Seeking God First is God's Command!

Matthew 6:8 **“For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.** For after all these things the Gentiles seek. 6:32 For your Heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. 6:33 **But Seek first the Kingdom of God and His Righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”** (see Luke 12:30-32)

Hebrews 11:6 But **without faith** it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that **He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him!**

Isaiah 40:31 **But those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength;** They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

Hebrews 10:22-24 **Let us draw near** (to Yeshus) with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled (with His Blood) from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is Faithful. And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together ...

2 Chronicles 26:5 ... and as long as he sought the LORD,
God made him prosper.

James 4:6-8 **God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.**
Therefore submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you.
Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands,
you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

Psalms 34:10 **But those who seek the LORD shall not lack any good thing.**

Jeremiah 29:13, 14 **And you will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart.** I will be found by you, says the LORD ...

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are **sons of God!**
Romans 8:14

Hebrews 7:24 But **He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable Priesthood.** 7:25 Therefore **He (Yeshua) is also able to save to the uttermost** those who come to God through Him, since **He always lives to make intercession for them.**

John 15:13 “**Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.**

1 Thessalonians 5:24 **He who calls you is Faithful,** who also will do it.

Romans 8:28 And we know that **all things work together for good** to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

Revelation 19:11 Now I saw Heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He (Yeshua) who sat on him was called **Faithful and True** ... (also in Revelation 3:14) 19:13 He was clothed with **a robe dipped in Blood, and His name is called The Word of God!** 19:16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written:

KING of Kings and LORD of Lords!

2 Timothy 2:12 If we endure, we shall also reign with Him.
If we deny Him, He also will deny us. 2:13 **If we are faithless,
He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself!**

Amos 5:4 (6) For thus says the LORD to the House of Israel,
“**Seek Me and live!**”

Psalm 27:8, When You said, “**Seek My face!**” My heart said to You,
“**Your face, LORD, I will seek (fellowship)!** 27:9 Do not hide Your
face from me; do not turn Your servant away in anger; You have been
my help; do not leave me nor forsake me, O God of my Salvation!”

[God desires for us to have real fellowship with Him – talk to Him!]

Psalm 27:14 **Wait on the LORD; be of good courage, and He shall
strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the LORD!**

Psalm 62:5 My soul, wait silently for God alone, for my expectation
(hope) is from Him. 62:6 **He only is my Rock and my Salvation;
He is my defense; I shall not be moved.**

Isaiah 64:4 For since the beginning of the world men have not heard
nor perceived by the ear, nor has the eye seen any God besides You,
who acts for the one who waits for Him. 64:5 You meet him who
rejoices and does righteousness, who remembers You in Your ways.

Psalm 25:3 Indeed, let no one who waits on You be ashamed;
25:21 Let integrity and uprightness preserve me, for I wait for You.

Psalm 33:18 Behold, the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him,
on those who hope in His Mercy, 33:19 to deliver their soul from death,
and to keep them alive in famine. 33:20 Our soul waits for the LORD;
He is our help and our Shield. 33:21 For our heart shall rejoice in Him,
because we have trusted in His holy name. 33:22 Let Your Mercy,
be upon us, O LORD, just as we hope in You.

Philippians 3:10 **That I may know Him and the Power of His Resurrection ... and the fellowship of His sufferings**, being conformed to His death ... (John 15:15 “**I (Yeshua) have called you friends!”**)

Psalms 37:7 Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him;
37:9 **But those who wait upon the LORD they shall inherit the earth.**

Isaiah 55:6 Seek the LORD while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near.

Mark 1:35 Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, Yeshua went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.

Luke 5:16 So He Himself often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed. Luke 6:12 Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God ...

Matthew 26:40 Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, “What! Could you not watch with Me one hour?”

Mark 14:37 Then He came and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, “Simon, are you sleeping? Could you not watch one hour?”

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Messiah Jesus for **good works**, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them (giving Yeshua all the Glory).

Isaiah 53:12 Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and **He shall divide the spoil** with the strong. Because **He poured out His soul unto death**, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and He bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Ephesians 4:8 Therefore He says, “When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts to men.”

Revelations 21:7 “**He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God, and he shall be My son!”**

Genesis 49:18 I have waited for Your Salvation, O LORD!

Genesis 1:26, 27 Then God said, “**Let Us make man (Adam) in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.**

[Man was originally made only into God’s image. But it was not until after Yeshua's death, Resurrection and ascension into Heaven that 'born again' believers could begin being made into God's likeness.]

Luke 3:38 ..., the son of Seth, the son of **Adam, the son of God!**

Psalms 8:3-9 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained, what is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him? 8:5 For You have made him **a little lower than Elohim (God)**, and You have crowned him with glory and honor. You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet, all sheep and oxen, even the beasts of the field, the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea that pass through the paths of the seas. O LORD ... how Excellent is Your name in all the earth!

Psalms 24:1 **The earth is the LORD’s and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein**. (Deuteronomy 32:43 ...Atonement would be made by Messiah for God’s people and for God’s land of Israel.)

Luke 10:19 “Behold, **I give you the Authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you**. 10:20 ... **but rather rejoice because your names are written in Heaven!**”

Romans 11:29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

Psalms 37:4 **Delight yourself also in the LORD**, and He shall give you the desires of your heart.

Isaiah 11:1-3 There shall come forth **a Rod** from the stem of Jesse (king David's father), and **a Branch** shall grow out of his roots. **The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him: the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD. His delight is in the fear of the LORD!**

Matthew 11:28-30 **"Come to Me**, all you who labor and are heavy laden, **and I will give you rest**. **Take My yoke upon you** and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and **you will find rest for your souls**. **For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."**

(Read Revelation 3:20 ... Behold, I stand at the Door and knock ...)

Philippians 2:12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling!

Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went home. And in his upper room, with his windows open toward Jerusalem, he knelt down on his knees three times that day, and prayed, (without fear) and gave thanks before his God, as was his custom since early days. [And for this reason he was cast into the den of lions.]

John 5:30 **"I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I Judge; and My Judgment is Righteous**, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of My Father who sent Me."

John 5:44 "How can you believe, who receive honor from one another, **and do not seek the honor that comes from the only God?**"

Luke 18:1 Then He spoke a parable to them, that men ought always to pray and not lose heart ... (see Psalm 86:5, 6)

John 7:18 “He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but **He who seeks the Glory of the One who sent Him** is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him.”

John 15:4, 5, 7 “**Abide in Me (Yeshua), and I in you**. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. **I am the Vine, you are the branches**. **He who abides in Me, and I in him**, bears much fruit; **for without Me you can do nothing!** If you abide in Me, **and My Words abide in you**, you will ask what you desire, **and it shall be done for you!**”

Matthew 4:19 Then He said to them,
“**Follow Me**, and I will make you fishers of men.”

Romans 8:13-16 For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, **these are sons of God**. For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.” The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

1 John 2:15, 16 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone **loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him**. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life is not of the Father, but is of the world.

1 Peter 5:6 Therefore humble yourselves under the Mighty Hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, 5:7 **casting all your care upon Him**, for He cares for you.

John 13:36 Simon Peter said to Him, “Lord, where are You going?” Yeshua answered him, “Where I am going you cannot follow Me now, but **you shall follow Me afterward**.”

1 John 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the Victory that has overcome the world, **our faith!**

John 13:34 “A new Commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. 13:35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

John 14:15 “If you love Me, keep My Commandments.” 14:21 He who has My Commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be Loved by My Father, and I will Love him and manifest Myself to him.” 14:20 “At that Day you will know that I am in My Father, and you (are) in Me, and I (am) in you.” 14:23 Yeshua answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and My Father will Love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him!”

John 15:10 “If you keep My Commandments, you will abide in My Love, just as I have kept My Father’s Commandments and abide in His Love. 15:11 These things I have spoken to you, that My Joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full! 15:12 This is My Commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. 15:13 Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. 15:17 “These things I Command you, that you love one another!”

John 21:17 He said to him the third time, “Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?” Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, “Do you love Me?” And he said to Him, “Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You.” Yeshua said to him, “Feed My sheep!” 21:19 And when He had spoken this, He said to him, “Follow Me.” 21:22 Yeshua said to him, “If I will that he remain until I come, what is that to you? You follow Me!”

John 16:33 “These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have Peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world!”

Nevertheless I have this against you,
that you have left your first love. Revelation 2:4

Isaiah 44:22 “I have blotted out, like a thick cloud, your transgressions, and like a cloud, your sins. **Return to Me, for I have redeemed you.**”

Jeremiah 4:1 “If you will return, O Israel,” says the LORD, “**Return to Me;** and if you will put away your abominations out of My sight, then you shall not be moved.”

Jeremiah 24:7 “Then **I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the LORD;** and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, **for they shall return to Me with their whole heart.**”

Nehemiah 1:9 "... but **if you return to Me, and keep My Commandments and do them** though some of you were cast out to the farthest part of the heavens, yet **I will gather them from there, and bring them to the place (Zion, Jerusalem) which I have chosen** as a dwelling for My name."

Zechariah 1:3 Therefore say to them, ‘Thus says the LORD of hosts, “**Return to Me,**” says the LORD of hosts, “**and I will return to you,**” says the LORD of hosts.’

Malachi 3:7, 8 “Yet from the days of your fathers you have gone away from My ordinances and have not kept them. **Return to Me, and I will return to you,**” says the LORD of hosts. “But you said, ‘In what way shall we return?’ “Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, ‘In what way have we robbed You?’ In tithes and offerings.”

2 Chronicles 7:14 “**If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from Heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.**”

Hosea 5:15 “I will return again to My place (Heaven) until they acknowledge their offense. Then they will seek My face. **In their affliction they will earnestly seek Me.**”

1 Samuel 15:22, 23 So Samuel said, “Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices (works), **as in obeying the Voice of the LORD?** Behold, **to obey is better than sacrifice**, and to heed than the fat of rams. For **rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft**, and **stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry.**”

Jeremiah 9:23 Thus says the LORD: “Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, let not the mighty man glory in his might, nor let the rich man glory in his riches; 9:24 “But let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD, exercising Loving kindness, Judgment, and Righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight,” says the LORD.

Isaiah 45:11 Thus says the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and His Maker, “**Ask of Me of things to come, concerning My sons, and concerning the work of My hands, you command Me!**”

Exodus 15:26 "If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. **For I am the LORD who heals you!**"

Psalms 103:1-4 **Bless the LORD**, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His Holy name! Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits. Who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from destruction, who crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercies, who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Jeremiah 30:17 “For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds,’ says the LORD, ‘Because they called you an outcast saying: “This is Zion; No one seeks her.” ‘

Isaiah 53:1 ... to whom has **the Arm of the LORD** been revealed 53:4 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. 53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and **by His stripes we are healed!**

Proverbs 4:22 For My Words are Life to those who find them,
and health to all their flesh.

Mathew 15:30 Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Yeshua's feet, **and He healed them.** 15:31 So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

Matthew 8:16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a Word, **and healed all who were sick,** 8:17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet (Isaiah 53:4, 5), saying:
“He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.”

1 Peter 2:24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness —
by whose stripes you were healed!

Mark 16:17 “And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 16:18 they will take up servants; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; **they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover!**”

Malachi 4:2 “But to you who fear My name **the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with Healing in His wings;** And you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. 4:3 You shall trample the wicked, for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the Day that I do this,” says the LORD of hosts.

Matthew 9:35 Then Yeshua went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, **and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.**

Proverbs 3:5-10 **Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and depart from evil. It will be health to your flesh, and strength to your bones. Honor the LORD with your possessions, and with the firstfruits of all your increase; so your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine.**

Isaiah 6:9, 10 And He said, “Go, and tell this people, ‘Keep on hearing, but do not understand; keep on seeing, but do not perceive.’ Make the heart of this people dull, and their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, **and return and be healed!**”

Psalms 107:20 **He sent His Word and healed them**, and delivered them from their destructions.

“Speak to all the Congregation of the children of Israel, and say to them, **‘You shall be holy, for I the LORD your God am Holy!’**”
Leviticus 19:2

1 Corinthians 3:17 If anyone defiles the Temple of God, God will destroy him. For the Temple of God is Holy, **which Temple you are.**

1 Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that **your body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you**, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

2 Corinthians 6:16 ... **for you are the Temple of the Living God!**

John 14:10 “Do you not believe that I am in My Father, and My Father (is) in Me? The Words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own Authority; but My Father who dwells in Me does the works.”

Habakkuk 2:2-4 Then the LORD answered me and said “**Write the vision** and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, **wait for it**; because **it will surely come, it will not tarry!**” “ ... but **the just shall live by his faith.**”

Deuteronomy 18:15 “The LORD your God will raise up for you **a Prophet like me** (Moses) from your midst, from your brethren. Him you shall hear, 18:18 I will raise up for them **a Prophet like you** from among their brethren, and I will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I Command Him. 18:19 And it shall be that **whoever will not hear My Words, which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him!**”

Daniel 10:11, 12 And He said to me, “O Daniel, **man greatly beloved**, understand the Words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for I have now been sent to you.” While He was speaking this Word to me, I stood trembling. Then He said to me, “Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard; and I have come because of your words.” 10:19 And He said, “**O man greatly beloved, fear not!** Peace be to you; **be Strong, yes, be Strong!**” So when He spoke to me I was strengthened, and said, “Let my Lord speak, for You have strengthened me.”

Ephesian 3:14 For this reason I bow my knees to **the Father of our Lord Messiah Yeshua**, 3:15 from whom the whole family in Heaven and earth is named, 3:16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory **to be strengthened with Might through His Spirit in the inner man**, 3:17 that the Messiah may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, 3:18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height, 3:19 **to know the Love of Messiah which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.**

Luke 10:42 “But one thing is needed, and Miriam has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her.”

Luke 17:20, 21 “The Kingdom of God does not come with observation ... nor will they say, ‘See here!’ or ‘See there!’

For indeed **the Kingdom of God is within you!**”

Matthew 6:21 For where **your treasure is**, there your heart will be also. (also in Luke 12:34)

Deuteronomy 33:3 Yes, **He Loves the people**; all His saints are in Your hand; they sit down at Your feet; everyone receives Your Words.

Joshua 1:5 “No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. 1:6 Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. 1:7 Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the Torah which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.”

(This Scripture is also found in Deuteronomy 1:6)

Hebrews 13:5 For He Himself has said, "**I will never leave you nor forsake you.**"

Matthew 28:18 And Yeshua came and spoke to them, saying, "**All Authority** has been given to Me in Heaven and on earth. 28:19 **Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 28:20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, **I am with you always**, even to the end of the Age." Amen.

Psalms 136:1 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, **for He is Good, for His Mercy endures forever!**

Colossians 1:17 **And He (Yeshua) is before all things, and in Him all things consist.** 1:18 **And He is the Head of the Body, the Church ...**

Isaiah 42:9 “Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things I declare; before they spring forth I tell you of them.”

Psalms 100:4 Enter into His gates with Thanksgiving, and into His courts with Praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.
100:5 **For the LORD is Good; His Mercy is Everlasting, and His Truth endures to all generations.**

Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to Glory, to **make the Captain of their Salvation Perfect through sufferings.**

Romans 8:29, 30 For whom He foreknew, **He also predestined** to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the Glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

John 17:11 “Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. **Holy Father**, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, **that they may be One as We are.** 17:15 I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. 17:21 that they all may be One, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; **that they also may be One in Us,** that the world may believe that You sent Me. 17:22 And **the Glory** which You gave Me I have given them, **that they may be One, just as We are One.** 17:23 I in them, and You in Me; **that they may be made Perfect in One,** and that the world may know that You have sent Me, **and have Loved them as You have Loved Me.**”

John 15:14 “**You are My friends, if you do whatever I Command you.**
15:15 No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; **but I have called you friends, for all things heard from My Father I have made known to you.**”

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all like an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags;

Romans 7:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells;

Philippians 1:6 ...being confident of this very thing, that **He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the Day of Yeshua the Messiah;**

Psalm 138:8 **The LORD will perfect that which concerns me;**

Amos 3:7 Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

2 Chronicles 20:20 Jehoshaphat stood and said, “Hear me, O Judah, and you inhabitants of Jerusalem. **Believe in the LORD your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper.**”

Isaiah 44:26 “ ‘... who confirms the word of His servant, and performs the counsel of His messengers;’ ”

1 Samuel 3:19 So Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground.

Psalm 105:19 Until the time that His Word came to pass, the Word of the LORD tested him (Joseph).

Jeremiah 1:12 Then the LORD said to me, “You have seen well, **for I am ready to perform My Word (for I am watching over My Word to perform it).**”

John 3:30 “**He must Increase, but I must decrease.**”

John 8:29 “And He who sent Me is with Me. My Father has not left Me alone, **for I always do those things that please Him!**”

Luke 22:42 "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless **not My will, but Yours, be done!**" (in Matthew 26:39)

Mark 14:36 And He said, "**Abba, Father, all things are possible for You. Take this cup away from Me; nevertheless, not what I will, but what You will!**"

John 3:11-13 “Most assuredly, I say to you, **We speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive Our witness.** If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things? No one has ascended to Heaven but **He who came down from Heaven, that is, the Son of Man who is in Heaven!**”

John 5:19 Then Yeshua answered and said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, **the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.** 5:20 For the Father loves the Son, **and shows Him all things that He Himself does;** and He will show Him **Greater works** than these, that you may marvel.”

John 5:36, 37 “But I have a greater witness than John’s; **for the works which My Father has given Me to finish, the very works that I do, bear witness of Me, that My Father has sent Me.** And My Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His Voice at any time, nor seen His form.”

Mark 4:24 Then He said to them, “Take heed what you hear. With the same measure you use, it will be measured to you; **and to you who hear, more will be given.**” (also see Mark 7:16)

Hebrews 6:1, 2 **Therefore, let us go on to perfection ... [Love!]**

Proverbs 16:9 A man's heart plans his way, but the LORD directs his steps.

Psalms 119:105 **Your Word is a lamp to my feet** and a light to my path.

1 John 1:7-9 But if we walk in the light **as He is in the Light**, we have fellowship with one another, and **the Blood of Yeshua the Messiah His Son cleanses us from all sin.** If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the Truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is Faithful and Just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 6:22 "The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light."

Psalms 16:11 You will show me the Path of Life; In Your Presence is fullness of Joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

John 10:3-5, 7-11, 14-17, 24-31, 33-38 "**To Him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear His Voice; and He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.** And when he brings out His own sheep, He goes before them; and the sheep follow Him, for they know His Voice. Yet they will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers." Then Yeshua said to them again, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **I am the Door of the sheep!** All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them. **I am the Door!** If anyone enters by Me, he will be Saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have Life, and that they may have it more abundantly. **I am the Good Shepherd!** **The Good Shepherd gives His life for the sheep. I am the Good Shepherd;** and I know My sheep, and am known by My own. As My Father knows Me, even so I know My Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them

also I must bring, and they will hear My Voice; and there will be one flock and one Shepherd. Therefore My Father Loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again.” Then the Jews surrounded Him and said to Him, “How long do You keep us in doubt? If You are the Messiah, tell us plainly.” Jesus answered them, “I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father’s name, they bear witness of Me. But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. **My sheep hear My Voice**, and I know them, and they follow Me. **And I give them Eternal Life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand!** My Father, who has given them to Me, is Greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father’s hand! **I and My Father are One!**” Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. The Jews answered Him, saying, “For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God.” Yeshua answered them, “Is it not written in your Torah, ‘I said, “**You are god’s?**” ’ (Psalm 82:6) “If He called them gods, to whom the Word of God came (and the Scripture cannot be broken), do you say of Him whom My Father sanctified and sent into the world, ‘You are blaspheming,’ because I said, ‘**I am the Son of God?**’ If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; **but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works**, that you may know and believe **that My Father is in Me, and I in Him!**”

Psalm 91:1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 91:2 I will say of the LORD, “**He is my Refuge and my Fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.**” 91:3 Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence. 91:4 He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His Truth shall be your shield and buckler. 91:14 “Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.” 91:15 He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. With long life I will satisfy him and show him My Salvation.”

Exodus 33:15 Then he (Moses) said to Him, “If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here.”

Daniel 2:28 “But there is a God in Heaven who reveals secrets, He has made known ...”

Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind (with the Word of God), that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Proverbs 18:21 **Death and life** are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

Hebrews 4:16 **Let us therefore come boldly to the Throne of Grace, that we may obtain Mercy and find Grace to help in time of need.**

1 John 2:20 But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things.

Proverbs 18:22 He who finds **a wife** finds a good thing, and obtains favor from the LORD.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but **(a Spirit) of power and of love and of a sound** (disciplined) mind.

Psalms 127:2 For so **He (the LORD) gives His beloved sleep.**

Psalms 4:8 **I will both lie down in peace, and sleep;** For You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety.

Proverbs 3:24 When you lie down, you will not be afraid; Yes, you will lie down and your sleep will be sweet.

Isaiah 26:3 **You will keep him in perfect Peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.**

John 14:27 “**Peace I leave with you, My Peace I give to you**; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.”

Philippians 4:6 **Be anxious for nothing**, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 4:7 And **the Peace of God**, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Messiah Yeshua.

Psalms 119:165 **Great peace** have those who love Your Torah, and nothing causes them to stumble.

1 John 4:4 **You are of God, little children**, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is Greater than he who is in the world. 4:7 Beloved, let us love one another, **for love is of God**; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. 4:8 He who does not love does not know God, for **God is Love**. 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. **God is Love**, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him. 4:17 Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the Day of Judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. 4:18 There is no fear in love; **but Perfect Love casts out fear**, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

2nd Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, **but (a Spirit) of Power and of love and of a sound mind!**

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus the Messiah, who according to His abundant Mercy has begotten us again to a Living hope through the Resurrection of Messiah Yeshua from the dead, 1:4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in Heaven for you,

Romans 8:17 and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and joint heirs with Messiah, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

Ephesians 1:5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Yeshua the Messiah to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 1:6 to the praise of the glory of His Grace, by which **He made us accepted in the Beloved**. 1:17 that the God of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah, **the Father of Glory**, may give to you the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the knowledge of Him ...

Psalm 27:1 **The LORD is my Light and my Salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the Strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?**

Psalm 121:7 **The LORD shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul.** 121:8 The LORD shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore.

Isaiah 52:12 For you shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight; **For the LORD will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard.**

Isaiah 62:6 I have set watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they shall never hold their peace day or night. You who make mention of the LORD, do not keep silent, 62:7 and give Him no rest until He establishes and until He makes **Jerusalem a Praise in the earth!**

Hebrews 12:1 Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, 12:2 looking unto Yeshua, the Author and Finisher of our faith, who for the Joy that was set before Him endured the Cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the Throne of God.

Galatians 2:20 **I have been crucified with Messiah; it is no longer I who live, but the Messiah lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith (the faith of) in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.**

Malachi 3:6 "**For I am the LORD, I do not change**; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob.

Yeshua the Messiah is the same yesterday, today, and forever!
Hebrews 13:8

For if anyone thinks himself to be something,
when he is nothing, he deceives himself (pride). Galatians 6:3

1 Corinthians 8:1 Now concerning things offered to idols: We know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, but love edifies. 8:2 **And if anyone thinks that he knows anything, he knows nothing yet as he ought to know.** 8:3 But if anyone loves God, this one is known by Him.

Isaiah 30:15 For thus says the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel: "In returning and rest shall you shall be Saved; In quietness and confidence shall be your strength."

Deuteronomy 7:9 "Therefore know that the LORD your God, He is God, **the Faithful God who keeps Covenant and Mercy for a thousand generations** with those who love Him and keep His Commandments;

Galatians 4:6 And because you are sons, God has sent forth **the Spirit of His Son** into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!"

Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 5:23 gentleness, self control. Against such there is no law.

Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. 51:11 Do not cast me away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. 51:12 Restore to me **the Joy of Your Salvation**, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit. 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, a broken and a contrite heart —

Exodus 20:8 “Remember the Sabbath day, **to keep it holy!**”

Matthew 7:7 "**Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.** 7:8 **For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.**”

John 14:13 “**And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do,** that My Father may be glorified in the Son. 14:14 **If you ask anything in My name, I will do it!**”

John 15:7 “If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, **you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you!**”

John 15:16 “You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that **whatever you ask My Father in My name He may give you!**”

John 16:23 “And in that Day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, **whatever you ask My Father in My name He will give you.** 16:24 Until now you have asked nothing in My name. **Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full!**”

1 John 3:22 **And whatever we ask we receive from Him,** because we keep His Commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. 3:23 And this is His Commandment: **that we should believe on the name of His Son Yeshua the Messiah and love one another,** as He gave us Commandment.

1 John 5:14 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, **that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.** 5:15 **And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him!**

Mark 10:27 But Yeshua looked at them and said, “With men it is impossible, but not with God; **for with God all things are possible!**”

Jeremiah 32:17 “ ‘Ah, Lord GOD! ... There is nothing too hard for You.
32:27 “**Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh.**
Is there anything too hard for Me?”

Matthew 19:26 But Yeshua looked at them and said to them,
"With men this is impossible, **but with God all things are possible!**"

Mark 9:23 Yeshua said to him, “If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes!”

Ezekiel 43:7 And He said to me, “Son of man, **this is the place of My Throne and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever!**

Psalms 132:13 **For the LORD has chosen Zion**; He has desired it for His dwelling place: 132:14 "**This is My resting place forever; Here I will dwell**, for I have desired it.

Psalms 68:16 **This is the Mountain (Zion) which God desires to dwell in; Yes, the LORD will dwell in it forever!**

Isaiah 24:23 Then the moon will be disgraced and the sun ashamed; For the LORD of hosts **will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem** and before His elders, Gloriously.

Isaiah 27:13 So it shall be in that Day **the Great Trumpet (Shofar) will be blown**; They will come, who are about to perish in the land of Assyria, and they who are outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the Holy Mount (Zion) at Jerusalem.

Genesis 18:25 “**Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?**”

Zechariah 2:5 “ ‘For I' says the LORD, ' will be a wall of fire all around her, **and I will be the Glory in her midst!**’ “

John 15:10 “If you keep My Commandments, you will abide in My Love, just as I have kept My Father's Commandments and abide in His Love. 15:11 “These things I have spoken to you, that My Joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full. 15:15 No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.”

John 14:16 And I will pray to My Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever 14:17 the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. 14:18 I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. 14:26 “But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom My Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you. 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My Peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.” (also John 14:27 is on page 21)

John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the Truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. 16:13 “However, when He, the Spirit of Truth, has come, He will guide you into all Truth; for He will not speak on His own Authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. 16:14 He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. 16:15 All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you.”

Psalms 105:7 He is the LORD our God; His Judgments are in all the earth. 105:8 He remembers His Covenant forever, the Word which He Commanded, for a thousand generations, 105:9 The Covenant which He made with Abraham, and His oath to Isaac, 105:10 And confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, to Israel as an Everlasting Covenant, 105:11 saying, “To you I will give the land of Canaan as the allotment of your inheritance,”

Joshua 5:13 And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, **a Man** stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, "Are You for us or for our adversaries?" 5:14 So He said, "**No, but as Commander of the Army of the LORD I have now come.**" And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped, and said to Him, "What does my Lord say to His servant?"

Nehemiah 8:10 Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; **for this day is Holy to our LORD. Do not sorrow, for the Joy of the LORD is your Strength!**"

Daniel 7:13 "I was watching in the night visions, and behold, **One like the Son of Man**, coming with the clouds of Heaven! He came to **the Ancient of Days**, And they brought Him near before Him. 7:14 Then to Him was given Dominion and Glory and a Kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. **His Dominion is an Everlasting Dominion, which shall not pass away, and His Kingdom the One which shall not be destroyed."**

Isaiah 55:11 So shall **My Word be that goes forth from My mouth;** It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it. 55:12 "**For you shall go out with Joy, and be led out with Peace;** The mountains and the hills shall break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

Isaiah 43:18 "Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old. 43:19 "Behold, **I will do a new thing!** Now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert."

John 3:7 "Do not marvel that I said to you, '**You must be born again.**' "

Isaiah 61:1 “**The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me**, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted, **to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound**; 61:2 to proclaim the acceptable Year of the LORD, and the Day of Vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, 61:3 to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of Righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified.”

Luke 4:18 “**The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me**, because He has anointed Me **to preach the Gospel to the poor**, He has sent Me **to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed**. 4:19 to proclaim the acceptable Year of the LORD.”

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Yeshua of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, **who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil**, for God was with Him.

1 John 3:8 **For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.**

Isaiah 35:10 And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with singing, **with Everlasting Joy on their heads**. They shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

John 1:12 **But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God**, to those who believe in His name: 1:13 **who were born**, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. 1:14 **And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His Glory, the Glory as of the only Begotten of the Father, full of Grace and Truth.**

Romans 4:17 ... **God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did**;

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.” 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit **that we are children of God ...**

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, **thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.**

Matthew 5:6 **“Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.”**

Psalms 34:4 I sought the LORD, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

Hebrews 4:12 **For the Word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.**

John 8:31 Then Yeshua said to those Jews who believed Him, **“If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. 8:32 And you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free!”**

John 8:12 Then Yeshua spoke to them again, saying, **“I am the Light of the world! He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the Light of Life!”**

Romans 8:37 Yet in all these things **we are more than conquerors through Him who Loved us.** 8:38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, 8:39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, **shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Messiah Yeshua our Lord.**

1 Corinthians 2:16 **But we have the Mind of Christ!**

Philippians 2:3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind **let each esteem others better than himself.**
2:4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. 2:5 Let this Mind be in you which was also in Messiah Yeshua, 2:6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 2:7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
2:8 And being found in appearance as a Man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the Cross.
2:9 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, 2:10 **that at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, of those in Heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth,** 2:11 **and that every tongue should confess that Yeshua the Messiah is Lord,** to the Glory of God the Father. 2:14 Do all things without complaining and disputing, 2:15 that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, 2:16 holding fast the Word of Life, so that I may rejoice in the Day of Messiah that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

Isaiah 60:1 **Arise, shine; for your light has come! And the Glory of the LORD is risen upon you.** 60:2 For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; But the LORD will arise over you, and His Glory will be seen upon you.

Daniel 11:33 And those of the people who understand shall instruct many. 11:35 And some of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify them, and make them white, until the time of the end; because it is still for the appointed time.

Daniel 12:3 Those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, and those who turn many to Righteousness (Yeshua) like the stars forever and ever.

So then **faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.**
Romans 10:17

Matthew 17:19 Then the disciples came to Yeshua privately and said, “Why could we not cast it out?” 17:20 So Yeshua said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, **if you have faith as a mustard seed**, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. 17:21 However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.”

Mark 11:22 So Yeshua answered and said to them, “**Have faith in God!** 11:23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. 11:24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, **believe that you receive them, and you will have them.**”

Luke 17:5 And the apostles said to the Lord, “**Increase our faith.**” 17:6 So the Lord said, “**If you have faith as a mustard seed**, you can say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you.”

Ephesians 3:20 Now to Him who is able **to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think**, according to the Power that works in us, 3:21 **to Him be Glory in the Church by Messiah Yeshua** to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Jeremiah 32:39 “ ‘**I will give them one heart and one Way, that they may fear Me forever**, for the good of them and their children after them. 32:40 And I will make an Everlasting Covenant with them, that I will not turn away from doing them Good; but I will put My fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from Me. 32:41 Yes, **I will rejoice over them to do them Good**, and I will assuredly plant them in this land (Israel), with all My heart and with all My soul.’ ”

For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the Glory of God ... 2 Corinthians 1:20

Mark 10:18 So Yeshua said to him, "Why do you call Me good?
No one is good but One, that is, God!"

Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good and necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the Day of Redemption. 4:31 Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. 4:32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Messiah forgave you.

Psalms 23:6 Surely **Goodness and Mercy** shall follow me all the days of my life; And I will dwell in the House of the LORD forever!

Matthew 15:13 But He (Yeshua) answered and said, "**Every plant which My Heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted.**"

Psalms 27:4 One thing I have desired of the LORD, that will I seek: **that I may dwell in the House of the LORD all the days of my life**, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in His Temple. 27:5 For in the time of trouble **He shall hide me** in His Pavilion; in the secret place of His Tabernacle **He shall hide me**; He shall set me high upon a rock. 27:6 And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; Therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy in His Tabernacle; **I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the LORD.**

2 Samuel 5:20 So David went to Baal Perazim, and David defeated them there; and he said, "The LORD has broken through my enemies before me, like a breakthrough of water." Therefore he called the name of that place Baal Perazim. (also 1 Chronicles 14:11)

1 Corinthians 13:1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, **but have not love**, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. 13:2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, **but have not love, I am nothing!** 13:3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, **but have not love, it profits me nothing.** 13:4 Love suffers long (is patient) and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; 13:5 does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, (is not controlling) is not provoked, thinks no evil; 13:6 does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; 13:7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 13:8 **Love never fails!**

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, **be strong in the Lord and in the Power of His Might.** 6:11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 6:13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 6:14 **Stand** therefore, having girded your waist with Truth, having put on the breastplate of Righteousness, 6:15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the Gospel of Peace; 6:16 above all, taking the Shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 6:17 And take the helmet of Salvation, and the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God; 6:18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance & supplication for all the saints—

Isaiah 65:13 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, **My servants shall eat ... Behold, My servants shall drink ... Behold, My servants shall Rejoice ...** 65:14 Behold, **My servants shall sing for Joy of heart ...** 65:18 But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; For behold, I create Jerusalem as a Rejoicing, and her people a joy. 65:19 **I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and Joy in My people;** The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, Nor the voice of crying.

Psalms 22:3 **But You are Holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel.**

Psalm 23:1 **The LORD is my Shepherd; I shall not want!** 23:3 **He restores my soul;** 23:6 Surely **Goodness and Mercy shall follow me all the days of my life;** And I will dwell in the House of the LORD forever!

Revelation 12:11 **And they overcame him by the Blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death!**

Matthew 7:1 "**Judge not, that you be not judged.** 7:2 **For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you.** 7:3 And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye? 7:4 Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me remove the speck from your eye'; and look, a plank is in your own eye?

Matthew 22:36 “Teacher, which is the Great Commandment in the Torah?” 22:37 Yeshua said to him, “**You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.**” 22:38 This is the first and great Commandment. 22:39 And the second is like it: “**You shall love your neighbor as yourself.**” 22:40 On these two Commandments hang all the Torah and the prophets.”

And His Greatness is unsearchable.

John 12:25 “He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for **Eternal Life.** 12:26 If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, **him My Father will honor.**”

Song of Solomon 6:3 **I am my Beloved's, and my Beloved is mine.**

Proverbs 8:17 I love those who love Me, and those who seek Me diligently **will find Me.**

Psalm 46:1 **God is our Refuge and Strength**, a very present help in trouble. 46:2 Therefore we will not fear, even though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; 46:4 There is a river whose streams shall make glad the city of God, the Holy Place of the Tabernacle of the Most High. 46:7 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our Refuge. Selah 46:9 He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear in two; He burns the chariot in the fire. 46:10 **Be still, and know that I am God**; I will be exalted among the nations, **I will be exalted in the earth!** 46:11 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our Refuge.

Exodus 20:5 **For I, the LORD your God, am a Jealous God**, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, 20:6 but **showing Mercy** to thousands, **to those who love Me and keep My Commandments!**

Isaiah 40:3 The voice of one crying in the wilderness: “**Prepare the Way of the LORD**; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. 40:4 Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; The crooked places shall be made straight and the rough places smooth; 40:5 **The Glory of the LORD shall be revealed**, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the LORD has spoken.”

John 14:12 “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; **and Greater Works than these he will do**, because I go to My Father.”

Psalm 149:5 **Let the saints be joyful in glory;** Let them sing aloud on their beds. 149:6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand, 149:7 to execute Vengeance on the nations, and punishments on the peoples; 149:8 To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron; 149:9 To execute on them the written judgment — this honor have all His saints. Praise the LORD!

Revelation 3:18 I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.

Revelation 3:20 “Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice **and opens the door,** I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.”

Revelation 4:8 “**Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!**” 4:11 “**You are Worthy, O Lord, to receive Glory and Honor and Power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created.**”

Revelation 5:5 But one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep. Behold, **the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David,** has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals." Rev 5:6 And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the Throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb** as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth. 5:11 Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the Throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and

the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, 5:12 saying with a loud voice: “**Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive Power and Riches and Wisdom, and Strength and Honor and Glory and Blessing!**” 5:13 And every creature which is in Heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: “**Blessing and Honor and Glory and Power be to Him who sits on the Throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!**”

Revelation 7:9 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the Throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, 7:10 and crying out with a loud voice, saying, :Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the Throne, and to the Lamb!” 7:11 All the angels stood around the Throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the Throne and worshiped God, 7:12 saying: “Amen! Blessing and Glory and Wisdom, Thanksgiving and Honor and Power and Might, be to our God forever and ever. Amen.” 7:13 Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, “Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?” 7:14 And I said to him, “Sir, you know.” So he said to me, “**These are the ones who come out of the Great Tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the Blood of the Lamb.**”

Revelation 17:14 “**The Lamb will Overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful.**”

Revelation 19:1 After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in Heaven, saying, “Alleluia! **Salvation and Glory and Honor and Power belong to the Lord our God!**”

Revelation 21:4 And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes, There shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away." 21:5 Then He who sat on the Throne said, "**Behold, I make all things new.**" And He said to me, "Write, for these Words are True and Faithful." 21:6 And He said to me, "**It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of Life freely to him who thirsts.**"

Exodus 23:31 "And I will set your bounds from the Red Sea to the sea, Philistia, and from the desert to the River. For I will deliver the inhabitants of the land into your hand, and you shall drive them out before you. 23:32 **You shall make no covenant with them,** nor with their gods. 23:33 They shall not dwell in your land, lest they make you sin against Me. For if you serve their gods, it will surely be a snare to you."

Deuteronomy 7:1 "When the LORD your God brings you into the land which you go to possess, and has cast out many nations before you, the Hittites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Canaanites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than you, 7:2 and when the LORD your God delivers them over to you, you shall conquer them and utterly destroy them. **You shall make no covenant with them nor show mercy to them.** 7:6 "For you are a holy people to the LORD your God; the LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the face of the earth. 7:7 The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples; 7:8 but because the LORD loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the LORD has brought you out with a Mighty Hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt."

Leviticus 25:23 “**The land (all of Israel including Gaza)** shall not be sold permanently, **for the land is Mine**; for you are strangers and sojourners with Me.”

Habakkuk 3:2 O LORD, ... revive Your work in the midst of the years!
In the midst of the years make it known; **in Wrath remember Mercy!**

Jeremiah 46:28 “Do not fear, O Jacob My servant,” says the LORD,
“For I am with you; **For I will make a complete end of all the nations to which I have driven you**, but I will not make a complete end of you.
I will rightly correct you, for I will not leave you wholly unpunished.”

2nd Corinthians 10:4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal
but Mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 10:5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

James 1:2 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,
1:3 knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. 1:4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

James 1:19 So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath;

Psalms 34:1 I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Philippians 4:4 **Rejoice in the Lord always.** Again I will say, rejoice!

Psalms 118:24 **This is the day the LORD has made;** We will rejoice and be glad in it!

Hosea 4:6 “My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the Torah of your God, I also will forget your children.”

Daniel 6:25 Then King Darius wrote: “To all peoples, nations, and languages that dwell in all the earth: Peace be multiplied to you.
6:26 I make a decree that in every dominion of my kingdom men must tremble and fear before the God of Daniel (the God of Israel). For He is the Living God, and steadfast forever; His Kingdom is the one which shall not be destroyed, and His dominion shall endure to the end. 6:27 He delivers and rescues, and He works signs and wonders in Heaven and on earth, who has delivered Daniel from the power of the lions.”

Psalms 99:1 The LORD Reigns; let the peoples tremble! He dwells between the cherubim; Let the earth be moved! 99:2 **The LORD is great in Zion**, and He is high above all the peoples. 99:3 Let them praise Your Great and Awesome name— **He is Holy!** 99:5 Exalt the LORD our God, and worship at His footstool— **He is Holy!**

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, **not willing that any should perish** but that all should come to repentance.

1 Corinthians 14:26 How is it then, brethren? Whenever you come together, each of you has a psalm, has a teaching, has a tongue, has a revelation, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.

1 Peter 3:7 Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

1st Timothy 1:17 **Now to the King Eternal, Immortal, Invisible,** to God who alone is Wise, be Honor and Glory forever and ever! Amen.
