Many Waters.

“YOU, AS MEMBERS OF THE ISRAEL GOVERNMENT ARE MOST PRIVILEGED TODAY TO EXPERIENCE MY PRESENCE. THIS HAS NOT HAPPENED FOR 3500 YEARS, SINCE THE DAYS OF MOSES, MY SERVANT, WHEN HE WAS INVITED WITH AARON, NADAB AND ABIHU, ALONG WITH THE 70 ELDERS OF ISRAEL, TO COME UP ON MOUNT SINAI, TO BE WITH ME. THEY SAW THE GOD OF HEAVEN, AND THEY DID EAT AND DRINK.” (Exodus 24:9-11)

“YOU HAVE HAD MY HOLY WORD TO STUDY AND OBEY FOR A FEW THOUSAND YEARS, BUT YOU HAVE CHALLENGED ME AND HEAVEN MANY TIMES. THE CRIES OF THIS MAN AARON, AND THOUSANDS LIKE HIM, BOTH JEWS AND GENTILES, HAVE COME UP BEFORE MY THRONE TOO OFTEN.

NOW I HAVE COME DOWN TO SHOW YOU **THE WORD OF GOD**, SPOKEN FROM THE MOUTH OF MY HOLY PROPHETS LONG AGO; THE WORD FOUND IN THE HEBREW HOLY SCRIPTURES CONCERNING **MY TRUE IDENTITY** AS YOUR GOD. MY IDENTITY, WHICH YOUR RABBINICAL LEADERS AND TORAH SCHOLARS HAVE NOT UNDERSTOOD, AND HAVE REPEATEDLY REFUSED TO ACCEPT, AND THEREBY HAVE FAILED TO TEACH MY PEOPLE.”

“SO I WILL NOW CALL FORWARD FROM HEAVEN MANY OF MY PROPHETS TO WITNESS TO MY TRUE IDENTITY AS THE ONE AND ONLY LIVING GOD OF HEAVEN AND EARTH, AS THEY WILL ALSO TESTIFY IN DEFENSE OF WHAT AARON HAS PRESENTED. THEY WILL SPEAK TO YOU MY HOLY WORD FROM THE SCRIPTURES, WHICH THEY GAVE TO YOU WHILE THEY LIVED ON EARTH, IN ORDER THAT YOU MAY SEE AND HEAR AND UNDERSTAND MORE CLEARLY **WHO I AM AS YOUR GOD AND SAVIOR**, AND WHO YOU TRULY ARE, AS MY SONS AND DAUGHTERS!”

At this point a Giant Viewing Screen is lowered down into the Knesset auditorium for all Knesset members and for everyone else in the room to see, those in the audience surrounding the Knesset floor and those in the balcony, so **THE WORD OF GOD** will be **seen** as it is **spoken** by the Heavenly Hosts.

Everyone is breathless. No one dares to speak or even move.

There is a great hush over the whole Knesset.

THE GLORY OF THE LORD is now very heavy over the entire room.

God speaks again: **“IN 1989, THE ISRAELI SUPREME COURT RULED ON A COURT DECISION CONCERNING SEVERAL OF MY JEWISH FAMILIES WHO BELIEVE IN MY SON YESHUA, PASSING UNJUST DECISIONS REGARDING THEIR LEGAL RIGHTS TO CITIZENSHIP AS JEWS HERE IN MY LAND. THIS HAS CLOSED THE DOOR OF MY LAND TO MANY OF MY BELOVED SERVANTS. AND THIS HAS NOT HELPED YOU; IT HAS ONLY REINFORCED THE EXISTING BARRIERS BETWEEN YOU AND I. FOR I AM A HOLY, RIGHTEOUS GOD, AND YOUR SINS SEPARATE YOU FROM ME!**

“MANY NEW LAWS WERE MADE BECAUSE MY PEOPLE STILL DO NOT UNDERSTAND SO MANY OF THE TRUTHS REGARDING MY DIVINITY, WHICH WERE PLACED IN MY HOLY SCRIPTURES. YOU DENIED THE DEITY OF MY BELOVED SON YESHUA, WHO CAME TO EARTH TO MAKE ATONEMENT FOR YOU BY OFFERING HIS SINLESS BODY OF FLESH AND BLOOD IN EXCHANGE FOR ALL OF YOUR SINS, SO THAT YOU WOULD BE ABLE TO INHERIT ETERNAL LIFE, AND RETURN TO ME, YOUR LOVING FATHER.

MY SON CAME TO EARTH TO RESTORE TO YOU YOUR TRUE NATURE AS SONS OF GOD, YOUR IDENTITY WHICH HAD BEEN LOST TO YOU THROUGH ADAM’S SIN. MY SON DIED TO BRING YOU INTO THESE WONDERFUL TRUTHS, LONG REJECTED BY MOST OF YOU AND BY YOUR RELIGIOUS LEADERS.”

“BUT MY HOLY WORD WILL STAND FOREVER!” (Isaiah 40:8)

“Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?” The Jews answered Him, saying: “For a good work we do not stone You. But for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God!” Yeshua answered them, “Is it not written in your Torah, ‘I said, “You are gods” ’? (see Psalm 82:6) “If He called them gods, to whom the Word of God came, do you say of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, ‘You are blaspheming’, because I said, ‘I am the Son of God’ ”? (John 10:32-36) (see Hosea 1:10)

“Take heed to yourself, lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land where you are going, lest it be a snare in your midst. But you shall destroy their altars, break their sacred pillars, and cut down their wooden images, for you shall worship no other god. For the LORD, whose name is Jealous, **is a jealous God**. Lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land, and they play the harlot with their gods and make sacrifice to their gods, and one of them invites you, and you eat of his sacrifice, and you take of his daughters for your sons, and his daughters play the harlot with their gods, and make your sons play the harlot with their gods.” Exodus 34:12-16

So we shall be separate, Your people and I, from all the people who are upon the face of the earth.” So the LORD said to Moses, “I will also do this thing that you have spoken; for you have found grace in My sight, and I know you by name.” And he said, **“Please, show me Your Glory.”** Then He said, “I will make all My Goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the Name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.” But He said, **“You cannot see My Face; for no man shall see Me, and live!”**

And the LORD said, “Here is a place by Me, and you shall stand on the rock. So it shall be, **while My Glory passes by**, that I will put you in the cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My Hand while I pass by.

Then I will take away My Hand, and **you shall see My back,**

but My Face shall not be seen !”

Exodus 33:9-11,13-23

“Then Moses rose early in the morning and went up Mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him; and he took in his hand the two tablets of stone. Now the LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and **Proclaimed the Name of the LORD**. And the LORD passed before him and **Proclaimed**:

**“The LORD, the LORD God,
Merciful and Gracious, Longsuffering,
and Abounding in Goodness and Truth,
keeping Mercy for thousands,
Forgiving Iniquity and Transgression and Sin,
and by no means clearing the guilty;
Visiting the Iniquity of the fathers
upon the children and the children's children
to the third and fourth generation.”**

So Moses made haste and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshiped.

Exodus 34:4,5-8

Abraham: (Abraham sees and stands before the LORD Himself!)

Then **the LORD appeared to him** (Abraham) by the terebinth trees of Mamre, as he was sitting in the tent door in the heat of the day. So he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, **three men** were standing by him; and when he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them, and bowed himself to the ground, and said, “My Lord, if I have now found favor in Your sight, do not pass on by Your servant.”

And He said, “I will certainly return to you according to the time of life, and behold, Sarah your wife shall have a son.” Now Abraham and Sarah were old, well advanced in age; and Sarah had passed the age of child-bearing. Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, “After I have grown old, shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?” And the LORD said to Abraham, “Why did Sarah laugh, saying, ‘Shall I surely bear a child, since I am old?’ **Is anything too hard for the LORD?** At the appointed time I will return to you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.”

Then the men rose from there and looked toward Sodom, and Abraham went with them to send them on the way. And the LORD said, “Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing, since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?”

Then **the men turned away from there and went toward Sodom,**
but **Abraham still stood before the LORD.**

And Abraham came near and said, “Would You also destroy the righteous with the wicked? ... Shall not the Judge of all the earth do Right?”

So the LORD went His way as soon as He had finished speaking with Abraham; and Abraham returned to his place.

Now **the two angels (messengers)** came to Sodom in the evening...

Genesis 18:1-3,10-14,16-18,22,23,25,33; 19:1

[How is this possible for Abraham to stand before his God, face to face, seeing and talking to the LORD? For God told us in Exodus 33: 20 and 23, **that nobody can see the Face of the LORD and live! God cannot lie!**]

Isaac: (Isaac sees the LORD!)

Then **the LORD appeared to him** (Isaac) and said: “Do not go down to Egypt; live in the land of which I shall tell you. Dwell in this land, and I will be with you and bless you; for to you and your descendants I give all these lands, and I will perform the oath which I swore to Abraham your father.” And **the LORD appeared to him** (Isaac) the same night and said, “I am the God of your father Abraham; do not fear, for I am with you. I will bless you and multiply your descendants for My servant Abraham’s sake.” Genesis 26:2,3,24 [How could Isaac see the LORD?]

Jacob: (Jacob wrestles with God!)

Then Jacob was left alone; and **a Man** wrestled with him until the breaking of day. Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob’s hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him. And He said, “Let Me go, for the day breaks.” But he said, “I will not let You go unless You bless me!” So He said to him, “What is your name?” And he said, “Jacob.” And He said, “Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, **but Israel**; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed.” Then Jacob asked, saying, “Tell me Your Name, I pray.” And He said, “Why is it that you ask about My Name?” And He blessed him there. And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: **“For I have seen God face to face**, and my life is preserved.” Genesis 32:24-30

[How is this possible? For God told us plainly that **nobody can see the Face of God and live!** In the book of Hosea, we see the answer. **The Man** Jacob wrestled with is **‘The Messenger’, ‘the LORD God of hosts’!**]

Hosea:

‘He (Jacob) took his brother by the heel in the womb, and in his strength he struggled with God. Yes, he (Jacob) struggled with **‘the Messenger’** (Angel) and prevailed; he wept, and sought favor from Him.’ He found him at Bethel, and there He spoke with him, that is, **the LORD God of hosts! The LORD is His Name renown.** Hosea 12:3-5

Appearances of ‘the Messenger of the LORD’!

Who is **this most unique Man**, who appears throughout the Hebrew Holy Scriptures. We discover that He is an Expression of God Himself! Besides being called ‘**The Messenger of the LORD**’, **He appears under many other different titles**. Let’s look at His Divine appearances first as ‘**the Messenger of the LORD**’, and then look at His other Divine appearances and titles throughout the Hebrew Holy Scriptures.]

[This Hebrew word for ‘**Messenger**’ is ‘**Mal’ak**’ (Strong’s # 4397), ‘**a messenger**’; spec. of God, i.e. an angel (also a prophet, priest, or teacher): ambassador, angel, king, messenger.]

Abraham: (The Messenger of the LORD spares the life of his son Isaac!)

And Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to slay his son. But **the Messenger (Angel) of the LORD** called to him from heaven and said, “Abraham, Abraham!” And he said, “Here I am.” And He said, “Do not lay your hand on the lad, or do anything to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, **your only son, from Me.**” Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind him was **a ram caught in a thicket by its horns**. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son. And Abraham called the name of the place, ‘**THE LORD WILL PROVIDE**’; as it is said to this day, “In the Mount of The LORD it shall be provided.”

Then **the Messenger of the LORD** called to Abraham a second time out of heaven, and said: “**By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD**, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, **your only son**, that in blessing I will bless you, and in multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies. In **your Seed** all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.” Genesis 22:10-18

The Messenger of the LORD speaks for the LORD, as God Himself!

Jacob:

And he blessed Joseph, and said: “God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, the God who has Shepherded me all my life to this day, **the Messenger** who has delivered me from all evil, bless the boys; may they be called by my name, and the name of my fathers.” Genesis 48:15,16

Moses:

Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro, his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock to the back of the desert, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. And **the Messenger (Angel) of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush**. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed. Then Moses said, “I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn.” So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, **God called to him from the midst of the bush** and said, “Moses, Moses!” And he said, “Here I am.” Then He said, “Do not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground.” Moreover He said, “I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.” And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God. Exodus 3:2-6

And **the Messenger (Angel) of God**, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the Pillar of Cloud went from before them and stood behind them. Exodus 14:19

God tells Moses that God’s Name is in this Messenger:

“Behold, I send **a Messenger** (Angel) before you to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. Beware of Him and **obey His Voice**; do not provoke Him, for **He will not pardon** your transgressions; for **My Name is in Him!** But if you indeed **obey His Voice** and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries. “For **My Messenger** will go before you **and bring you in (to the Promised Land).**” Exodus 23:20-23

Manoah:

Now there was a certain man from Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; and his wife was barren and had no children. And **the Messenger (Angel) of the LORD** appeared to the woman and said to her, “Indeed now, you are barren and have borne no children, but you shall conceive and bear a son. Now therefore, please be careful not to drink wine or similar drink, and not to eat anything unclean. For behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. And no razor shall come upon his head, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb; and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines.” “... A Man of God came to me... His countenance like the Messenger of the LORD, very awesome!”

Then Manoah said to the Messenger of the LORD, “What is Your name?” And the Messenger of the LORD said to him, “Why do you ask My Name, seeing it is **Wonderful ?**” So Manoah took the young goat with the grain offering, and offered it upon the rock to the LORD. And He did a wondrous thing while Manoah and his wife looked on. It happened as the flame went up toward heaven from the altar, **the Messenger of the LORD ascended in the flame of the altar!** When Manoah and his wife saw this, they fell on their faces to the ground. ...then Manoah knew that He was the Messenger of the LORD. And Manoah said to his wife, “We shall surely die, because **we have seen God!**” But his wife said to him, “If the LORD had desired to kill us, He would not have accepted a burnt offering and a grain offering...” So the woman bore a son and called his name **Samson**; and the child grew, and the LORD blessed him. Judges 13:2-5,6,17-24

[Manoah and his wife both knew that the Messenger of the LORD was God!]

Daniel:

And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace. Then King Nebuchadnezzar was astonished; and he rose in haste and spoke, saying to his counselors, “Did we not cast three men bound into the midst of the fire?” They answered and said to the king, “True, O king.” “Look!” he answered, “**I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire; and they are not hurt, and the form of the fourth is like ‘the Son of God!’**” Nebuchadnezzar spoke, saying, “Blessed be the God of Shadrach ... who sent **His Messenger** and delivered His servants who trusted in Him.” Daniel 3:23-25,28

David:

And God sent **a Messenger (angel)** to Jerusalem to destroy it. As He was destroying, the LORD looked and relented of the disaster, and said to **the Messenger** who was destroying, “It is enough; now restrain your hand.” And **the Messenger of the LORD** stood by the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite. Then David lifted his eyes and saw **the Messenger of the LORD standing between earth and heaven**, having **in His Hand a drawn Sword** stretched out over Jerusalem.

So David and the elders, clothed in sackcloth, fell on their faces. And David said to God, “Was it not I who commanded the people to be numbered? I am the one who has sinned and done evil indeed; but these sheep, what have they done? Let Your hand, I pray, O LORD my God, be against me and my father's house, but not against Your people that they should be plagued.” Therefore, **the Messenger of the LORD** commanded Gad to say to David that David should go and erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.

1st Chronicles 21:15-18 (see also in 2nd Samuel 24:15-18)

Gideon: (He sees **the Messenger of the LORD** who calls Himself LORD!)

Now **the Messenger (Angel) of the LORD** came **and sat** under the terebinth tree which was in Ophrah, belonging to Joash the Abiezrite, while his son Gideon threshed wheat in the winepress, in order to hide it from the Midianites. And **the Messenger of the LORD** appeared to him, and said to him, “The LORD is with you, you mighty man of valor!” Then **the LORD turned to him and said**, “Go in this might of yours, and you shall save Israel from the hand of the Midianites. Have I not sent you?” So he (Gideon) said to Him, “O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house.” And **the LORD said** to him, “Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat the Midianites as one man.” “... If now I have found favor in Your sight, show me a sign that it is really You talking to me.” Judges 6:11,12,14-16,17

[This Person who speaks to Gideon is referred to by both of these titles, ‘the Messenger of the LORD’ and ‘the LORD’.]

Zechariah:

Then he showed me Yeshua (Yehoshua) the High Priest standing before **the Messenger (Angel) of the LORD**, and Satan standing at His right Hand to oppose him. And the LORD said to Satan, “The LORD rebuke you, Satan! The LORD who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you! Is this not a brand plucked from the fire?” Now Yeshua was clothed with filthy garments, and was standing before **the Messenger**. Then He answered and spoke to those who stood before Him, saying, “Take away the filthy garments from him.” And to him He said, “See, I have removed your iniquity from you, and I will clothe you with rich robes.” And I said, “Let them put a clean turban on his head.” So they put a clean turban on his head, and they put the clothes on him. **The Messenger of the LORD** stood by.

Then **the Messenger of the LORD** admonished Yeshua, saying, “Thus says **the LORD of hosts**: ‘If you will walk in My ways, and if you will keep My command, then you shall also judge My house, and likewise have charge of My courts. I will give you places to walk among these who stand here. **Hear, O Yeshua, the High Priest, you and your companions who sit before you, for they are a wondrous sign;** for behold I am bringing forth **My Servant, ‘the Branch.’**” Zechariah 3:8
[The Messenger of the LORD speaks to the High Priest, Yeshua, and prophesies the coming of ‘the Branch’ (Yeshua, the Messiah).]

Isaiah:

For He said, “Surely they are My people, children who will not lie.”

So He became their Savior.

In all their affliction He was afflicted, and **‘the Messenger of His Presence’ saved them;** in His love and in His pity He redeemed them; and He bore them and carried them all the days of old. But they rebelled and grieved **His Holy Spirit;** so He turned Himself against them... Isaiah 63:8-10

And **the Lord**, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His Temple, even **‘the Messenger of the Covenant’**... Malachi 3:1

Melchi Zedek, Priest of God Most High!

Abram:

Then **Melchi Zedek** ('My King of Righteousness'),
King of Salem ('King of Peace'),
('King of the Perfect One'), brought out
bread and wine. He was **the Priest of God Most High.**
And He blessed him and said: "Blessed be Abram of God Most High,
possessor of heaven and earth. And blessed be God Most High,
who has delivered your enemies into your hand."

And he (Abram) gave Him a tithe of all. Genesis 14:18-20

[Who is this Mysterious King Priest, who appears out of nowhere?]

King David wrote about this Man's Priesthood.

The LORD has sworn and will not relent, "You are a Priest forever
according to '**the Order of Melchi Zedek.**'" Psalm 110:4

King Solomon:

It is the Glory of God to conceal a matter,
but it is the glory of kings to search out a matter.

Proverbs 25:2

Moses and Seventy Elders see the God of Israel on Mount Sinai:

Now He said to Moses, “Come up to the LORD, you and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and worship from afar. And Moses alone shall come near the LORD, but they shall not come near; nor shall the people go up with him.” And Moses took the blood, sprinkled it on the people, and said, “This is **the blood of the Covenant** which the LORD has made with you according to all these words.”

Then Moses went up, also Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and they saw **the God of Israel.**

And there was under His feet as it were a paved work of sapphire stone, and it was like the very heavens in its clarity. But on the nobles of the children of Israel He did not lay His Hand.

So they saw God, and they ate and drank.

Exodus 24:1,2,8-11

Isaiah sees the LORD of hosts on His Throne in Heaven:

In the year that King Uzziah died, **I saw the Lord sitting on a Throne**, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one cried to another and said:

**“Holy, Holy, Holy is the LORD of hosts;
the whole earth is full of His Glory!”** Isaiah 6:1-3

Daniel’s sees ‘the Ancient of Days’ (Father God):

“I watched till thrones were put in place, and **the Ancient of Days** was seated; **His garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head was like pure wool.** His Throne was a fiery flame, its wheels a burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him. A thousand thousands ministered to Him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him. The court was seated, and **the Books** were opened.”

Daniel 7:9,10

Ezekiel sees the LORD of Glory on His Throne in Heaven:

The word of the LORD came expressly to Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzi, in the land of the Chaldeans by the River Chebar; and the Hand of the LORD was upon him there. Then I looked, and behold, a Whirlwind was coming out of the north, a great cloud with raging fire engulfing itself; and brightness was all around it and radiating out of its midst like the color of amber, out of the midst of the fire. Also from within it came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance: they had the likeness of a man. Each one had four faces, and each one had four wings.

...the likeness of the firmament above the heads of the living creatures was like the color of an awesome crystal, stretched out over their heads. And under the firmament their wings spread out straight, one toward another.

Each one had two wings which covered one side, and each one had two which covered the other side of the body. When they went, I heard the noise of their wings, like the noise of many waters, like the voice of the Almighty, a tumult like the noise of an army; and when they stood still, they let down their wings.

A Voice came from above the firmament that was over their heads. Whenever they stood, they let down their wings. And above the firmament over their heads was the likeness of **a Throne**, in appearance like a sapphire stone; on the likeness of **the Throne** was a likeness with **the appearance**

of a Man high above it.

Also from the appearance of His waist and upward I saw, as it were, the color of amber with the appearance of fire all around within it; and from the appearance of His waist and downward I saw, as it were, the appearance of fire with brightness all around. Like the appearance of a Rainbow in a cloud on a rainy day, so was the appearance of the brightness all around it. This was the appearance of the likeness of the Glory of the LORD.

So when I saw it, I fell on my face, and I heard **a Voice of One** speaking.

Ezekiel 1:3-6, 22-28 (also Ezekiel 8:1-3)

The Commander of The Armies of Heaven!

Joshua (Yehoshua):

And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, a Man stood opposite him with His drawn **Sword** in His Hand. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, “Are You for us or for our adversaries?” He said, “No, but as **Commander of the Army of the LORD** I have now come.” And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped, and said to Him, “What does **my Lord** say to His servant?”

Then **the Commander of the LORD’s Army** said to Joshua, “Take your sandal off your foot, for the place where you stand is holy.” And Joshua did so. Joshua 5:13-15

[Joshua had spent forty years serving under Moses, and knew His God. He also knew the laws of God, especially not to worship any man or angel. **So who is this Man** called ‘the Commander of the LORD’S Army’, who gave to Joshua Israel’s first Victory at Jericho, as Israel entered into the Promised Land? Joshua behaved as if this Man was His God, or he would never have called him Lord and bowed down and worshiped Him!

But just how could this be? For God had told Moses that nobody could see the Face of God and live! And God is not a man that He should lie!]

The same Hebrew word for ‘worship’ is used both here in Joshua 5:14 as in Exodus 34:8, when Moses falls on his face and worships the LORD.

Isn’t this an interesting mystery. Let’s look at it in much greater depth.

**The fear of the LORD is the beginning of Wisdom,
and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding!**

Proverbs 9:10

Daniel is visited by the Heavenly Man of Glory!

Now on the twenty-fourth day of the first month, as I was by the side of the great river, that is, the Tigris, I lifted my eyes and looked, and behold,

a certain Man clothed in linen,
whose waist was girded with gold of Uphaz! His Body was like beryl,
His Face like the appearance of Lightning,
His Eyes like torches of Fire,
His Arms and Feet like burnished bronze in color, and
the sound of His Words like the Voice of a Multitude!

And He said to me, “O Daniel, man greatly beloved, understand the words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for I have now been sent to you.” While He was speaking this word to me, I stood trembling. Then He said to me, “Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard; and I have come because of your words. But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood Me twenty-one days; and behold, **Michael**, one of **the chief princes**, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia. Now I have come to make you understand what will happen to your people in the latter days, for the vision refers to many days yet to come.”

And suddenly, **One having the likeness of the sons of men** touched my lips; then I opened my mouth and spoke, saying to Him who stood before me, “**My Lord**, because of the vision my sorrows have overwhelmed me, and I have retained no strength. For how can this servant of **my Lord** talk with You, **my Lord**? As for me, no strength remains in me now, nor is any breath left in me.”

Then again, **the One having the likeness of a Man** touched me and strengthened me. And He said, “O man greatly beloved, fear not! Peace be to you; be strong, yes, be strong!” So when He spoke to me I was strengthened, and said, “Let **my Lord** speak, for You have strengthened me.” Then He said, “Do you know why I have come to you?”

And now I must return to fight with the prince of Persia; and when I have gone forth, indeed the prince of Greece will come. But I will tell you what is noted in the Scripture of Truth.” Daniel 10: 4-6, 11-14, 16-21

“At that time **Michael** shall stand up, **the great prince** who stands watch over the sons of your people; and there shall be **a time of trouble**, such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time. And at that time your people shall be rescued, every one who is found written in **the Book**.

And **many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to Everlasting Life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. Those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever.**

But you, Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book until the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase.”

Then I, Daniel, looked; and there stood **two others**, one on this side of the riverbank and the other on that side of the riverbank. And one said to **the Man clothed in linen**, who was above the waters of the river, “How long shall the fulfillment of these wonders be?” Then I heard **the Man clothed in linen**, who was above the waters of the river, when **He held up His Right Hand and His Left Hand to Heaven, and swore by Him who Lives forever**, “that it shall be for a time, times, and half a time; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered, all these things shall be finished.” Although I heard, I did not understand. Then I said, “My Lord, what shall be the end of these things?” And He said, “Go your way, Daniel, for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end. **Many shall be purified, made white, and refined**, but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand,

but the wise shall understand!

And from the time that **the daily sacrifice** is taken away, and **the abomination of desolation** is set up...” Daniel 12:1-11

Moses also speaks of God’s affirmation of Oath, as seen by Daniel:

“Now see that **I, even I, am He, and there is no God besides Me; I kill and I make alive; I wound and I heal; nor is there any who can deliver from My Hand. For I Raise My Hand to Heaven, and say, ‘As I Live Forever... !’**” Deuteronomy 32:39,40 (Exodus 6:8)

THE PLURALITY OF THE GOD OF ISRAEL!

God's Word Reveals that God Expresses Himself in Plurality!

The Shema: “Shema Israel Adonai **Elohenu** Adonai **Echad!**”

“Hear, O Israel: The **LORD our GOD's**, the **LORD, One!**”
Deuteronomy 6:4

Genesis:

Then God said, “**Let Us** make **Adam** in **Our Image**,
according to Our Likeness; let them have dominion over the fish
of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth
and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.”

So **God created Adam in His own image**; in the Image of God
He created him; **male and female He created them.** Genesis 1:26,27

[Adam was made in the image and likeness of God. God then made Adam
fall asleep, and took Eve out of Adam. **Adam, one being, carried woman
within himself.** Adam was one, but within him existed his counterpart.
So Adam was really more than one. **Doesn't God's initial creation
of Adam, as a plurality, also suggest the Plurality of our own God,
since Adam was made in the image and likeness of Adam's God.]**

Then the **LORD God** said, “Behold, **Adam** has become like one **from Us**,
to know good and evil. And now, lest he put out his hand and take also
of **the Tree of Life**, and eat, and live forever (but separated from his God).”
Therefore the **LORD God** sent him out of the garden of Eden to till
the ground from which he was taken. Genesis 3:22,23

they sit down at Your feet; everyone receives Your Words,
the Torah that Moses gave to us, the heritage of the assembly of Jacob.”

Deuteronomy 33:1-4

Joshua:

“For the LORD your God dried up the waters of the Jordan before you until you had crossed over, as the LORD your God did to the Red Sea, which He dried up before us until we had crossed over, that all the peoples of the earth may know **the Hand of the LORD is Mighty**, that you may fear the LORD your God forever.” Joshua 4:23-24

David:

You will show me **the Path of Life; in Your Presence is Fullness of Joy; at Your Right Hand are Pleasures** forevermore. Psalm 16:11

You have also given me the Shield of Your **Salvation; Your Right Hand** has held me up, your Gentleness has made me great. Psalm 18:35

We have heard with our ears, O God; our fathers have told us, the deeds You did in their days, in days of old. You drove out the nations with **Your Hand**, but them You planted; you afflicted the peoples, and cast them out. Oh, sing to the LORD a new song! For He has done marvelous things; **His Right Hand and His Holy Arm** have gained Him the **Victory**. The LORD has made known ‘**His Salvation**’; His Righteousness He has revealed in the sight of the nations. He has remembered His Mercy and His Faithfulness to the house of Israel; **all the ends of the earth have seen ‘the Salvation’ of our God.** Psalm 98:1-3

The LORD is my strength and song, and He has become **my Salvation**.

The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tents of the righteous;

The Right Hand of the LORD does Valiantly!

The Right Hand of the LORD is Exalted!

The Right Hand of the LORD does Valiantly!

I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD. Psalm 118:14-17

Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me; You will stretch out **Your Hand** against the wrath of my enemies, and **Your Right Hand will Save me**. The LORD will perfect that which concerns me; Your mercy, O LORD, endures forever; do not forsake the works of Your Hands.

Isaiah:

For the LORD has comforted His people, He has redeemed Jerusalem.

The LORD has made bare **His Holy Arm**
in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth
shall see **‘the Salvation’ of our God!** Isaiah 52:9,10

And **in this Mountain** the LORD of hosts will make for all people **a feast** of choice pieces, **a feast** of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of well-refined wines on the lees. And He will destroy on this mountain the surface of the covering cast over all people, and the veil that is spread over all nations. **He will swallow up death forever.** And the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces; the rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; for the LORD has spoken. And it will be said in that day: “Behold, this is our God; we have waited for Him, and He **will Save us**. This is the LORD; we have waited for Him; we will be glad and **rejoice in His Salvation.**” For **on this Mountain (Jerusalem, Zion)** **the Hand of the LORD** will rest... Isaiah 25:6-10

Isaiah:

O Zion, you who bring **Good Tidings**, get up into the high mountain;
O Jerusalem, you who bring **Good Tidings**, lift up your voice with strength,
lift it up, be not afraid; say to the cities of Judah, “Behold your God!”

**Behold, the Lord GOD shall come with a Strong Hand,
and His Arm shall Rule for Him;**

Behold, His Reward is with Him, and His Work before Him.

He will feed His flock like a Shepherd;

He will gather the lambs with **His Arm**, and carry them in His Bosom,

iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him,

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own
way; and the LORD **has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.**

For He was cut off from the land of the living;
for the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief.

When You make His Soul an offering for sin,
He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure

My Righteous Servant shall justify many,

peoples in My Anger, made them drunk in My Fury, and brought down

“Where is **He who put His Holy Spirit within them,** who led them by
the right hand of Moses, with **His Glorious Arm,** dividing the water
before them to make for Himself an everlasting name.” Isaiah 63:11-12

Isaiah:

For our transgressions are multiplied before You, and our sins testify against us; for our transgressions are with us, and as for our iniquities, we know them. In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood. Justice is turned back, and righteousness stands afar off; for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter. So truth fails, and he who departs from evil makes himself a prey.

Then the LORD saw it, and it displeased Him that there was no justice. He saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor; therefore His own Arm brought Salvation for Him; and His own Righteousness, it sustained Him. For He put on Righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of Salvation on His head; He put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloak. According to their deeds, accordingly He will repay, fury to His adversaries, recompense to His enemies; the coastlands He will fully repay. So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and His Glory from the rising of the sun. For He will come like a pent-up flood that the Spirit of the LORD drives along.

“The Redeemer will come to Zion, and to those who turn from transgression in Jacob,” says the LORD. “As for Me,” says the LORD, “this is **My Covenant** with them: **My Spirit who is upon you, and My Words** which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants' descendants, from this time and forevermore.” says the LORD.

Isaiah 59:12-21

Thus says the LORD: “Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom. Let not the mighty man glory in his might, nor let the rich man glory in his riches. **But let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD,** exercising Lovingkindness, Judgment, and Righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight,” says the LORD. Jeremiah 9:23,24

MORE DIVINE EXPRESSIONS OF GOD:

THE STONE!

“Joseph is a fruitful bough, a fruitful bough by a well; his branches run over the wall. But his bow remained in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by **the Hands of the Mighty God of Jacob**, because of the One Shepherding, **the Stone of Israel.**” Genesis 49:22,24

[The Hebrew word for stone is ‘eben’. Could this be a composite of two Hebrew words? ‘Av’ is the word for father, and ‘ben’ is the word for son.]

David:

The Stone
which the builders **Rejected**
has become **the Chief Cornerstone!**

This was the LORD’s doing; it is marvelous in our eyes.
This is the Day the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.
Save now, I pray, O LORD; O LORD, I pray, send now prosperity.
Blessed is He who comes in the Name of the LORD!
We have blessed you from the House of the LORD. Psalm 118:22-26

Isaiah:

Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: “Behold, **I lay in Zion a Stone** for a Foundation, **a tried Stone, a Precious Cornerstone,** a sure Foundation; whoever believes will not act hastily.” Isaiah 28:16

Isaiah:

“The LORD of hosts, Him you shall hallow; let Him be your fear, and let Him be your dread. He will be as a Sanctuary, but a Stone of Stumbling and a Rock of Offense to both the houses of Israel, as a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And many among them shall stumble; they shall fall and be broken, be snared and taken.” Bind up the testimony, seal the Torah among My disciples. And I will wait on **the LORD, who hides His face from the house of Jacob**; and I will hope in Him.

Here am **I and the children** whom the LORD has given me!
We are for Signs and Wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, who dwells in Mount Zion. Isaiah 8:13-18

Zechariah:

‘Hear, **O Yeshua, the High Priest**, you and your companions who sit before you, for they are **a wondrous sign**; for behold, I am bringing forth **My Servant ‘the Branch’**. For behold, **the Stone** that I have laid before **Yeshua**: upon **the Stone are Seven Eyes**.

Behold, I will engrave its inscription,’ says the LORD of hosts, ‘And I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.’ Zechariah 3:8,9

Daniel:

“You, O king, were watching; and behold, a great image! This great image, whose splendor was excellent, stood before you; and its form was awesome.

You watched while **a Stone was cut out without hands**, which struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces. Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found.

And **the Stone** that struck the image
became a Great Mountain
and filled the whole earth!” Daniel 2:31,34,35

Moses is told by God of ‘**a Star and a Scepter!**’ and ‘**a Prophet!**’:

“**I see Him**, but not now; **I behold Him**, but not near;
a Star shall come out of Jacob; **a Scepter** shall rise out of Israel,
and batter the brow of Moab, and destroy all the sons of tumult.
Out of Jacob **One shall have Dominion...**” Numbers 24:17,19

And the LORD said to me: “What they have spoken is good.
I will raise up for them **a Prophet** like you from among their brethren,
and **I will put My Words in His mouth**. And
He shall speak to them all that I command Him.
And it shall be that **whoever will not hear My Words**,
which He speaks in My Name,
I will require it of him!” Deuteronomy 18:17-19

Isaiah:

Behold, **a King will Reign in Righteousness**,
and princes will rule with justice. Isaiah 32:1

Malachi announces ‘**the Sun of Righteousness!**’:

“For behold, the Day is coming, burning like an oven,
and all the proud, yes, all who do wickedly will be stubble. And the Day
which is coming shall burn them up,” says the LORD of hosts, “that will
leave them neither root nor branch. But to you who fear My Name
**the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with Healing
in His Wings**; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves.
You shall trample the wicked, for they shall be ashes under the soles of your
feet on the Day that I do this,” says the LORD of hosts. Malachi 4:1-3

‘MY SERVANT’, ‘MY RIGHTEOUS SERVANT’

Isaiah:

“And now says the LORD,
**who formed Me from the womb to be His Servant,
to bring Jacob back to Him, so that Israel is gathered to Him.**

For I am honored in the eyes of the LORD,
and My God shall be My strength.

Indeed He says, ‘It is too small a thing that

You should be **My Servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob,
and to restore the preserved ones of Israel;
I will also give You as a Light to the Gentiles,
that You should be My Salvation to the ends of the earth.’ ”**

Thus says the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, their Holy One,

**to Him whom man despises,
to Him whom the nation abhors,
to the Servant of rulers:**

“Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship,
because of the LORD who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel;
and He has chosen You.”

Thus says the LORD: “**In an acceptable Time** I have heard You,
and in **the Day of ‘Salvation’** (‘Yeshuah’)

**I have helped You; I will preserve You,
and I will give You as a Covenant to the people,**
to restore the earth, to cause them to inherit the desolate heritages.

That You may say to the prisoners, ‘Go forth,’
to those who are in darkness, ‘Show yourselves.’ ”

Isaiah 49:5-9

Isaiah:

“Behold! **My Servant** whom I uphold, my Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put **My Spirit upon Him**. He will bring forth Justice to the Nations. He will not cry out, nor raise His voice, nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. A bruised reed He will not break, and smoking flax He will not quench; He will bring forth Justice for Truth. He will not fail nor be discouraged, till He has established Justice in the earth; and the coastlands shall wait for His Torah.”

Thus says God the LORD, who created the heavens and stretched them out, who spread forth the earth and that which comes from it, who gives breath to the people on it, and Spirit to those who walk on it:

“I, the LORD, have called You in Righteousness, and will hold Your Hand; I will keep You and **give You as a Covenant** to the people, **as a Light** to the Nations, to open blind eyes, to bring out prisoners from the prison, those who sit in darkness from the prison house. I am the LORD, that is My Name; and **My Glory I will not give to another**, nor My praise to graven images. Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things I declare; before they spring forth I tell you of them.” Isaiah 42:1-9

Behold, **My Servant** shall deal prudently;
He shall be Exalted and Extolled and be Very High!

Just as many were astonished at you,

so **His visage was marred** more than any man,
and **His form** more than the sons of men.

So shall He sprinkle many nations.

Kings shall shut their mouths at Him;
for what had not been told them they shall see,
and what they had not heard they shall consider.

Isaiah 52:13-15

With what do you think **this Servant** sprinkles the nations?

With His Own Blood, God’s Son’s Sinless Blood!

Isaiah:

Who has believed our report? And to whom has

‘the Arm of the LORD’ been revealed?

For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; and when we see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and ‘by His stripes we are healed!’

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth;

He was led **as a lamb to the slaughter**, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He opened not His mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; **for the transgressions of My people He was stricken**. And they made His grave with the wicked, but with the rich at His death, because He had done no violence, nor was any deceit in His mouth.

Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief.

When **You make His Soul an offering for sin,**

He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His Hand. He shall see the labor of His Soul, and be satisfied. **By His Knowledge**

My Righteous Servant

shall justify many, for **He shall bear their iniquities.**

Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong, because He poured out His soul unto death, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and **He bore the sin of many**, and made intercession for the transgressors. Isaiah 53:1-12

‘BRANCH’ IS ANOTHER DIVINE TITLE OF GOD!

Isaiah:

And there shall come forth a rod out of **the stem of Jesse**,
and **a Branch** shall grow out of his roots:

And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Might, the Spirit of Knowledge and of the Fear of the LORD; And His delight is in the fear of the LORD. And He shall not Judge after the sight of His eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of His ears. But He shall Judge the poor with Righteousness, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth;

He shall smite the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips shall He slay the wicked. And Righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and Faithfulness the girdle of His reins.

And in that Day there shall be **a Root of Jesse**, who shall Stand for a banner of the Peoples; to Him the Nations shall seek.

And His Resting Place shall be **Glory!** Isaiah 11:1-5,10

[Yeshua grew up in ‘Nazareth’, an Israeli town which means ‘**a branch**’.]

Jeremiah:

“In those days and at that time I will cause to grow up to David **a Branch of Righteousness.** He shall execute Judgment and Righteousness in the earth. In those days Judah will be saved, and Jerusalem will dwell safely. And this is the Name by which She will be called:

‘THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS!’ ”

“For thus says the LORD: ‘David shall never lack **a Man** to sit on the Throne of the house of Israel; nor shall the Priests, the Levites, lack **a Man** to offer burnt offerings before Me, to kindle grain offerings, and to sacrifice continually.’ ” Jeremiah 33:15-18

[Here again we see a **Man** who is both a King and a Priest of God!]

“Behold, the days are coming,” says the LORD, “That I will raise to David **a Branch of Righteousness**; a King shall Reign and prosper, and execute Judgment and Righteousness in the earth. In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell safely; now this is His Name by which He will be called: **‘THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS!’**”
Jeremiah 23:5,6

Zechariah:

“Hear, **O Yeshua, the High Priest**, you and your companions who sit before you, for **they are a Wondrous Sign**.
For Behold I am bringing forth **My Servant, ‘the BRANCH’!**
For behold **the Stone** that I have laid before **Yeshua**:
upon **the Stone are Seven Eyes**.
Behold, I will engrave its inscription,” says the LORD of hosts,
“and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.” Zechariah 3:8-9

“And take silver and gold, make **Crowns**, and set on the head of **Yeshua, the High Priest**, the son of Jehozadok.” Then speak to him, saying,
“Thus says the LORD of hosts, saying: “Behold, **the Man** whose Name is **‘the BRANCH’!** From His place He shall branch out, and He shall build the Temple of the LORD. Yes, **He shall build the Temple of the LORD. He shall bear the Glory! He shall sit and Rule on His Throne. And He shall be a Priest on His Throne, and the Counsel of Peace shall be between the two of Them.**” ’ Zechariah 6:11-13

[God told us that **God’s Glory belongs only to God, and to none other!**

Where else have we seen this Man, who is both King and Priest of God? In Genesis 14:18! God has told us that His Throne would not be shared with anyone, but only by God Himself? Therefore, ‘the Branch’ is God Himself!]

THE ANCIENT OF DAYS GLORIFIES ‘THE SON OF MAN’!

“I watched till **Thrones** were put in place, and **the Ancient of Days** was seated; His garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head was like pure wool. His throne was a fiery flame, its wheels a burning fire; A fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him. A thousand thousands ministered to Him. Ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him. The court was seated, and **the Books** were opened.

I watched then because of the sound of the pompous words which ‘the horn’ was speaking; I watched till the beast was slain, and its body destroyed and given to the burning flame.

As for the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away, yet their lives were prolonged for a season and a time.”

“I was watching in the night visions, and behold, **One like ‘the Son of Man’** coming with **the Clouds of Heaven!**
He came to ‘the Ancient of Days’,
and they brought Him near before Him. Then **to Him was given Dominion and Glory and a Kingdom,** that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him.
His Dominion is an Everlasting Dominion,
which shall not pass away, and
His Kingdom, that which shall not be destroyed!”

Daniel 7:9-14

[The Prophet Daniel had a most powerful End Time vision...

Father God, ‘the Ancient of Days’ gives His Dominion and **Glory** and a Kingdom of all peoples, nations, and languages to this **‘Son of Man’!**

Who is this ‘Son of Man’ to whom the **‘Ancient of Days’** gives not only **His Glory,** but **Authority** over all the Earth, as an **Everlasting Kingdom?** God has told us that **He will never give His Glory to another!** **And God cannot lie!** This means that this **‘Son of Man’** has to be an expression of the **One God, Himself!]**

GOD WILL NOT GIVE HIS GLORY TO ANOTHER!

Then He appears as **the Almighty LORD of hosts, the Conquering King** coming from Heaven, **sounding the Great Shofar** over His Creation, as He proceeds to destroy all His enemies, and set up His earthly Kingdom.]

We know from these verses and from other Scriptures, as Psalm 24:10

just whom **the LORD of hosts** really is ...

The LORD of hosts is The KING of GLORY!

A King will Sit on His Throne in the Tent of David

“On that day, I will raise up the Tent of David, which has fallen down, and repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins, and rebuild it as in the days of old; that they may possess the remnant of Edom, and all the Peoples who are called by My Name,” says the LORD who does this thing. Amos 9:11,12

“In Mercy the Throne will be established; and One will sit on it in Truth, in the Tent of David, Judging and seeking Justice and hastening Righteousness!” Isaiah 16:5

[The Tent of David was where David had the Ark of the Covenant placed. Only the Sons of Aaron, Levitical Priests, were allowed to go into the Tent. **The King** who sits on **this Throne** is both **King and High Priest of God!**]

The God of Israel is the Aleph and the Tav!

“Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel, and His Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: **‘I am the First (Aleph) and I am the Last (Tav); besides Me there is no God!’** ” Isaiah 44:6

“Listen to Me, O Jacob, and Israel, My called: **I am He, I am the First (Aleph), I am also the Last (Tav).** Indeed My Hand has laid the foundation of the earth, and My **Right Hand** has stretched out the heavens; when I call to them, they stand up together.

Come near to Me, hear this: I have not spoken in secret from the Beginning; from the time that it was, **I was there.** And now **the Lord GOD and His Spirit** have sent Me.”

THE GOD OF ISRAEL IS OUR SAVIOR!

God told us over and over that **there is no other god, but the God of Israel! He is the Creator of Heaven and Earth! Only our God would be our Savior, there is no other Savior!**

But now, thus says the LORD, who created you, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel: “Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; you are Mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch you. For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, **your Savior**; I gave Egypt for your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba in your place. For **He** was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgressions of My people **He** was stricken. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise **Him**; He has put **Him** to grief. When **You make His soul an offering for sin...** Isaiah 53:1,4-6,8,10

THE GOD OF ISRAEL IS OUR LOVING FATHER!

He will also bless the fruit of your womb, and the fruit of your land, your grain and your new wine and your oil, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flock, in the land of which He swore to your fathers to give you. You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall not be a male or female barren among you or among your livestock. And the LORD will take away from you all sickness, and will afflict you with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt which you have known, but will lay them on all those who hate you.”

the Arm of the LORD been revealed? Isaiah 53:1

[King David knew this great Truth about the Plurality and Oneness of God.]

**Then the LORD saw it, and it displeased Him

and His own Righteousness, it sustained Him. **For He put on
Righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of Salvation on His head;

Nathan:

And it shall be, when your days are fulfilled, when you must go to be with your fathers, that I will set up **your Seed** after you, who will be from your sons; and I will establish His Kingdom.

He shall build Me a House, and I will establish **His Throne Forever**.

I will be to Him as a Father, and He shall be to Me as a Son; and I will not take My mercy away from him, as I took it from him (Saul)

who was before you. **And I will establish Him in My House and in My Kingdom Forever; and His Throne shall be established Forever!”**

According to all these words and according to all this vision, so Nathan spoke to David. 1 Chronicles 17:4,10-15 (see also 2nd Samuel 7:4,5,11-17)

Jeremiah:

And the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah, saying, “Thus says the LORD: ‘**If you can break My Covenant with the day and My Covenant with the night**, so that there will not be day and night in their season, **then My Covenant may also be broken with David My servant**, so that he shall not have **a Son to Reign on his Throne**, and with the Levites, **the Priests**, My ministers. As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, nor the sand of the sea measured, so will I multiply the descendants of David My servant, and the Levites who minister to Me.’ ” Jeremiah 33:19-22

“The LORD said to **my Lord**, ‘Sit at My Right Hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool.’ ” Psalm 110:1

[If the Messiah is David’s son, how then can David call Him ‘**my Lord**’?]

David:

The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against **the LORD and against His Anointed (Messiah)**, saying, “Let us break Their bonds in pieces and cast away Their cords from us.” He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; the LORD shall hold them in derision. Then He shall speak to them in His Wrath, and distress them in His deep displeasure:

“Yet I have set My King on My holy hill of Zion!

I will declare the decree: the LORD has said to Me,

‘You are My Son, today I have begotten You.

Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession. You shall break them with a rod of iron; you shall dash them to pieces like a potter’s vessel.’ ”

Psalm 2:2-9

Let Your Hand be upon **the Man of Your Right Hand**, upon **‘the Son of man’** whom You made strong for Yourself. Psalm 80:17

Daniel:

“Seventy weeks are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in **Everlasting Righteousness**, to seal up vision and prophecy, and **to anoint the Most Holy**. Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until **Messiah the Prince**, there shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times. And after the sixty-two weeks

**Messiah shall be cut off,
but not for Himself!**

And **the people of the prince** who is to come shall destroy the city **and the sanctuary**. The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined.

Then **he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week**; but in the middle of the week **he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering**. And on the wing of **abominations** shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.”

Daniel 9:24-27

God our Shepherd becomes **the Lamb Offering!**

The LORD is my Shepherd, I shall not want! Psalm 23:1

But Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, “My father!”
And he said, “Here I am, my son.” Then he said, “Look, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?” And Abraham said,
“My son, **God will provide Himself the lamb**
for a burnt offering.” Genesis 22:7,8

There they shall lie down in a good fold and feed in rich pasture on the mountains of Israel. **I will Shepherd My flock**, and I will make them lie down,” says the Lord GOD.’ “I will seek what was lost, and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen what was sick; but I will destroy the fat and the strong, and feed them in judgment. Therefore I will save My flock, and they shall no longer be a prey; and I will judge between sheep and sheep.

I will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall shepherd them. **My servant David, he shall shepherd them and be their shepherd.** And I, the LORD, will be their God, and My servant David a prince among them; I, the LORD, have spoken. I will make a **Covenant of Peace** with them, and cause wild beasts to cease from the land; and they will dwell safely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods. **I will give them and the places around My Hill (Zion) a blessing; and I will cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing.**

Ezekiel 34:10-16,22-26

Jeremiah:

“Return, O backsliding children,” says the LORD; “for **I am Married to you.** I will take you, one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion. And **I will give you shepherds according to My heart,** who will feed you with knowledge and understanding.” Jeremiah 3:14,15

WHO AND WHAT IS MAN?

Men and women, the children of Adam (Adam and Eve), were created and destined for true intimacy and **Sonship** with their Creator. “Ask Me about things to come, concerning **My sons...**” Isaiah 45:11
[Isaiah 54:5-8; Jeremiah 3:6-(8)-14; Hosea 2:14-(16)-23; Isaiah 62:1-7]

Then God said, “**Let Us make Adam in Our image, according to Our likeness; *let them have Dominion*** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” So God created **Adam** in His own image; in the image of God He created him; **male and female** He created **them**.

Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; ***have Dominion*** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.” Genesis 1:26-28

What is man that You are mindful of him, and ‘the son of man’ that You visit him? **For You have made him a little lower than Elohim (God), and You have crowned him with glory and honor. You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your Hands; You have put all things under his feet.** Psalm 8:4-6

I said, “**You are gods, and all of you are children of the Most High.** But you shall die like men...” Psalm 82:6,7

“Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be ... numbered. And it shall come to pass in the place where it was said to them, ‘You are not My people,’ there it shall be said to them, **‘You are sons of the living God!’** Hosea 1:10

MAN'S PROBLEM OF SIN: SEPARATION FROM GOD

And the LORD passed before him and proclaimed,
“The LORD, the LORD God, Merciful and Gracious, Longsuffering,
and abounding in Goodness and Truth, keeping Mercy for thousands,
forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means
clearing the guilty, **visiting the iniquity of the fathers
upon the children and the children's children to the third
and the fourth generation.**” Exodus 34:6,7; Numbers 14:18

“Fathers shall not be put to death for their children, nor shall the
children be put to death for their fathers; **a person shall be put to death
for his own sin.**” Deuteronomy 24:16

**‘Cursed is the one who does not confirm
all the Words of this Torah!’** Deuteronomy 27:26

[What does this mean? Does it mean that whoever does not keep all the
written Torah, but breaks even one point of Torah has failed, and is cursed?]

Behold, **the LORD'S Hand** is not shortened, that it cannot
save; nor His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. **But your iniquities
have separated you from your God; and your sins
have hidden His face from you**, so that He will not hear.

Isaiah 59:1-2

“Come now, and let us reason together,” says the LORD, “**though your
sins are like scarlet**, they shall be **as white as snow**; though they are red like
crimson, they shall be **as wool**. If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat
the good of the land. But if you refuse and rebel, you shall be devoured by
the sword”; for the mouth of the LORD has spoken. Isaiah 1:18-20

David:

The fool has said in his heart, “There is no God.” They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, **there is none who does good**. The LORD looks down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there are any who understand, who seek God. They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **there is none who does good, no, not one**. Psalm 14:1-3 (also Psalm 53:1)

Isaiah:

“To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices to Me?” says the LORD. “I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams and the fat of fed cattle. **I do not delight in the blood of bulls, or of lambs or goats.**” Isaiah 11:11

But **we are all like an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags**; we all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. And there is no one who calls on Your Name, who stirs himself up to take hold of You; for You have hidden Your Face from us, and have consumed us because of **our iniquities**. Isaiah 64:6,7

Ezekiel:

“Say to them: ‘As I live,’ says the Lord GOD, ‘I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live. **Turn, turn from your evil ways! For why should you die, O house of Israel?**’

“Therefore you, O son of man, say to the children of your people: ‘The righteousness of the righteous man shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression; as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall because of it, in the day that he turns from his wickedness; nor shall the righteous be able to live because of his righteousness in the day that he sins.’

When I say to the righteous that he shall surely live, but he trusts in his own righteousness and commits iniquity, none of his righteous works shall be remembered; but because of the iniquity that he has committed, he shall die. Again, when I say to the wicked, ‘You shall surely die,’ if he turns from his sin and does what is lawful and right, if the wicked restores the pledge, gives back what he has stolen, and walks in the statutes of life without committing iniquity, he shall surely live; he shall not die. None of his sins which he has committed shall be remembered against him; he has done what is lawful and right; he shall surely live.” Ezekiel 33:11-16

Ezekiel:

“The soul who sins shall die. The son shall not bear the guilt of the father, nor the father bear the guilt of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself. But if a wicked man turns from all his sins which he has committed, keeps all My statutes, and does what is lawful and right, he shall surely live; he shall not die. None of the transgressions which he has committed shall be remembered against him; because of the righteousness which he has done, he shall live. Do I have any pleasure at all that the wicked should die?” says the Lord GOD, “and not that he should turn from his ways and live?

But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked man does, shall he live? All the righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered; because of the unfaithfulness of which he is guilty, and the sin which he has committed, because of them he shall die.

Yet you say, ‘The way of the Lord is not fair.’ Hear now, O house of Israel, is it not My way which is fair, and your ways which are not fair? When a righteous man turns away from his righteousness, commits iniquity, and dies in it, it is because of the iniquity which he has done that he dies. Again, when a wicked man turns away from the wickedness which he committed, and does what is lawful and right, he preserves himself alive. Because he considers and turns away from all the transgressions which he committed, he shall surely live; he shall not die.

Yet the house of Israel says, ‘The way of the Lord is not fair.’ O house of Israel, is it not My ways which are fair, and your ways which are not fair? **Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways,**” says the Lord GOD.

“Repent, and turn from all your transgressions, so that iniquity will not be your ruin. Cast away from you all the transgressions which you have committed, and **get yourselves a new heart and a new spirit.** For why should you die, O house of Israel?

For I have no pleasure in the death of one who dies,” says the Lord GOD. **“Therefore turn (back to God) and live!”** Ezekiel 18:20-32

[How can a person get **a new heart and a new spirit**? Only God can give you these gifts. See pages 92, 93 (Jeremiah 31:31-34 and Ezekiel 36:26,27)]

GOD’S SOLUTION FOR SIN: GOD’S BLOOD ATONEMENT

To redeem **sinfull blood** of mankind would require **the Sinless Blood** of man. But **this ruled out everyone on earth**, for everyone’s blood had sin from the fall of Adam and Eve. Just how would God accomplish this impossibility? **God came to earth in Sinless Flesh and Blood** to redeem **sinfull flesh!**

Your **lamb** shall be **without blemish, a male** of the first year...

Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel and said to them, “Pick out and take lambs for yourselves according to your families, and **kill the Passover lamb**. And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, dip it in **the blood** that is in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two doorposts with **the blood** that is in the basin. And none of you shall go out of the door of his house until morning. **For the LORD will pass through** to strike the Egyptians; and **when He sees the blood** on the lintel and on the two doorposts, **the LORD will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you**. And you shall observe this thing as **an ordinance forever** for you and your sons.” Exodus 12:5,21-24

‘For **the life of the flesh** is in **the blood**, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is **the Blood that makes Atonement for the soul.**’

Leviticus 17:11

And the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man (Adam) forever, for **he is indeed flesh...**” Genesis 6:3

[What Blood Covenant is God talking about? **The New Covenant!** **Whose Blood is it? The Blood of this Humble King,** the God of Heaven, who came in Sinless Flesh, riding into Jerusalem on an ass, to bring ‘Salvation’ to both Israel and to all of mankind who would return to their God!]

I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with **the garments of ‘Salvation’**, He has covered me with **the robe of Righteousness**, as **a bridegroom decks himself** with ornaments, and as **a bride adorns herself** with her jewels. Yes, while I was speaking in prayer, **the man Gabriel**, whom I had seen
in the vision at the beginning, being caused to **fly swiftly**, reached me about
the time of the evening offering. And he informed me, and talked with me,
and said, “O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you skill to understand.
At the beginning of your supplications the command went out, and I have
come to tell you, for you are greatly beloved; therefore consider the matter,
and understand the vision:

‘Seventy weeks are determined for your people and for your Holy City
(Jerusalem), to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make
reconciliation for iniquity, **to bring in Everlasting Righteousness,**
to seal up vision and prophecy, and **to anoint the Most Holy.’**

Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command
to restore and build Jerusalem **until Messiah the Prince,**
there shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks.

The street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times.

And after the sixty-two weeks
Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself!”

Daniel 9:21-26

“But you, **Bethlehem Ephrathah**, though you are little among the thousands of Judah, **yet out of you shall One come forth to Me, to be Ruler in Israel**, whose goings forth are from **of old, from Everlasting.**” Therefore He shall give them up, until the time that she who is in labor has given Birth; then the remnant of His brethren shall return to the children of Israel.

And He shall stand and feed His flock in the Strength of the LORD, in the Majesty of the Name of the LORD His God; and They shall abide, for now He shall be Great to the ends of the earth!

And this One shall be Peace. Micah 5:1-5

Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened; burnt offering and sin offering You did not require. Then I said, **“Behold, I come; in the Scroll of the Book it is written of Me. I delight to do Your Will, O My God, and Your Torah is within My Heart.** I have proclaimed **the Good News of Righteousness** in the Great Assembly; indeed, I do not restrain My lips, O LORD, You Yourself know.

O I have not hidden Your Righteousness within My heart; I have declared Your Faithfulness and Your Salvation. I have not concealed Your Loving-kindness and Your Truth from the Great Assembly. Do not withhold Your tender Mercies from Me, O LORD. Let Your Lovingkindness and Your Truth continually preserve Me.” Psalm 40:6-11

“Behold, I send **My messenger**, and he will prepare the way before Me. And **the Lord**, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His Temple, even **the Messenger of the Covenant**, in whom you delight. **Behold, He is coming,**” says the LORD of hosts. Malachi 3:1

Behold, **My Servant** shall deal prudently; He shall be **Exalted and Extolled** and be **Very High!** Just as many were astonished at you, so His visage was marred more than any man, and His form more than the sons of men. **So shall He sprinkle many nations.** Kings shall shut their mouths at Him; for what had not been told them they shall see, and what they had not heard they shall consider. Isaiah 52:13-15

“The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach Good Tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; To proclaim the Acceptable Year of the LORD, and the Day of Vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of Righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He may be Glorified.” Isaiah 61:1-3

Who has believed our report? And to whom has **the Arm of the LORD** been revealed? For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; and when we see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him. He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Surely **He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows;** yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. **But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities (sins);** the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, **and by His Stripes we are healed.** All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and **the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.** He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He opened not His mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who will declare His generation? **For He was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgressions of My people He was stricken.** And they made His grave with the wicked, but with the rich at His death, because He had done no violence, nor was any deceit in His mouth. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. **When You make His Soul an offering for sin,** He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. He shall see the labor of His Soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge **My Righteous Servant shall justify many,** for **He shall bear their iniquities.**

Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong, because He poured out His Soul unto death, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and **He bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.** Isaiah 53:1-12

‘And whoever blasphemes the name of the LORD shall surely be put to death...’ Leviticus 24:16

“If a man has committed a sin deserving of death, and he is put to death, and **you hang him on a tree...**” Deuteronomy 21:22

“**My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?** Why are You so far from helping Me, and from the words of My groaning? But **You are Holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel.** Our fathers trusted in You; they trusted, and You delivered them. ...All those who see Me ridicule Me; they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, ‘He trusted in the LORD, let Him rescue Him; let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!’ ...Many bulls have surrounded Me; strong bulls of Bashan have encircled Me. They gape at Me with their mouths, like a raging and roaring lion. **I am poured out like water,** and all My bones are out of joint; my heart is like wax; it has melted within Me. My strength is dried up like a potsherd, and My tongue clings to My jaws; you have brought Me to the dust of death. For dogs have surrounded Me; the congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me.

They pierced My hands and My feet; I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me. They divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots. But You, O LORD, do not be far from Me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me!” Psalm 22:1,3,4,7,8,12-19

“...the Blood of the Sin Offering of Atonement... It is Most Holy to the LORD.” Exodus 30:10

“...you shall bring a sheaf of **the firstfruits** of your harvest to the Priest. He shall wave the sheaf before the LORD.... And you shall offer on that day, when you wave the sheaf, **a male lamb** of the first year, **without blemish, as a burnt offering to the LORD.**” Leviticus 23:10-12

“I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. **I will put My Spirit within you** and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.” Ezekiel 36:26,27

PROPHECIES OF MESSIAH'S SECOND COMING

“And in the days of these kings the God of Heaven will set up a Kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the Kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand Forever!”

Daniel 2:44

“Behold, I will send you **Elijah the prophet** before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD. And he will turn the hearts of the fathers (Orthodox) to the children (New Testament believers in Yeshua), and the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the earth with a curse.” Malachi 4:5,6

“Seventy weeks are determined for your people and for your Holy City, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, **to bring in Everlasting Righteousness**, to seal up vision and prophecy, and **to anoint the Most Holy**. Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until **Messiah the Prince**, there shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks. The street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times.

And after the sixty-two weeks

Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself.

And the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined.

Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the middle of the week he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.” Daniel 9:21-27

Come, and **let us return to the LORD**; for He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. After two days He will revive us; **on the third day He will raise us up, that we may live in His sight.**

Let us know, let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His going forth is established as the morning; **He will come to us like the rain, like the latter and former rain to the earth.** Hosea 6:1-3

“For thus says the LORD: ‘We have heard a voice of trembling, of fear, and not of peace. Ask now, and see, whether a man is ever in labor with child? So why do I see every man with his hands on his loins like a woman in labor, and all faces turned pale? Alas! For **that Day is great**, so that none is like it; and **it is the time of Jacob’s trouble!**

But he shall be saved out of it.’ ” Jeremiah 30:5-7

“At that time **Michael** shall stand up, **the great prince** who stands watch over the sons of your people; and there shall be **a time of trouble**, such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time. And at that time your people shall be rescued, every one who is found written in **the Book.**

And **many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to Everlasting Life**, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.” Daniel 12:1,2

Let the priests, who minister to the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar; let them say, “**Spare Your people, O LORD, and do not give Your heritage to reproach, that the nations should rule over them.** Why should they say among the peoples, ‘Where is their God?’ ” Joel 2:17

“... **but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits.** And those of the people who understand **shall instruct many**; yet for many days they shall fall by sword and flame, by captivity and plundering. Now when they fall, they shall be aided with a little help; but many shall join with them by intrigue. And some of those of understanding shall fall, **to refine them, purify them, and make them white**, until the time of the end; because it is still for the appointed time.” Daniel 11:32-35

A Highway shall be there, and a road, and it shall be called **‘the Highway of Holiness’**. The unclean shall not pass over it, but it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, shall not go astray. No lion shall be there, nor shall any ravenous beast go up on it; it shall not be found there. **But the Redeemed shall walk there. And the Ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with singing, with Everlasting Joy on their heads. They shall obtain Joy and Gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.** Isaiah 35:8-10 (see Isaiah 51:11)

Indeed the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the world: “Say to the daughter of Zion, ‘Surely your Salvation is Coming; behold, His Reward is with Him, and His work before Him.’ ” And they shall call them **The Holy People, the Redeemed of the LORD;** and you shall be called Sought Out, a City Not Forsaken. Isaiah 62:11,12

Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, and the LORD listened and heard them; so **a Book of Remembrance** was written before Him for those who fear the LORD and who meditate on His name. “They shall be Mine,” says the LORD of hosts, “on the day that I make them **My jewels**. And I will spare them as a man spares his own son who serves him.” Then you shall again discern between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve Him. Malachi 3:16-18

Bind up the testimony, **seal the Torah among My disciples.** And I will wait on **the LORD, who hides His face from the house of Jacob;** and I will hope in Him. Here am **I and the children** whom the LORD has given me! **We are for signs and wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts,** who dwells in Mount Zion. Isaiah 8:16-18

“For the lips of **a Priest should keep knowledge,** and people should seek **the Torah** from his mouth; for **he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts.**” Malachi 2:7

“And it shall come to pass afterward **that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh;** your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions. And also on My men servants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days.

And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth: blood and fire and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the coming of the great and awesome **Day of the LORD.**

And it shall come to pass that **whoever calls on the Name of the LORD shall be saved!** For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem **there shall be deliverance,** as the LORD has said, **among the remnant whom the LORD calls.”** Joel 2:28-32

“...but the just **shall live by his faith.**” Habakkuk 2:4

“For behold, the **Day** is coming, burning like an oven, and **all the proud, yes, all who do wickedly will be stubble.** And the day which is coming shall burn them up,” says the LORD of hosts, “that will leave them neither root nor branch. **But to you who fear My Name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings!** And you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. You shall trample the wicked, for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day that I do this,” says the LORD of hosts. Malachi 4:1-3

The LORD gives Voice before His Army, for His camp is very Great; for Strong is the One who executes His Word. For **the Day of the LORD** is Great and very Terrible; who can endure it? Joel 2:11 (see Isaiah 13:4,5)

Blessed is He who comes in the Name of the LORD!

We have blessed You out of the house of the LORD.

Psalm 118:26

“I will surely assemble all of you, O Jacob, I will surely gather **the remnant of Israel**; I will put them together like sheep of the fold, like a flock in the midst of their pasture; they shall make a loud noise because of so many people. **The One who breaks open will come up before them**; they will break out, pass through the gate, and go out by it; **their King will pass before them, with the LORD at their head.**” Micah 2:12,13

Then **the LORD** will be seen over them, and His arrow will go forth like lightning. **The Lord GOD will blow the Shofar**, and go with whirlwinds from the south. **The LORD of hosts** will defend them; they shall devour and subdue with slingstones. They shall drink and roar as if with wine; they shall be filled with blood like basins, like the corners of the altar. **The LORD their God will save them in that Day**, as the flock of His people. For they shall be like the jewels of a crown, lifted like a banner over His land. Zechariah 9:14-16

And it shall come to pass **in that Day** that the LORD will thresh, from the channel of the River to the Brook of Egypt; and you will be gathered one by one, O you children of Israel. So it shall be in that Day **the Great Shofar will be blown**; they will come, who are about to perish in the land of Assyria, and they who are outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the Holy Mount in Jerusalem. Isaiah 27:12,13

Then you shall cause **the Shofar of the Jubilee** to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month; **on the Day of Atonement**, you shall make **the shofar to sound throughout all your land.**

‘And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be **a Jubilee for you**; and each of you shall return to his possession, and each of you shall return to his family. **That fiftieth year shall be a Jubilee to you**; in it you shall neither sow nor reap what grows of its own accord, nor gather the grapes of your untended vine. For **it is the Jubilee; it shall be Holy to you**; you shall eat its produce from the field. In **this Year of Jubilee**, each of you shall return to his possession.’ Leviticus 25:9-13

“In that Day the LORD will defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; the one who is feeble among them **in that Day** shall be like David, and the house of David shall be like God, like the Angel of the LORD before them.

It shall be **in that Day** that **I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.** And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then **they will look on Me whom they have pierced; they will mourn for Him as one mourns for His only Son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.**

In that Day there shall be **a great mourning** in Jerusalem, like the mourning at Hadad Rimmon in the plain of Megiddo. **And the land shall mourn, every family by itself:** the family of the house of David by itself, and their wives by themselves; the family of the house of Nathan by itself, and their wives by themselves; the family of the house of Levi by itself, and their wives by themselves; the family of Shimei by itself, and their wives by themselves; all the families that remain, every family by itself, and their wives by themselves. Zechariah 12:8-14

I will also gather **all nations**, and bring them down to **the Valley of Jehoshaphat**; and I will **enter into Judgment** with them there on account of **My people, My heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations; they have also divided up My land.** They have cast lots for My people, have given a boy as payment for a harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they may drink. Proclaim this among the nations: “Prepare for war! Wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near, let them come up. Let the nations be wakened, and come up to **the Valley of Jehoshaphat; for there I will sit to Judge all the surrounding nations.** Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, go down; for the winepress is full, the vats overflow, for their wickedness is great. **Multitudes, multitudes in the Valley of Decision!** For **the Day of the LORD is near in the Valley of Decision.** The sun and moon will grow dark and the stars will diminish their brightness. The LORD also will roar from Zion, and utter His Voice from Jerusalem; the heavens and earth will shake; but the LORD will be a shelter for His people, and the strength of the children of Israel. So you shall know that I am the LORD your God, dwelling in Zion, My Holy Mountain.” Joel 3:2,3,9,12-14

Behold, **the Day of the LORD** is coming, and your spoil will be divided in your midst. For I will gather all the nations to battle against Jerusalem; the city shall be taken, the houses rifled, and the women ravished. Half of the city shall go into captivity, but the remnant of the people shall not be cut off from the city. Then the LORD will go forth and fight against those nations, as He fights in the Day of Battle. And in that Day **His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives**, which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, from east to west, making a very large valley; half of the mountain shall move toward the north and half of it toward the south. Then you shall flee through My mountain valley, for the mountain valley shall reach to Azal. Yes, you shall flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Thus **the LORD my God will come, and all the saints with Him.**

It shall come to pass in that Day that there will be no light; the lights will diminish. It shall be one Day which is known to the LORD, neither day nor night. But at evening time it shall happen that it will be light. And in that Day it shall be that **Living Waters shall flow from Jerusalem**, half of them toward the eastern sea and half of them toward the western sea; in both summer and winter it shall occur.

And the LORD shall be King over all the earth.
In that Day it shall be

“The LORD is One, and His Name One!”

And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship **the King, the LORD of hosts**, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.

Zechariah 14:1-9,16

‘But the saints of the Most High shall receive the Kingdom, and possess the Kingdom forever, even forever and ever!’ Daniel 7:18 (see Daniel 7:27)

So the LORD will Reign over them in Mount Zion from now on, even forever! Micah 4:7

Now it shall come to pass in the latter days that the Mountain of the LORD'S House shall be established on the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow to it. Many people shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the Mountain of the LORD, to the House of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, and we shall walk in His paths." **For out of Zion shall go forth the Torah, and the Word of the LORD from Jerusalem.** He shall Judge between the nations, and rebuke many people; they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore. Isaiah 2:2-4

"I will Betroth you to Me forever; yes, I will Betroth you to Me in Righteousness and Justice, in Lovingkindness and Mercy; I will Betroth you to Me in Faithfulness, and you shall know the LORD! It shall come to pass in that Day that I will answer," says the LORD; "I will answer the heavens, and they shall answer the earth. The earth shall answer with grain, with new wine, and with oil; they shall answer Jezreel. Then **I will sow her for Myself in the earth,** and I will have Mercy on her who had not obtained mercy; then I will say to those who were not My people, '**You are My people!**' And they shall say, '**You are my God!**' " Hosea 2:19-23

A Highway shall be there, and a road, and it shall be called **the Highway of Holiness.** But **the Redeemed** shall walk there. And **the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with singing, with everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness,** and sorrow and sighing shall flee away. Isaiah 35:8,9,10

For the earth shall be full of the Knowledge of the LORD,
as the waters cover the sea. Isaiah 11:9

Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for He is Good!

Conclusion:

In this book I have shown many of the different faces and expressions of our God. I have also listed various key Scriptures under each category to reveal more about the identity of our God. However, there are many more Scriptures you can find under each of these categories to show the validity of each point presented in this book. For once the veil is lifted off your eyes and heart to see, **the whole Tanakh** makes these same statements of the identity of our Loving God. **Believing in Yeshua is not another religion.**

It is the fulfillment of Torah! and of Judaism!

God's Word will stand Forever! God is our real Father! God also expresses Himself as **our Savior**, as the Son, our Messiah. God sent His Son to earth **to redeem Israel and the nations** from all their sins, and to show 'the Way' back to our Father, our Creator. All of these Scriptures from God's Word have proven these Truths, for everyone to see and study. To believe in Yeshua is Eternal Life! To refuse the Sacrifice made by God for your live is Eternal Death! Therefore, as Moses said: **"Choose Life!"** (Deuteronomy 30:14-20)

God told us that He would send **a Special Prophet** that all the world **would be required to listen to and obey!** (Deuteronomy 18:17-19) God did this when He sent His own beloved Son.

Yeshua said: "For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the Torah until all is fulfilled!" (Matthew 5:18) **"Heaven and earth will pass away, but My Words will by no means pass away!"** (Matthew 24:35)

The Kingdom of Heaven is about to come down to earth, and the Reign of **the King of Heaven** will soon begin from Jerusalem, but only after the nation of Israel cries out for their true Messiah.

Appendix I : The Wonderful Words of Yeshua

Read some of **the remarkable Words spoken by Yeshua**, found in the New Testament, the Brit Hadasha, and decide for yourself whether these are the Words of an ordinary man. Or are these the Words of God, Himself, spoken by God's own Son?

These Words were recorded by one of Yeshua's closest and most faithful disciples, Yochanan, an Israeli from Capernaum, by the Sea of Galilee. Yochanan walked with Yeshua for over three years, witnessing 1000's of incredible miraculous healings, deliverances, raising of the dead to life, as the Son of God walked throughout Israel, bringing the Message of **His Father's Love** and the Promises of **God's Salvation** and **Eternal Life!**

Yeshua fulfilled these Promises by giving His Sinless Life for us. He revealed God to us as our **personal Father**, who really **Loves us**. His Kingdom, **the Kingdom of Heaven**, is about to come to earth.

“That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. **He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.** He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. **But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name**, who were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

And 'the Word' became Flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His Glory, the Glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of Grace and Truth.

And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. For the Torah was given through Moses, **but Grace and Truth came through Yeshua, the Messiah.** No man has seen God at any time. **The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.”** John 1:9-14,16-18

“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that **the world through Him might be Saved.**”

John 3:16,17

Then Jesus answered and said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner. For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel. For as the Father raises the dead and gives Life to them, even so the Son gives Life to whom He will. For the Father Judges no one, but has committed all Judgment to the Son, that all should honor the Son, just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him. Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My Word and believes in Him who sent Me, has **Everlasting Life**, and shall not come into Judgment, but has passed from Death into **Life**.

Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the Voice of the Son of God; and those who hear will Live. For as the Father has Life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have Life in Himself, and has given Him authority to execute Judgment also, because He is the Son of man. Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His Voice, and come forth; those who have done good to the Resurrection of Life; those who have done evil, to the Resurrection of condemnation. I can of Myself do nothing.

For the works which the Father has given Me to finish, the very works that I do, bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent Me.”

“You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have Eternal Life; and these are they which testify of Me. But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have Life.”

John 5:19-30,36,39,40

And Jesus said to them, **“I Am the Bread of Life!** He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst. This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, **but should raise it up at the last day.** And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have **Everlasting Life;** and **I will raise him up at the last day.**

No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and **I will raise him up at the last day.** It is written in the prophets, ‘And they shall all be taught by God.’ Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me. Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from God; He has seen the Father. Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has Everlasting Life. **“I Am the Bread of Life!”** Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and are dead. This is the Bread which comes down from heaven, that one may eat of it and not die. I am **‘the Living Bread’** which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this Bread, he will Live forever; and the Bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world.” The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, “How can this Man give us His flesh to eat?”

Then Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has Eternal Life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will Live because of Me. This is the Bread which came down from heaven, not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this Bread will Live forever.

It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing.
The Words that I speak to you are ‘Spirit’, and they are Life.”

John 6:35,39,40,44-58,63

On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." But this He spoke concerning **the Spirit**, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet Glorified.

The officers answered, "**No man ever spoke like this Man!**"

John 7:37,38,39,46

Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "**I am the Light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the Light of Life.**"

"You judge according to the flesh; I Judge no one. And yet if I do Judge, My Judgment is true; for I am not alone, but I am with the Father who sent Me. It is also written in your law that the testimony of two men is true. I am One who bears witness of Myself, and the Father who sent Me bears witness of Me." Then they said to Him, "Where is Your Father?" Jesus answered, "You know neither Me nor My Father. **If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also.**"

And He said to them, "You are from beneath; **I am from above.** You are of this world; **I am not of this world.** Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; **for if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins.**"

Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "**If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free.**" They answered Him, "We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How can you say, 'You will be made free'?" Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **whoever commits sin is a slave of sin.** And a slave does not abide in the house forever, **but a son abides forever. Therefore, if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed!**

Most assuredly I say to you, **if anyone keeps My Word, he shall never see death!**" John 8:12,15-19,23-24,31-36,51

Jesus answered, “If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing. **It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your God.** Yet you have not known Him, but I know Him. And if I say, ‘I do not know Him,’ I shall be a liar like you; but I do know Him and keep His Word. Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad.” Then the Jews said to Him, “You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?” Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, **I AM.**”

John 8:54-58

Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him (the blind man whom He healed), “Do you believe in **the Son of God?**” He answered and said, “Who is He, Lord, that I may believe in Him?” And Jesus said to him, “You have both seen Him and it is He who is talking with you.” Then he said, “Lord, I believe!” And he worshiped Him. And Jesus said, “For Judgment I have come into this world, that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind.”

John 9:35-39

Then Jesus said to them again, “Most assuredly, I say to you, ‘I Am the Door of the sheep.’ **I Am the Door.**’ If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. **I have come that they may have Life,** and that they may have it more abundantly.

‘I Am the Good Shepherd!’ The Good Shepherd gives His life for the sheep. I am the Good Shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own. **As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father;** and I lay down My life for the sheep. Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again.

This command I have received from My Father.”

John 10:7-18

Jesus answered them, “I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them Eternal Life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. **I and My Father are One!**”

John 10:25,27-30

Jesus answered them, “Is it not written in your law, ‘I said, “You are gods” ’? “If He called them gods, to whom the word of God came (and the Scripture cannot be broken), do you say of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, ‘You are blaspheming,’ because I said, ‘**I am the Son of God**’? If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that **the Father is in Me, and I in Him.**”

Jesus said to her, “Your brother will rise again.” Martha said to Him, “I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day.” Jesus said to her, “**I Am the Resurrection and the Life!**

He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall Live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?” She said to Him, “Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Messiah, the Son of God, who is to come into the world.”

John 11:23-27

Now a great many of the Jews knew that He was there; and they came, not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might also see Lazarus, whom He had raised from the dead. But the chief priests plotted to put Lazarus to death also, because on account of him many of the Jews went away and believed in Jesus. The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast (Passover), when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, took branches of palm trees

and went out to meet Him, and cried out: **“Hosanna! ‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!’ The King of Israel!”** Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written: “Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your King is coming, sitting on a donkey’s colt.” (quoting from Zechariah 9:9)

He who rejects Me, and does not receive My Words, has that which Judges him, **the Word that I have spoken will Judge him in the last day.** For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak. And I know that His command is Everlasting Life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak.” John 12:47-50

“Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father’s house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.”

Jesus said to him, **“I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life! No one comes to the Father except through Me.”**

Jesus said to him: **“He who has seen Me has seen the Father.** Don’t you believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but **the Father who dwells in Me does the works.** Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves. Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these will he do, because I go to My Father.”

John 14:1-3,6,9,10-12

“A new commandment I give to you, **that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.** By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another.”

John 13:34-35

“**I Am the True Vine**, and My Father is the Vinedresser. Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. You are already clean because of the Word which I have spoken to you. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. **I Am the Vine**, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; **for without Me you can do nothing!** If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love. If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. These things I have spoken to you, that My Joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full.

This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no man than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

You are My friends if you do whatever I command you. No longer do I call you servants... I have called you friends; You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.”

John 15:1-14,15,16

“I came forth from the Father and have come into the world. Again, I leave the world and go to the Father.”

John 16:28

“Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may Glorify You, as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give **Eternal Life** to as many as You have given Him. **And this is Eternal Life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus the Messiah whom You have sent.** I have Glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do. Father, Glorify Me together with Yourself, with the Glory which I had with You before the world was.

And the Glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be One, just as We are One: I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in One, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me. **Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My Glory which You have given Me;** for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.

O Righteous Father, the world has not known You, but I have known You. And these have known that You sent Me. And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it, that the Love with which You Loved Me may be in them, and I in them.”

John 17:1-5,20-26

Jesus answered, “My Kingdom is not of this world. If My Kingdom were of this world, then My servants would fight, so that I should not be delivered to the Jews. But now My Kingdom is not from here.” “Are You a king then?” Jesus answered, “You say rightly that I am a King. APPENDIX II:

TORAH RIGHTS OF GENTILES (STRANGERS, FOREIGNERS AND ALIENS) GIVEN BY GOD IN HIS WORD TO THOSE WHO COME TO LIVE IN ISRAEL!

The following booklet contains a list of quoted Scriptures taken from the Hebrew Holy Scriptures, showing **the Torah rights and mandates** given by GOD from HIS WORD to the **strangers, foreigners and aliens**, who come to live in Israel, to serve, and worship, and obey the One True and Living GOD, the GOD of Israel.

1) Exodus 12:43,44,48,49 [one law] ... 43 And the LORD said to Moses and Aaron: 'This is the regulation of the Passover, any son of a foreigner (נכר) may not eat from it. 44 But any male slave, bought with money, and you have circumcised him, he may eat it. 48 And if a **stranger** (גר) lives with you and he would celebrate the Passover to the LORD, **circumcise** every male, and then he may take part to celebrate, and he will be like those born of the land, but any of the uncircumcised may not eat from it. 49 **The same law applies to the native born** (אזרח) **and to the stranger** (גר) **living among you**.
