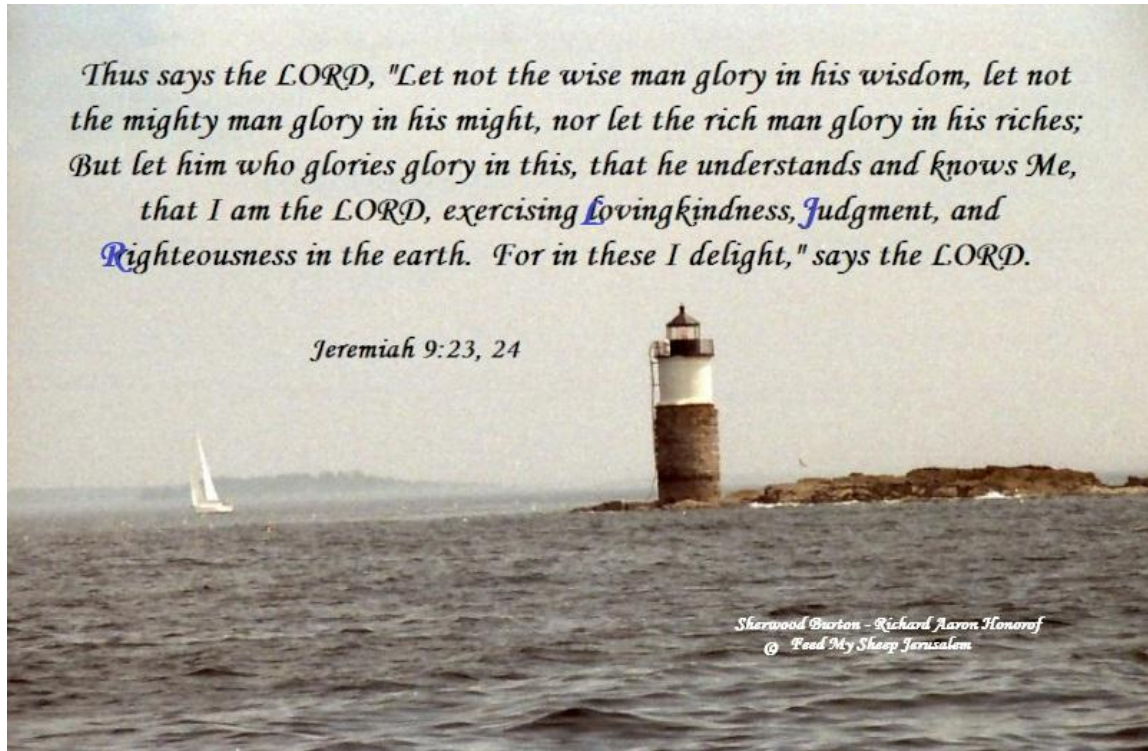

Matthew 6:8 **“For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.** For after all these things the Gentiles seek. 6:32 For your Heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. 6:33 **But Seek first the Kingdom of God and His Righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”** (also Luke 12:30-32, page 47)

Hebrews 11:6 But **without faith it is impossible to please Him,** for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him!

Isaiah 40:31 **But those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength;** They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint. (also see Isaiah 40:29)

Hebrews 10:22-24 **Let us draw near (to Yeshua)** with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled (with His Blood) from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is Faithful! And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together;

says the LORD ...

Romans 8:14

Hebrews 7:24 But **He (Yeshua), because He continues forever,**
has an unchangeable Priesthood. 7:25 Therefore **He is also able to save**
(heal) to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since
He always lives to make intercession for them. (see Romans 8:32, 34)

John 15:13 “**Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down**
one’s life for his friends.”

1 Thessalonians 5:24 **He who calls you is Faithful, who also will do it.**

Romans 8:28 And we know that **all things work together for good**
to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His
purpose. (also see Jeremiah 29:11)

Revelation 19:11 Now I saw Heaven opened, and behold, a white horse.
And He (Yeshua) who sat on him was called **Faithful and True** ... (also
in Revelation 3:14) 19:13 He was clothed with **a robe dipped in Blood,**
and His name is called The Word of God! 19:16 And **He has on His**
robe and on His thigh a name written:

KING of Kings and LORD of Lords!

2 Timothy 2:12 If we endure, we shall also reign with Him.
If we deny Him, He also will deny us. 2:13 **If we are faithless,
He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself!**

Amos 5:4 (6) For **thus says the LORD to the House of Israel,**
“Seek Me and live!”

Psalms 27:8 When You said, “**Seek My face!**” My heart said to You,
“Your face, LORD, I will seek (fellowship)!” 27:9 Do not hide Your
face from me; do not turn Your servant away in anger; You have been
my help; do not leave me nor forsake me, **O God of my Salvation!**
[God desires for us to have real fellowship with Him – talk with Him!]

Psalms 27:14 **Wait on the LORD**; be of good courage, and He shall
strengthen your heart; **Wait, I say, on the LORD!**

Psalms 62:5 My soul, wait silently for God alone, for my expectation
(hope) is from Him. 62:6 **He only is my Rock and my Salvation;**
He is my defense; I shall not be moved.

Isaiah 64:4 For since the beginning of the world men have not heard
nor perceived by the ear, nor has the eye seen any God besides You,
who acts for the one who waits for Him. 64:5 You meet him who
rejoices and does righteousness, who remembers You in Your ways.

Psalms 25:3 Indeed, **let no one who waits on You be ashamed**;
25:21 Let integrity and uprightness preserve me, for I wait for You.

Psalms 33:18 Behold, the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him,
on those who hope in His Mercy, 33:19 to deliver their soul from death,
and to keep them alive in famine. 33:20 Our soul waits for the LORD;
He is our help and our Shield. 33:21 For our heart shall rejoice in Him,
because we have trusted in His holy name. 33:22 Let Your Mercy,
be upon us, O LORD, just as we hope in You.

Genesis 49:18 I have waited for Your Salvation, O LORD!

Philippians 3:10 **That I may know Him and the Power of His Resurrection ... and the fellowship of His sufferings**, being conformed to His death ... [John 15:15 “**I have called you friends!**” on page 16]

Psalms 37:7 Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him;
37:9 **But those who wait upon the LORD they shall inherit the earth.**

Isaiah 55:6 Seek the LORD while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near.

Mark 1:35 Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, Yeshua went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.

Luke 5:16 So He Himself often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed. Luke 6:12 Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God ...

Matthew 26:40 Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, “What! Could you not watch with Me one hour?”

Mark 14:37 Then He came and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, “Simon, are you sleeping? Could you not watch one hour?”

Isaiah 53:12 Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and **He shall divide the spoil with the strong**. Because **He poured out His soul unto death**, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and **He bore the sin of many**, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Messiah Yeshua **for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them** (and give Yeshua all the Glory).

Ephesians 4:8 Therefore He says, “When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts to men.” 4:11 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 4:12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Messiah, till we all come to the unity of the faith. [Read 1st Corinthians 12, about our spiritual gifts; from verses 4-12, and especially 28, similar to Ephesians 4:11; Also read Romans 12:3-21;]

Revelations 21:7 “**He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God, and he shall be My son!”**

Genesis 1:26, 27 Then God said, “**Let Us make man (Adam) in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.”**

[Man was originally made only into God’s image. But it was not until after Yeshua's death, Resurrection and ascension into Heaven that ‘born again’ believers could begin being made into God’s likeness.]

Luke 3:38 ... the son of Seth, the son of **Adam, the son of God!**

Psalm 8:3-9 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained, what is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him? 8:5 For You have made him **a little lower than Elohim (God)**, and You have crowned him with glory and honor. You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet, all sheep and oxen, even the beasts of the field, the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea that pass through the paths of the seas. **O LORD ... how Excellent is Your name in all the earth!**

Psalm 24:1 **The earth is the LORD’s and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein**. (Deuteronomy 32:43 ... Atonement would be made by Messiah for both God’s people and God’s land of Israel.)

2nd Corinthians 5:20 Now then, **we are ambassadors for Messiah** ...

Luke 10:19 “Behold, I give you **the Authority** to trample on serpents and scorpions, and **over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you**. 10:20 ... **but rather rejoice because your names are written in Heaven!**” (We are victors, not the victims!)

Romans 11:29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

Psalm 37:4 **Delight yourself also in the LORD**, and He shall give you the desires of your heart.

Isaiah 11:1-3 There shall come forth **a Rod** from the stem of Jesse (king David's father), and **a Branch** shall grow out of his roots. **The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him (Yeshua): the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.**
His delight is in the fear of the LORD!

Matthew 11:28-30 “**Come to Me**, all you who labor and are heavy laden, **and I will give you rest**. **Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me**, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and **you will find rest for your souls**. **For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.**”

Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went home. And in his upper room, with his windows open toward Jerusalem, he knelt down on his knees three times that day, and prayed, (without fear) and gave thanks before his God, as was his custom since early days. [And for this reason he was cast into the den of lions.]

Daniel 12:3 Those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, **and those who turn many to Righteousness (to Yeshua) like the stars forever and ever.**

John 5:22 “**For My Father judges no one**, but has committed **all Judgment to the Son ... 5:30 I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I Judge; and My Judgment is Righteous**, because I do not seek My own will, **but the will of My Father who sent Me.**”

John 5:44 “How can you believe, who receive honor from one another, and do not seek the honor that comes from the only God?”

Luke 18:1 Then He spoke a parable to them, that men ought always to pray and not lose heart ... (see Psalm 86:5-7)

John 7:18 “He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but **He who seeks the Glory of the One who sent Him** is true, **and no unrighteousness is in Him.**”

John 15:4, 5, 7 “**Abide in Me (Yeshua), and I in you**. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me! **I am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing!** **If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you!**”

Matthew 4:19 He said to them, “**Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.**”
(also found in Mark 1:17)

John 13:36 Simon Peter said to Him, “Lord, where are You going?”
Yeshua answered him, “Where I am going you cannot follow Me now, but you shall follow Me afterward.”

1 John 2:15, 16 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life is not of the Father, but is of the world.

1 Peter 5:6 Therefore humble yourselves under the Mighty Hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, 5:7 **casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.** 5:10 But may **the God of all Grace ... after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.**

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from **the Father of lights**, with whom there is no variation;

Psalms 84:11 No good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly.

1 John 5:4 **For whatever is born of God** overcomes the world. And this is **the Victory** that has overcome the world, **our faith!**

Romans 8:13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if **by the Spirit** you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, **these are sons of God.**

John 13:34 “A new Commandment I give to you, that you love one another; As I have loved you, that you also love one another. 13:35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.” [Mat 5:44 & Luke 6:27 “... love your enemies,”]

John 14:15 “If you love Me, keep My Commandments.” 14:20 “At that Day you will know that I am in My Father, and you (are) in Me, and I (am) in you. 14:21 He who has My Commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be Loved by My Father, and I will Love him and manifest Myself to him.” 14:23 Yeshua answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and My Father will Love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him!” (Read king David’s great burden, Psalm 132:1-5)

John 15:10 “If you keep My Commandments, you will abide in My Love, just as I have kept My Father’s Commandments and abide in His Love. 15:11 These things I have spoken to you, that My Joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full! 15:12 This is My Commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. 15:13 Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one’s life for his friends. 15:17 “These things I Command you, that you love one another!”

John 21:17 He said to him the third time, “Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?” Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, “Do you love Me?” And he said to Him, “Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You.” Yeshua said to him, “Feed My sheep!” 21:19 ... And when He had spoken this, He said to him, “Follow Me!” 21:22 Yeshua said to him, “If I will that he (John) remain until I come, what is that to you? You follow Me!”

2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said to me, “My Grace is sufficient for you, for My Strength is made perfect in weakness!”

2nd Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but (a Spirit) of Power and of Love and of a sound (disciplined) mind!

Nevertheless I have this against you,
that **you have left your first love!** Revelation 2:4

Luke 10:39 ... Miriam, who also sat at Yeshua's feet, and heard His Word. 10:42 "**But one thing is needed, and Miriam has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her.**"

Isaiah 44:22 "I have blotted out, like a thick cloud, your transgressions, and like a cloud, your sins. **Return to Me, for I have redeemed you.**"

Jeremiah 4:1 "If you will return, O Israel," says the LORD, "**Return to Me;** and if you will put away your abominations out of My sight, then you shall not be moved."

Jeremiah 24:7 "Then **I will give them a heart to know Me,** that **I am the LORD;** and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, for they shall return to Me with their whole heart."

Nehemiah 1:9 "... but **if you return to Me,** and keep My Commandments and do them though some of you were cast out to the farthest part of the heavens, yet I will gather them from there, and bring them to the place (Zion, Jerusalem) which I have chosen as a dwelling for My name."

Zechariah 1:3 Therefore say to them, "Thus says the LORD of hosts, "**Return to Me,**" says the LORD of hosts, "**and I will return to you,**" says the LORD of hosts."

Malachi 3:7 "Yet from the days of your fathers you have gone away from My ordinances and have not kept them. **Return to Me, and I will return to you,**" says the LORD of hosts. "But you said, 'In what way shall we return?'" 3:8 "Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings!"

2 Chronicles 7:14 "**If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face,** and turn from their wicked ways, **then I will hear from Heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.**"

Hosea 5:15 “I will return again to My place (Heaven) until they acknowledge their offense. Then they will seek My face. **In their affliction they will earnestly seek Me!**”

1 Samuel 15:22, 23 So Samuel said, “Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices (works), **as in obeying the Voice of the LORD?** Behold, **to obey is better than sacrifice**, and to heed than the fat of rams. For **rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft**, and **stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry.**”

Jeremiah 9:23 Thus says the LORD: “Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, let not the mighty man glory in his might, nor let the rich man glory in his riches; 9:24 “But let him who glories glory in this, **that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD, exercising Loving kindness, Judgment, and Righteousness in the earth.** For in these I delight,” says the LORD.

Isaiah 45:11 Thus says the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and His Maker, “**Ask of Me of things to come, concerning My sons, and concerning the work of My hands, you command Me!**”

Exodus 15:26 “If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. **For I am the LORD who heals you!**”

Psalms 103:1-4 **Bless the LORD**, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His Holy name! Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits. Who forgives all your iniquities, **who heals all your diseases,** who redeems your life from destruction, who crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercies, who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s. 103:12 **As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.**

Jeremiah 30:17 “For **I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds,**” says the LORD, ‘Because they called you an outcast saying: “This is Zion; No one seeks her.” ’ ”

Isaiah 53:1 ... to whom has **the Arm of the LORD** been revealed 53:4 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. 53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and **by His Stripes we are healed!**

1 Peter 2:24 **who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree**, that we, having died to sins, **might live for righteousness** — **by whose Stripes you were healed!**

Matthew 8:16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a Word, **and healed all who were sick**, 8:17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet (Isaiah 53:4, 5), saying: **“He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses!”**

Matthew 15:30 Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Yeshua’s feet, **and He healed them!** 15:31 So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

Mark 16:17 **“And these signs will follow those who believe: in My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 16:18 they will take up servants; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover!”** (See Matthew 10:8 and Acts 5:12)

Psalms 107:20 **He sent His Word and healed them**, and delivered them from their destructions.

Malachi 4:2 **“But to you who fear My name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with Healing in His wings**; And you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. 4:3 You shall trample the wicked, for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the Day that I do this,” says the LORD of hosts.

Matthew 9:35 Then Yeshua went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, **and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.**

Proverbs 3:5-10 **Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and depart from evil. It will be health to your flesh, and strength to your bones. Honor the LORD with your possessions, and with the firstfruits of all your increase; so your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine.**

Proverbs 4:22 **For My Words are Life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh.**

James 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. 5:15 **And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up.** And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

Isaiah 6:9, 10 And He said, “Go, and tell this people, ‘Keep on hearing, but do not understand; keep on seeing, but do not perceive.’ Make the heart of this people dull, and their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and return and be healed!”

John 14:10 “Do you not believe that I am in My Father, and My Father (is) in Me? The Words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own Authority; **but My Father who dwells in Me does the Works!**”

1 Corinthians 3:17 If anyone defiles the Temple of God, God will destroy him. For the Temple of God is Holy, which Temple you are!

1 Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that **your body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you,** whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

2 Corinthians 6:16 ... **for you are the Temple of the Living God!**

Habakkuk 2:2-4 Then the LORD answered me and said “**Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it.** For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, **wait for it;** because **it will surely come, it will not tarry!**” “ ... but **the just shall live by his faith.**”

Deuteronomy 18:15 “The LORD your God will raise up for you **a Prophet like me** (Moses) from your midst, from your brethren. **Him you shall hear,** 18:18 I will raise up for them **a Prophet like you** from among their brethren, and **I will put My Words in His mouth,** and He shall speak to them all that I Command Him. 18:19 And it shall be that **whoever will not hear My Words, which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him!**”

Daniel 10:11, 12 And He said to me, “O Daniel, **man greatly beloved,** understand the Words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for I have now been sent to you.” While He was speaking this Word to me, I stood trembling. Then He said to me, “Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day **that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard;** and I have come because **of your words.**” 10:19 And He said, “**O man greatly beloved, fear not!** Peace be to you; **be Strong, yes, be Strong!**” So when He spoke to me **I was strengthened,** and said, “Let my Lord speak, for You have strengthened me.”

Ephesian 3:14 For this reason I bow my knees **to the Father** of our Lord Messiah Yeshua, 3:15 from whom the whole family in Heaven and earth is named, 3:16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory **to be strengthened with Might through His Spirit in the inner man,** 3:17 that the Messiah may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, **being rooted and grounded in love,** 3:18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height, 3:19 **to know the Love of Messiah which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.**

John 3:7 “Do not marvel that I said to you, **‘You must be born again!’**”

Luke 17:20, 21 “The Kingdom of God does not come with observation ... nor will they say, ‘See here!’ or ‘See there!’

For indeed **the Kingdom of God is within you!**”

1 John 4:17 Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the Day of Judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world!

Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Deuteronomy 33:3 Yes, He Loves the people; all His saints are in Your hand; they sit down at Your feet; everyone receives Your Words.

Joshua 1:5 “No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. 1:6 **Be strong and of good courage,** for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. 1:7 **Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the Torah which Moses My servant commanded you;** do not turn from it to the right hand or the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.” (also in Deuteronomy 31:6)

Hebrews 13:5 For He Himself has said, “**I will never leave you nor forsake you.**”

Romans 4:17 ... **God, who gives life to the dead** and calls those things which do not exist as though they did;

Matthew 28:18 And Yeshua came and spoke to them, saying, “**All Authority has been given to Me in Heaven and on earth.** 28:19 **Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations,** baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 28:20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, **I am with you always, even to the end of the Age!**” Amen.

Psalms 136:1 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, **for He is Good,** for His Mercy endures forever!

Colossians 1:17 **And He (Yeshua) is before all things, and in Him all things consist.** 1:18 **And He is the Head of the Body, the Church ...**

Isaiah 42:9 “Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things I declare; before they spring forth I tell you of them.”

Psalms 100:4 Enter into His gates with Thanksgiving, and into His courts with Praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.
100:5 **For the LORD is Good; His Mercy is Everlasting, and His Truth endures to all generations.**

Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to Glory, to **make the Captain of their Salvation Perfect through sufferings.**

Romans 8:29, 30 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the Glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

John 17:11 “Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. **Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be One as We are.** 17:15 I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. 17:21 that they all may be One, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; **that they also may be One in Us,** that the world may believe that You sent Me. 17:22 And **the Glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be One, just as We are One.** 17:23 I in them, and You in Me; **that they may be made Perfect in One, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have Loved them as You have Loved Me!**”

John 15:14 “**You are My friends, if you do whatever I Command you.**
15:15 No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; **but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you!**” (Ex 33:11; Is 41:8)

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all like an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags;

Romans 7:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells;

Philippians 1:6 ...being confident of this very thing, that **He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the Day of Yeshua** the Messiah;

Psalms 138:8 **The LORD will perfect that which concerns me;**

Amos 3:7 Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

2 Chronicles 20:20 Jehoshaphat stood and said, “Hear me, O Judah, and you inhabitants of Jerusalem. **Believe in the LORD your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper!**”

20:21 And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed those who should sing to the LORD, and who should praise the Beauty of Holiness, as they went out before the army and were saying:

“Praise the LORD, for His Mercy endures forever!”

Isaiah 44:26 “ ‘... who confirms the word of His servant, and performs the counsel of His messengers;’ ”

1 Samuel 3:19 So Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground.

Psalms 105:19 Until the time that His Word came to pass, the Word of the LORD tested him (Joseph).

Jeremiah 1:12 Then the LORD said to me, “You have seen well, **for I am ready to perform My Word** (watching over My Word to perform it.)”

John 3:30 “**He (Yeshua) must Increase, but I must decrease!**”

John 8:29 “And He who sent Me is with Me. My Father has not left Me alone, **for I always do those things that please Him!**”

Luke 22:42 "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless **not My will, but Yours, be done!**" (in Matthew 26:39)

Mark 14:36 And He said, "**Abba, Father, all things are possible for You. Take this cup away from Me; nevertheless, not what I will, but what You will!**"

John 3:11-13 “Most assuredly, I say to you, **We speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive Our witness**. If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things? No one has ascended to Heaven but **He who came down from Heaven, that is, the Son of Man who is in Heaven!**”

John 5:19 Then Yeshua answered and said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, **the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner**. 5:20 For the Father loves the Son, **and shows Him all things that He Himself does**; and He will show Him **Greater works** than these, that you may marvel.”

John 5:36, 37 “But I have a greater witness than John’s; **for the works which My Father has given Me to finish, the very works that I do, bear witness of Me, that My Father has sent Me**. And My Father Himself, who sent Me, **has testified of Me**. You have neither heard His Voice at any time, nor seen His form.”

Mark 4:24 Then He said to them, “Take heed what you hear. With the same measure you use, it will be measured to you; **and to you who hear, more will be given**.” (also see Mark 7:16)

Hebrews 6:1, 2 **Therefore, let us go on to perfection ... [Love!]**

Psalms 37:23 **The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD**, and He delights in his way. 37:24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; for the LORD upholds him with His hand!

Psalm 119:105 **Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.**

1 John 1:7-9 But if we walk in the light **as He is in the Light**, we have fellowship with one another, and **the Blood of Yeshua the Messiah His Son cleanses us from all sin.** If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the Truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is Faithful and Just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 6:22 “The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light.”

Psalm 16:11 You will show me **the Path of Life; In Your Presence is fullness of Joy;** at Your right hand are **pleasures forevermore.**

John 10:3-5, 7-11, 14-17, 24-31, 33-38 “**To Him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear His Voice; and He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.** And when he brings out His own sheep, He goes before them; and the sheep follow Him, for they know His Voice. Yet they will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers.” Then Yeshua said to them again, “Most assuredly, I say to you, **I am the Door of the sheep!** All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them. **I am the Door!** If anyone enters by Me, he will be Saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. **I have come that they may have Life, and that they may have it more abundantly!** **I am the Good Shepherd!** **The Good Shepherd gives His life for the sheep!** **I am the Good Shepherd;** and I know My sheep, and am known by My own. **As My Father knows Me, even so I know My Father;** and I lay down My life for the sheep. And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them

also I must bring, and they will hear My Voice; and there will be one flock and one Shepherd. Therefore My Father Loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again.” Then the Jews surrounded Him and said to Him, “How long do You keep us in doubt? If You are the Messiah, tell us plainly.” Yeshua answered them, “I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father’s name, they bear witness of Me. But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. **My sheep hear My Voice**, and I know them, and they follow Me. **And I give them Eternal Life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand!** **My Father, who has given them to Me, is Greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father’s hand!** **I and My Father are One!**” Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. The Jews answered Him, saying, “For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God.” Yeshua answered them, “Is it not written in your Torah, ‘I said, “**You are god’s?**” ’ (Psalm 82:6) “If He called them gods, to whom the Word of God came (and the Scripture cannot be broken), do you say of Him whom My Father sanctified and sent into the world, ‘You are blaspheming,’ because I said, ‘**I am the Son of God?**’ If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that My Father is in Me, and I in Him!” (See Romans 8:32)

Psalm 91:1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 91:2 I will say of the LORD, “**He is my Refuge and my Fortress; My God, in Him I will trust!**” 91:3 Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence. 91:4 He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His Truth shall be your shield and buckler. 91:14 “Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name. 91:15 He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. 9:16 With long life I will satisfy him and show him My Salvation!” (91:7-12 page 48)

Exodus 33:15 Then he (Moses) said to Him, “If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here.”

Daniel 2:28 “But there is a God in Heaven who reveals secrets, He has made known ...”

1 John 2:20 But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things.

Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind (with the Word of God), that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Proverbs 18:21 **Death and life** are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the Throne of Grace, that we may obtain Mercy and find Grace to help in time of need.

Proverbs 18:22 He who **finds a wife** finds a good thing, and obtains favor from the LORD.

Deuteronomy 30:14 But **the Word** is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, **that you may do it**.

Psalms 127:2 For so **He (the LORD) gives His beloved sleep**.

Psalms 4:8 I will both **lie down in peace**, and sleep; For You alone, O LORD, **make me dwell in safety**.

Proverbs 3:24 **When you lie down, you will not be afraid**; Yes, you will lie down **and your sleep will be sweet**.

Isaiah 26:3 **You will keep him in perfect Peace**, **whose mind is stayed on You**, because he trusts in You.

John 14:27 “**Peace I leave with you, My Peace I give to you;** not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.” John 16:33 “These things I have spoken to you, **that in Me you may have Peace.** In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, **I have overcome the world!”**

Philippians 4:6 **Be anxious for nothing,** but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 4:7 **And the Peace of God,** which surpasses all understanding, **will guard your hearts and minds** through Messiah Yeshua.

Psalms 119:165 **Great peace** have those who love Your Torah, and nothing causes them to stumble.

1 John 4:4 **You are of God, little children,** and have overcome them, **because He who is in you is Greater** than he who is in the world. 4:7 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. 4:8 He who does not love does not know God, **for God is Love!** 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. **God is Love,** and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him. 4:17 Love has been perfected among us in this: **that we may have boldness in the Day of Judgment;** **because as He is, so are we in this world!** 4:18 There is no fear in love; **but Perfect Love casts out fear,** because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah, who according to His abundant Mercy has begotten us again to a Living hope through the Resurrection of Messiah Yeshua from the dead, 1:4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in Heaven for you ...

Romans 8:17 and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and joint heirs with Messiah, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

Ephesians 1:5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Yeshua the Messiah to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 1:6 to the praise of the Glory of His Grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. 1:17 that the God of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah, the Father of Glory, may give to you the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened, that you may know what is the hope of His calling;

Psalm 27:1 **The LORD is my Light and my Salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the Strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?**

Psalm 121:7 **The LORD shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul.** 121:8 The LORD shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore.

Isaiah 52:12 For you shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight; **For the LORD will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard.**

Isaiah 62:6 I have set watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they shall never hold their peace day or night. You who make mention of the LORD, do not keep silent, 62:7 and give Him no rest until He establishes and until He makes Jerusalem **a Praise in the earth!**

Hebrews 12:1 Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, **let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,** 12:2 **looking unto Yeshua, the Author and Finisher of our faith,** who for the Joy that was set before Him endured the Cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the Throne of God.

Galatians 2:20 **I have been crucified with Messiah; it is no longer I who live, but the Messiah lives in me;** and the life which I now live in the flesh **I live by faith in (the faith of) the Son of God,** who loved me and gave Himself for me. (Romans 13:14 Put on Christ ... page 30)

Malachi 3:6 “**For I am the LORD, I do not change**; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob.”

Yeshua the Messiah is the same yesterday, today, and forever!
Hebrews 13:8

For if anyone thinks himself to be something,
when he is nothing, he deceives himself (pride). Galatians 6:3

1 Corinthians 8:1 Now concerning things offered to idols: We know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, but love edifies. 8:2 **And if anyone thinks that he knows anything, he knows nothing yet as he ought to know**. 8:3 But if anyone loves God, this one is known by Him.

Isaiah 30:15 For thus says the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel: “**In returning and rest shall you shall be Saved**; in quietness and confidence shall be your strength.”

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, **thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope**. (also see Romans 8:28)

Deuteronomy 7:9 “Therefore know that the LORD your God, He is God, **the Faithful God who keeps Covenant and Mercy for a thousand generations** with those who love Him and keep His Commandments;”

Psalms 105:7 **He is the LORD our God**; His Judgments are in all the earth. 105:8 **He remembers His Covenant forever**, the Word which He Commanded, for a thousand generations, 105:9 The Covenant which He made with Abraham, and His oath to Isaac, 105:10 And confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, **to Israel as an Everlasting Covenant**, 105:11 saying, “**To you I will give the land of Canaan as the allotment of your inheritance ...**”

Galatians 5:22 But **the fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 5:23 gentleness, self control. Against such there is no law.

Philippians 4:19 **And my God shall supply all your need** according to His riches in glory by Messiah Yeshua.

Matthew 7:7 “**Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.** 7:8 **For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.**”

Matthew 18:19 “Again I say to you that **if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in Heaven!**”

John 14:13 “**And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do,** that My Father may be glorified in the Son. 14:14 **If you ask anything in My name, I will do it!**”

John 15:7 “If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, **you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you!**”

John 15:16 “You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that **whatever you ask My Father in My name He may give you!**”

John 16:23 “And in that Day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, **whatever you ask My Father in My name He will give you.** 16:24 Until now you have asked nothing in My name.

Ask, and you will receive, that your Joy may be full!”

1 John 3:22 **And whatever we ask we receive from Him,** because we keep His Commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. 3:23 And this is His Commandment: **that we should believe on the name of His Son Yeshua the Messiah and love one another,** as He gave us Commandment.

1 John 5:14 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, **that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.** 5:15 **And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him!**

Mark 10:27 But Yeshua looked at them and said, “With men it is impossible, but not with God; **for with God all things are possible!**”

Jeremiah 32:17 “Ah, Lord GOD!... There is nothing too hard for You.

”32:27 “Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh.

Is there anything too hard for Me?”

Matthew 19:26 But Yeshua looked at them and said to them,
“With men this is impossible, **but with God all things are possible!**”

Mark 9:23 Yeshua said to him, “If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes!”

Ezekiel 43:7 And He said to me, “Son of man, **this is the place of My Throne and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever!**”

Psalm 132:13 For **the LORD has chosen Zion**; He has desired it for His dwelling place: 132:14 “**This is My resting place forever; Here I will dwell, for I have desired it.**”

Psalm 68:16 **This is the Mountain (Zion) which God desires to dwell in; Yes, the LORD will dwell in it forever!**

Isaiah 24:23 Then the moon will be disgraced and the sun ashamed; For **the LORD of hosts will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem and before His elders, Gloriously.**

Psalm 34:19 **Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the LORD delivers him out of them all!**

2nd Corinthians 3:17 **Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is Liberty!**

Genesis 18:25 “**Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?”**

Zechariah 2:5 “ ‘For I’ says the LORD, ‘will be a wall of fire all around her, **and I will be the Glory in her midst!**’ ”

Ephesians 2:4 **But God, who is rich in Mercy, because of His Great Love with which He Loved us**, 2:5 even when we were dead in trespasses, **made us alive together with Messiah** (by grace you have been saved), 2:6 and raised us up together, **and made us sit together in the Heavenly places in Messiah Yeshua**, 2:8 **For by Grace you have been saved through faith**, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 2:9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

John 14:16 “And I will pray to My Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you **forever** 14:17 **the Spirit of Truth!** whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. 14:18 I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.” 14:26 “But **the Helper, the Holy Spirit**, whom My Father will send in My name, **He will teach you all things**, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.”

John 16:7 “Nevertheless I tell you the Truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, **the Helper** will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. 16:13 “However, when He, **the Spirit of Truth**, has come, **He will guide you into all Truth**; for He will not speak on His own Authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. 16:14 He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. 16:15 All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you.” (see Isaiah 45:11 on page 10)

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; **but God is faithful**, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation **will also make the way of escape**, that you may be able to bear it.

Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. 51:11 Do not cast me away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. 51:12 Restore to me **the Joy of Your Salvation**, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit. 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, a broken and a contrite heart —

Joshua 5:13 And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, **a Man** stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, “Are You for us or for our adversaries?” 5:14 So He said, “**No, but as Commander of the Army of the LORD I have now come.**” And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped, and said to Him, “What does my Lord say to His servant?”

Nehemiah 8:10 Then he said to them, “Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; **for this day is Holy (Yom Teruah) to our LORD. Do not sorrow, for the Joy of the LORD is your Strength!**”

Daniel 7:13 “I was watching in the night visions, and behold, **One like the Son of Man**, coming with the clouds of Heaven! He came to **the Ancient of Days**, & they brought Him near before Him. 7:14 **Then to Him was given Dominion and Glory and a Kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His Dominion is an Everlasting Dominion, which shall not pass away, and His Kingdom the One which shall not be destroyed!”**

Isaiah 42:8 “I am the LORD, that is My name; And My Glory I will not give to another;” Isaiah 48:11 “And I will not give My Glory to another!”

Isaiah 43:18 “Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old. 43:19 Behold, I will do a new thing! Now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.”

Isaiah 55:11 So shall **My Word be that goes forth from My mouth;** It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it. 55:12 “**For you shall go out with Joy, and be led out with Peace;** The mountains and the hills shall break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.”

John 8:58 Yeshua said to them, “Most assuredly...**before Abraham was, I Am!**”

Isaiah 61:1 “**The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me**, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; 61:2 to proclaim the acceptable Year of the LORD, and the Day of Vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, 61:3 to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be **called trees of Righteousness**, the planting of the LORD, that He may be Glorified!”

Luke 4:18 “**The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me**, because He has anointed Me **to preach the Gospel to the poor**, He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; 4:19 To proclaim the acceptable Year of the LORD.”

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Yeshua of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with Power, **who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil**, for God was with Him.

1 John 3:8 **For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil!**

John 1:12 **But as many as received Him**, to them He gave the right to become **children of God**, to those who believe in His name: 1:13 **who were born**, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His Glory, the Glory as of the only Begotten of the Father, full of Grace & Truth! John 1:16 And of His fullness we have all received, and Grace for Grace. 1:17 For the law (Torah) was given through Moses, but **Grace and Truth came through Yeshua the Messiah!** 1:18 No one has seen God at any time. **The only begotten Son**, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the Glory of God ... 2 Corinthians 1:20

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father!” 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God ...

Galatians 4:6 And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, “Abba, Father!”

Isaiah 26:9 For when **Your Judgments** are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn Righteousness!

Psalms 34:4 I sought the LORD, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

Luke 19:13 “ **“Do business until I come!”** ”

Hebrews 4:12 **For the Word of God is Living and Powerful,** and **sharper than any two-edged sword,** piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

John 8:31 Then Yeshua said to those Jews who believed Him, **“If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed.** 8:32 **And you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free!”**

John 8:12 Then Yeshua spoke to them again, saying, **“I am the Light of the world! He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness,** but have **the Light of Life!”**

Romans 8:37 Yet in all these things **we are more than conquerors through Him who Loved us.** 8:38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, 8:39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, **(nothing) shall be able to separate us from the Love of God which is in Messiah Yeshua our Lord.**

1 Corinthians 2:16 **But we have the Mind of Christ (the Messiah)!**

Philippians 2:3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.

2:4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. 2:5 Let this Mind be in you which was also in Messiah Yeshua, 2:6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 2:7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

2:8 And being found in appearance as a Man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the Cross!

2:9 Therefore God also has highly Exalted Him & given Him the Name which is above every name, 2:10 that at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, of those in Heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 2:11 and that every tongue should confess that Yeshua the Messiah is Lord, to the Glory of God the Father!

2:12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own Salvation with fear and trembling! 2:13 for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure. 2:14 Do all things without complaining and disputing, 2:15 that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, 2:16 holding fast the Word of Life, so that I may rejoice in the Day of Messiah that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

Isaiah 60:1 Arise, shine; for your light has come! And the Glory of the LORD is risen upon you. 60:2 For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; But the LORD will arise over you, and His Glory will be seen upon you.

Daniel 11:32 “... but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits. 11:33 And those of the people who understand shall instruct many. 11:35 And some of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify them, and make them white, until the time of the end; because it is still for the appointed time.”

Romans 13:14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

So then **faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.**
Romans 10:17

Hebrews 11:1 **Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.**

Matthew 17:19 Then the disciples came to Yeshua privately and said, “Why could we not cast it out?” 17:20 So Yeshua said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, **if you have faith as a mustard seed**, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ **and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you!** 17:21 However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.”

Mark 11:22 So Yeshua answered and said to them, “**Have faith in God!** 11:23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ **and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.** 11:24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them!”

Luke 17:5 And the apostles said to the Lord, “**Increase our faith!**” 17:6 **So the Lord said, “If you have faith as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you!”**

Ephesians 3:20 Now to Him who is able **to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the Power that works in us,** 3:21 **to Him be Glory in the Church by Messiah Yeshua** to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Jeremiah 32:39 “ **I will give them one Heart and one Way, that they may fear Me forever,** for the good of them and their children after them. 32:40 **And I will make an Everlasting Covenant with them,** that I will not turn away **from doing them Good**; but I will put My fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from Me. 32:41 Yes, **I will Rejoice over them to do them Good,** and I will assuredly plant them **in this land (Israel), with all My Heart and with all My soul.** ”

Mark 10:18 So Yeshua said to him, “Why do you call Me good? No one is Good but One, that is, God!”

Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good and necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the Day of Redemption. 4:31 Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. 4:32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Messiah forgave you.

2nd Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, **if anyone is in Messiah, he is a New Creation**; old things have passed away; behold all things have become new!

Isaiah 30:20 And though the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, yet your teachers will not be moved into corner anymore, but your eyes shall see your teachers. 30:21 Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, **“This is the way, walk in it!”** Wherever you turn to the right hand or wherever you turn to the left.

Matthew 15:13 But He (Yeshua) answered and said, **“Every plant which My Heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted!”**

Psalms 27:4 One thing I have desired of the LORD, that will I seek: **that I may dwell in the House of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the Beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in His Temple.** 27:5 For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His Pavilion; in the secret place of His Tabernacle **He shall hide me;** He shall set me high upon a Rock. 27:6 And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; Therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy in His Tabernacle; **I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the LORD!**

2 Samuel 5:20 So David went to Baal Perazim, and David defeated them there; and he said, “The LORD has broken through my enemies before me, like a breakthrough of water.” Therefore he called the name of that place Baal Perazim. (also 1 Chronicles 14:11)

1 Corinthians 13:1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, **but have not love**, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. 13:2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, **but have not love, I am nothing!** 13:3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, **but have not love, it profits me nothing.** 13:4 **Love** suffers long (is patient) and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; 13:5 does not behave rudely (pushey), does not seek its own, (is not controlling) is not provoked (does not react), thinks no evil; 13:6 does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; 13:7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 13:8 **Love never fails!**

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, **my brethren, be Strong in the Lord and in the Power of His Might.** 6:11 **Put on the whole Armor of God**, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 6:13 **Therefore take up the whole Armor of God**, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, **and having done all, to stand.** 6:14 **Stand** therefore, having girded your waist with Truth, having put on the breastplate of Righteousness, 6:15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the Gospel of Peace; 6:16 above all, taking the Shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 6:17 And take the helmet of Salvation, and the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God; 6:18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance & supplication for all the saints —

Isaiah 65:13 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: “Behold, **My servants shall eat ... Behold, My servants shall drink ... Behold, My servants shall Rejoice ...** 65:14 Behold, **My servants shall sing for Joy of heart ...** 65:18 But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; For behold, **I create Jerusalem as a Rejoicing, and her people a joy.** 65:19 **I will Rejoice in Jerusalem, and Joy in My people**; The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, nor the voice of crying.”

Psalms 22:3 **But You are Holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel!**

Psalm 23:1 **The LORD is my Shepherd; I shall not want!** 23:3 **He restores my soul;** 23:6 Surely **Goodness and Mercy shall follow me all the days of my life;** And I will dwell in the House of the LORD forever!

Revelation 12:11 **And they overcame him by the Blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death!**

Matthew 7:1 **“Judge not, that you be not judged.** 7:2 **For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you.** 7:3 **And why do you look at the speck in your brother’s eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye?** 7:4 **Or how can you say to your brother, ‘Let me remove the speck from your eye’; and look, a plank is in your own eye?”**

Matthew 22:36 **“Teacher, which is **the Great Commandment** in the Torah?”** 22:37 Yeshua said to him, **‘You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’** 22:38 **This is the first and great Commandment.** 22:39 **And the second is like it: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’** 22:40 **On these 2 Commandments hang all the Torah & the prophets.”** (Deuteronomy 6:5)

Daniel 2:34 **You watched while **a Stone** was cut out without hands, which struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces.** 2:35 **Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found. **And the Stone that struck the image became a Great Mountain and filled the whole earth.**** 2:44 **And in the days of these kings the God of Heaven will set up a Kingdom which shall never be destroyed;** and the Kingdom shall not be left to other people; **it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever!**

John 14:6 Yeshua said to him, **“I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to My Father except through Me!”**

Psalm 77:13 Your way, O God, is in the Sanctuary; Who is so great a God as our God? 77:14 **You are the God who does wonders (Miracles)**; You have declared Your Strength among the peoples.

Zephaniah 3:17 “The LORD your God in your midst, **the Mighty One, will Save; He will Rejoice over you with Gladness, He will quiet you with His Love, He will Rejoice over you with Singing!**”

Hosea 6:3 Let us know, let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His going forth is established as the morning; **He will come to us like the rain, like the latter and former rain to the earth.**

Luke 22:27 “For who is greater, he who sits at the table, or he who serves? Is it not he who sits at the table? **Yet I am among you as the One who serves!**”

Matthew 25:21 His lord said to him, ‘**Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the Joy of your Lord!**’ (Mt 25:34, 40)

Psalm 9:1 I will praise You, O LORD, with my whole heart;

2 Samuel 6:14 Then David danced before the LORD with all his might;

2 Corinthians 5:21 **For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the Righteousness of God in Him!**

Zechariah 4:6 So he answered and said to me: “This is the Word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: ‘**Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,**’ says the LORD of hosts.”

John 6:68 But Simon Peter answered Him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the Words of Eternal Life!”

John 11:25 Yeshua said to her, “**I am the Resurrection and the Life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live!** 11:26 And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die! Do you believe this?”

Hosea 2:19 “**I will Betroth you to Me forever; Yes, I will Betroth you to Me in Righteousness and Justice, in Lovingkindness and Mercy;** 2:20 I will Betroth you to Me in Faithfulness, and you shall know the LORD!”

Psalm 145:3 **Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised.**
And His Greatness is unsearchable.

John 12:25 “He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for Eternal Life. 12:26 If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honor.”

**“And I, if I am lifted up from the earth,
will draw all peoples to Myself!” John 12:32**

Song of Solomon 6:3 **I am my Beloved’s, and my Beloved is mine.**

Romans 14:17 for **the Kingdom of God** is not eating and drinking, **but Righteousness and Peace and Joy in the Holy Spirit.**

Isaiah 30:18 Therefore the LORD will wait, that He may be gracious to you; and therefore **He will be Exalted,** that He may have Mercy on you. For the LORD is a God of Justice; Blessed are all those who wait for Him.

Proverbs 8:17 I love those who love Me, and those who seek Me diligently will find Me.

Matthew 6:15 “But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses!”

Isaiah 26:9 With my soul I have desired You in the night, yes, by my spirit within me I will seek You early; **For when Your Judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn Righteousness.**

Psalms 25:4 Show me Your ways, O LORD; teach me Your paths.
25:5 Lead me in Your Truth and teach me, **for You are the God of my Salvation**; on You I wait all the day.

Philippians 3:8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Messiah Yeshua my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Messiah 3:9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the Torah, but that which is through faith in Messiah, the Righteousness which is from God by faith;

Ephesians 4:26 “Be angry, and do not sin.” Do not let the sun go down on your wrath,

Psalms 138:6 Though the LORD is on high, yet He regards the lowly; but the proud He knows from afar.

Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall. Proverbs 18:12 Before destruction the heart of a man is haughty, and before honor is humility. Proverbs 29:23 A man’s pride will bring him low, but the humble in spirit will retain honor. Proverbs 22:4 By humility & **the fear of the LORD** are riches and honor and life.

Romans 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? **If God is for us, who can be against us?**

1 John 1:5 This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that **God is Light and in Him is no darkness at all!**

Psalms 29:1 A Psalm of David. **Give unto the LORD**, O you mighty ones, **give unto the LORD Glory and Strength!** 29:2 **Give unto the LORD the Glory due to His name;** Worship the LORD in the beauty of Holiness. 29:4 The voice of the LORD is Powerful; The voice of the LORD is full of Majesty. 29:10 The LORD sat enthroned at the Flood, and **the LORD sits as King forever!** 29:11 **The LORD will give Strength to His people;** the LORD will bless His people with Peace.

Psalm 46:1 **God is our Refuge and Strength**, a very present help in trouble. 46:2 Therefore we will not fear, even though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; 46:4 **There is a river whose streams shall make glad the city of God,** the Holy Place of the Tabernacle of the Most High. 46:7 **The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our Refuge.** Selah 46:9 He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear in two; He burns the chariot in the fire. 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth! 46:11 **The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our Refuge.**

Exodus 20:5 “**For I, the LORD your God, am a Jealous God,** visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, 20:6 but showing Mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My Commandments!”

Isaiah 40:3 The voice of one crying in the wilderness: “**Prepare the Way of the LORD;** make straight in the desert a highway for our God. 40:4 Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; The crooked places shall be made straight and the rough places smooth; 40:5 **The Glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together;** for the mouth of the LORD has spoken.”

John 14:12 “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the Works that I do he will do also; **and Greater Works than these he will do,** because I go to My Father!”

Exodus 20:8 “Remember the Sabbath day, **to keep it holy!**”

Isaiah 58:13 “If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My Holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the Holy day of the LORD honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, nor speaking your own words.

58:14 Then you shall delight yourself in the LORD; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the LORD has spoken.”

Numbers 30:1, 2 “This is the thing which the LORD has Commanded: If a man makes a vow to the LORD, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth. 30:8 But if her husband overrules her on the day that he hears it, he shall make void her vow which she took and what she uttered with her lips, by which she bound herself, and the LORD will release her.”

2 Peter 1:17 For He received from God the Father **Honor and Glory** when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: “**This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased!**” (see Matthew 3:17)

Hebrews 2:9 But **we see Yeshua**, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with Glory and Honor, that He, by the Grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, **not willing that any should perish** but that all should come to repentance.

1 Corinthians 14:26 How is it then, brethren? Whenever you come together, each of you has a psalm, has a teaching, has a tongue, has a revelation, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.

Proverbs 16:7 When a man's ways please the LORD, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him.

Romans 12:10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;

Proverbs 17:17 A (true) friend loves at all times ...

Psalms 149:5 **Let the saints be joyful in glory;** Let them sing aloud on their beds. 149:6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand, 149:7 to execute Vengeance on the nations, and punishments on the peoples; 149:8 To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron; 149:9 To execute on them the written Judgment — this honor have all His saints. Praise the LORD!

Revelation 3:18 “I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see! 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. **If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.**”

Revelation 4:8 “**Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!**” 4:11 “You are Worthy, O Lord, to receive Glory and Honor and Power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created!”

Revelation 5:5 But one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals.” 5:6 And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth. 5:9 And they sang a new song, saying: “**You are Worthy to take the scroll, & to open its seals; For You were slain, and have Redeemed us to God by Your Blood out of every tribe**

and tongue and people and nation, 5:10 “And have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth!” 5:11

Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, 5:12 saying with a loud voice: “**Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive Power and Riches and Wisdom, and Strength and Honor and Glory and Blessing!**” 5:13 And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: “**Blessing and Honor and Glory and Power be to Him who sits on the Throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!**”

Revelation 7:9 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before **the Throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes**, with palm branches in their hands, 7:10 and crying out with a loud voice, saying, “**Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the Throne, and to the Lamb!**” 7:11 All the angels stood around the Throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the Throne and worshiped God, 7:12 saying: “**Amen! Blessing and Glory and Wisdom, Thanksgiving and Honor and Power and Might, be to our God forever and ever. Amen.**” 7:13 Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, “Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?” 7:14 And I said to him, “Sir, you know.” So he said to me, “**These are the ones who come out of the Great Tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the Blood of the Lamb.**” (Revelation 1:5, 6, kings and priests)

Revelation 17:14 “**The Lamb will Overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful!**”

Revelation 19:1 After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in Heaven, saying, “Alleluia! **Salvation and Glory and Honor and Power belong to the Lord our God!**”

Revelation 21:4 “**And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes, There shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain,** for the former things have passed away.” 21:5 Then He who sat on the Throne said, “**Behold, I make all things new!**” And He said to me, “Write, for these Words are **True and Faithful!**” 21:6 And He said to me, “**It is done! I am the Alpha (Aleph) and the Omega (Tav), the Beginning and the End. I will give of the Fountain of the Water of Life freely to him who thirsts.**”

Exodus 23:31 “And I will set your bounds from the Red Sea to the sea, Philistia, and from the desert to the River. For I will deliver the inhabitants of the land into your hand, and you shall drive them out before you. 23:32 **You shall make no covenant with them,** nor with their gods. 23:33 **They shall not dwell in your land,** lest they make you sin against Me. For if you serve their gods, it will surely be a snare to you.”

Deuteronomy 7:1 “When the LORD your God brings you into the land which you go to possess, and has cast out many nations before you, the Hittites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Canaanites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than you, 7:2 and when the LORD your God delivers them over to you, you shall conquer them and utterly destroy them. **You shall make no covenant with them nor show mercy to them.** 7:6 For you are a holy people to the LORD your God; the LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the face of the earth. 7:7 The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples; 7:8 **but because the LORD loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers,** the LORD has brought you out with a Mighty Hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.”

Leviticus 25:23 “**The land (including Gaza) shall not be sold permanently, for the land is Mine;** for you are strangers & sojourners with Me!”

Jeremiah 46:28 “Do not fear, O Jacob My servant,” says the LORD,
“For I am with you; **For I will make a complete end of all the nations to which I have driven you**, but I will not make a complete end of you.
I will rightly correct you, for I will not leave you wholly unpunished.”

Habakkuk 3:2 O LORD ... revive Your work in the midst of the years!
In the midst of the years make it known; **in Wrath remember Mercy!**

2nd Corinthians 10:4 For **the Weapons of our warfare** are not carnal
but Mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 10:5 casting down arguments
and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God,
bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Messiah,

James 1:2 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,
1:3 knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. 1:4 But
let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete,
lacking nothing.

Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we
do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. 8:27
Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is,
because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

2nd Corinthians 4:17 For our **light affliction**, which is but for a moment,
is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory ...

James 1:19 So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift
to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath;

1 Peter 3:7 Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My Righteous Right Hand!’** 41:11 “Behold, all those who were incensed against you shall be ashamed and disgraced; They shall be as nothing, and those who strive with you shall perish. 41:12 You shall seek them and not find them — those who contended with you. Those who war against you shall be as nothing, as a nonexistent thing. 41:13 For I, the LORD your God, will hold your right hand, saying to you, ‘**Fear not, I will help you!**’ 41:14 “**‘Fear not, you worm Jacob, you men of Israel! I will help you,**” says the LORD and your Redeemer, **the Holy One of Israel.** 41:15 “Behold, I will make you into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth; You shall thresh the mountains and beat them small, and make the hills like chaff. 41:16 You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them; You shall Rejoice in the LORD, and glory **in the Holy One of Israel.**”

Isaiah 54:17 “**No weapon formed against you shall prosper**, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn! This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their Righteousness is from Me,” says the LORD.

Deuteronomy 33:27 **The Eternal God is your Refuge**, and underneath are the Everlasting Arms; He will thrust out the enemy from before you, and will say, ‘Destroy!’ 33:28 Then Israel shall dwell in safety ...

Psalm 89:20 “I have found My servant David (put in your own name); With My holy oil I have anointed him, 89:21 **with whom My Hand shall be established; also My Arm shall Strengthen him.** 89:22 The enemy shall not outwit him, nor the son of wickedness afflict him. 89:23 I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague those who hate him. 89:24 **But My Faithfulness and My Mercy shall be with him, and in My name (Yeshua) his horn shall be exalted!**”

Psalm 91:7 “A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; but it shall not come near you. 91:8 Only with your eyes shall you look, and see the reward of the wicked. 91:9 Because you have made the LORD, who is my Refuge, even **the Most High, your dwelling place,** 91:10 **no evil shall befall you, nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;** 91:11 For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways. 91:12 In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone.” (See page 19)

Acts 1:7 And He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. 1:8 **But you shall receive Power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; & you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, & in all Judea and Samaria, & to the end of the earth!**”

Mark 12:30 “**And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.**’ This is the first Commandment. 12:31 And the second, like it, is this: **‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’** There is no other Commandment greater than these.”

Deuteronomy 6:4 “**Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is One!** 6:5 **You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength!**”

Deuteronomy 30:20 “... that you may love the LORD your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days; & that you may dwell in the land which the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, to give them.”

Romans 5:7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. 5:8 **But God demonstrates His own Love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Messiah died for us.** 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His Blood, we shall be saved from Wrath through Him. 5:10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His Life. 12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned, for if by the one man’s offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of Grace and of the gift of Righteousness will reign in life through the One, Yeshua the Messiah!

Romans 6:4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, **that just as Messiah was raised from the dead by the Glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of Life.** 6:5 For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His Resurrection, 6:6 knowing this, that **our old man was crucified with Him,** that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. 6:7 For he who has died has been freed from sin. 6:8 **Now if we died with Messiah, we believe that we shall also live with Him,** 6:10 For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the Life that He lives, He lives to God. 6:11 Likewise **you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Messiah Yeshua our Lord.** 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under Grace!

Matthew 16:19 “**And I will give you the Keys of the Kingdom of Heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in Heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in Heaven!**” (see Mat 18:18)

Isaiah 1:18 “Come now, and let us reason together,” says the LORD, “Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool. 1:19 If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land; 1:20 But if you refuse and rebel, you shall be devoured by the sword;” For the mouth of the LORD has spoken.

Hebrews 10:35 Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. 10:36 For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: 10:37 “For yet a little while, and He who is coming will come and will not tarry. 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith; but if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.” 10:39 But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, **but of those who believe to the saving of the soul!**

Psalms 103:11 For as the heavens are high above the earth, **so great is His Mercy toward those who fear Him;** 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us!

Isaiah 55:9 “For as the heavens are higher than the earth, **so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.** 55:10 For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater, 55:11 So shall My Word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it. 55:12 For you shall go out with Joy, and be led out with Peace; the mountains and the hills shall break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.”

Seven Shofar Scriptures happen at the same moment as our Lord Yeshua returns into the earth's atmosphere with His Bride and the rest of His believing armies, **sounding the Last- Great Shofar Blast**: everyone is then **instantly changed into their Glorified bodies**: John 6:39;40;44. Zechariah 9:14 Then the LORD will be seen over them, and His arrow will go forth like lightning. **The Lord GOD (Yeshua) will blow the Shofar**, and go with whirlwinds from the south.

1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the Last Trumpet. For the Trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed! 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. 15:54 So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: **“Death is swallowed up in Victory!”**

Isaiah 27:13 So it shall be in that Day **the Great Trumpet (Shofar) will be blown**; They will come, who are about to perish in the land of Assyria, and they who are outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the Holy Mount (Zion) at Jerusalem.

3 more Scriptures: Matthew 24:27-31; Mark 13:26,27; 1 Thessalonians 4:16,17;

Micah 7:8 Do not rejoice over me, my enemy; When I fall, I will arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD will be a light to me!

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Messiah Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. 8:2 **For the Law of the Spirit of Life in Messiah Yeshua has made me free** from the law (torah) of sin and death. 8:3 For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, 8:4 **that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit**. 8:9 But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you!
